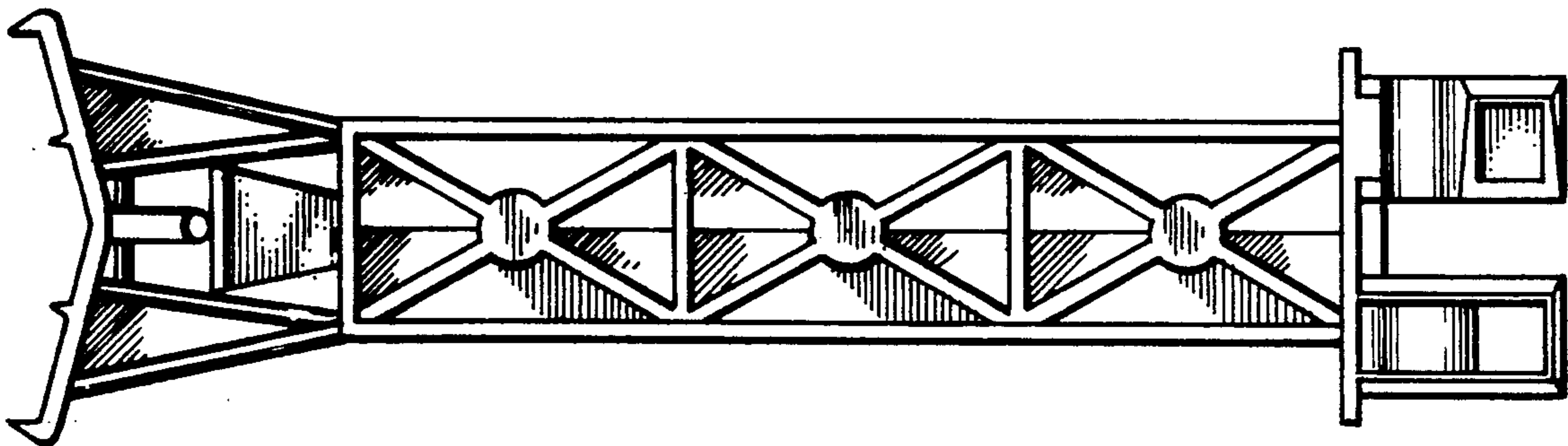
The ornamental design for an electric fence extender for wooden posts, substantