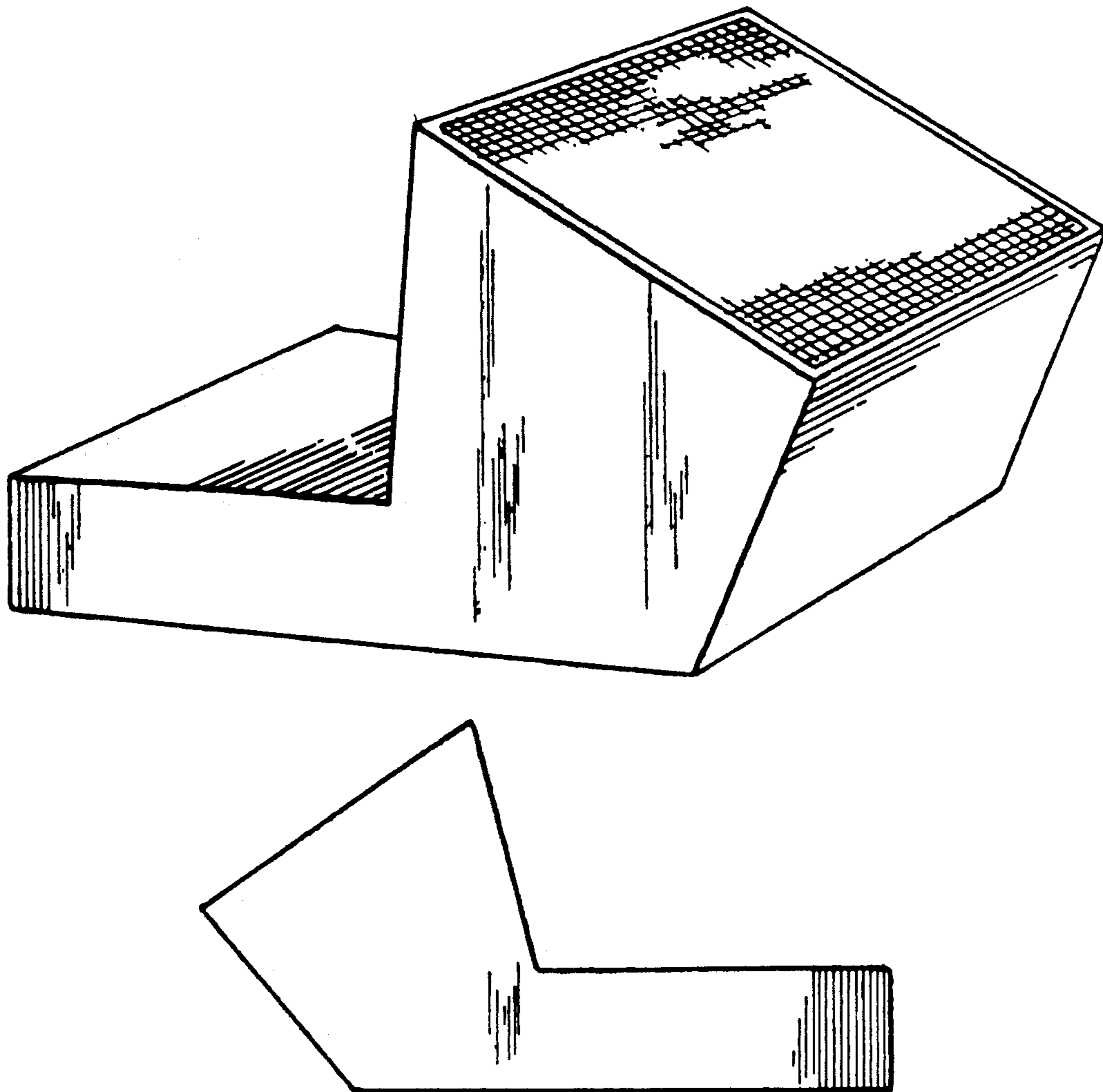

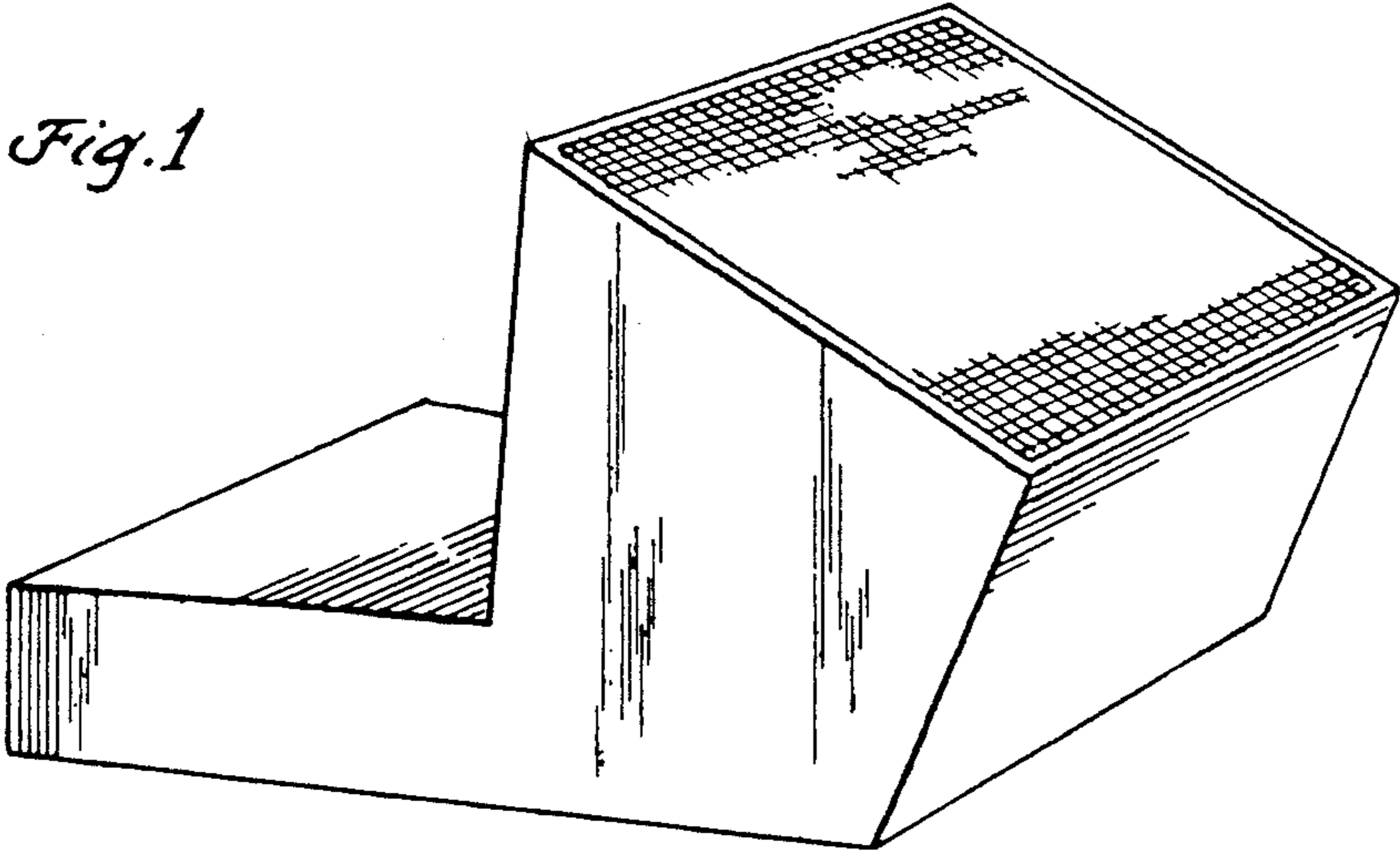
The ornamental design for a speaker enclosure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

