[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a jug, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a jug showing my new design with the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4 is an isometric view looking from above and the left of FIG. 1 at about a 45° angle;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

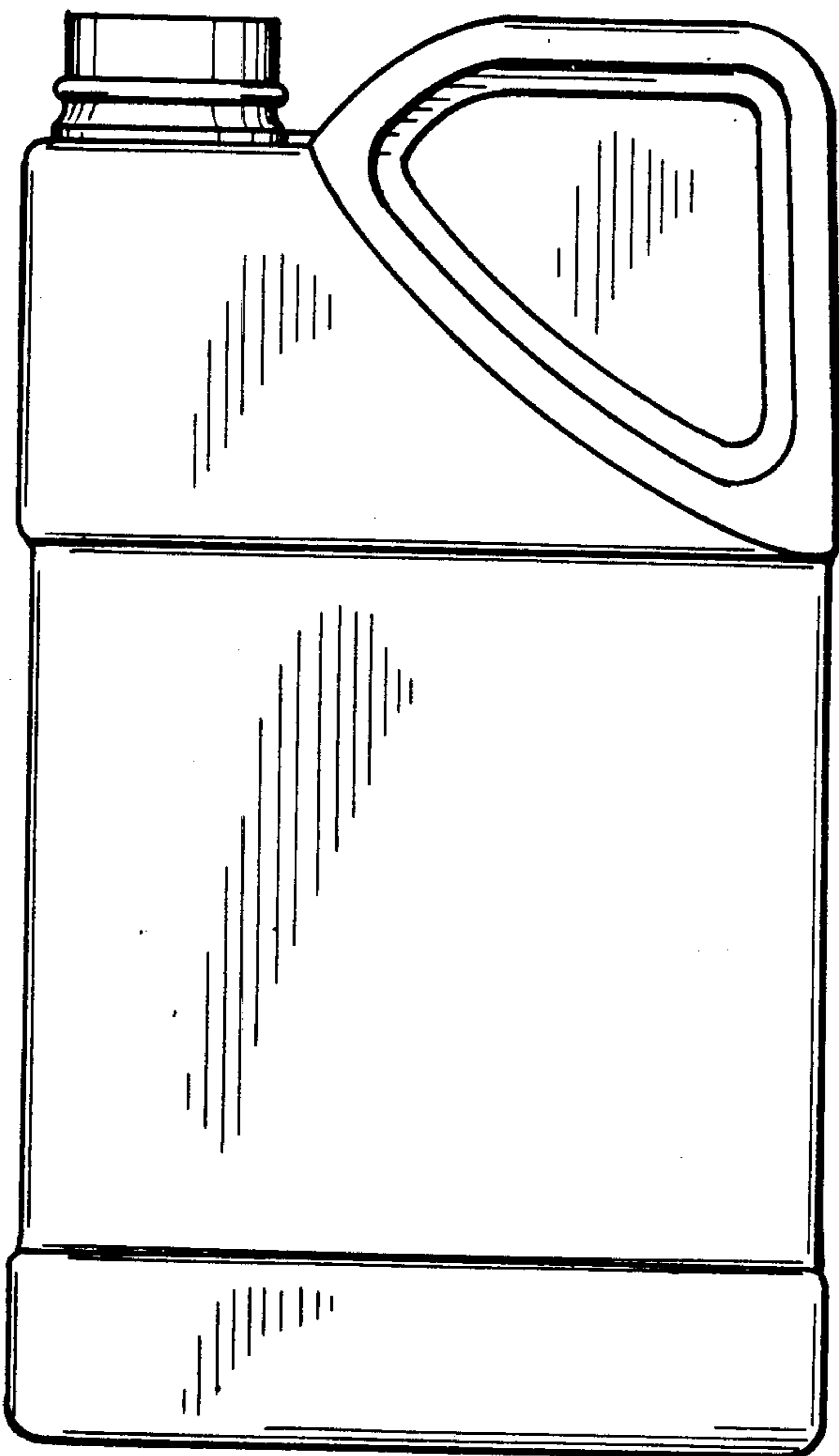

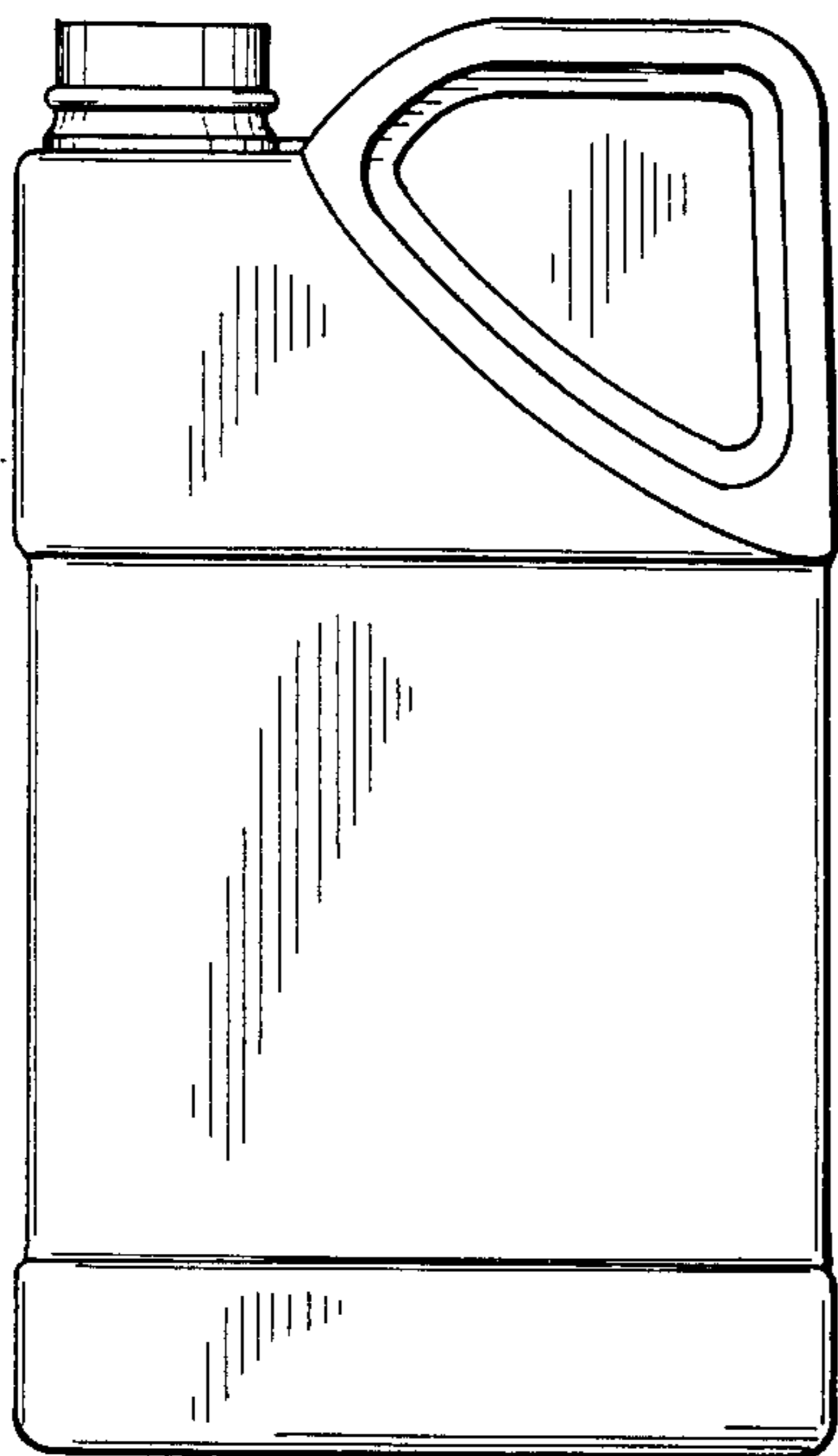