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

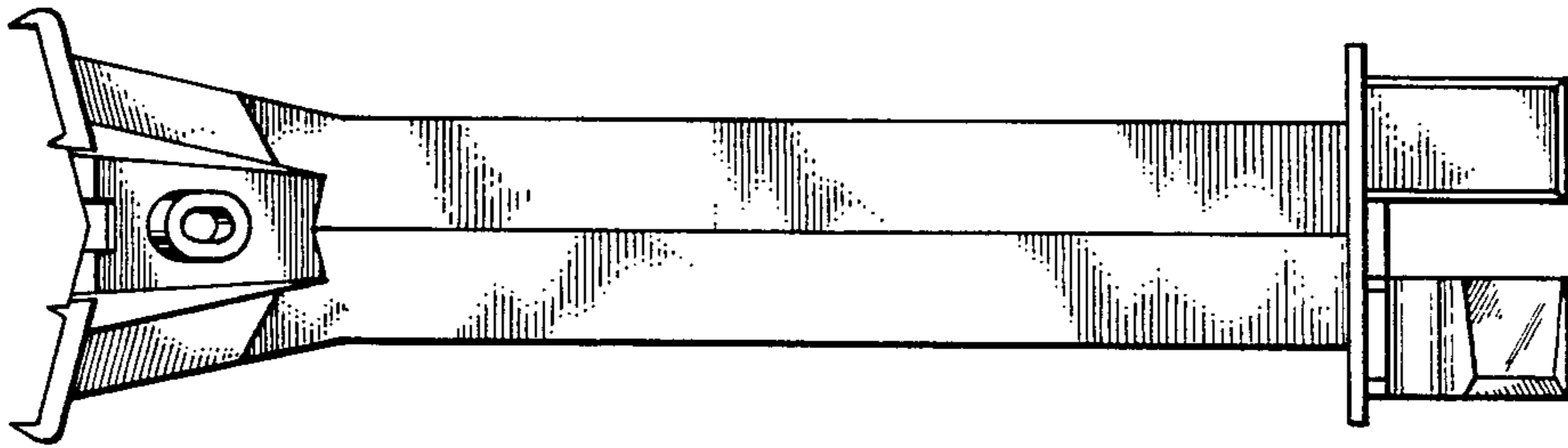
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