DESCRIPTION

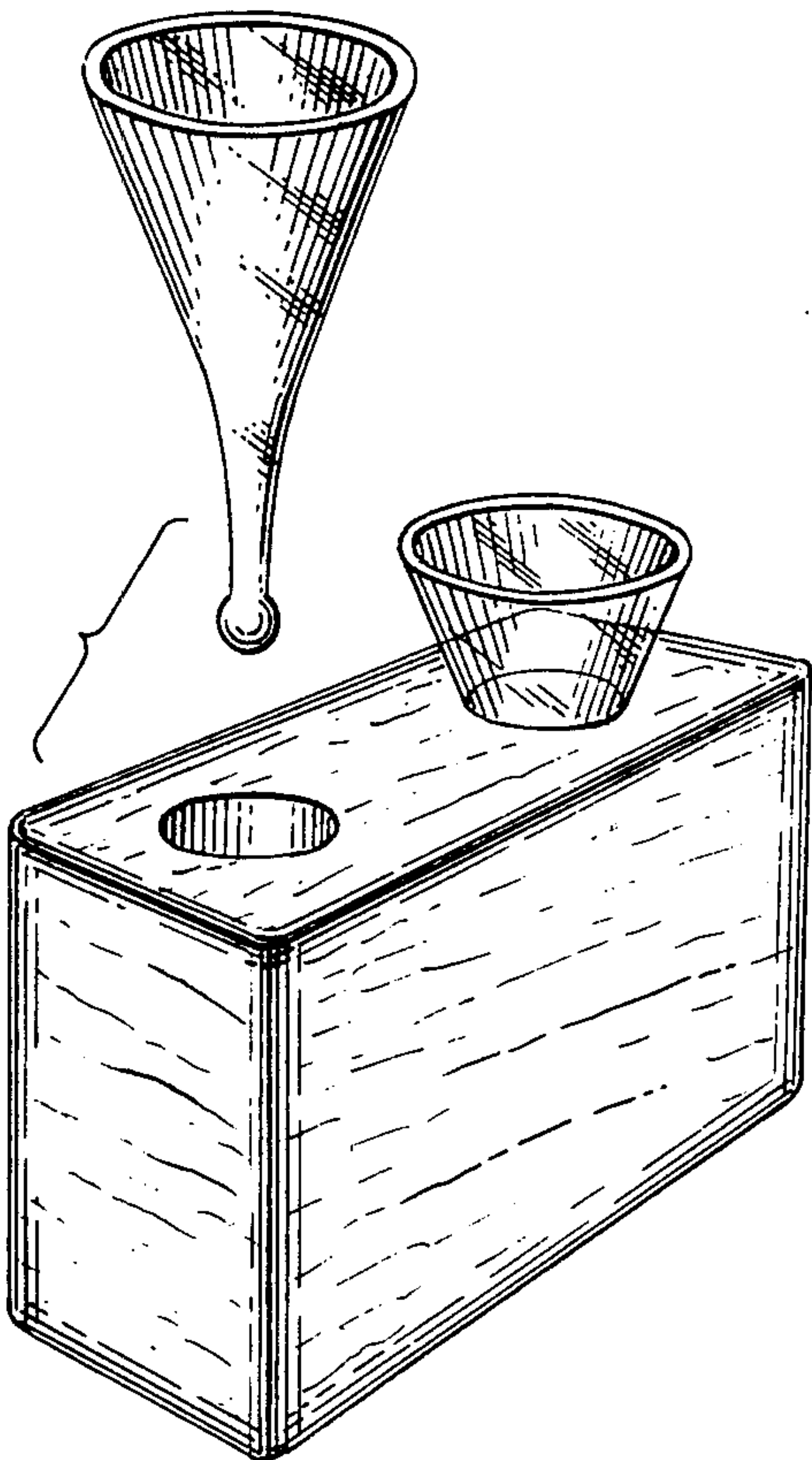
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of combined bever-

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof.