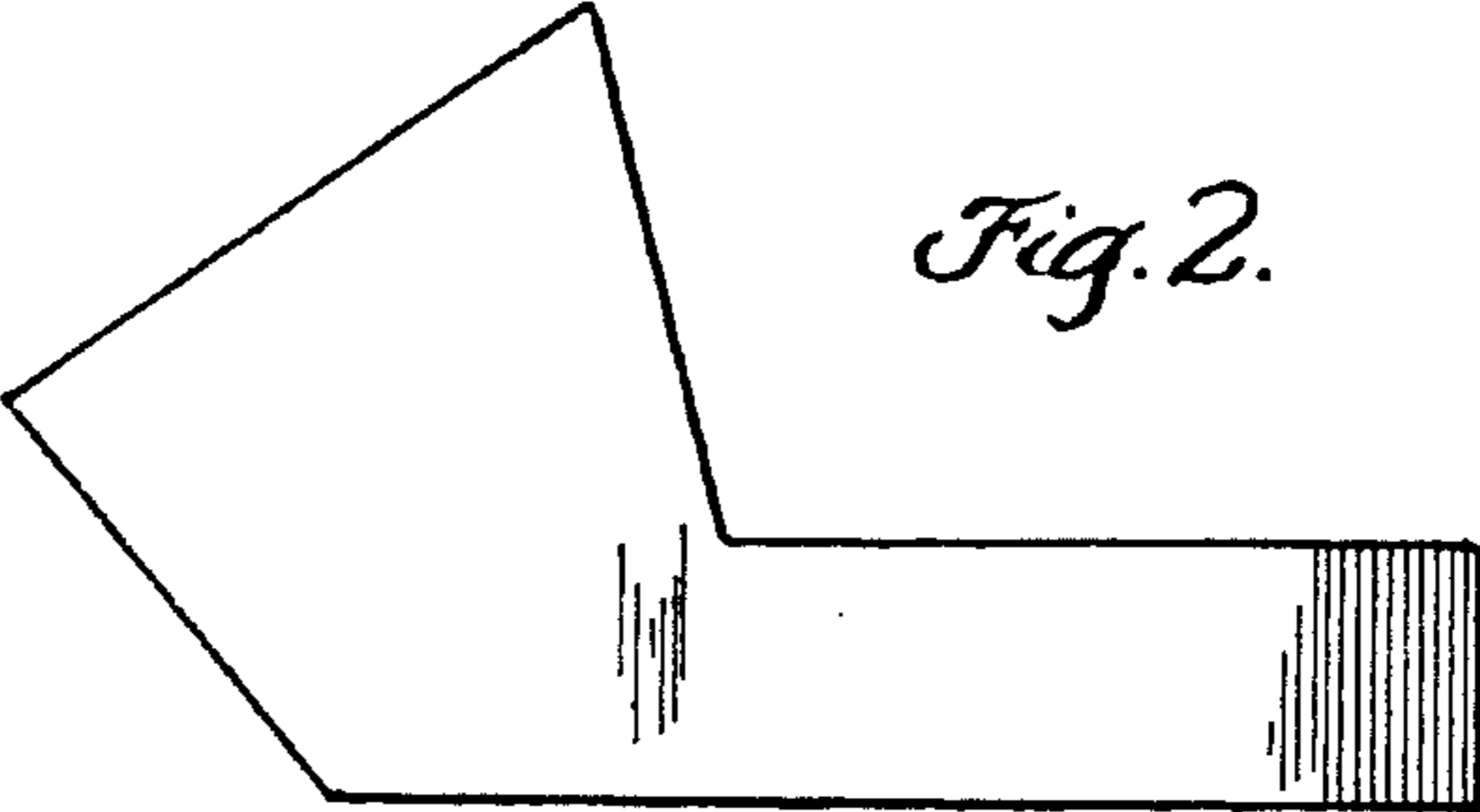
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a speaker enclosure showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof.



