DESCRIPTION

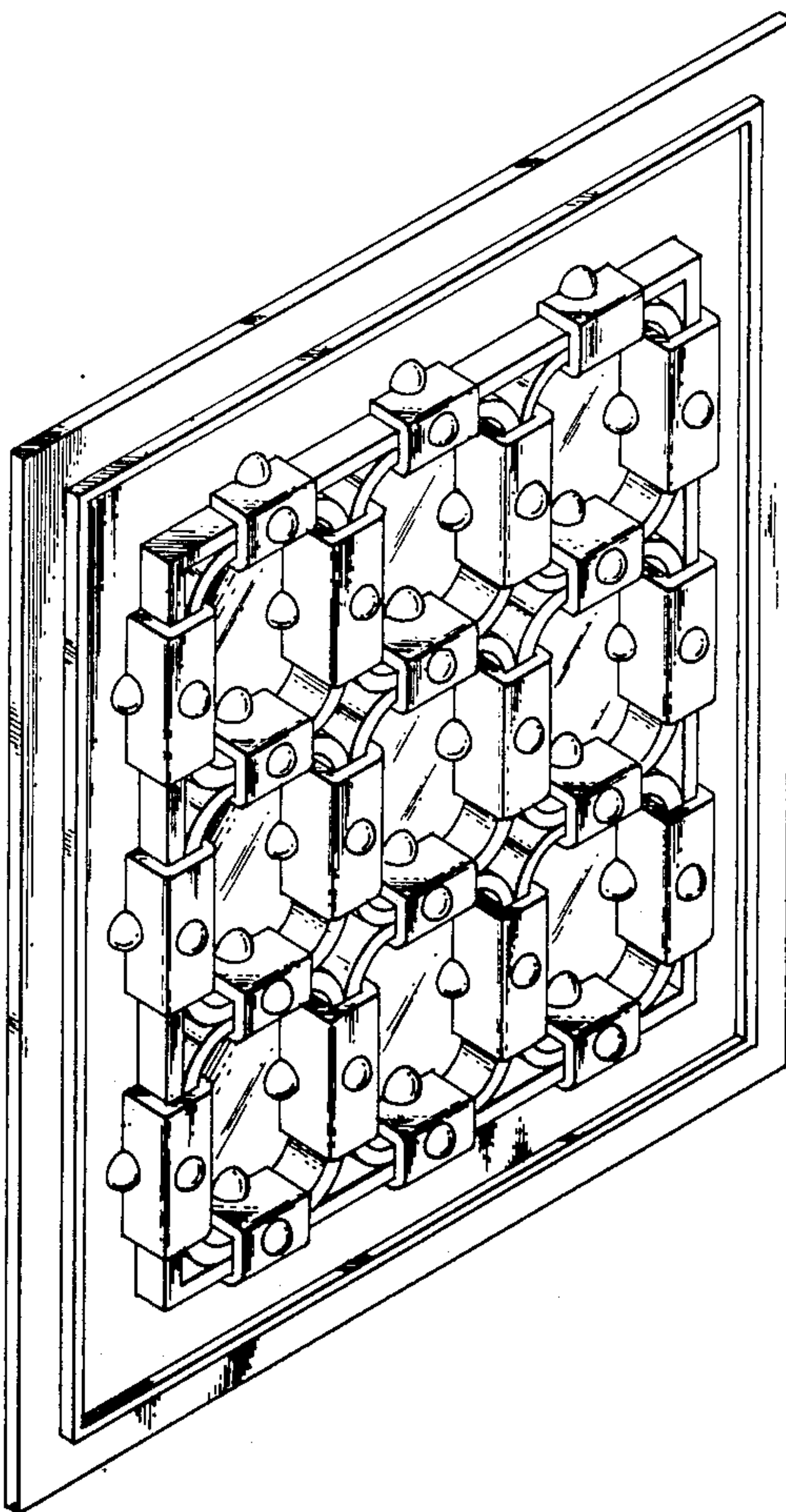
FIG. 1 is a front view of a door incorporating a speaking port showing our new design;

The door is shown in broken lines in FIG. 1 for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