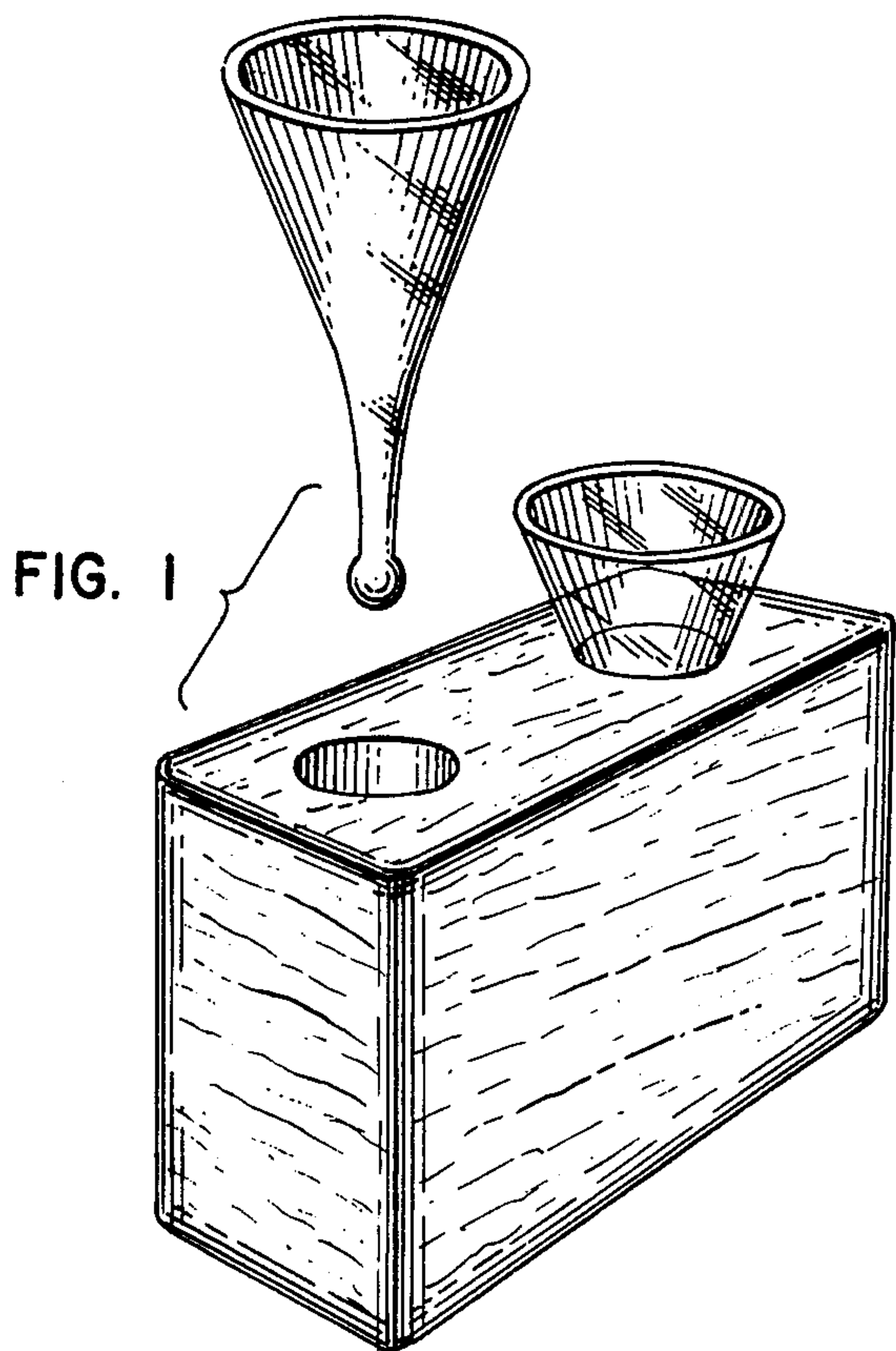

