The broken lines in FIG. 1 of the drawing are for illustrative purposes only.

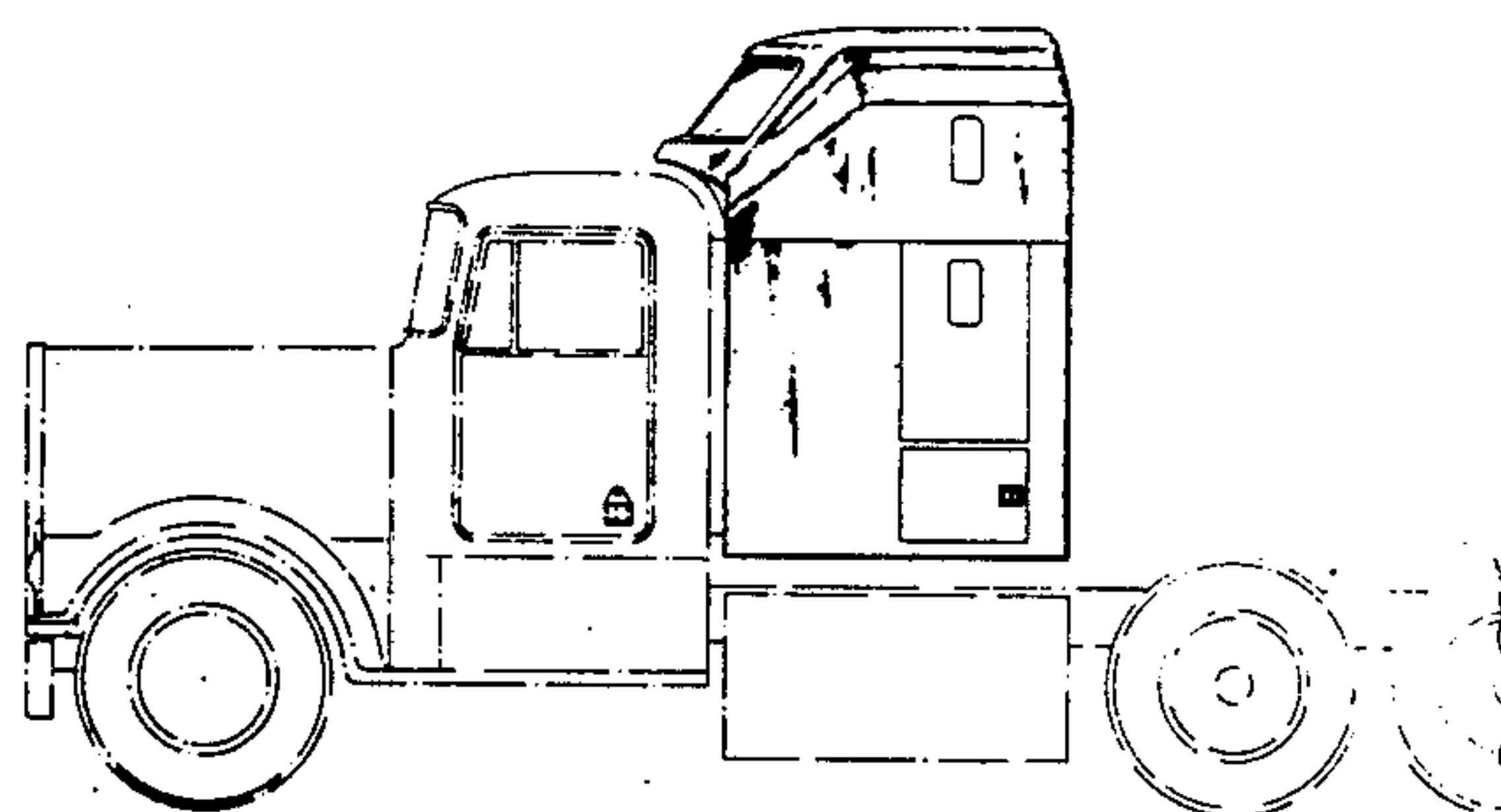