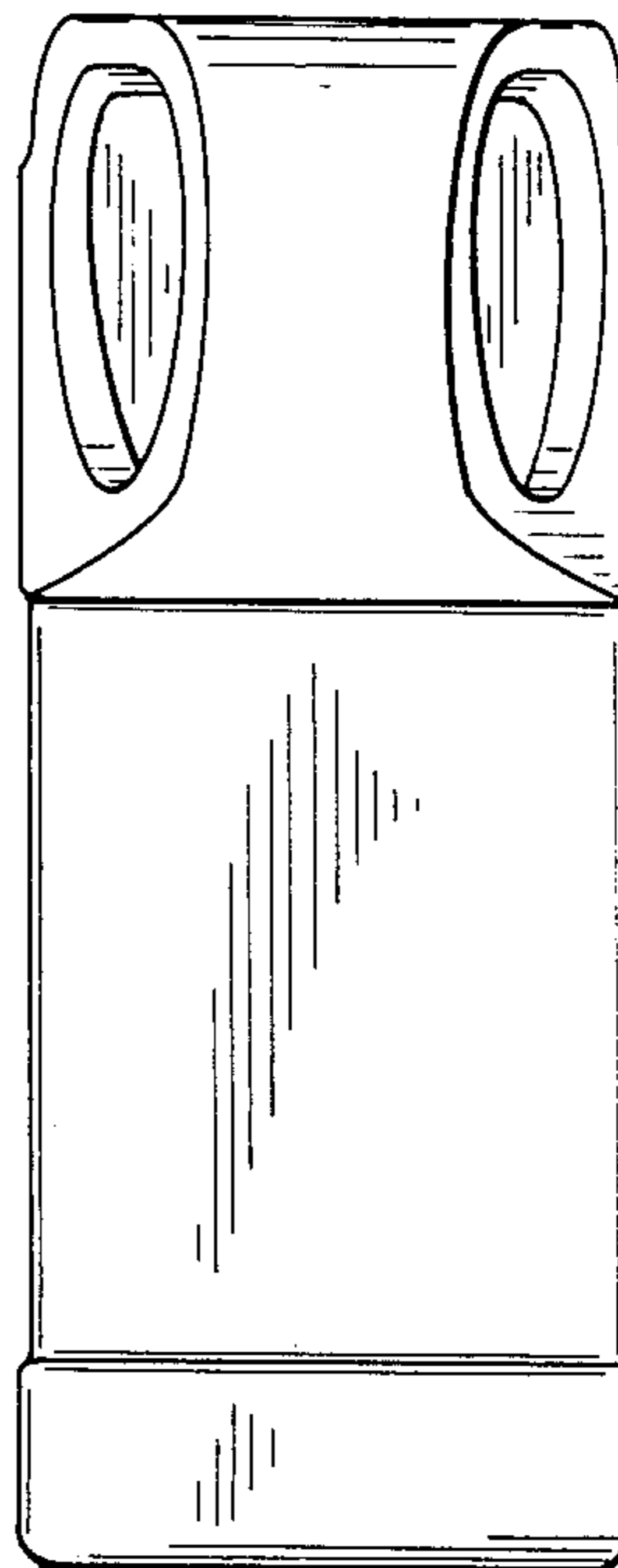

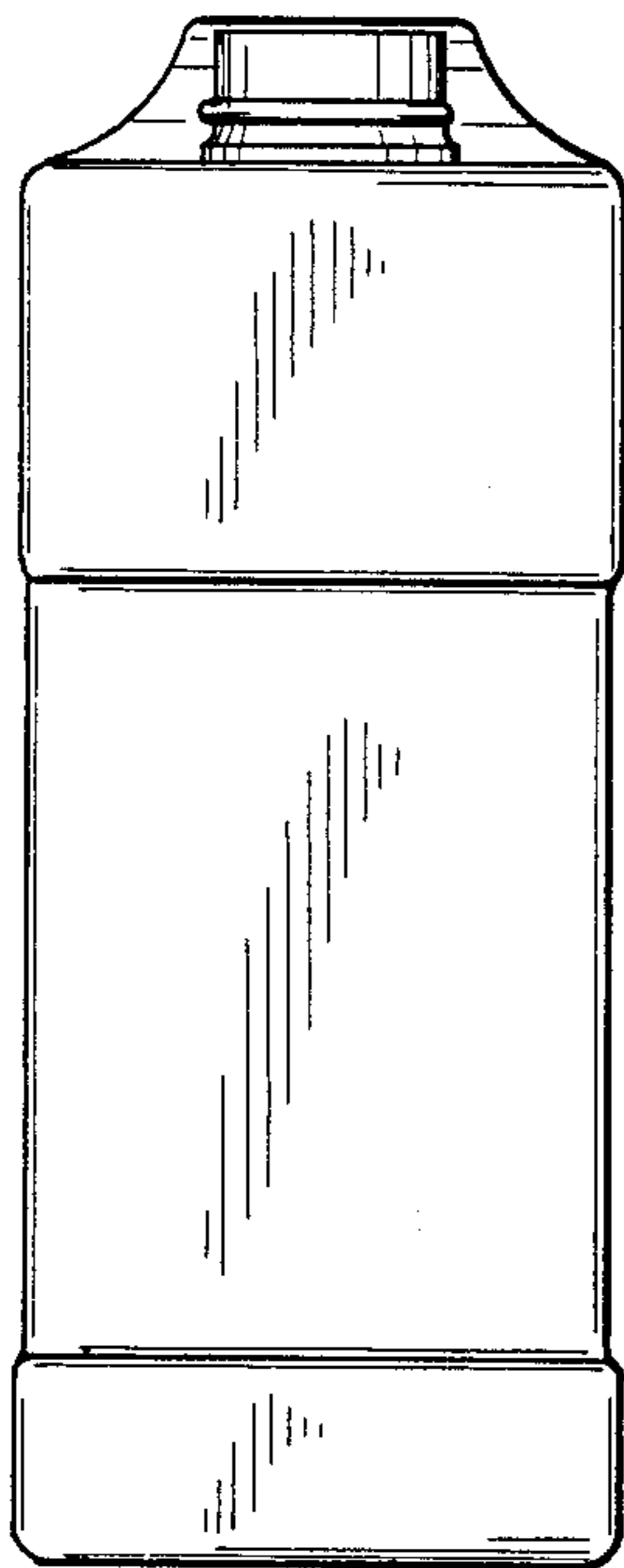

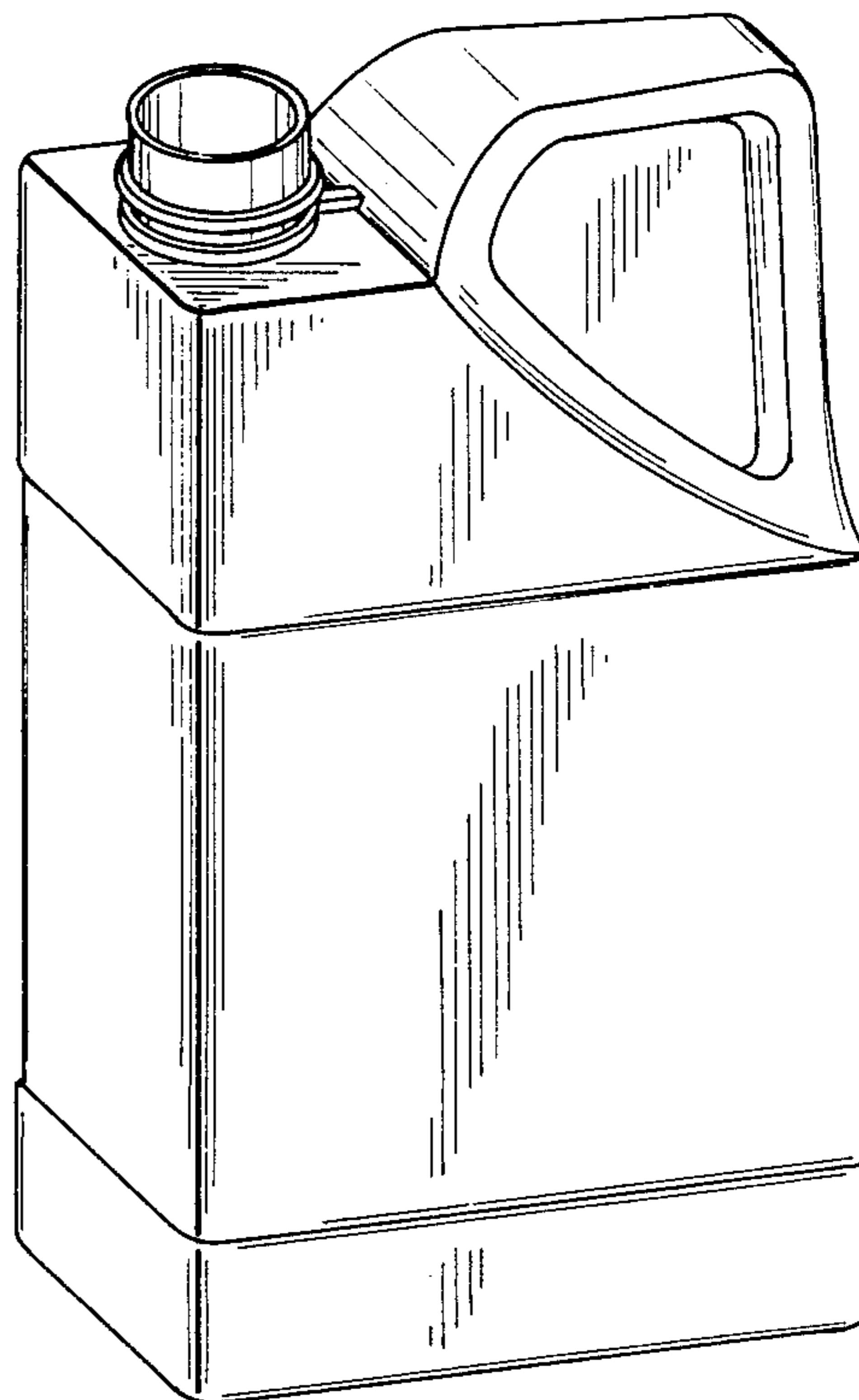
