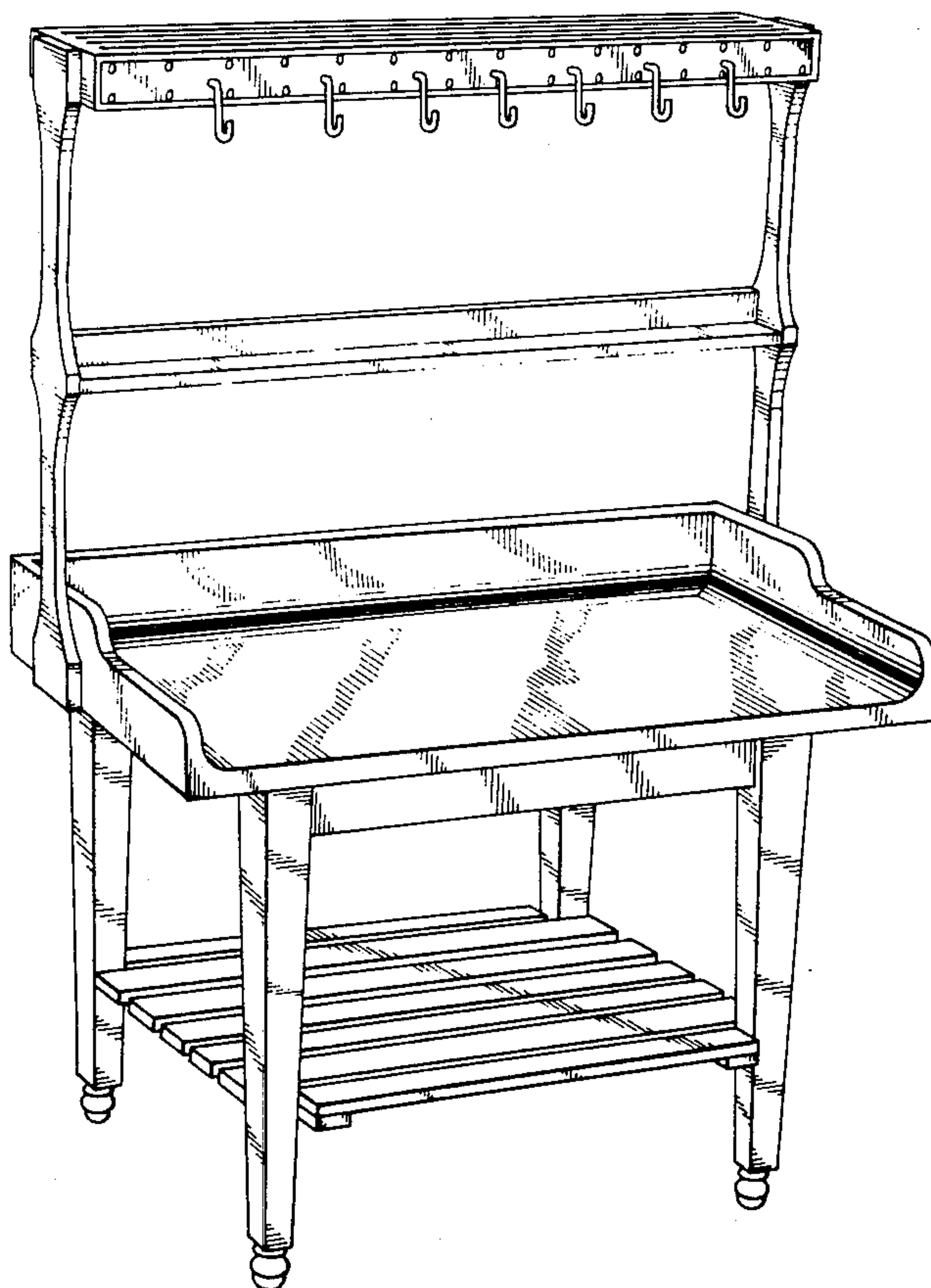
The ornamental design for a baker's Table or Similar Article, as shown and described.