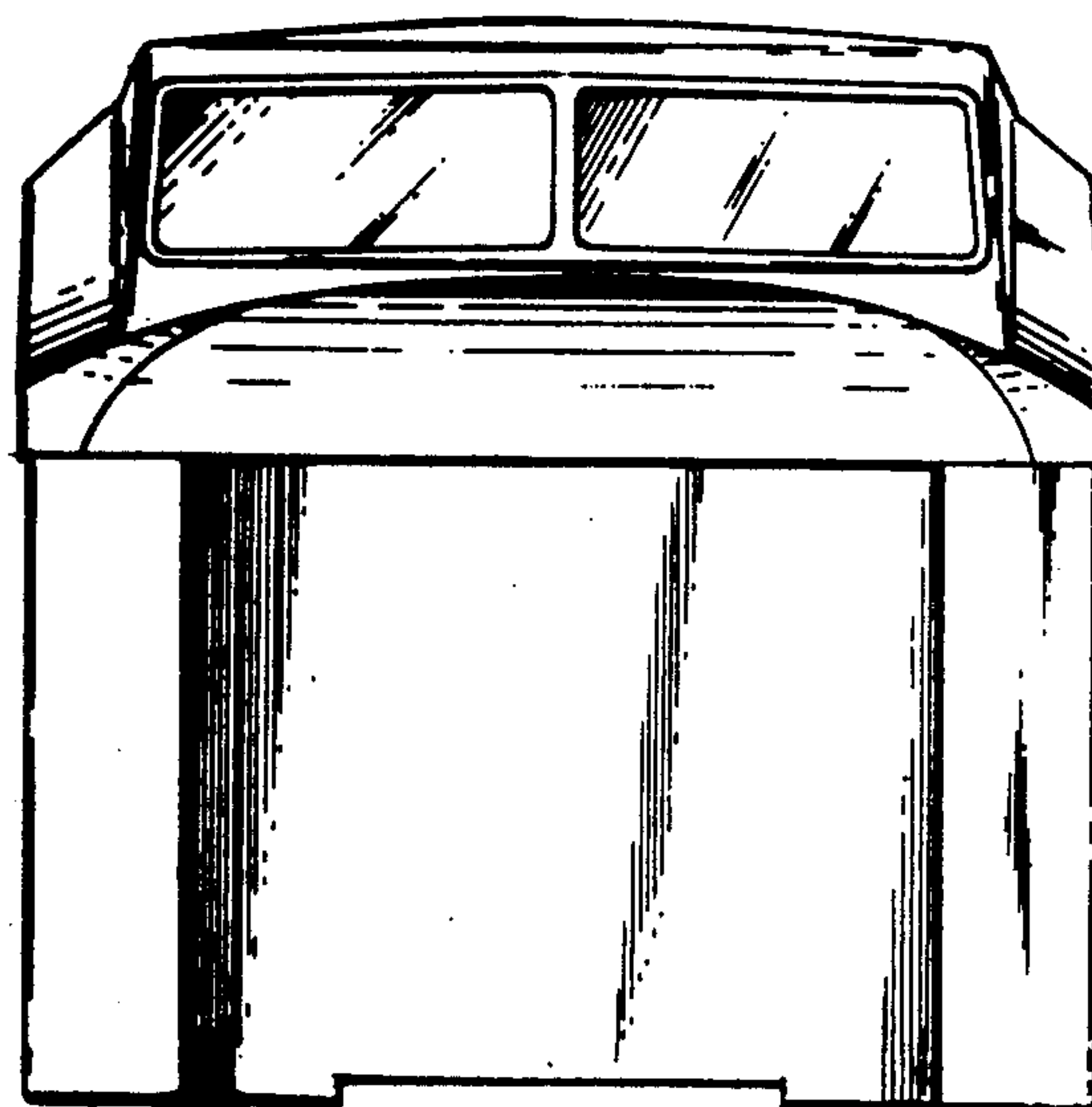