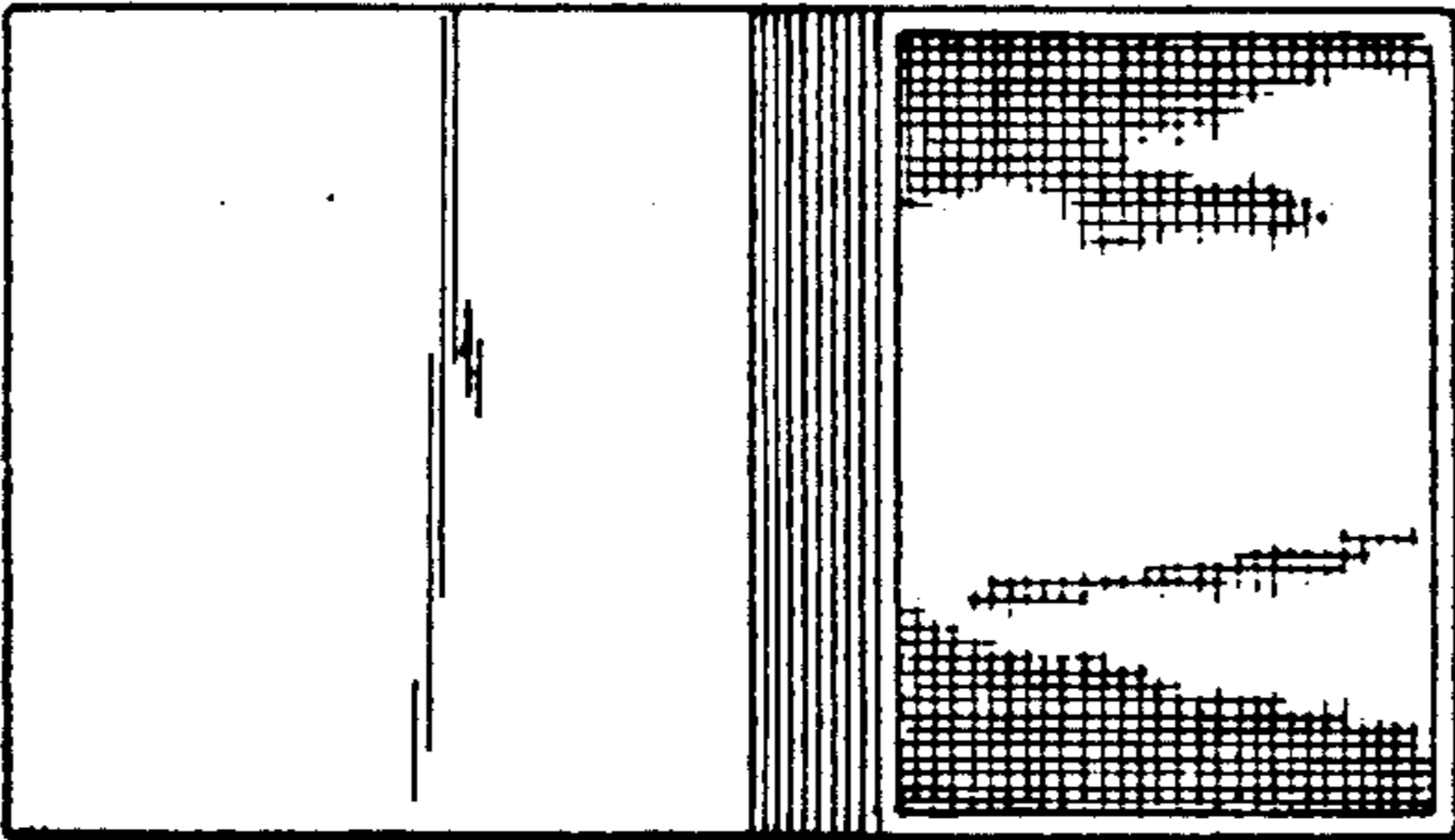

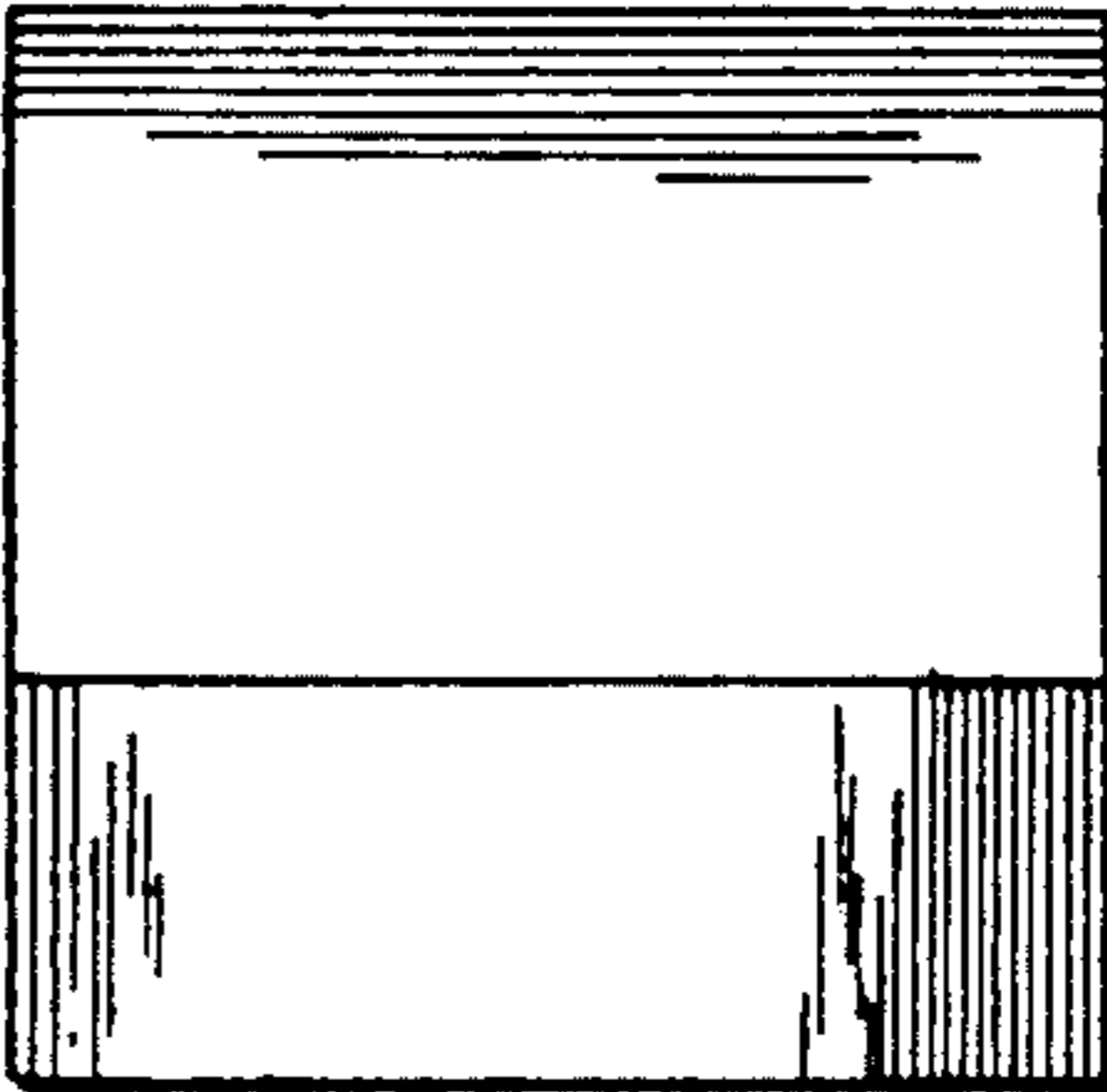

