FIG. 3 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view thereof.

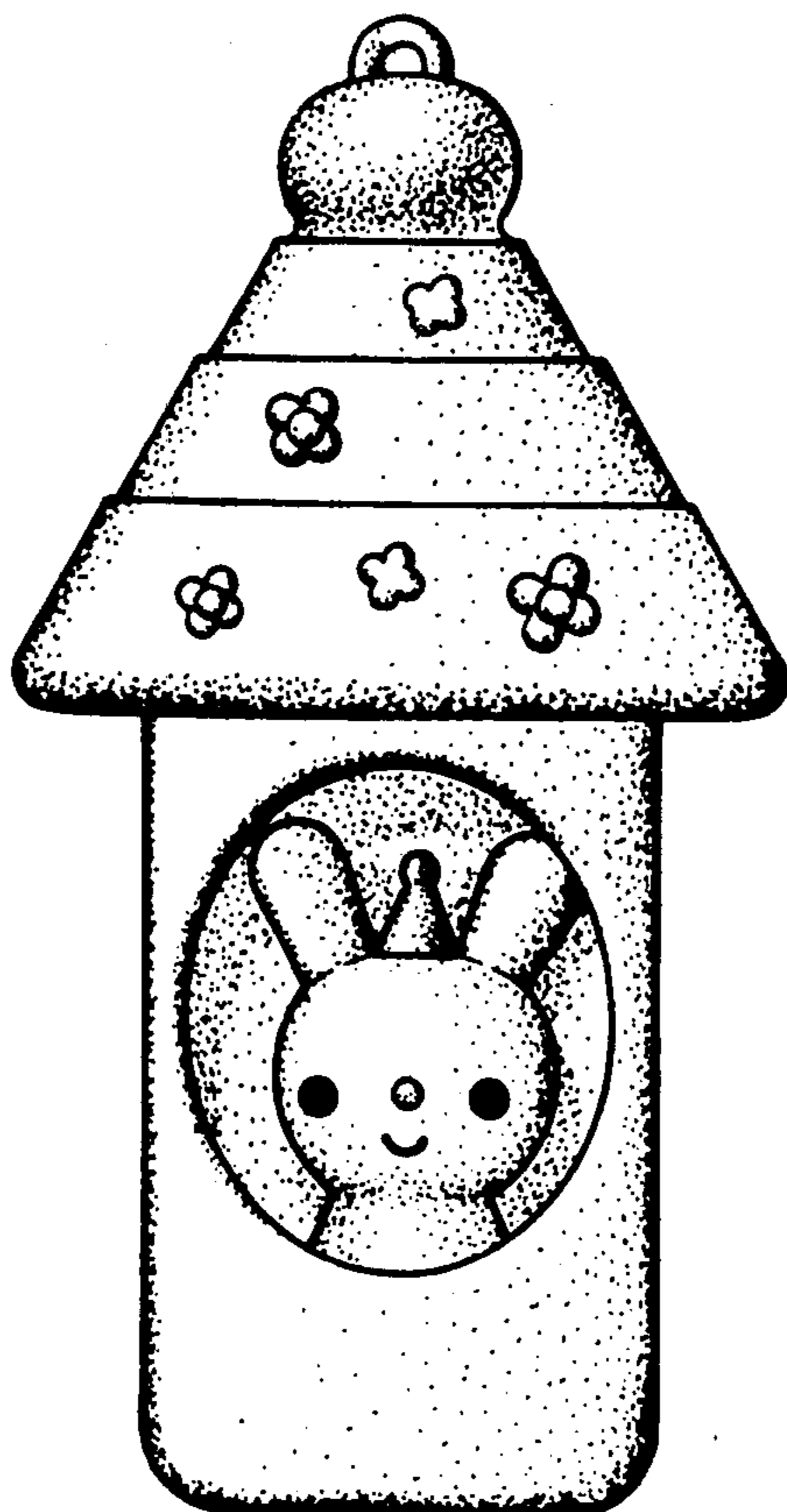