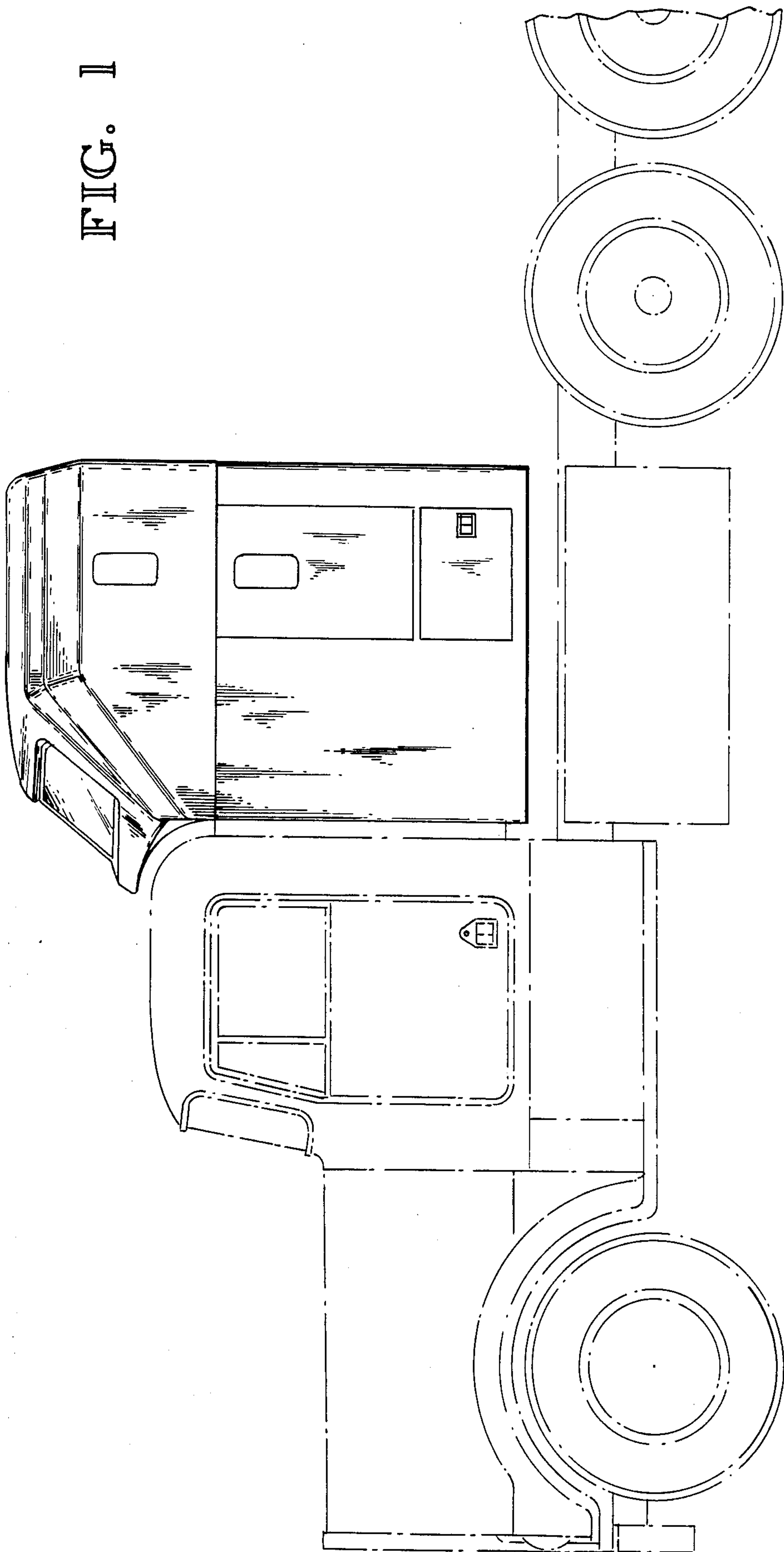