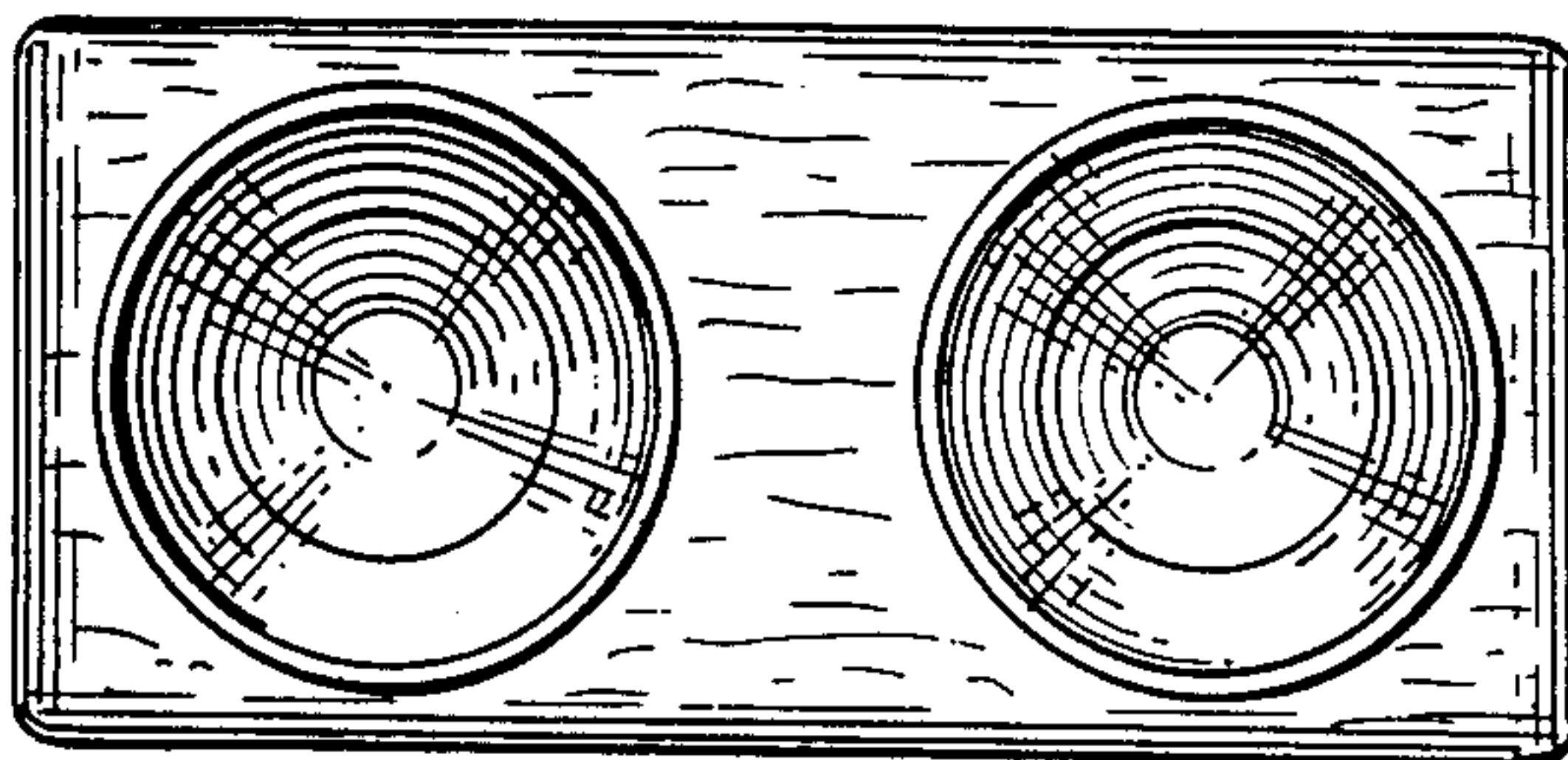

