CLAIM

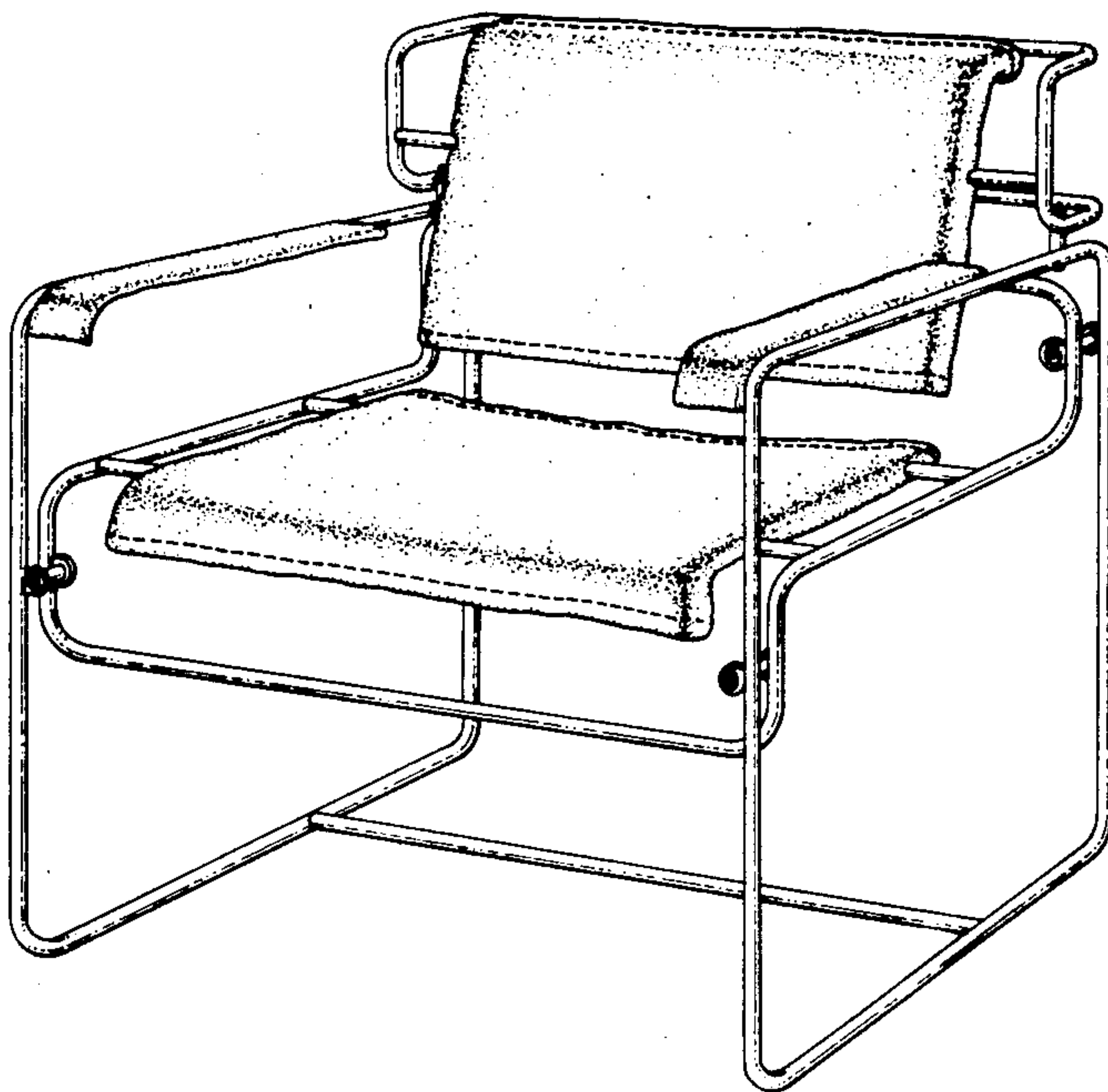
The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a chair showing my new design as it appears from the front and left side.

