The ornamental design for a marking pen, as shown and described.

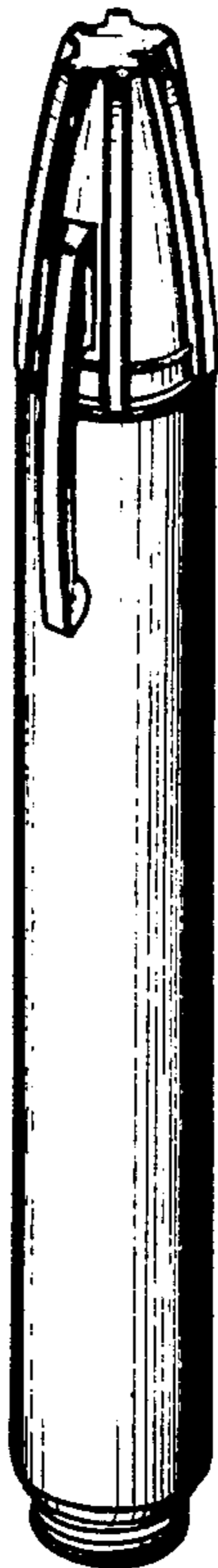
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.



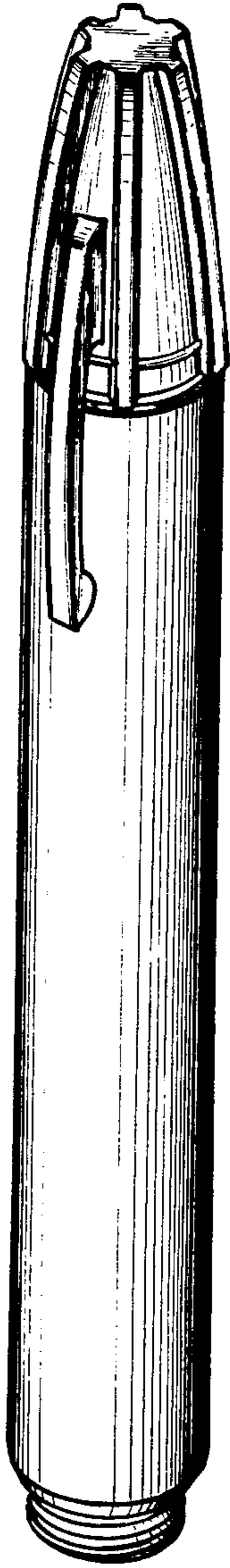

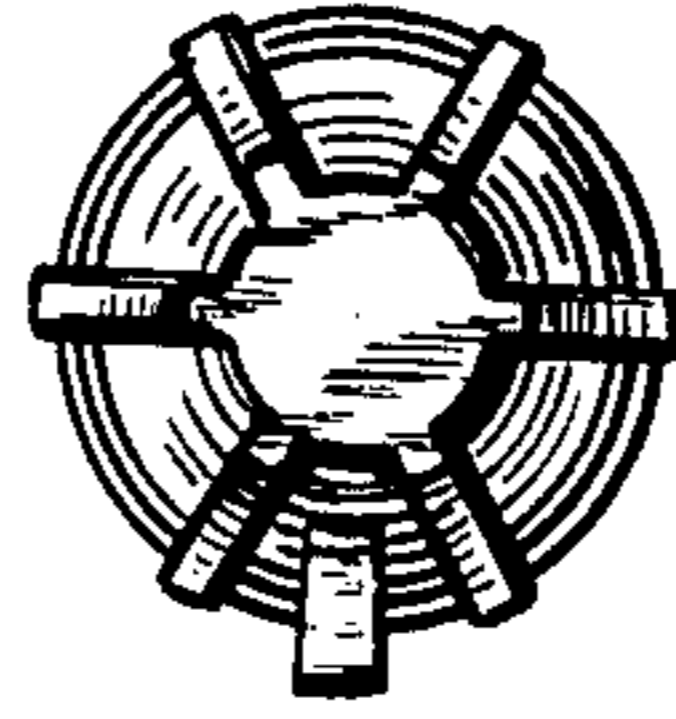

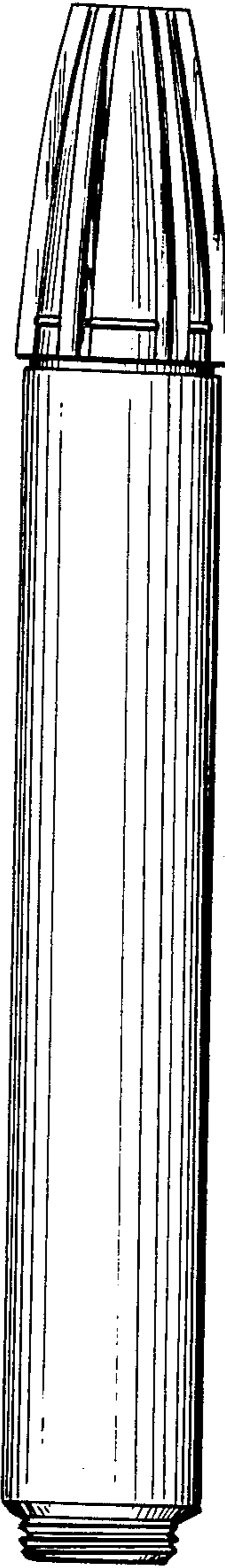

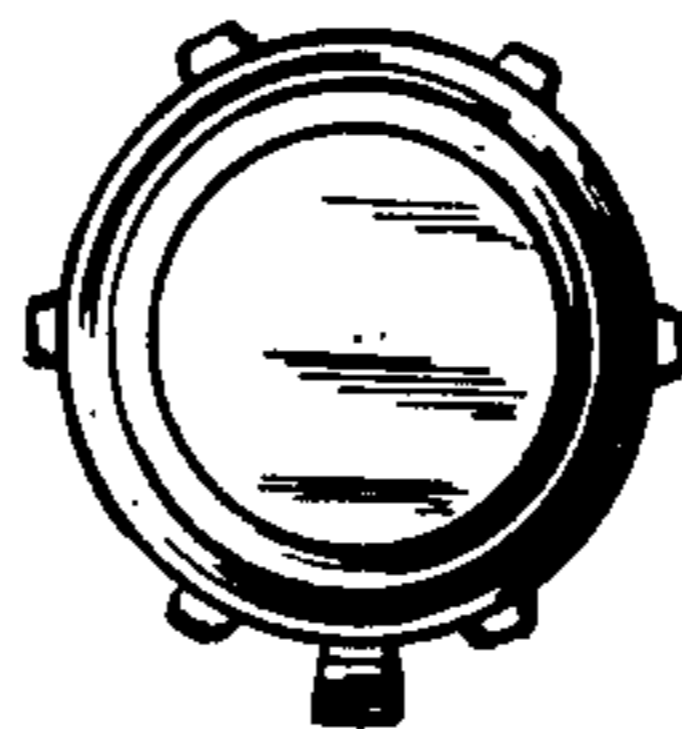
