CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle showing my new design, the other three sides being substantially the same in appearance;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and

FIG. 4 is a perspective view.

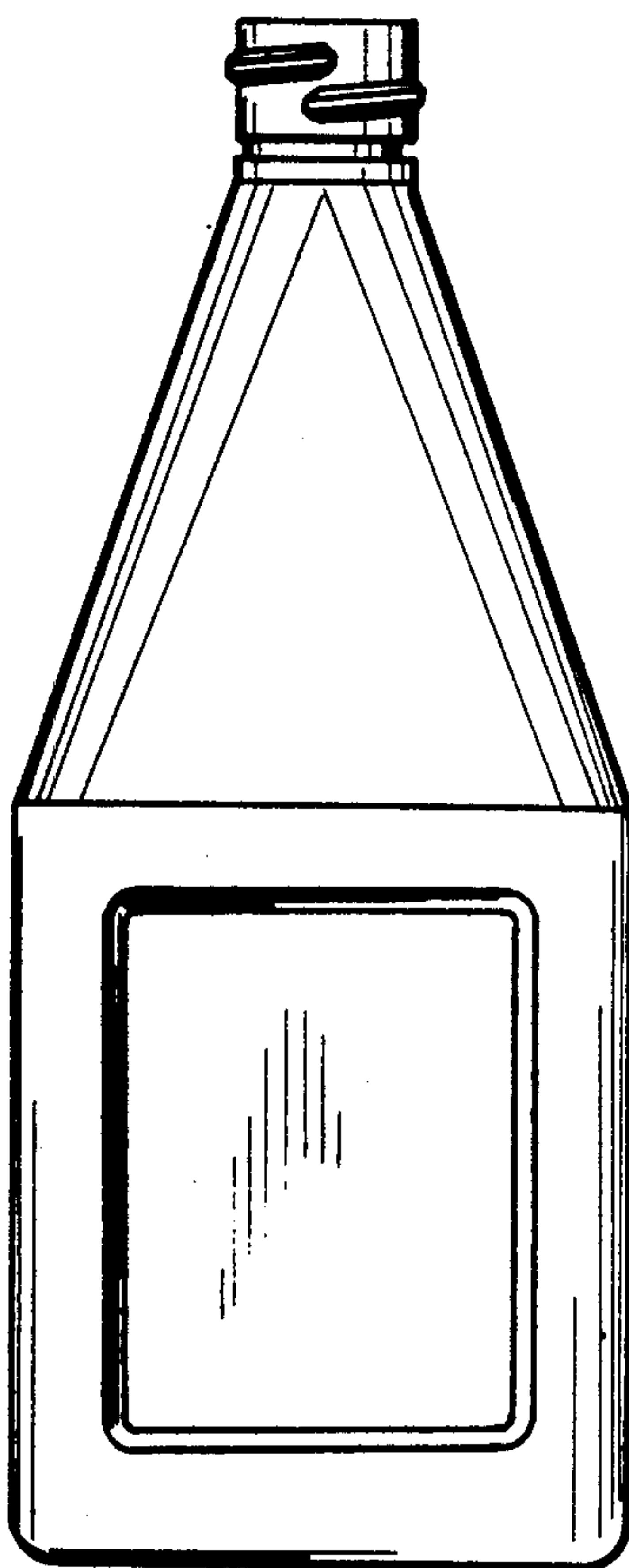