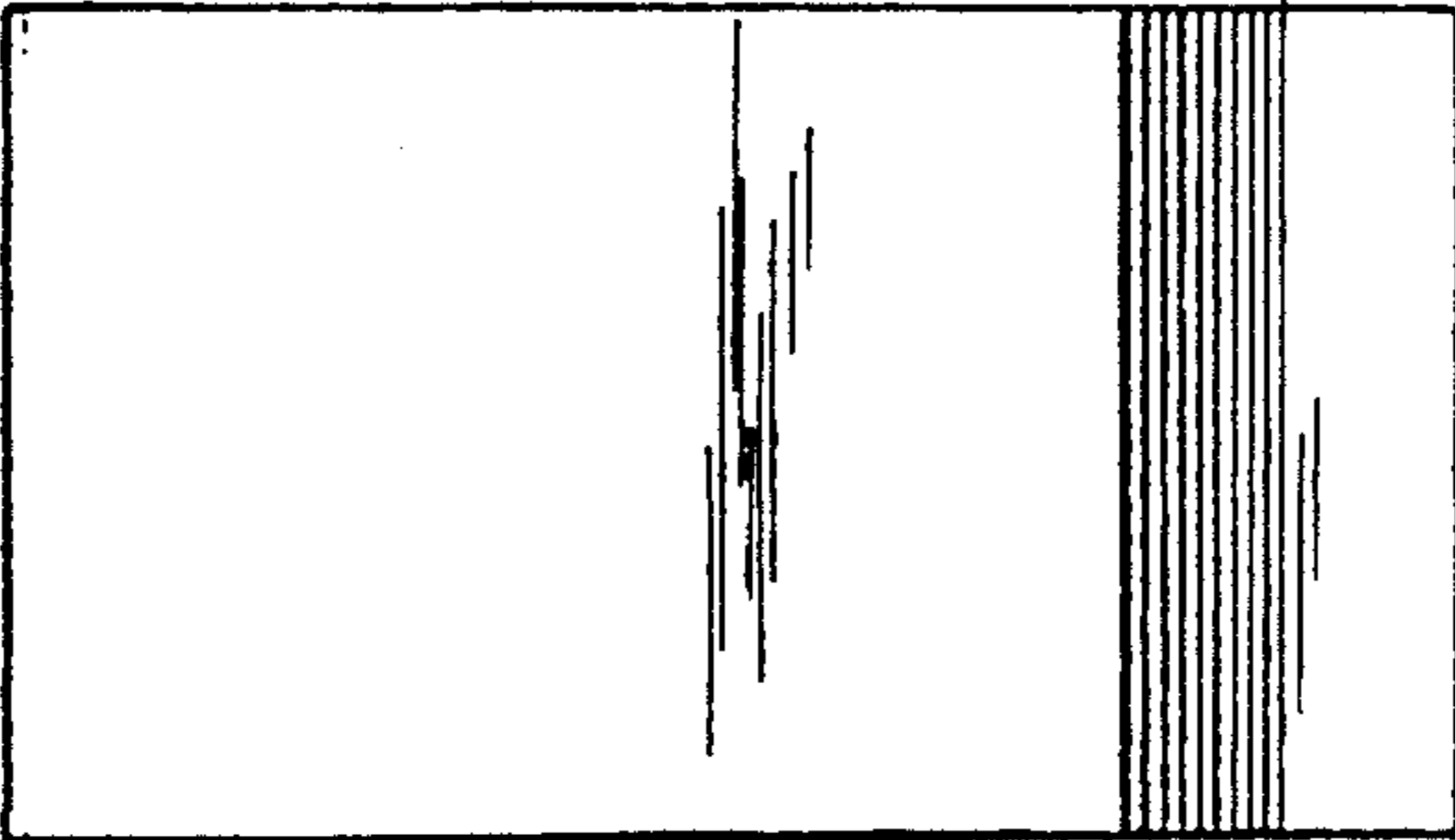

