**CLAIM**

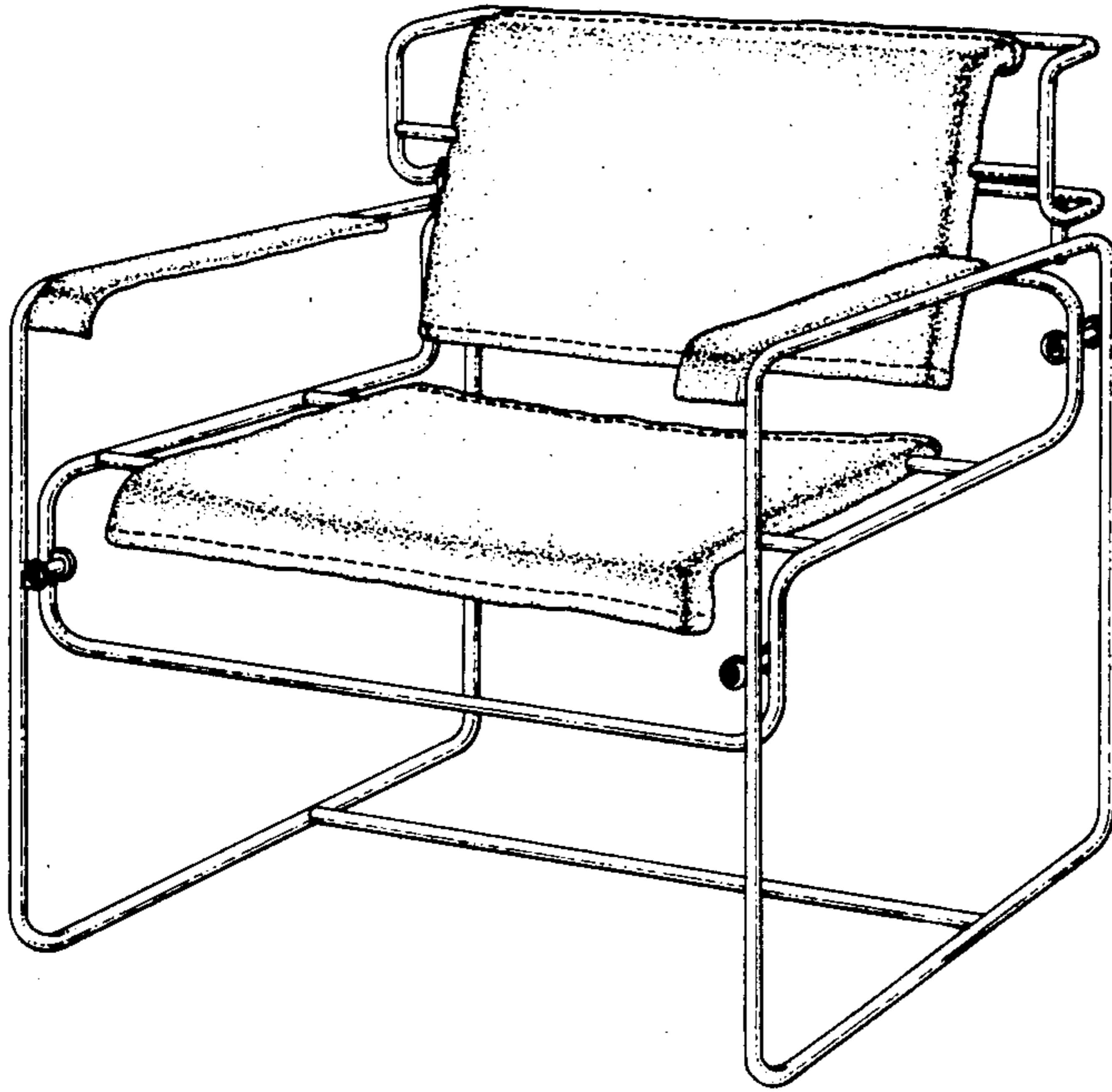
The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

