The ornamental design for a base for a candle holder, lamp or similar article, substantially as shown and described

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a base for candle holder, lamp or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an end view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a side view thereof on an enlarged scale, the opposite side being identical; FIG. 4 is a top view thereof on an enlarged scale; and FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof on an enlarged scale.

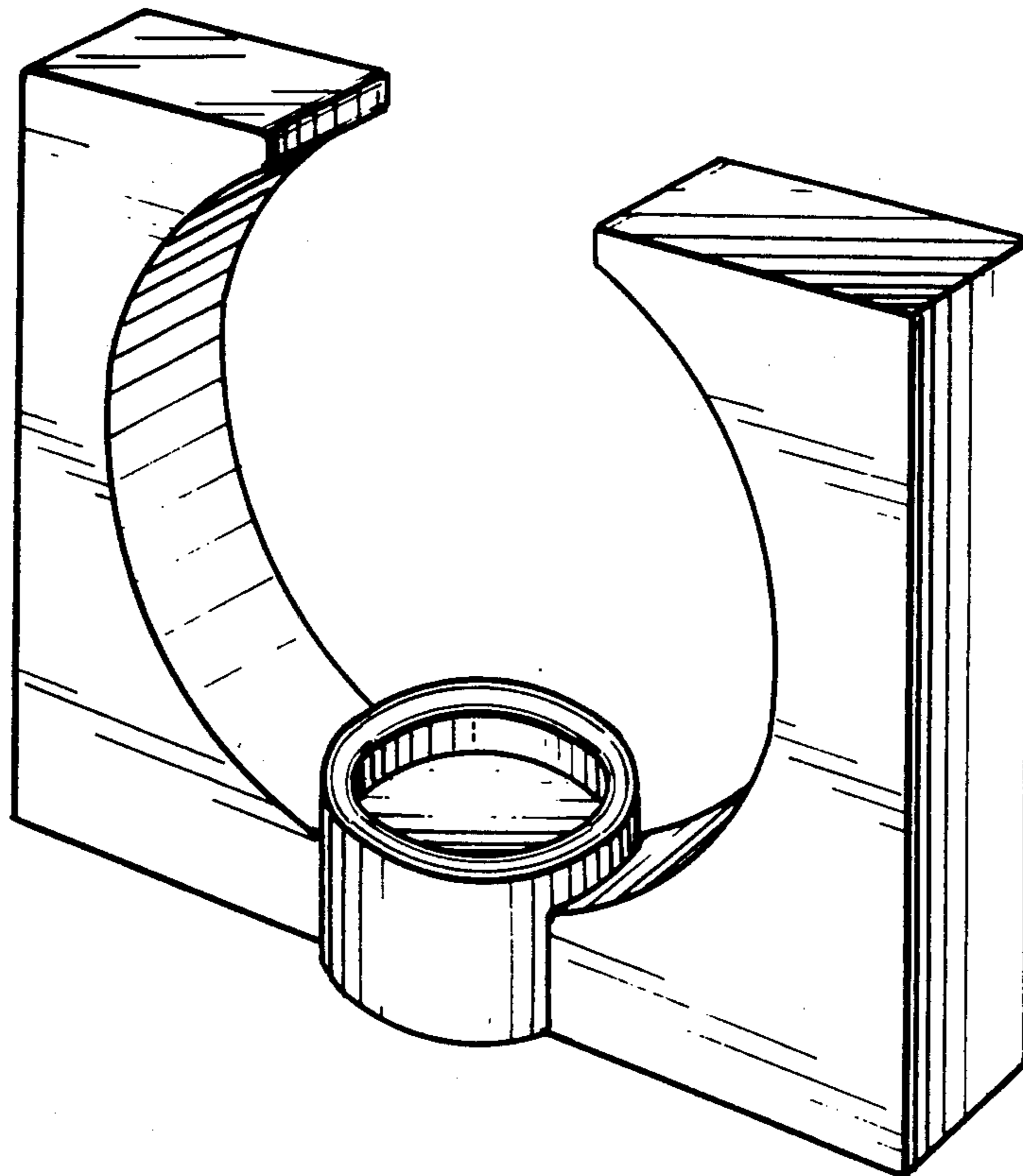