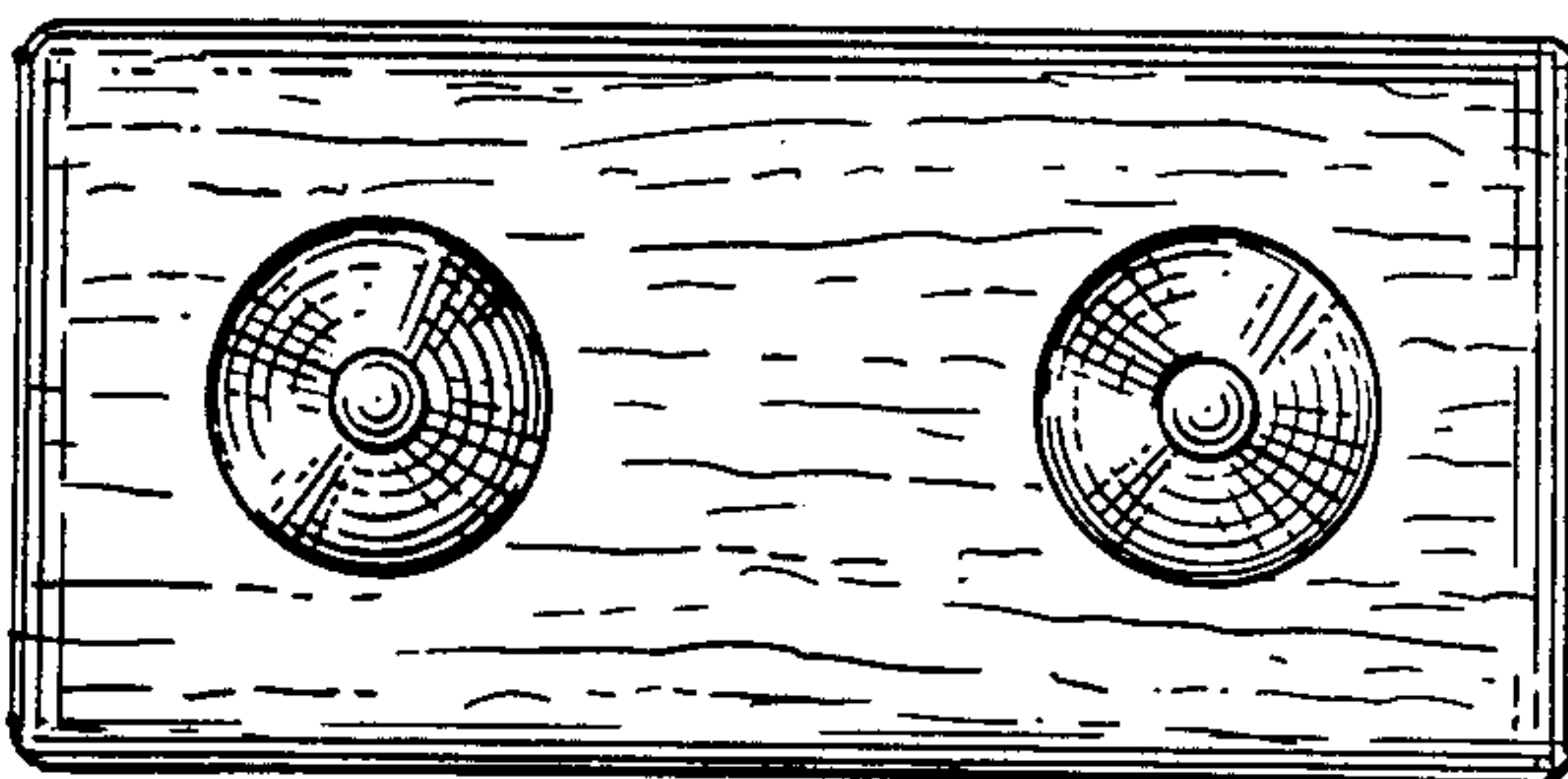