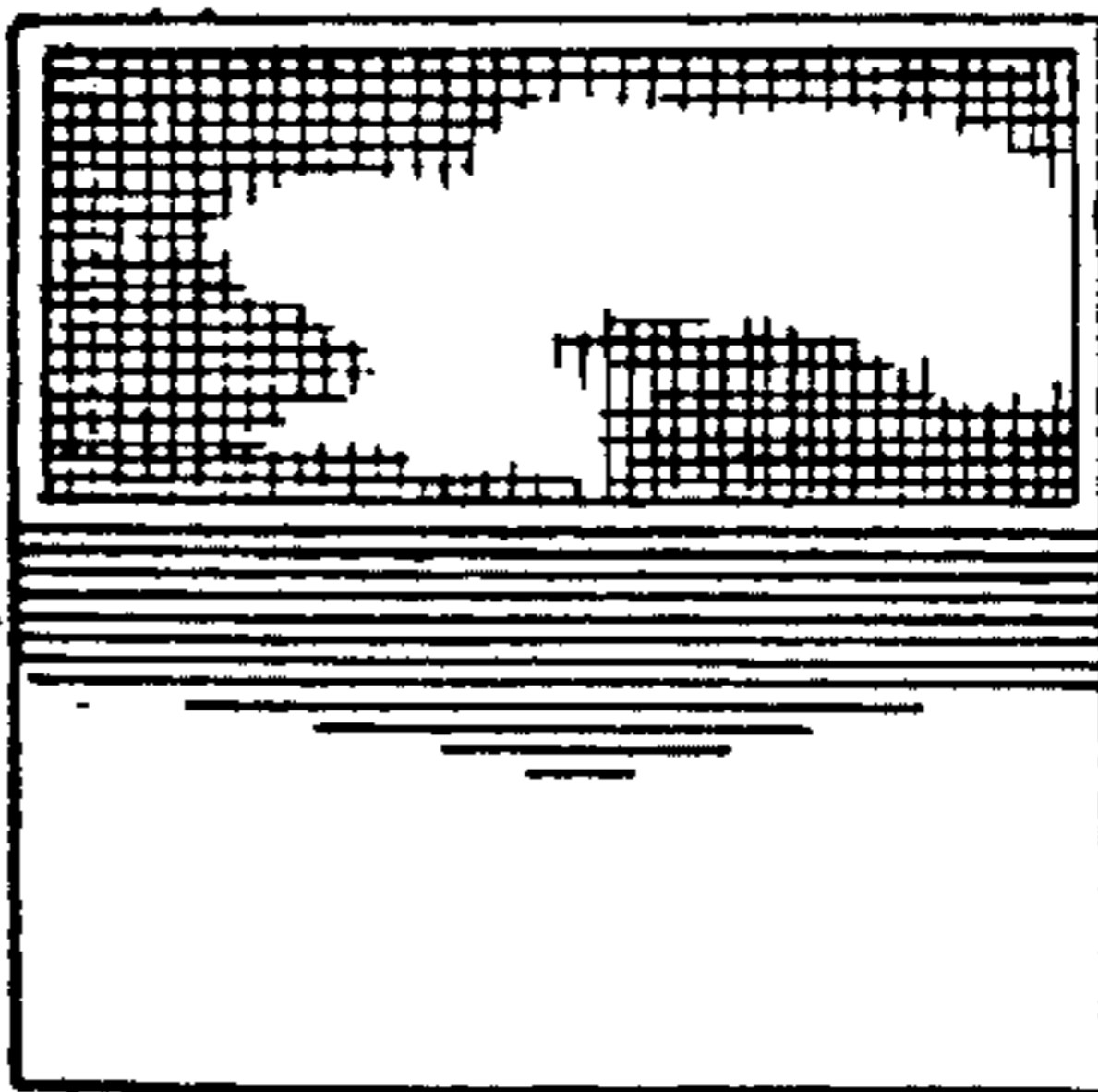

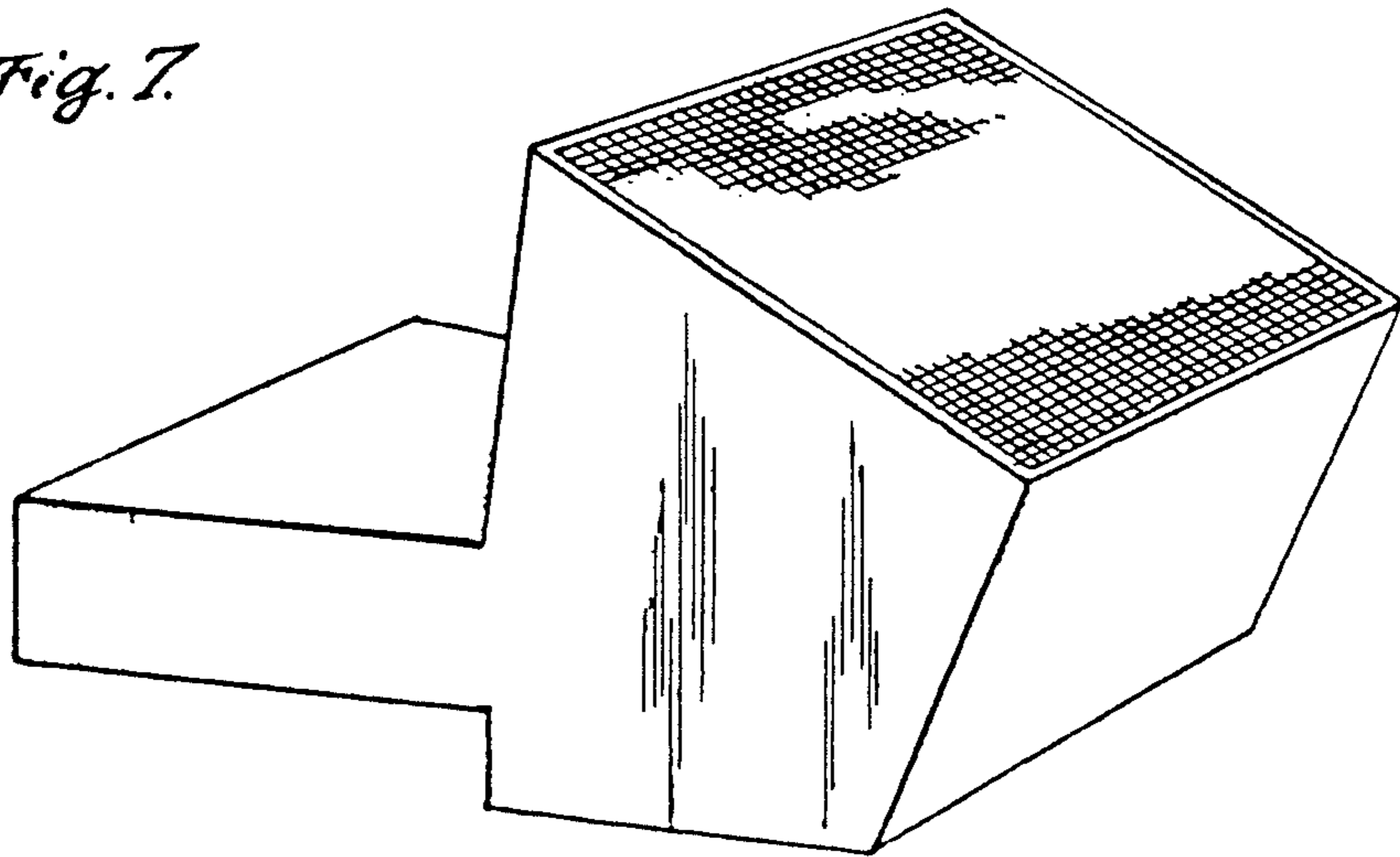