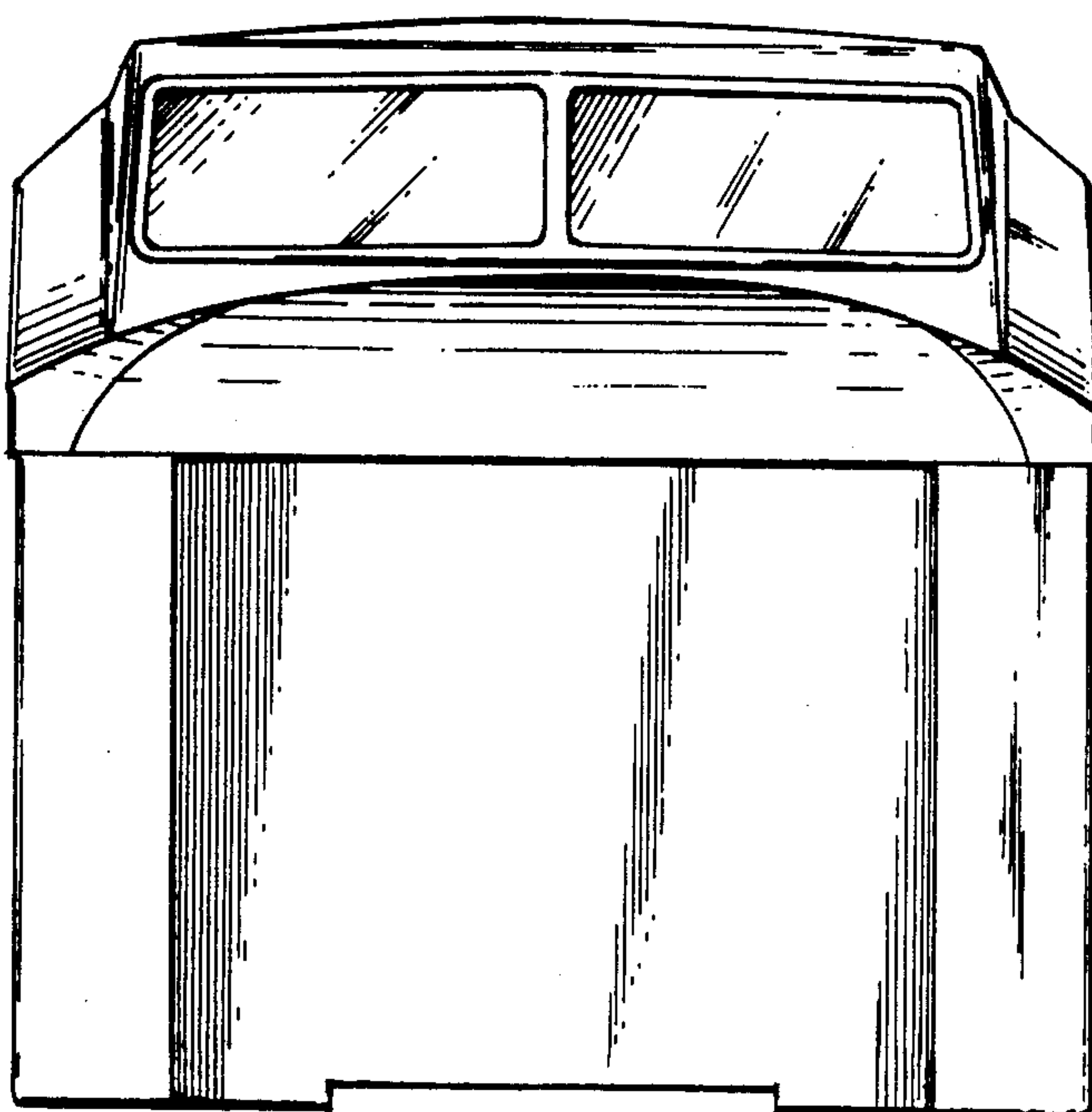

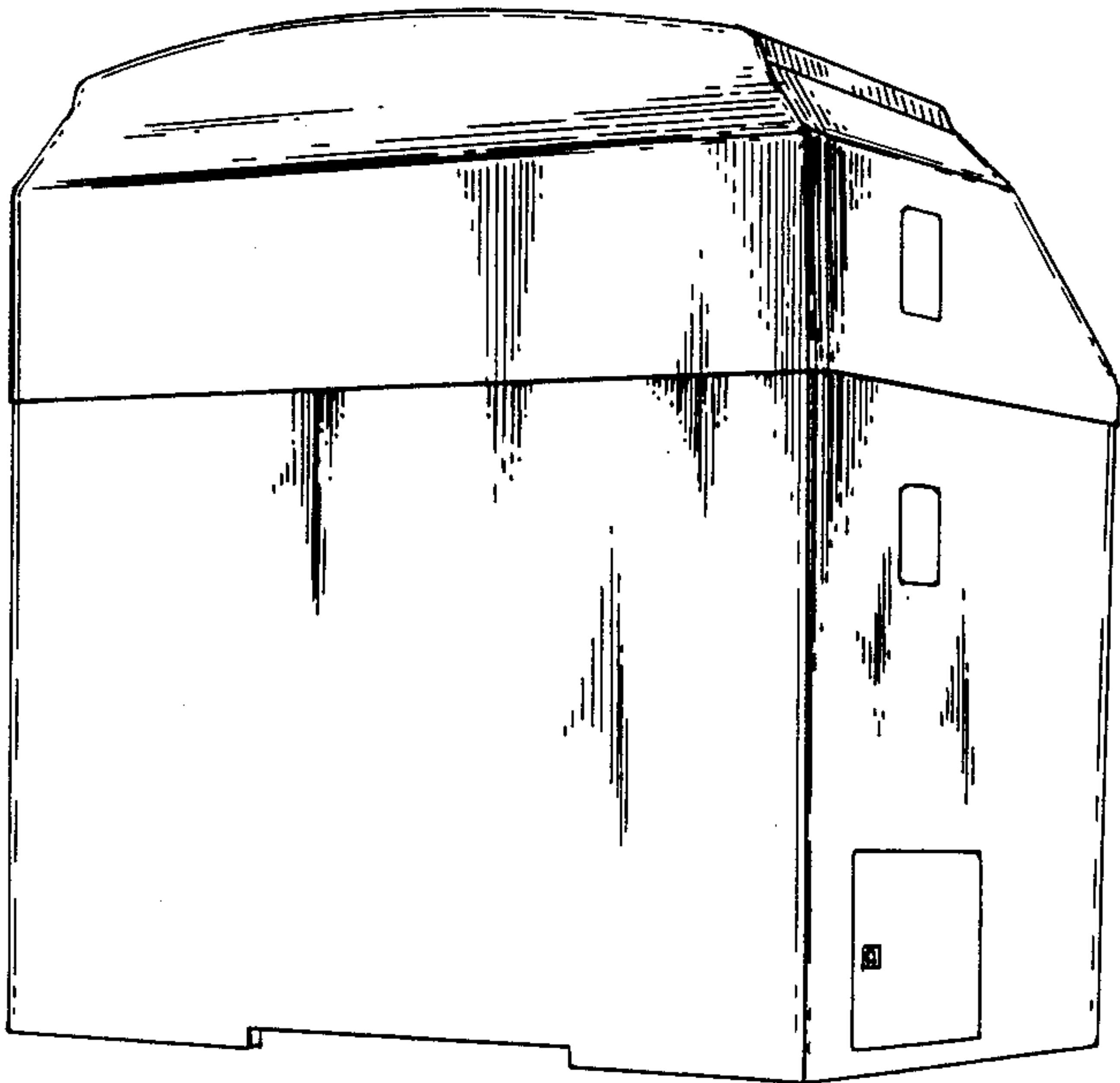
