FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the combined shelf and towel rings showing my new design;

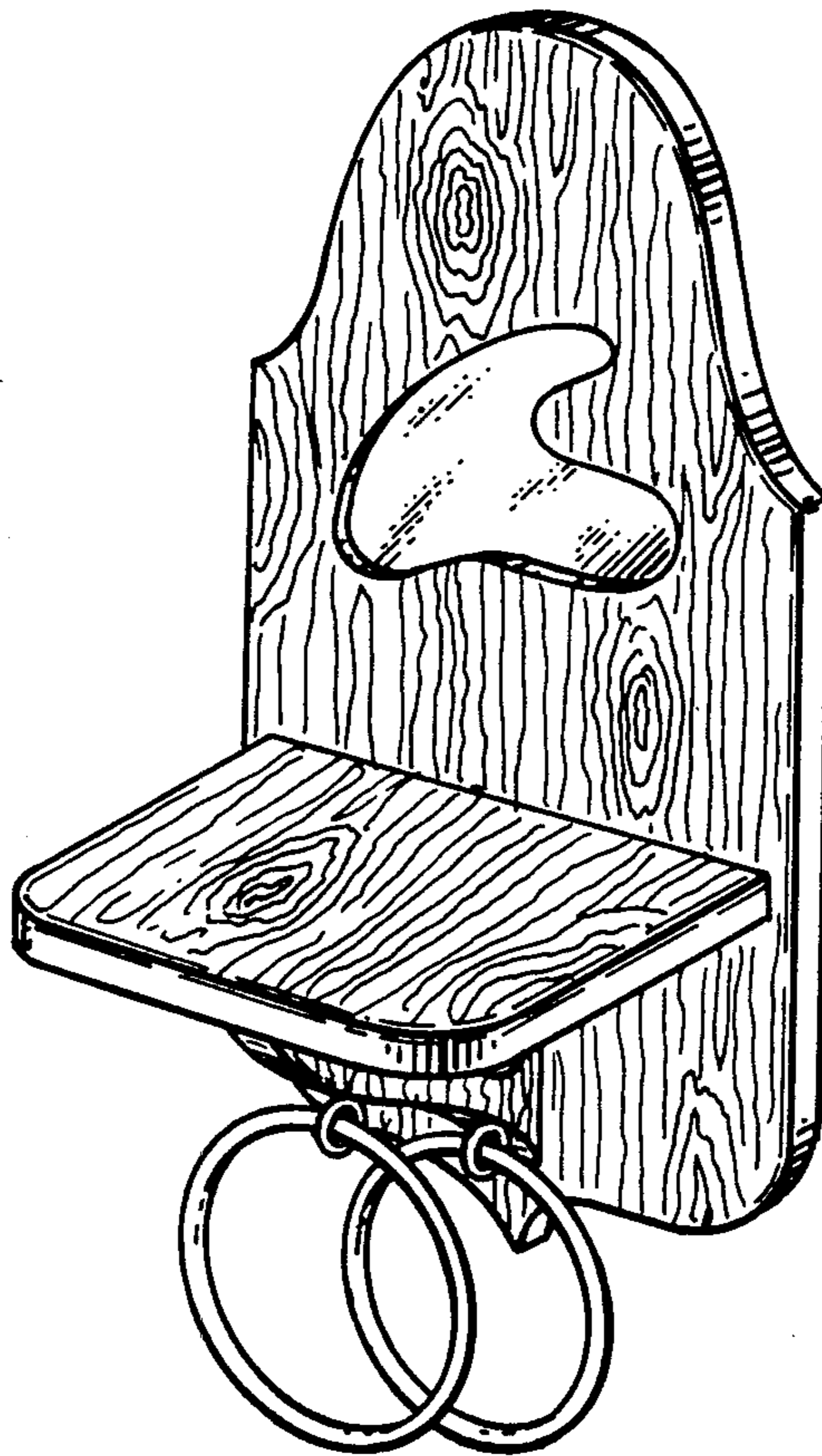