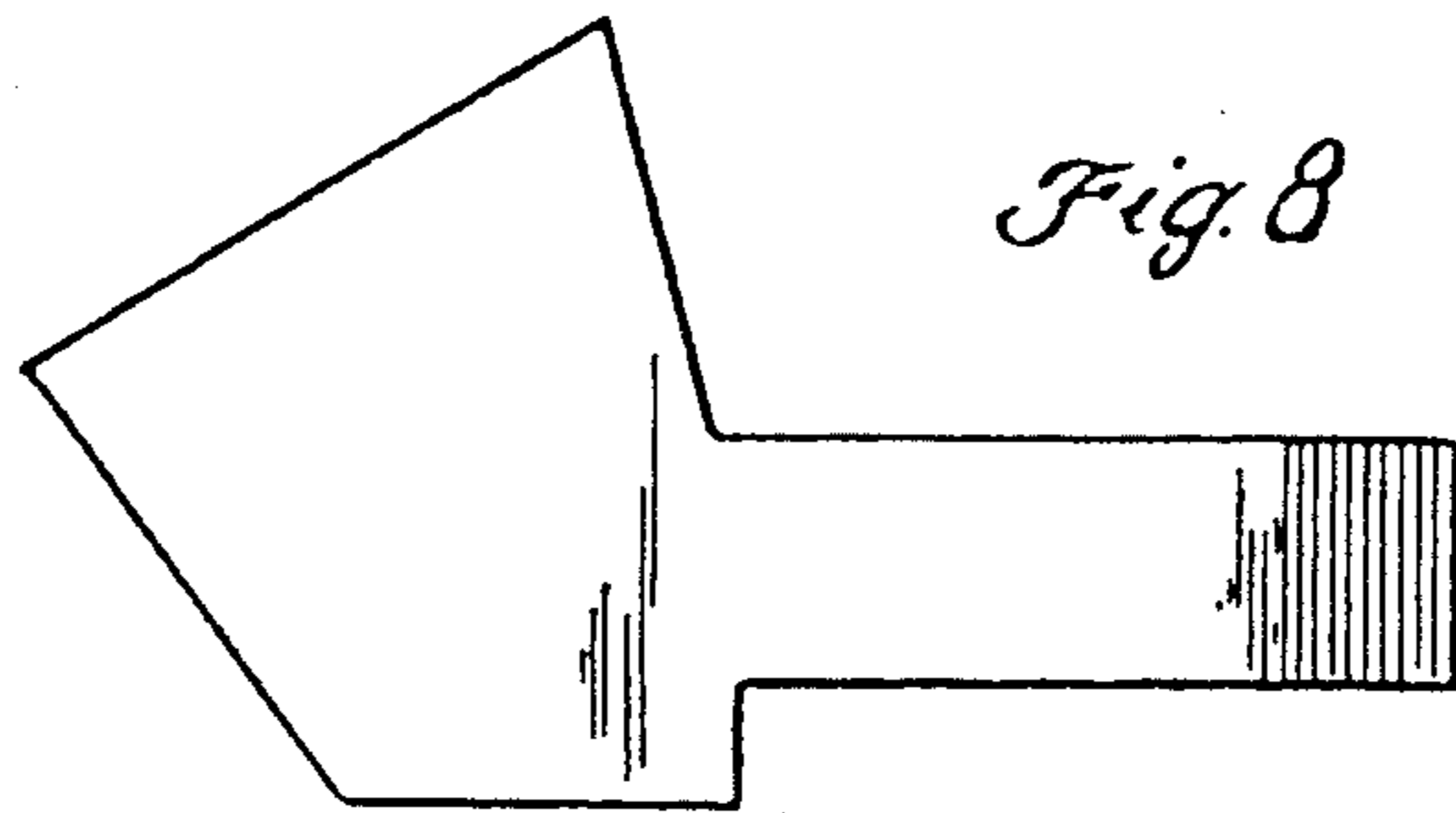

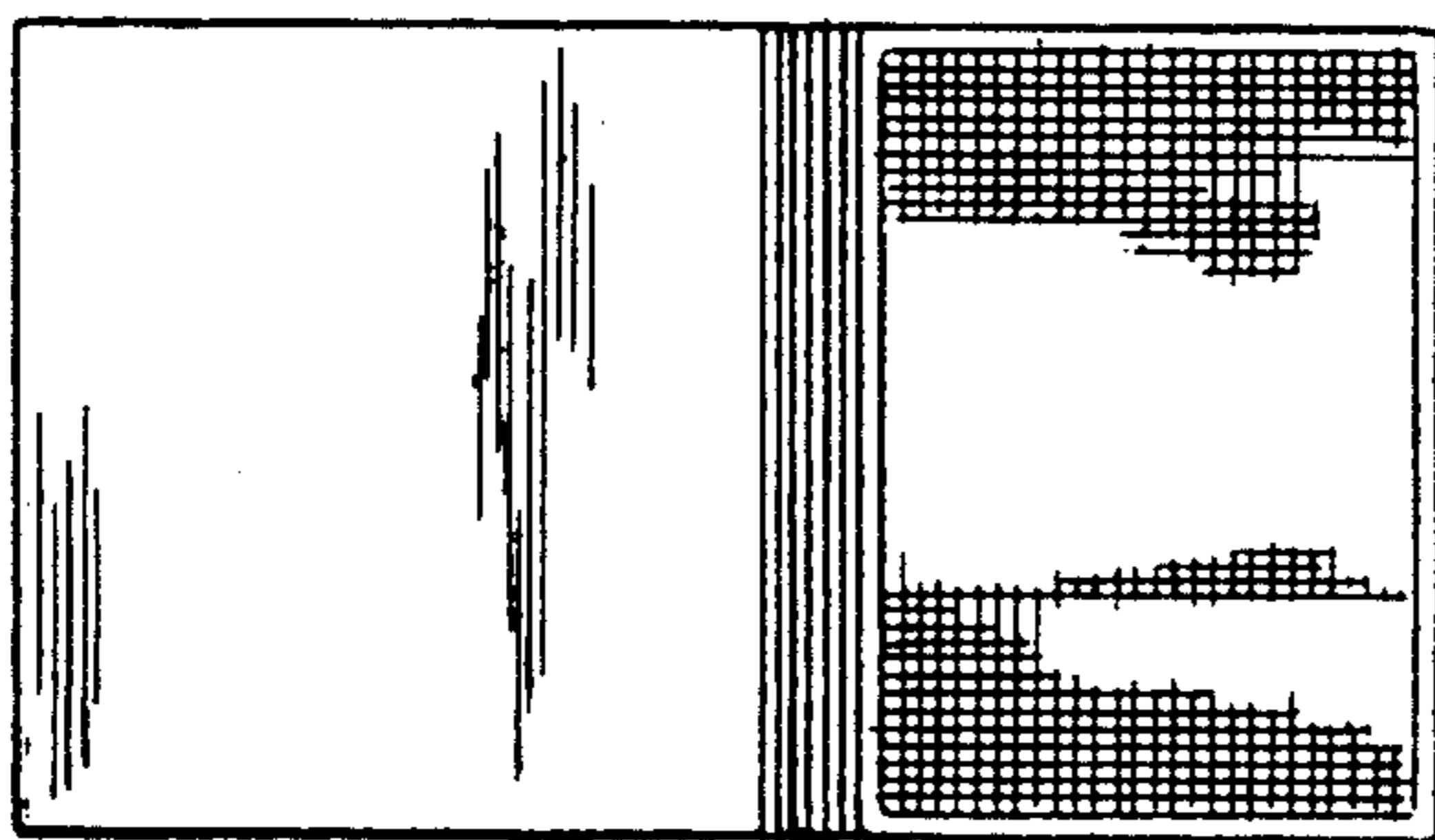

