[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined shelf and cabinet unit, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined shelf and cabinet unit showing my design; and FIG. 2 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1.

The rear of the combined shelf and cabinet unit is conventionally plain and unornamented.