electric fence extender for wooden posts embodying our new design;

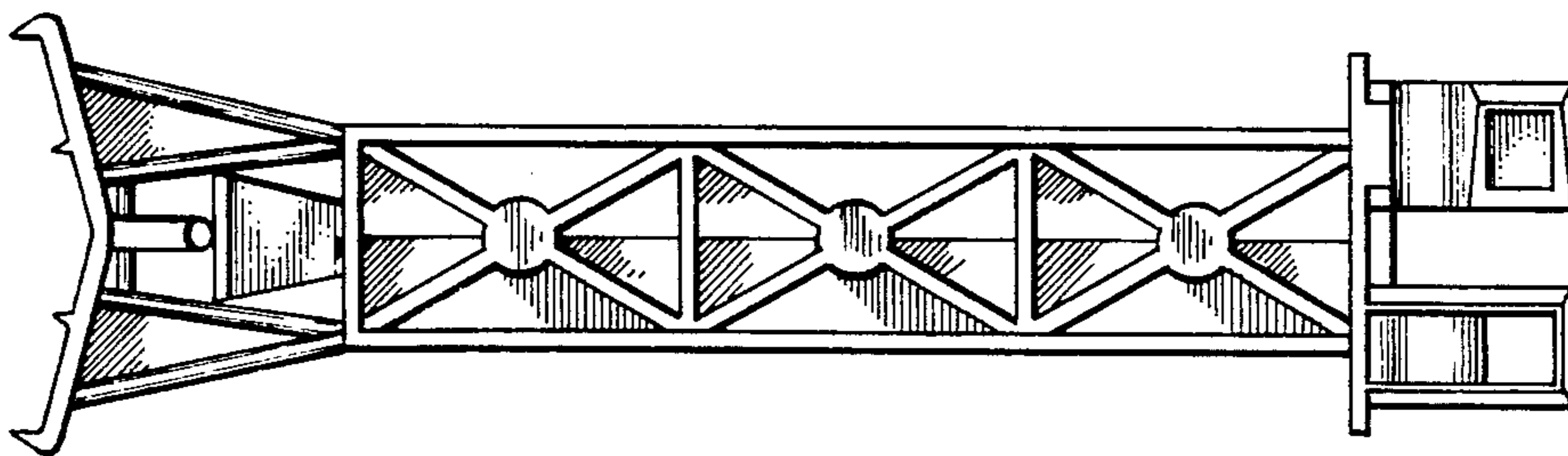

