The ornamental design for a combined ball point pen and pointer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined ball point pen and pointer showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;  
FIG. 6 is a reduced scale front elevational view showing the pointer section in a fully extended position.