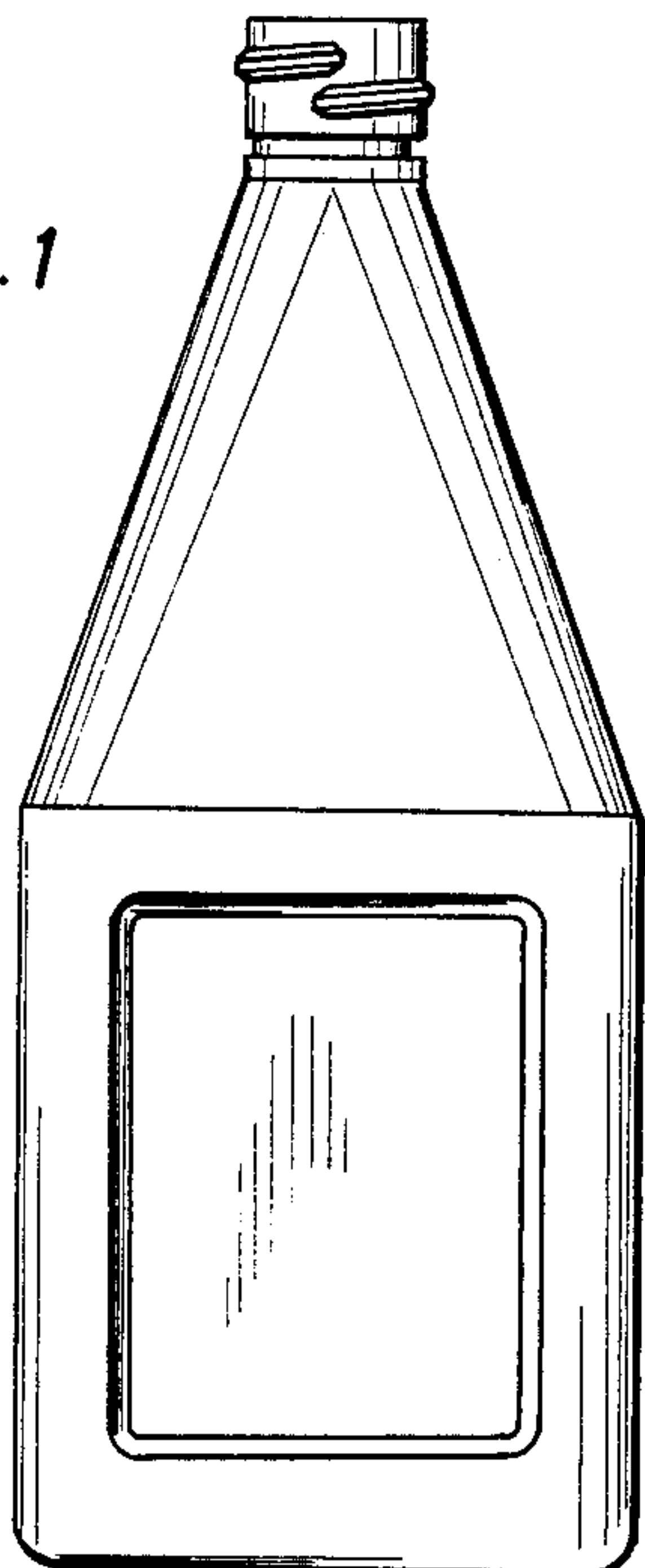

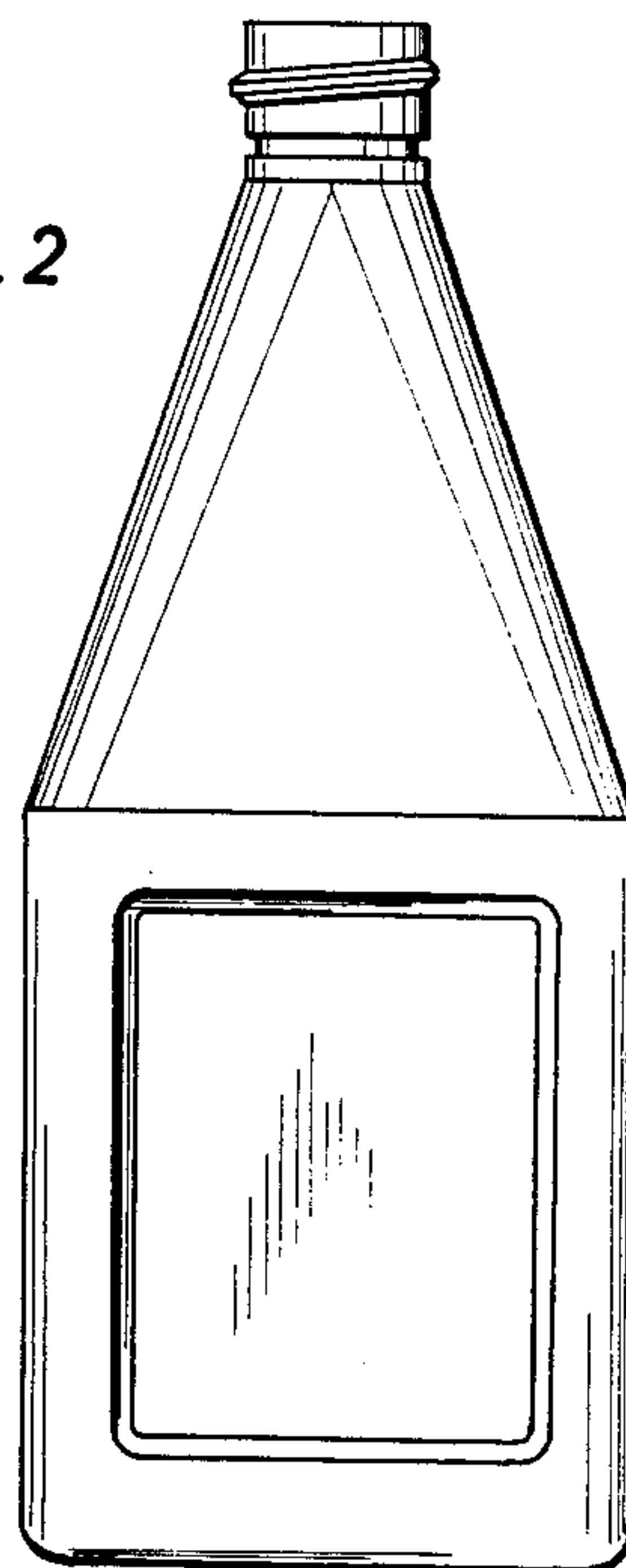

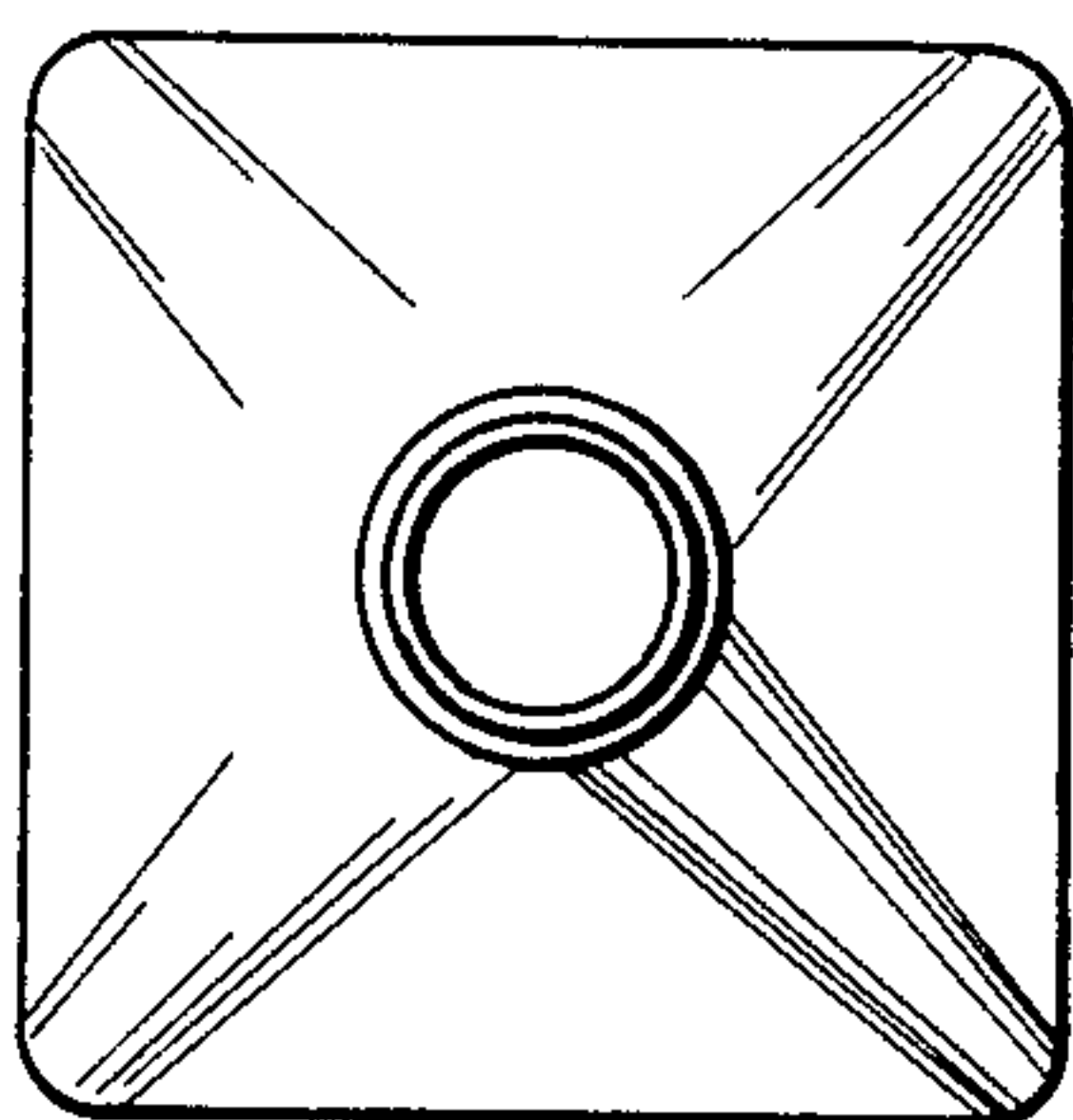