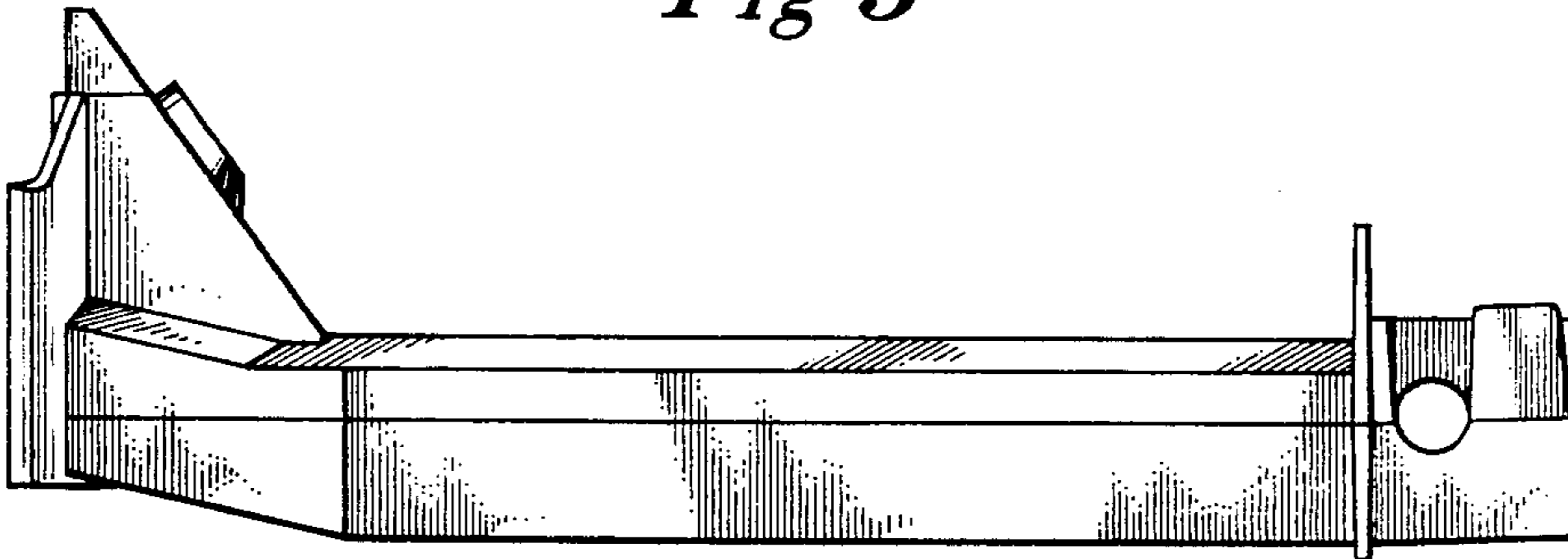

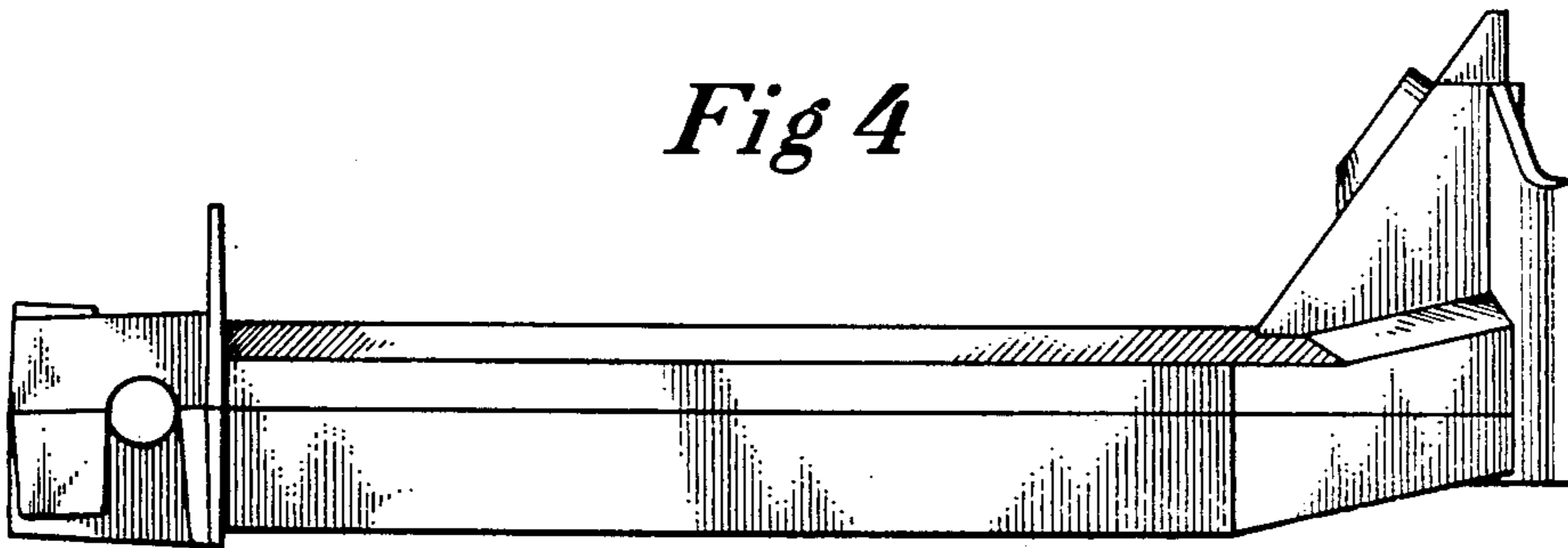

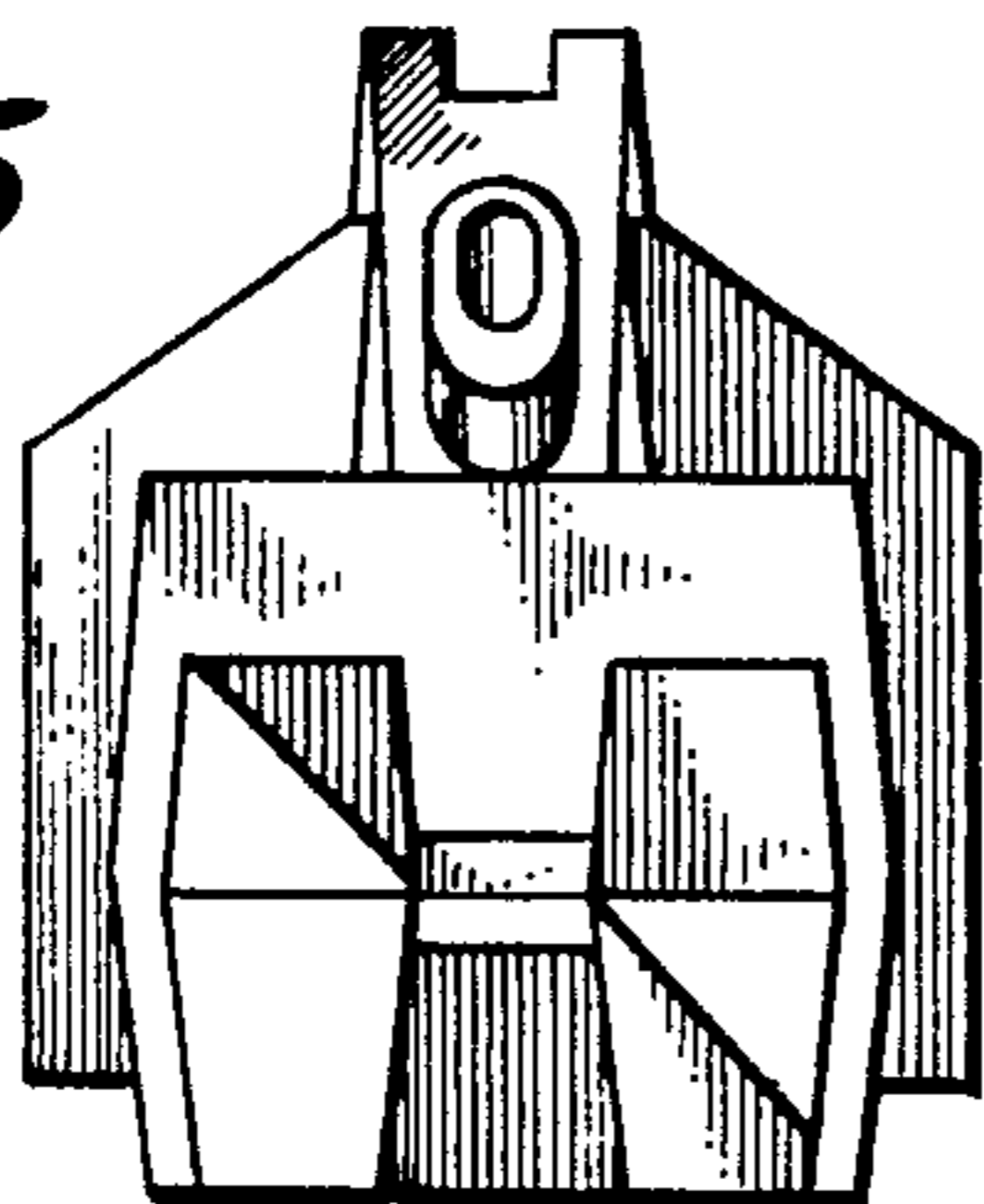