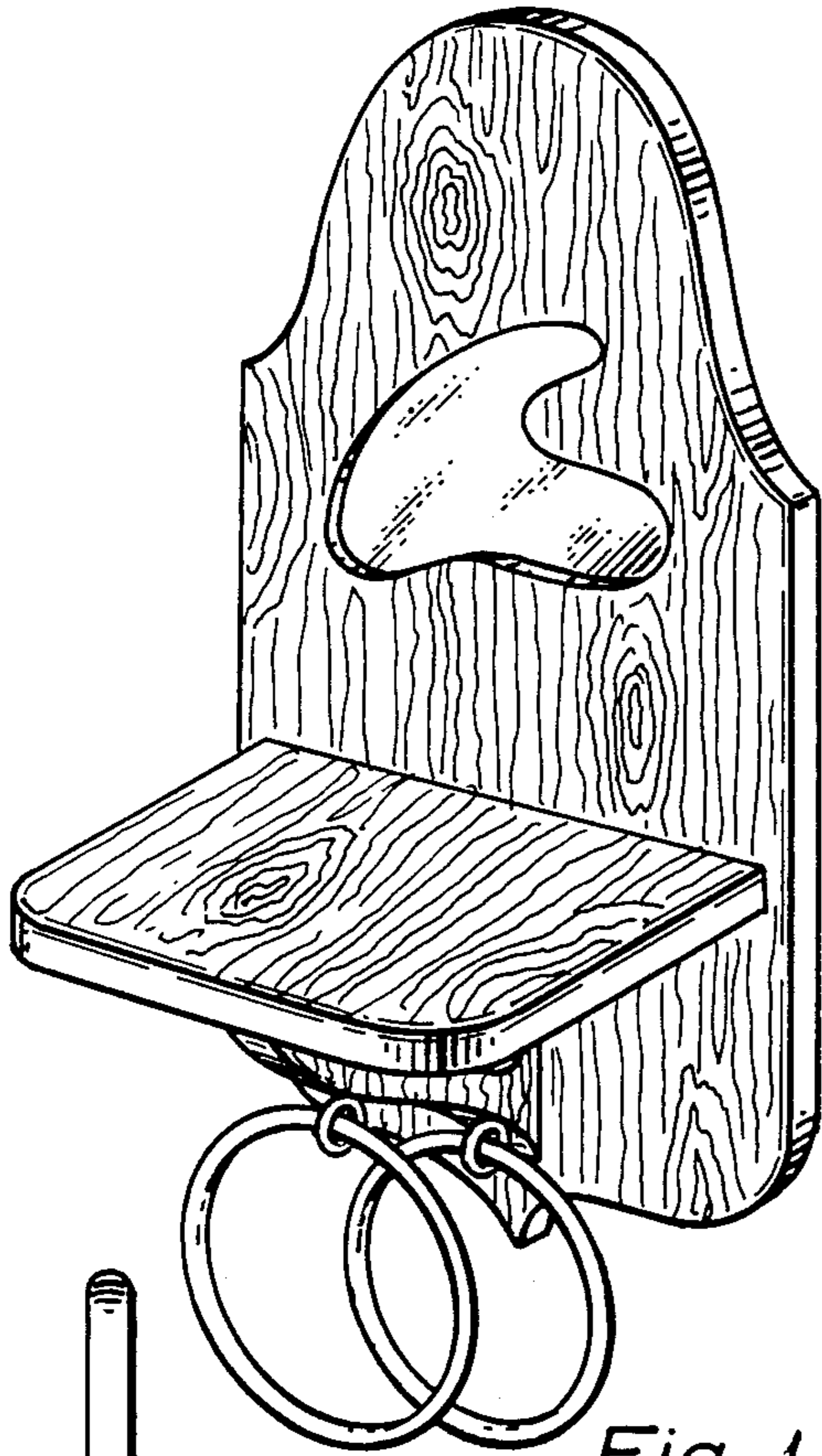

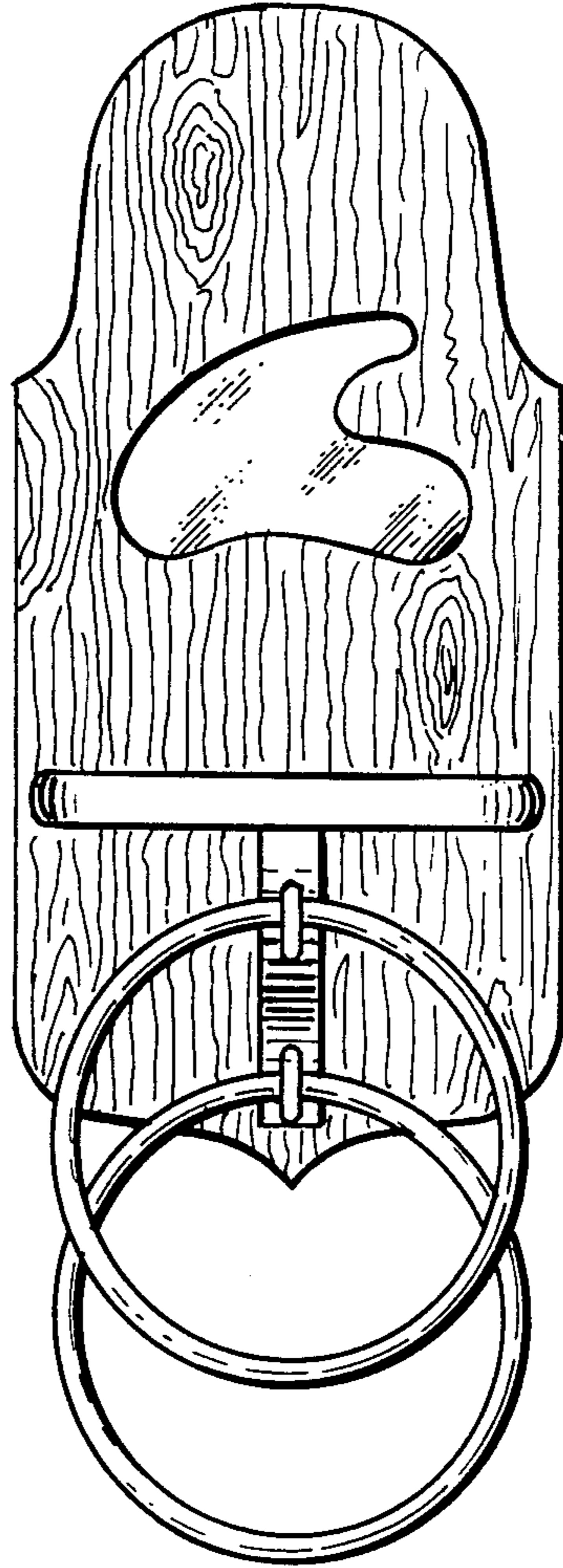