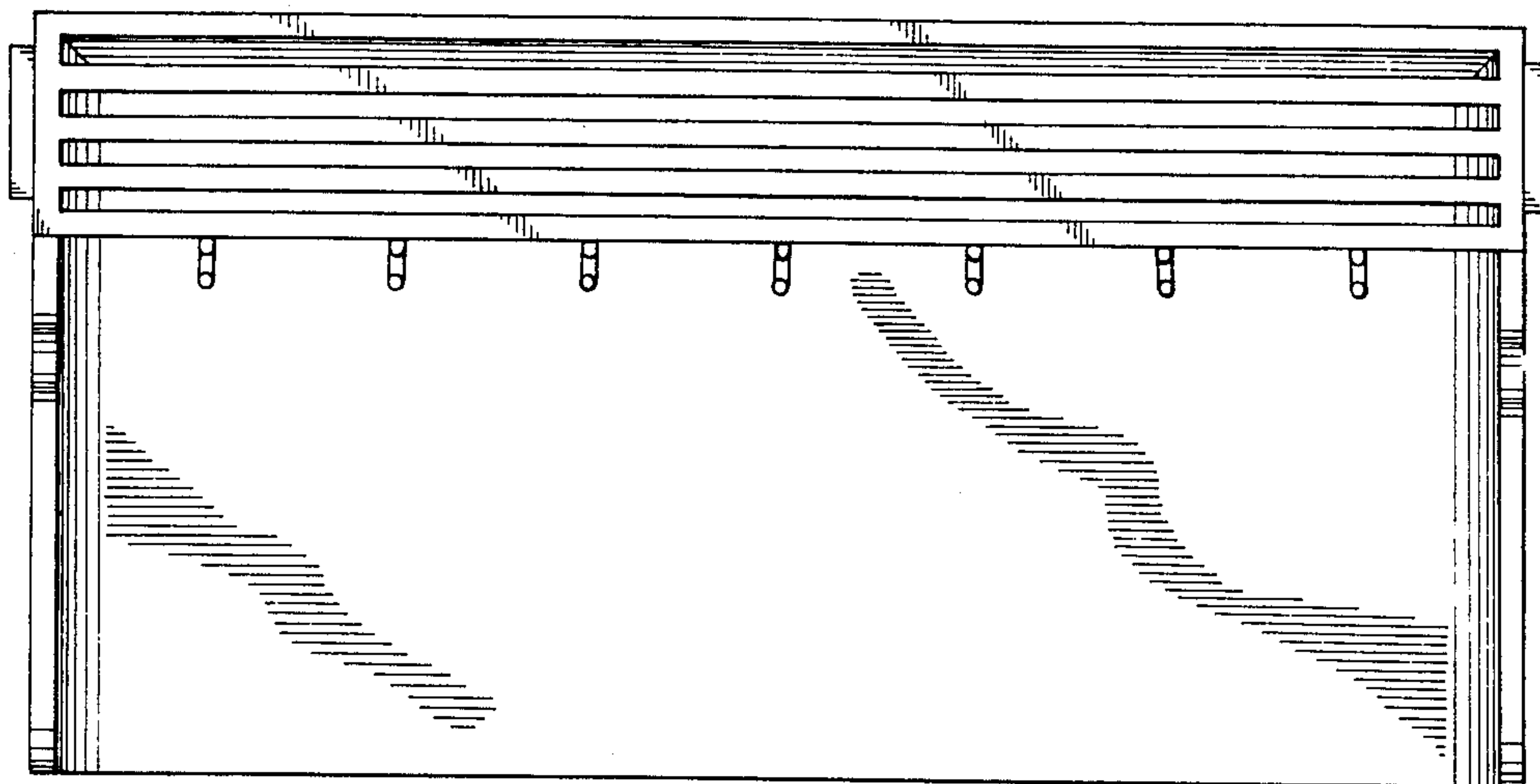
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a baker's table or similar article