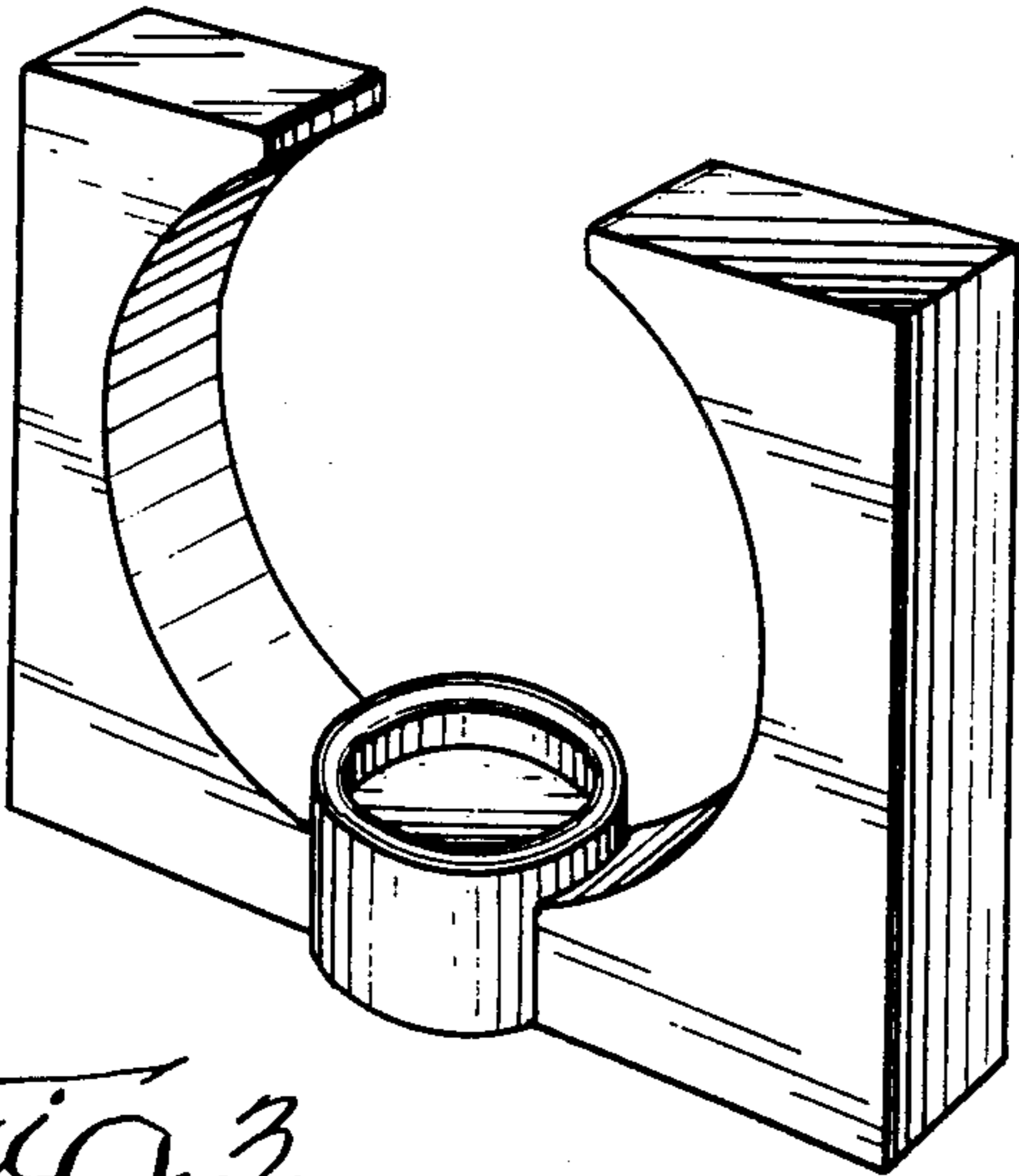

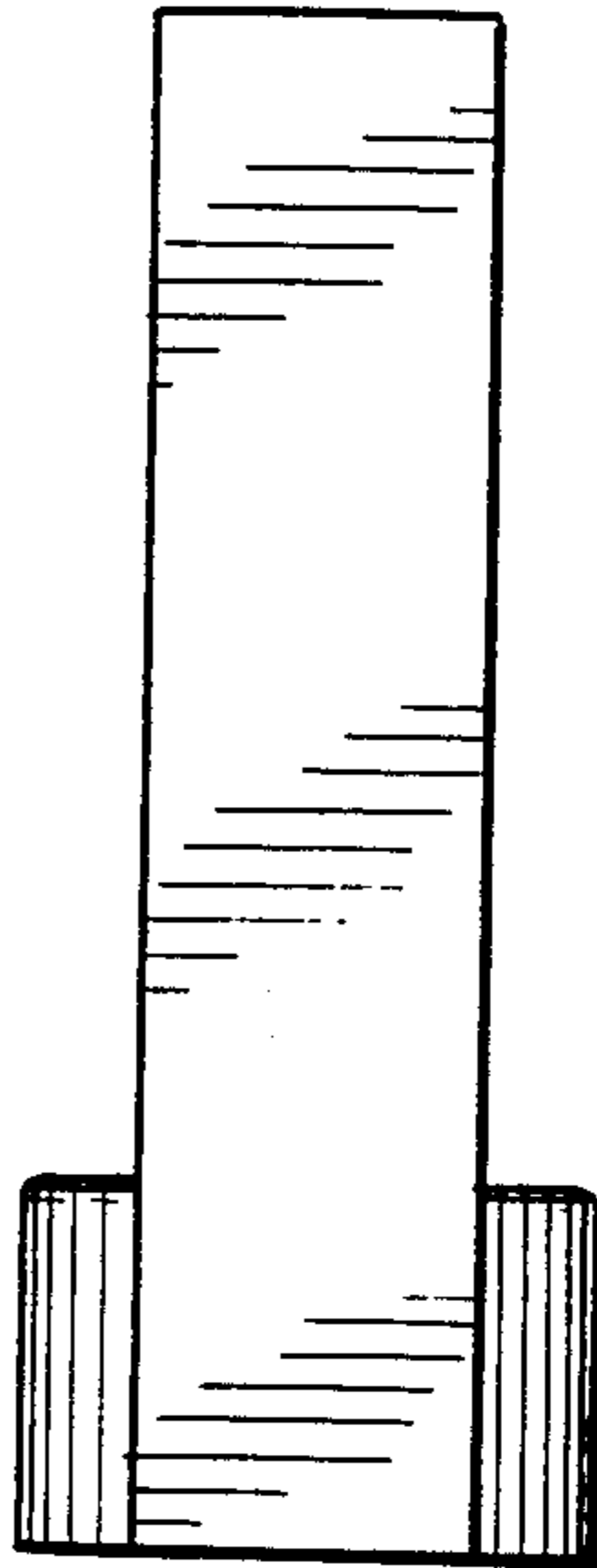

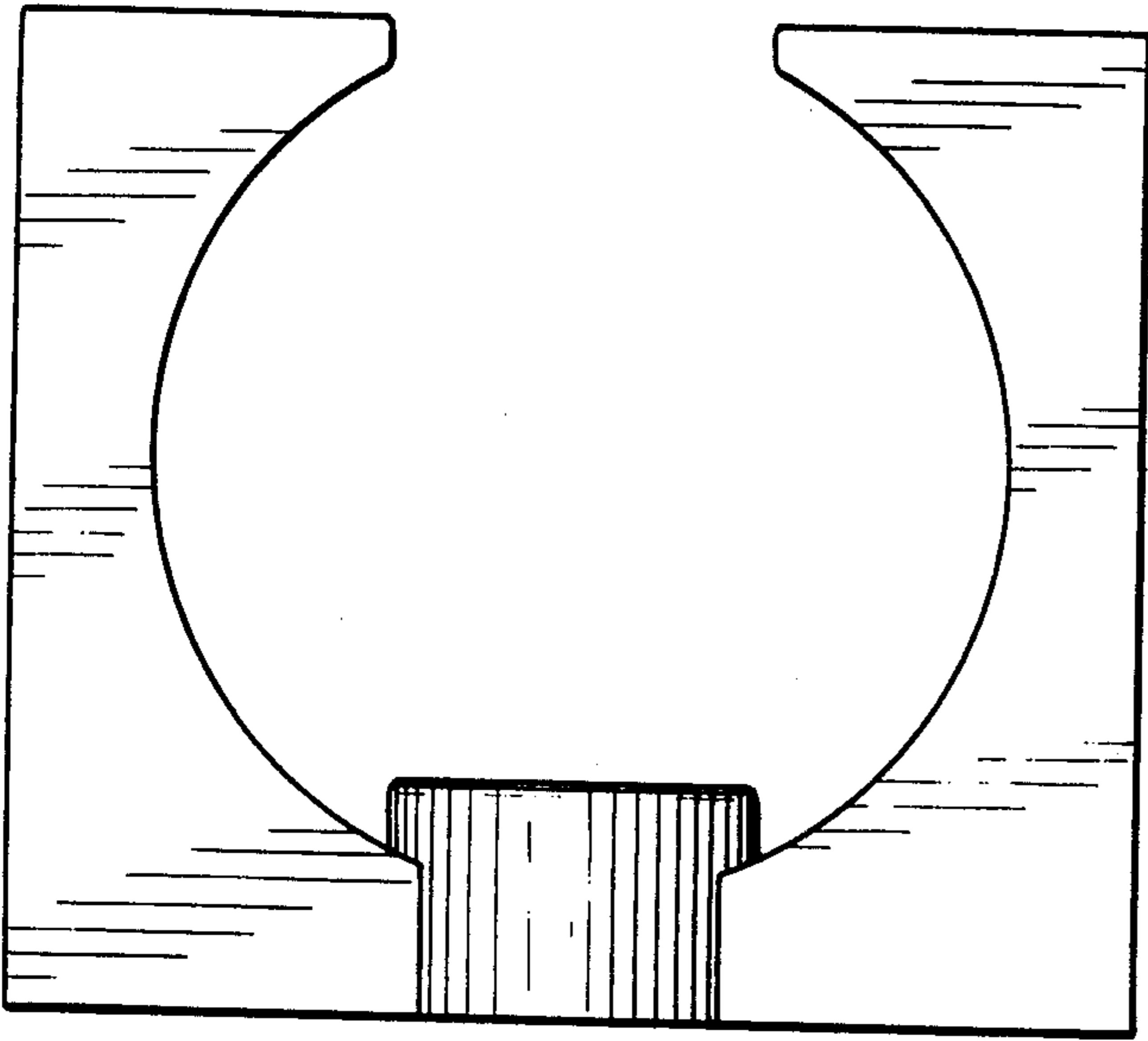

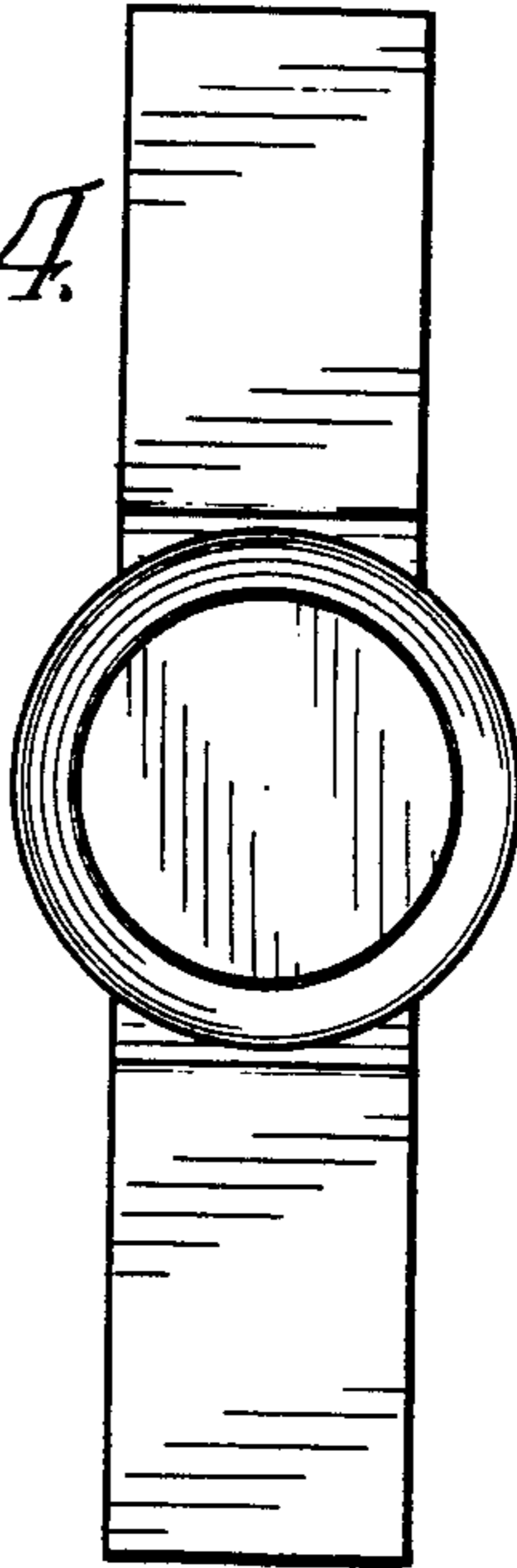