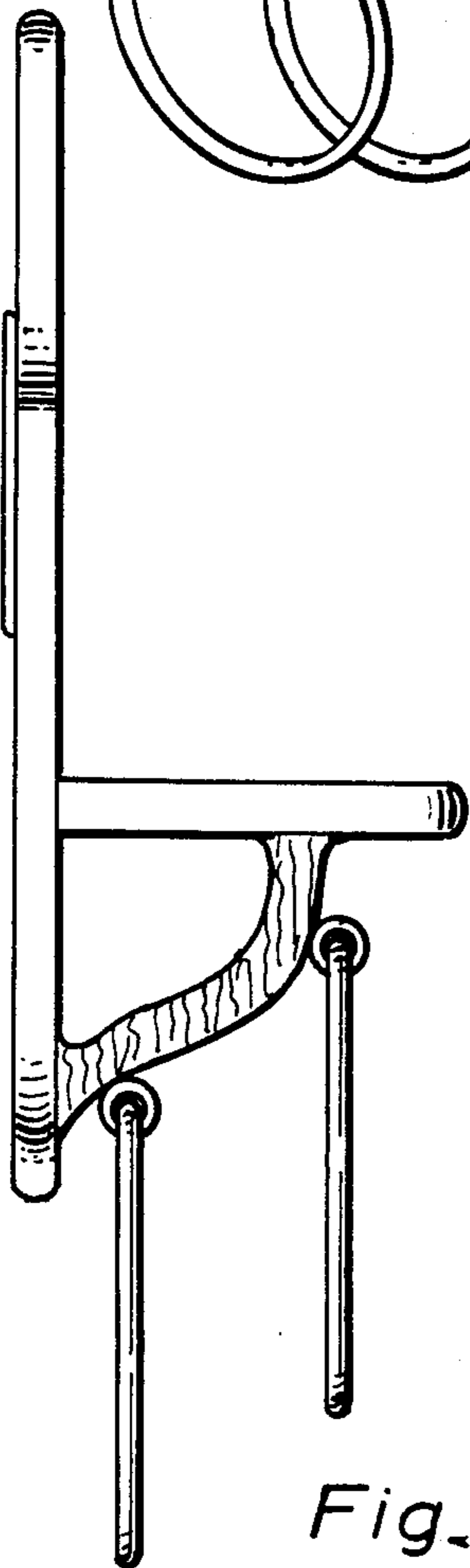

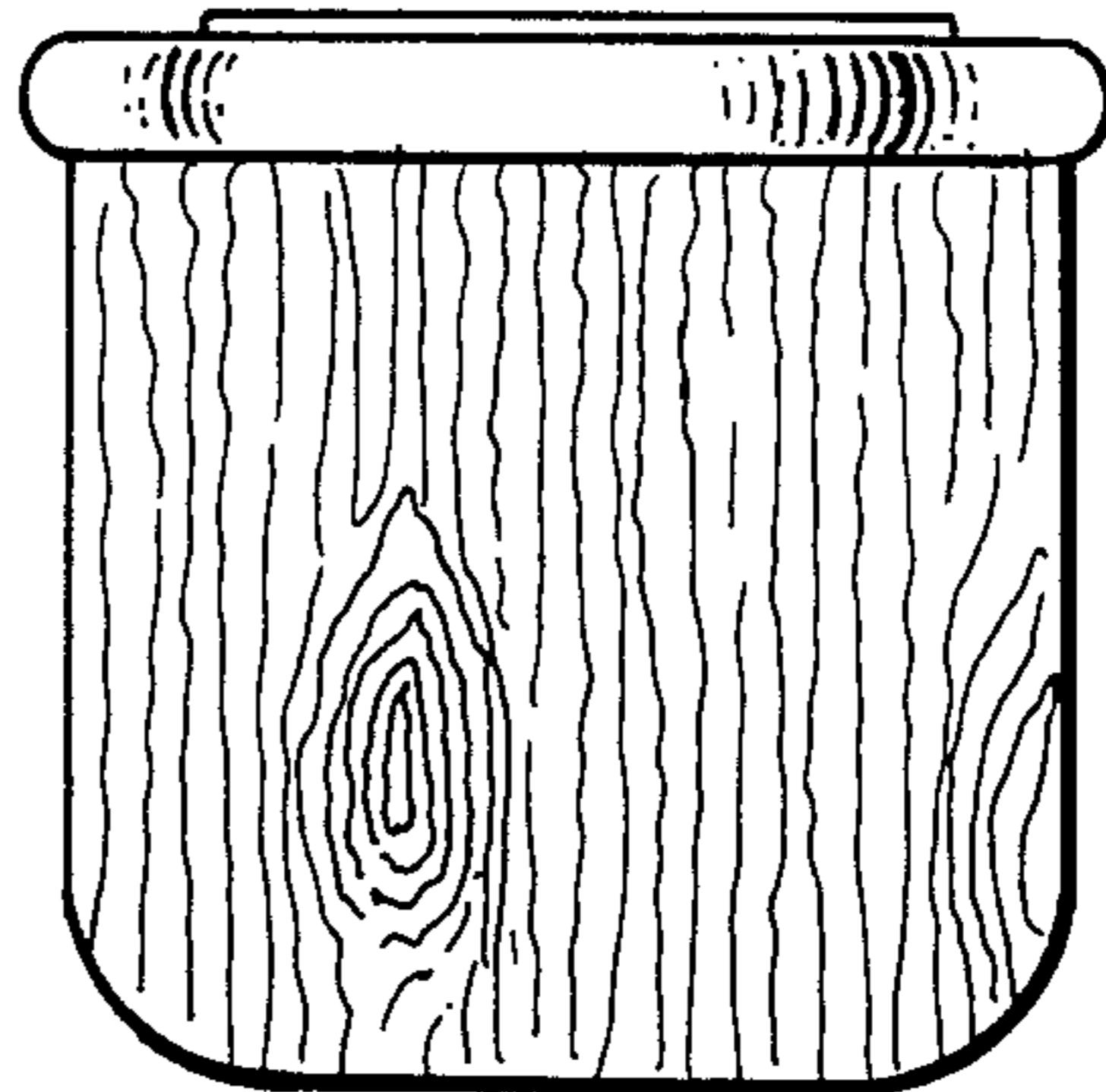