showing my new design; and

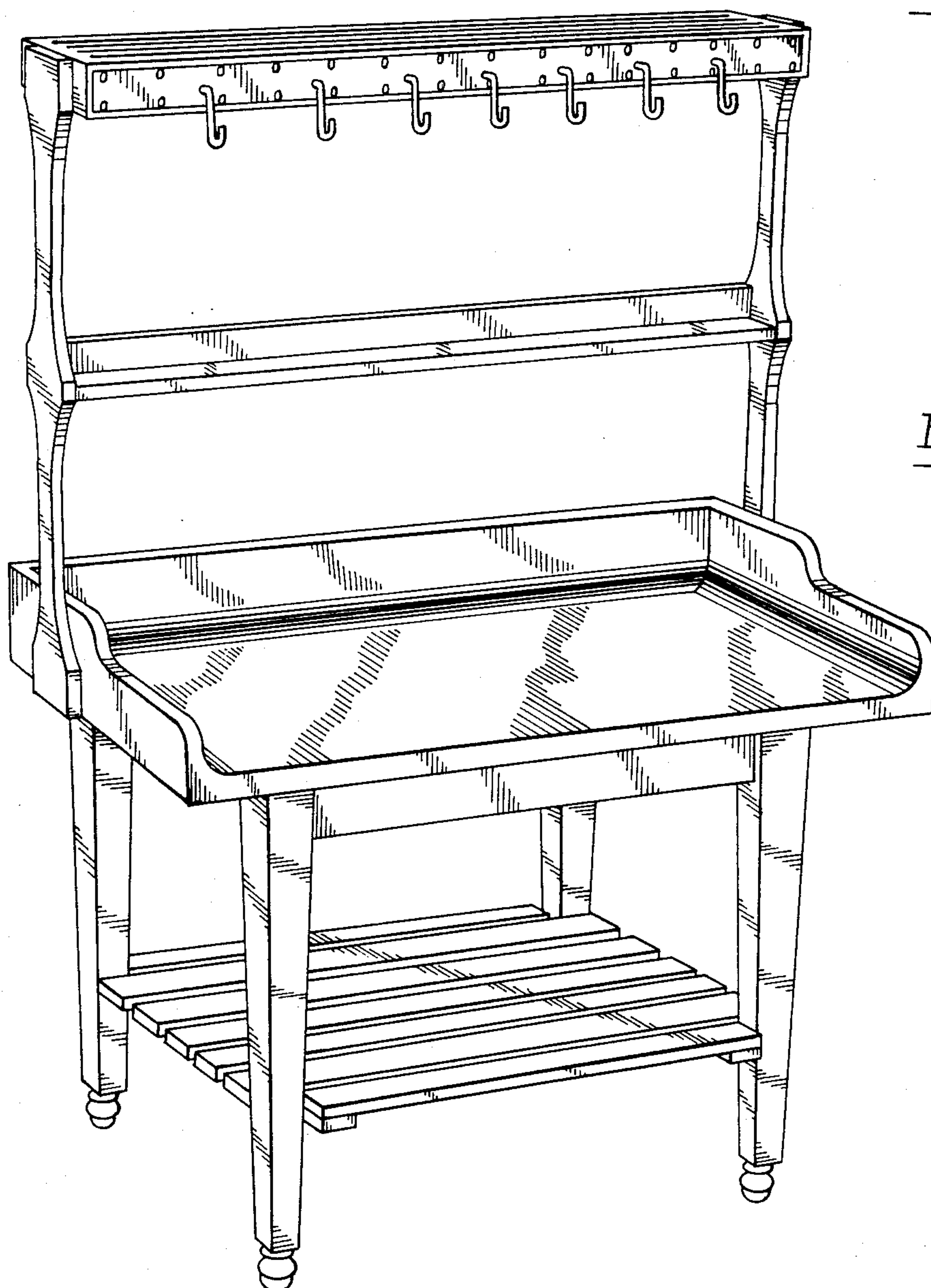
FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof.