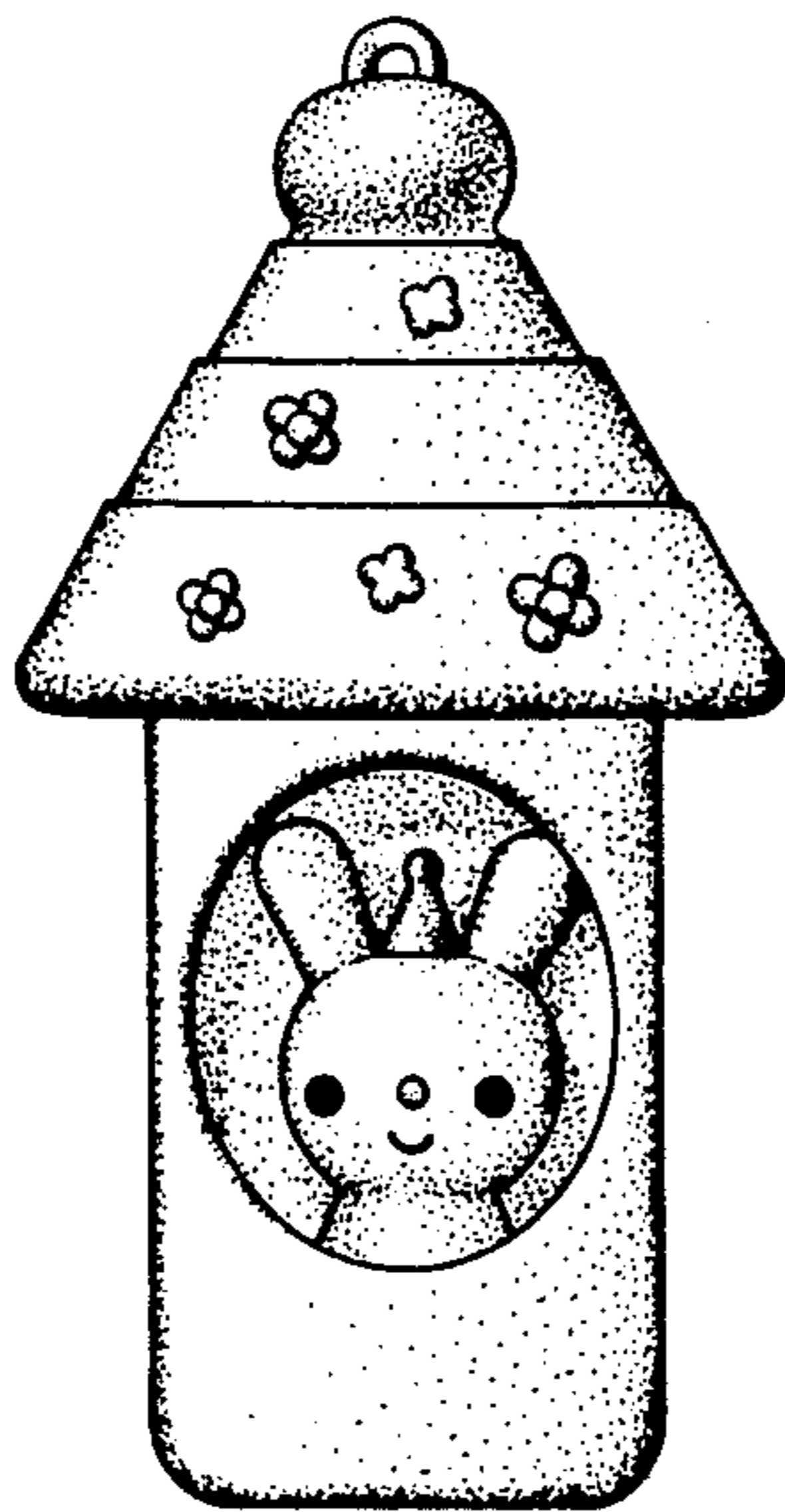

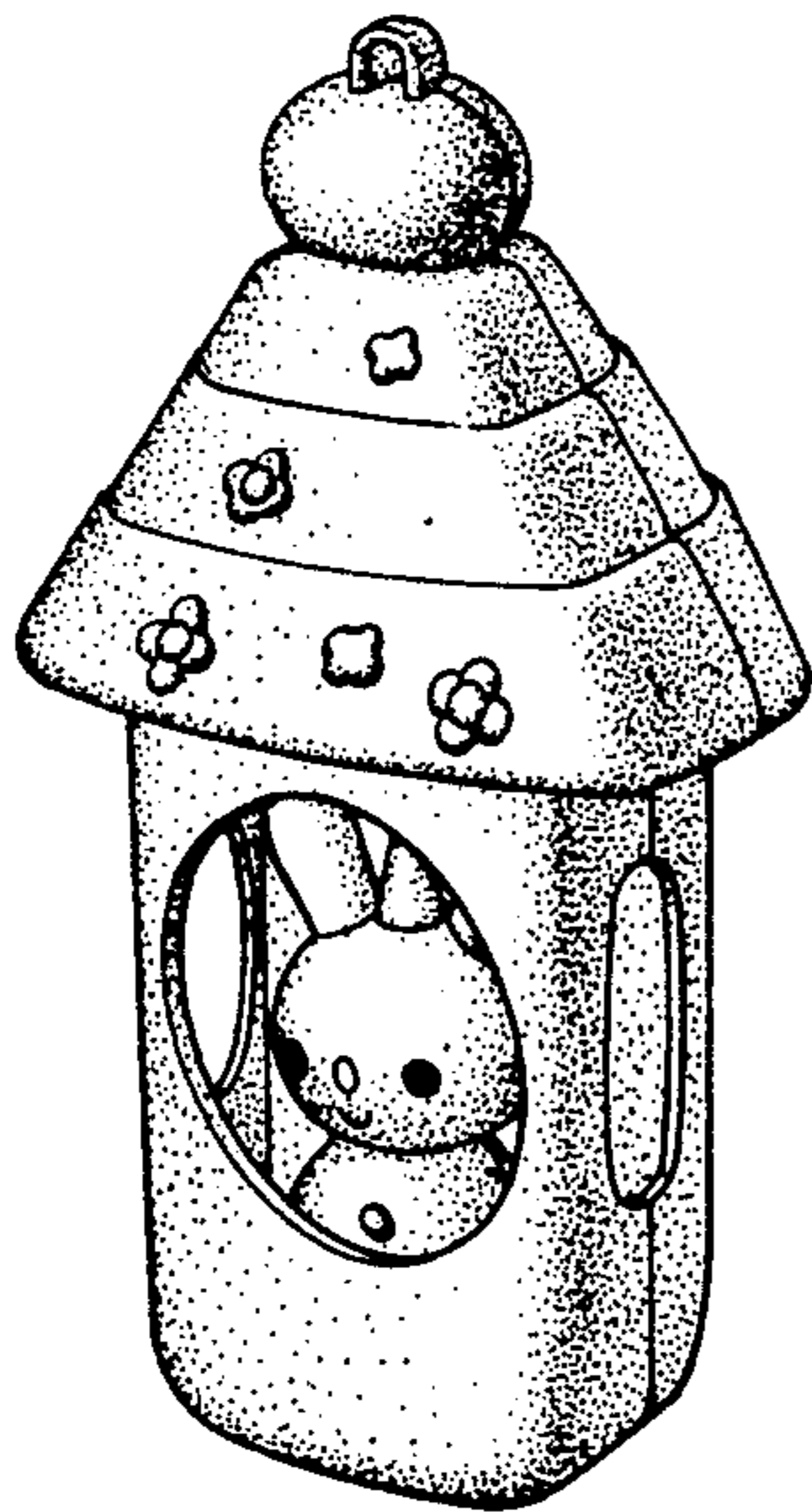