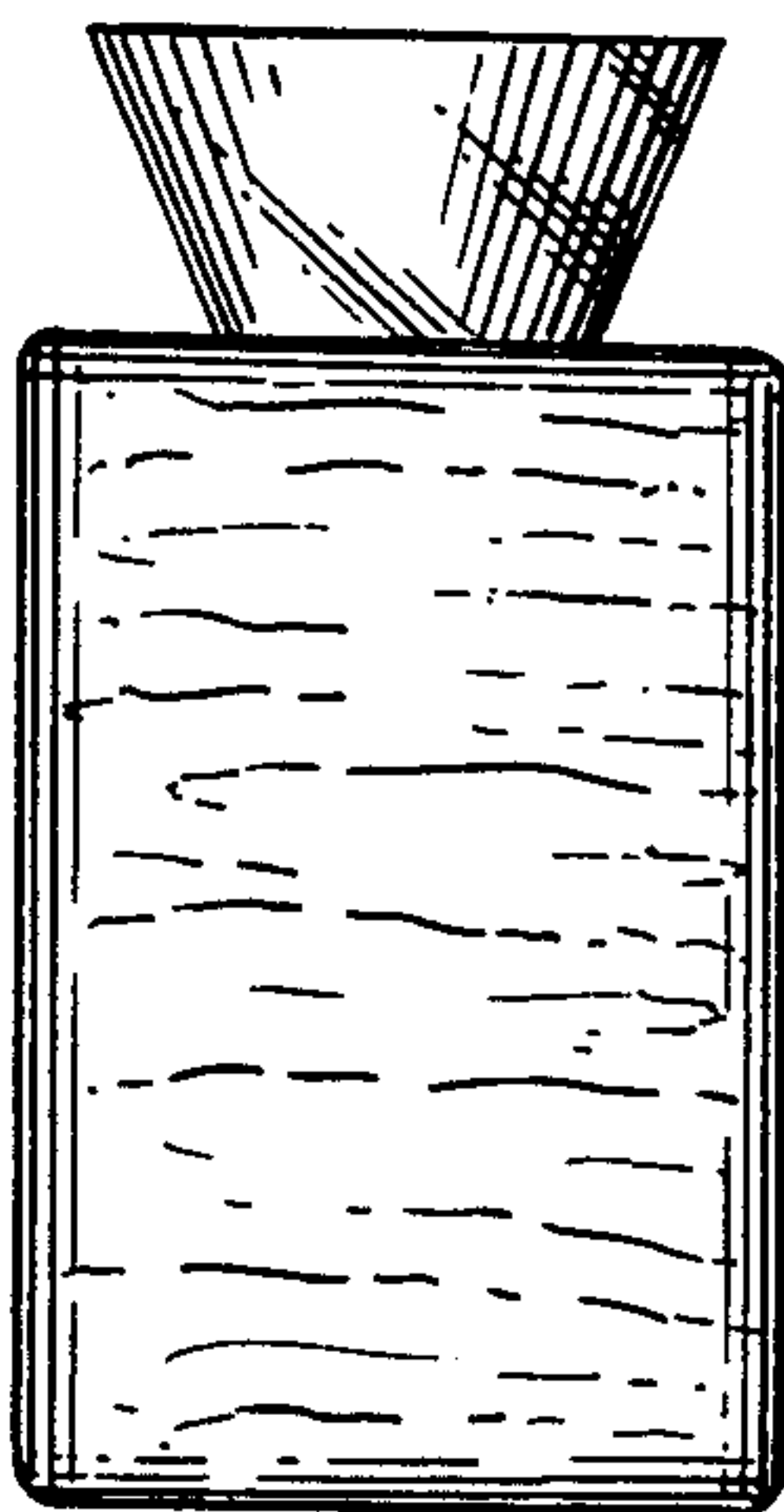