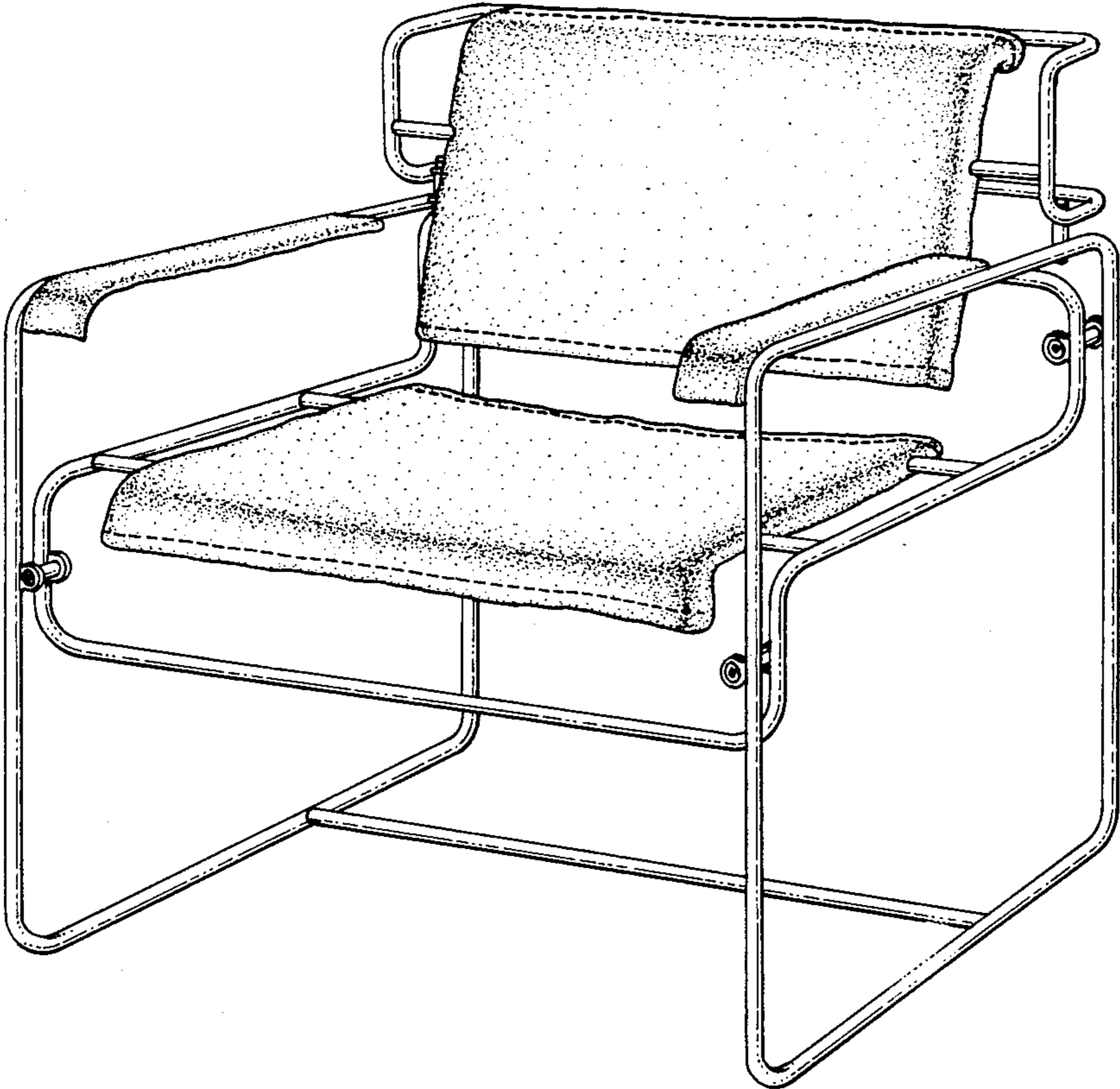
**DESCRIPTION**