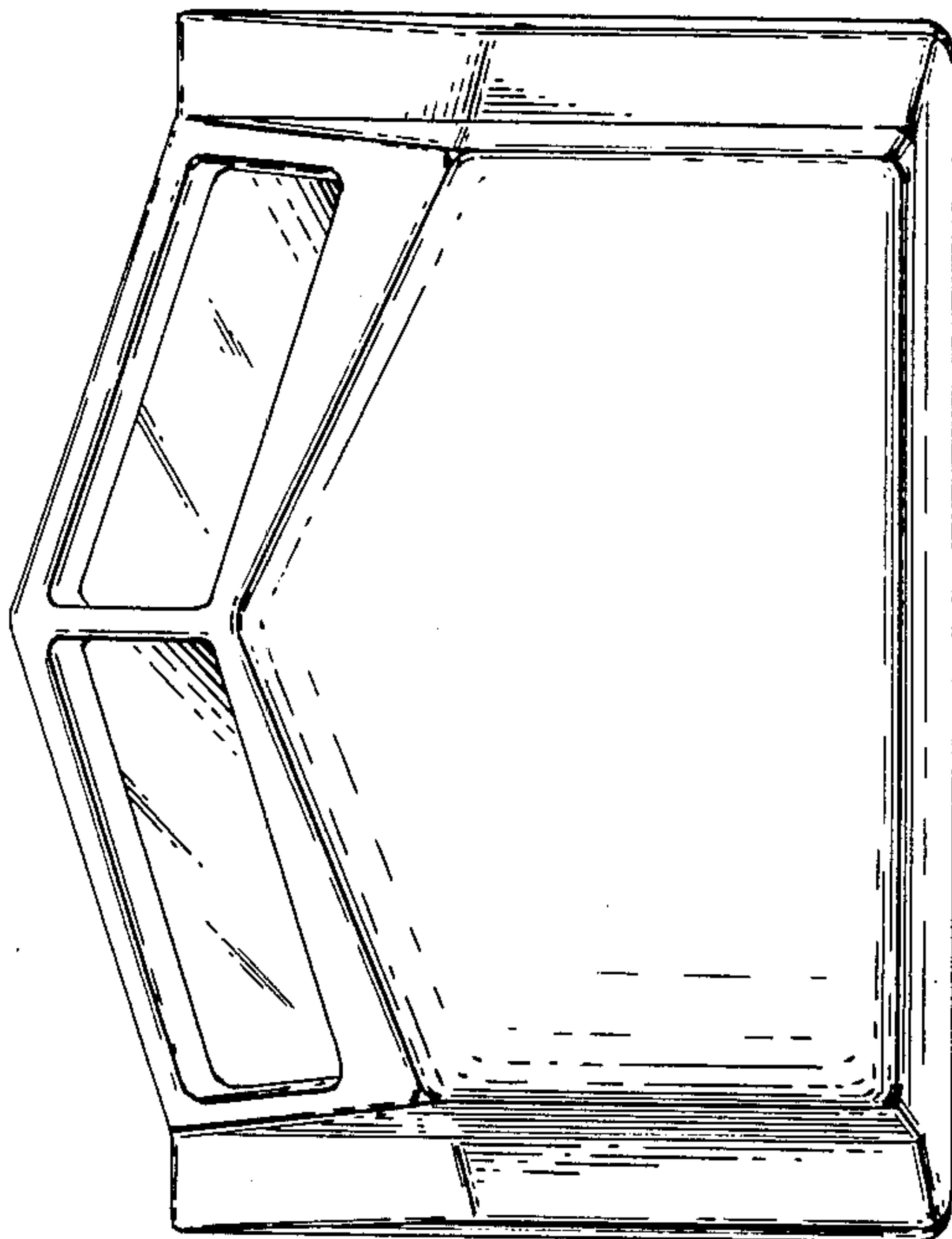