FIG. 2 is an isometric view of the chair shown in FIG. 1, as it appears from the rear and left side.

The right side of the chair appears the same as the left side, except reversed.



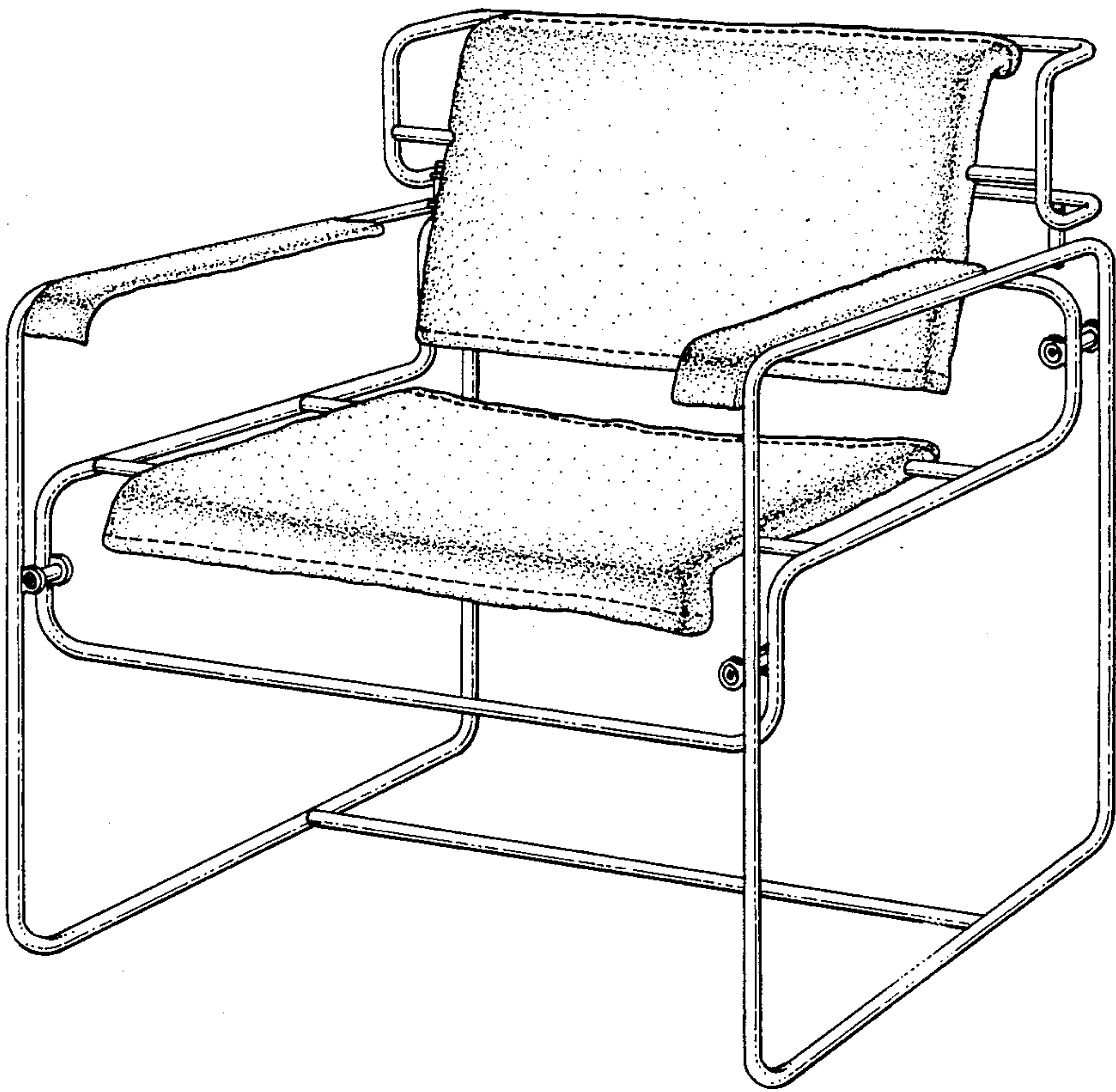