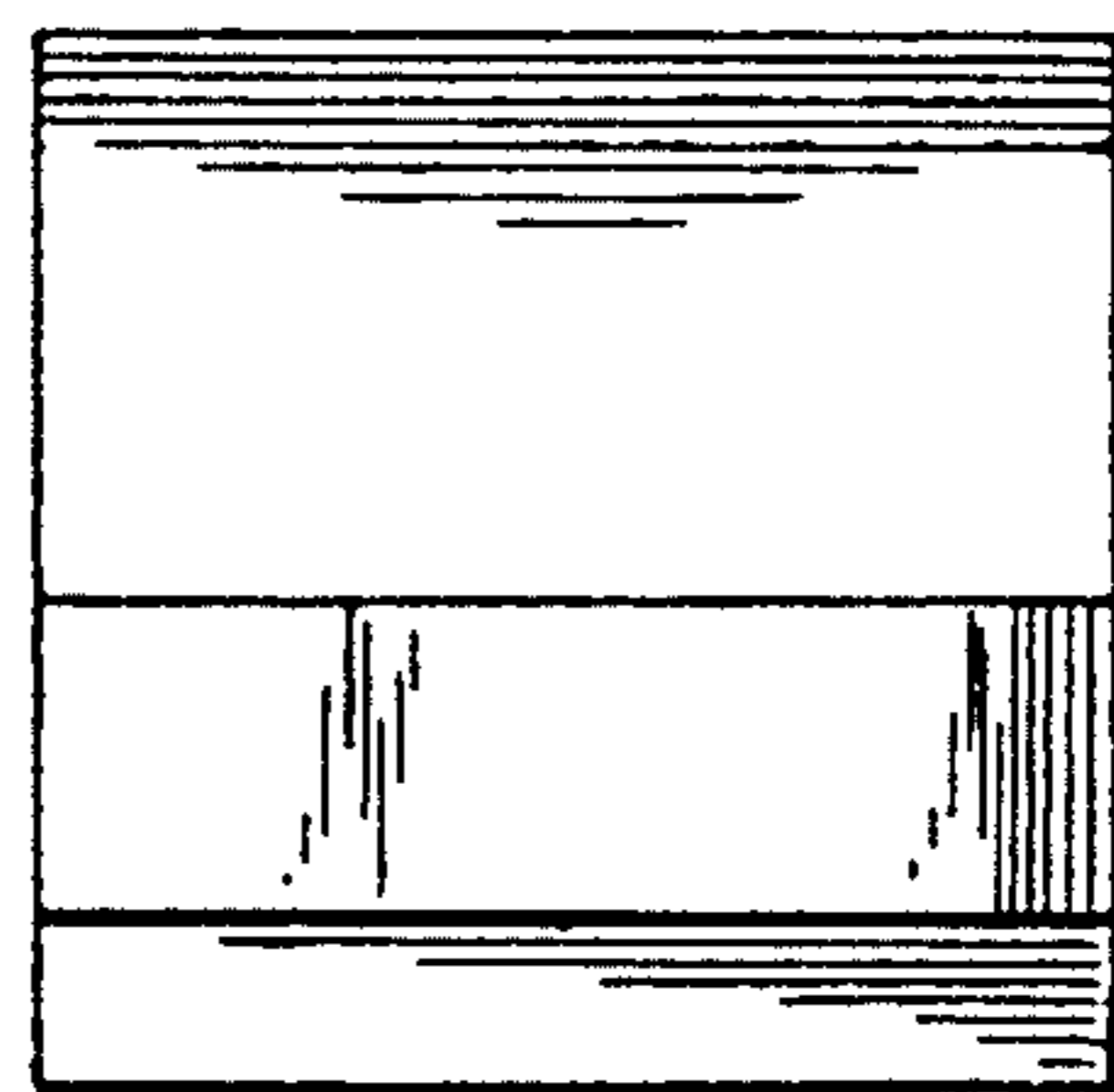

