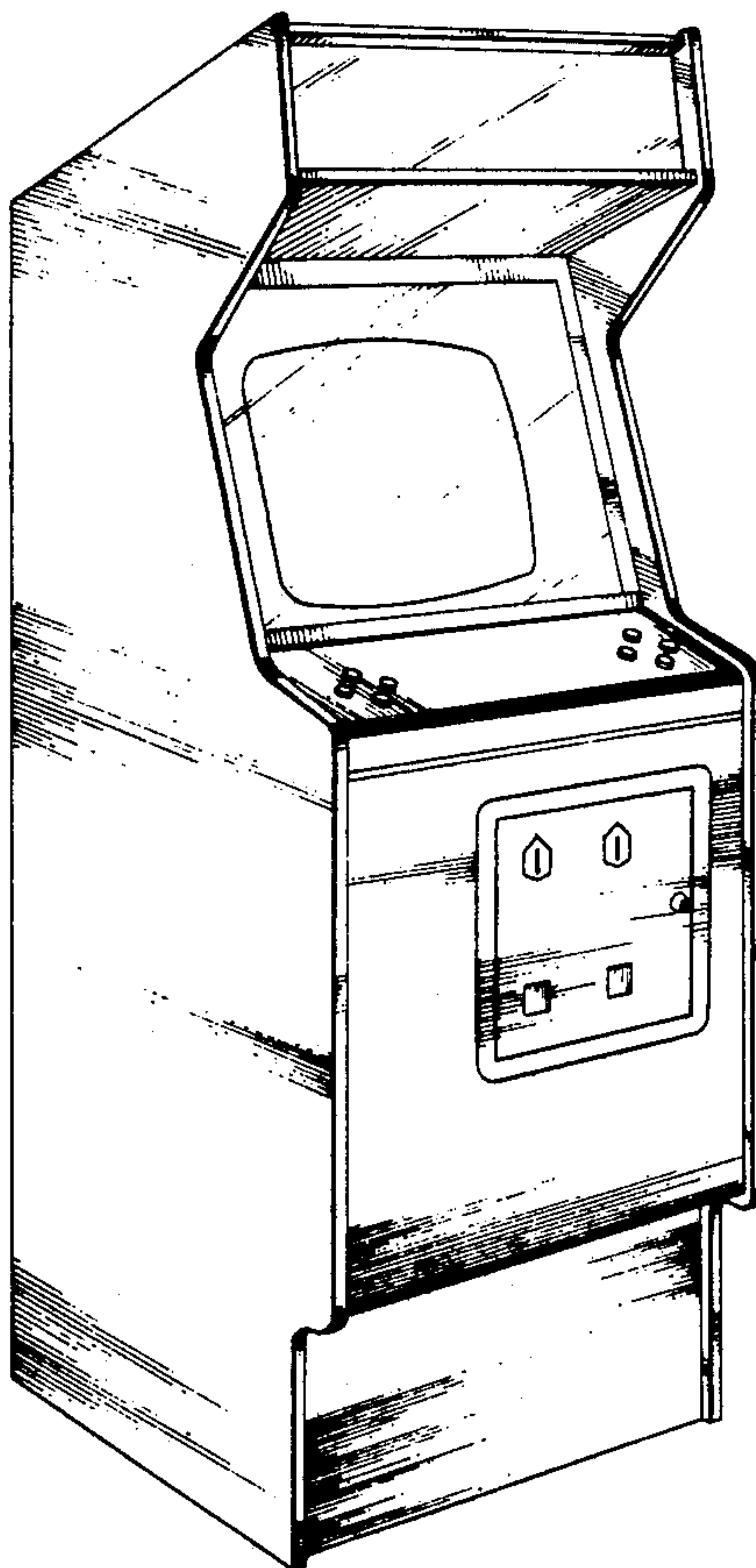

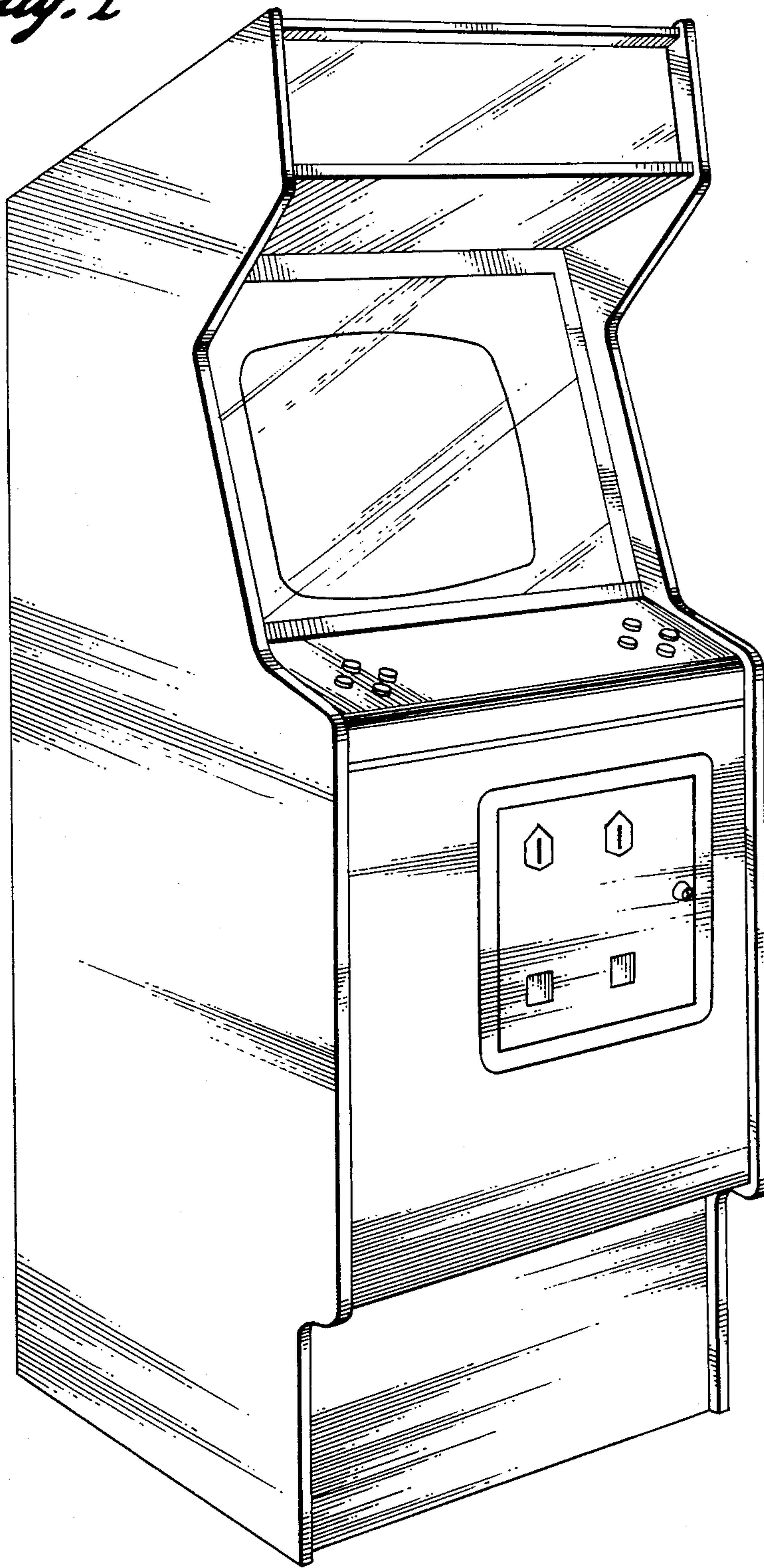
The ornamental design for video game cabinet, substantially as shown and described.