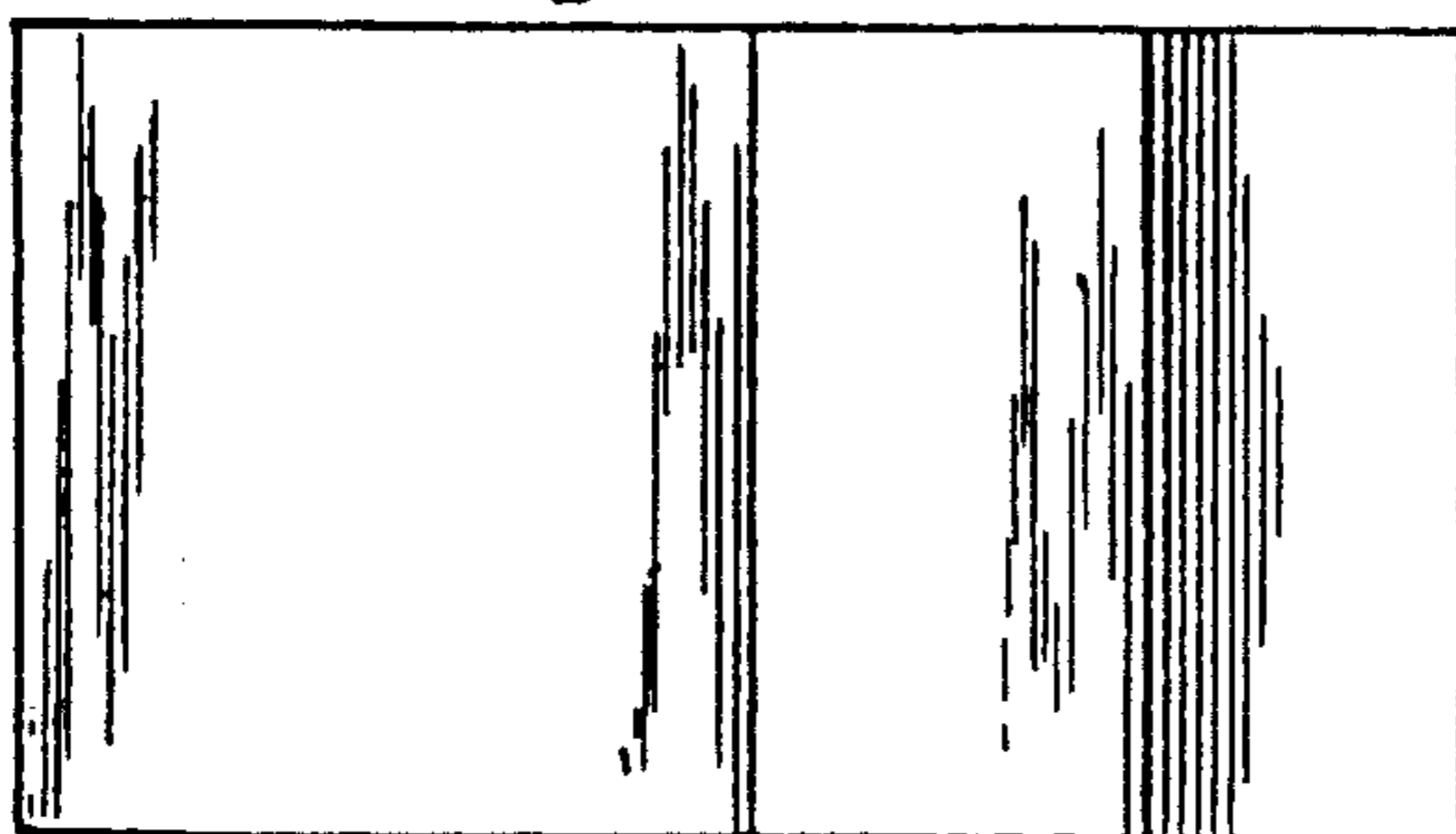

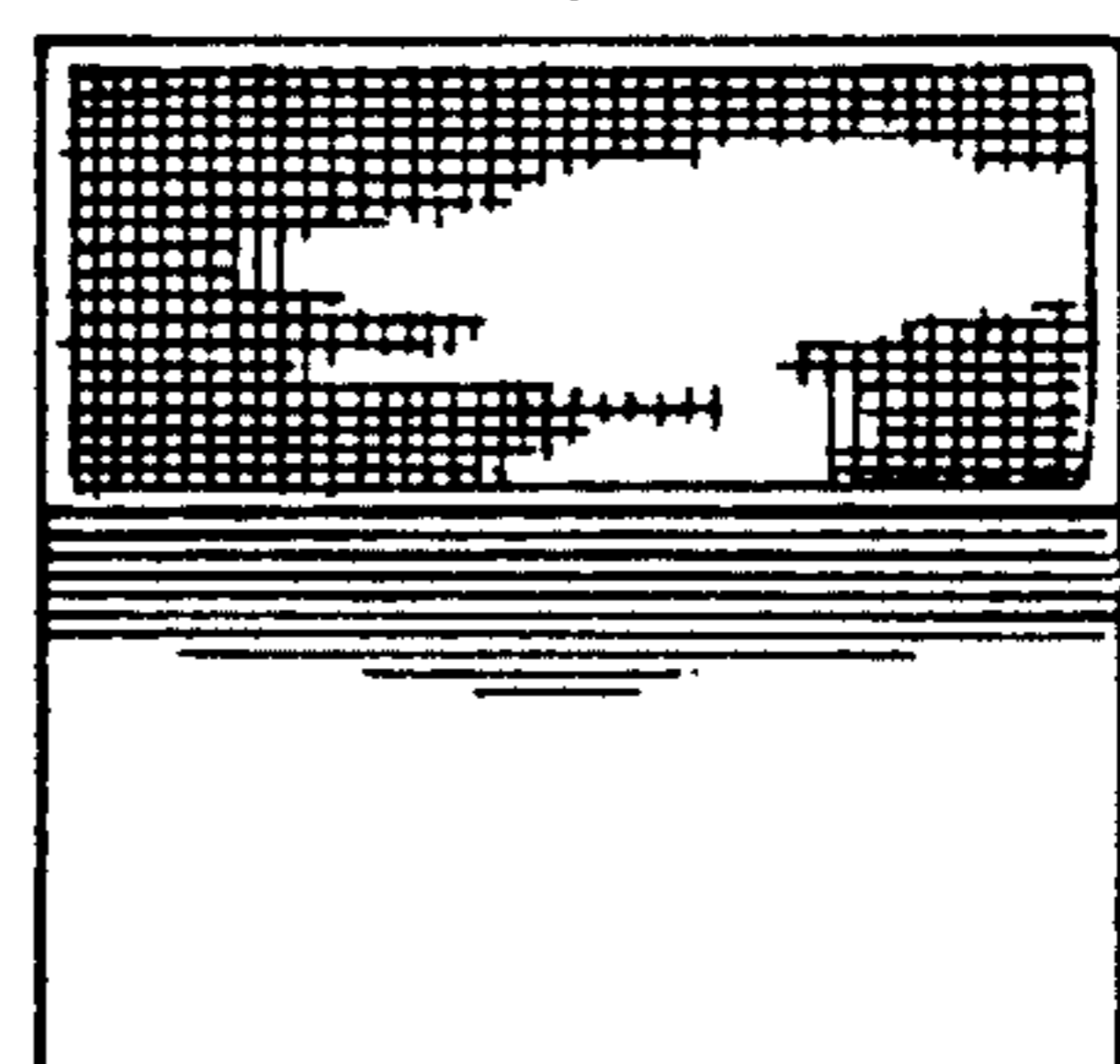