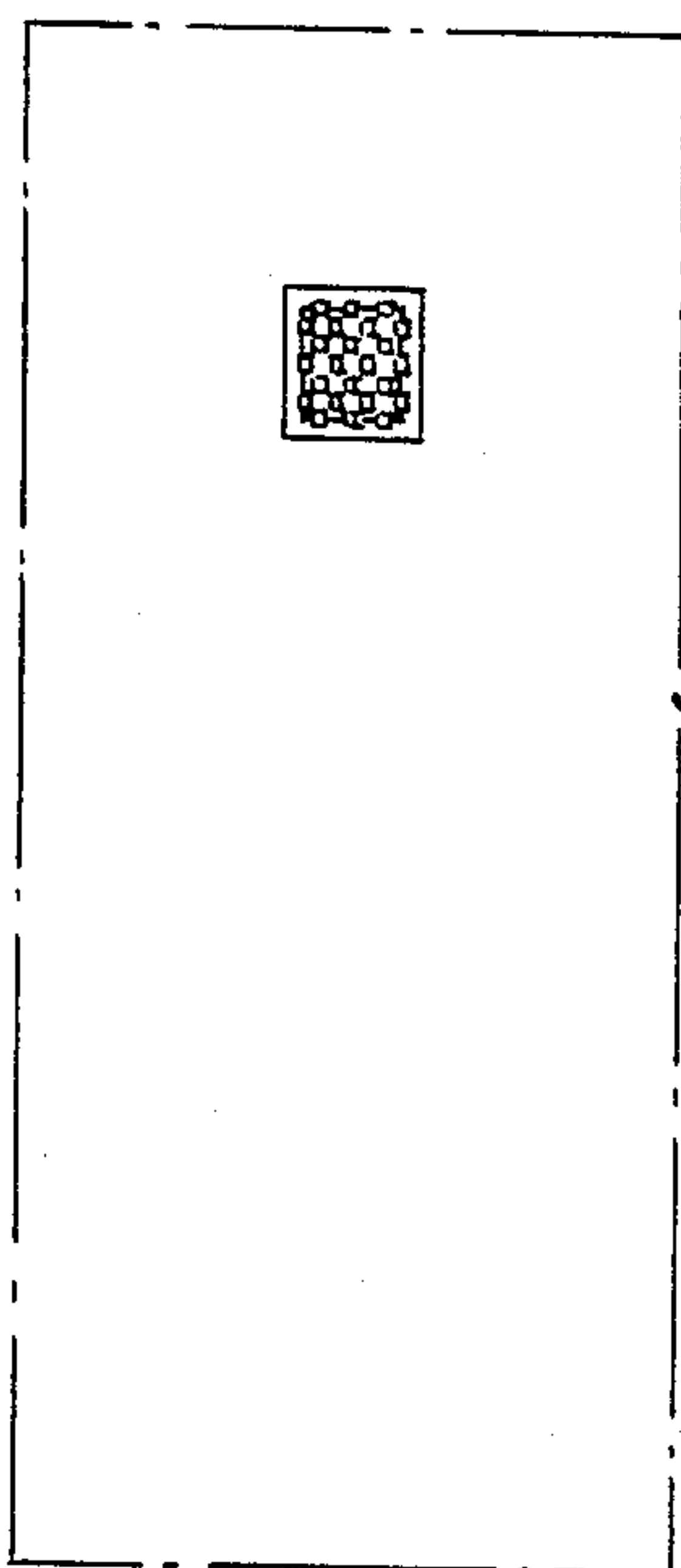

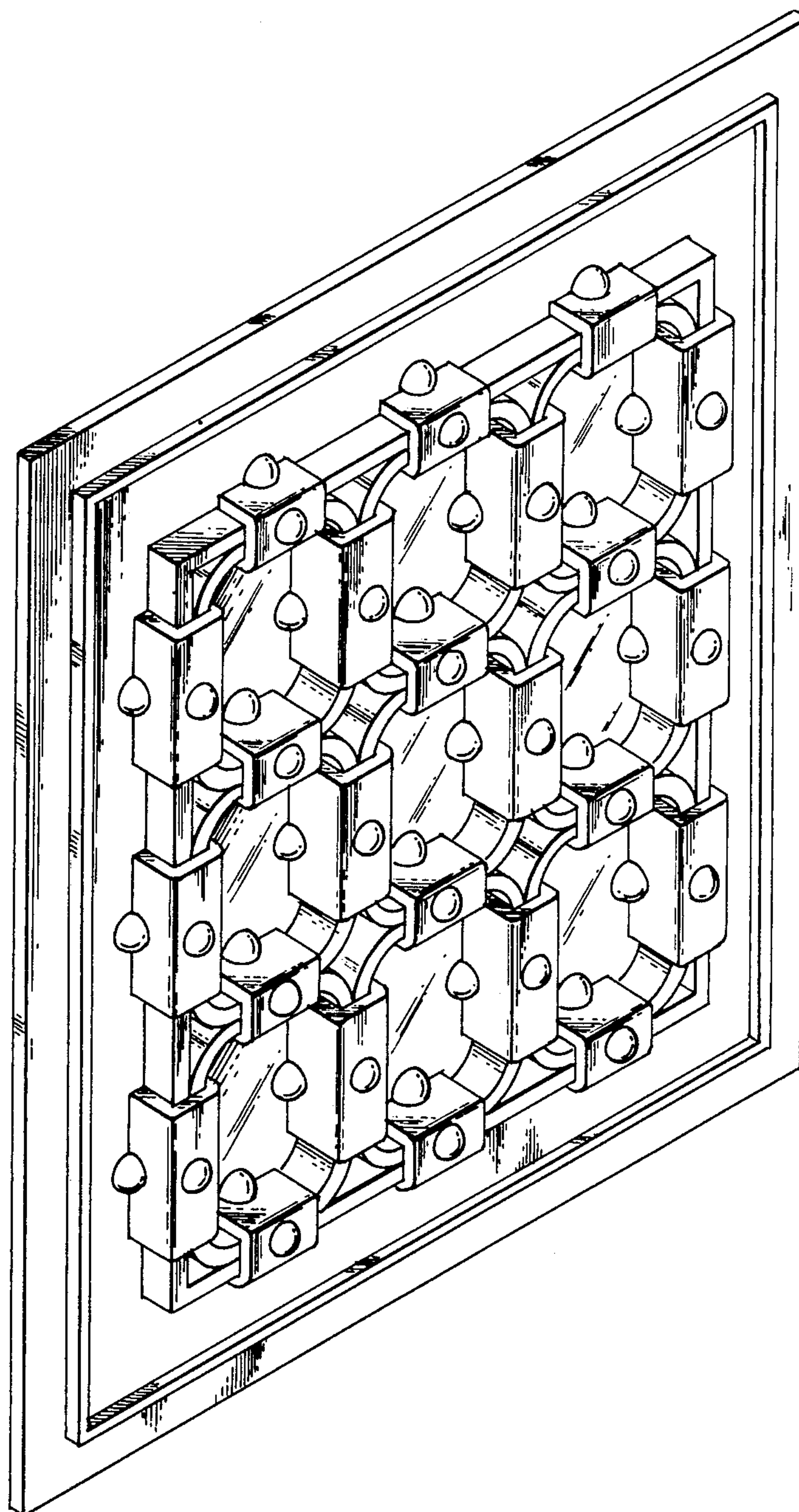

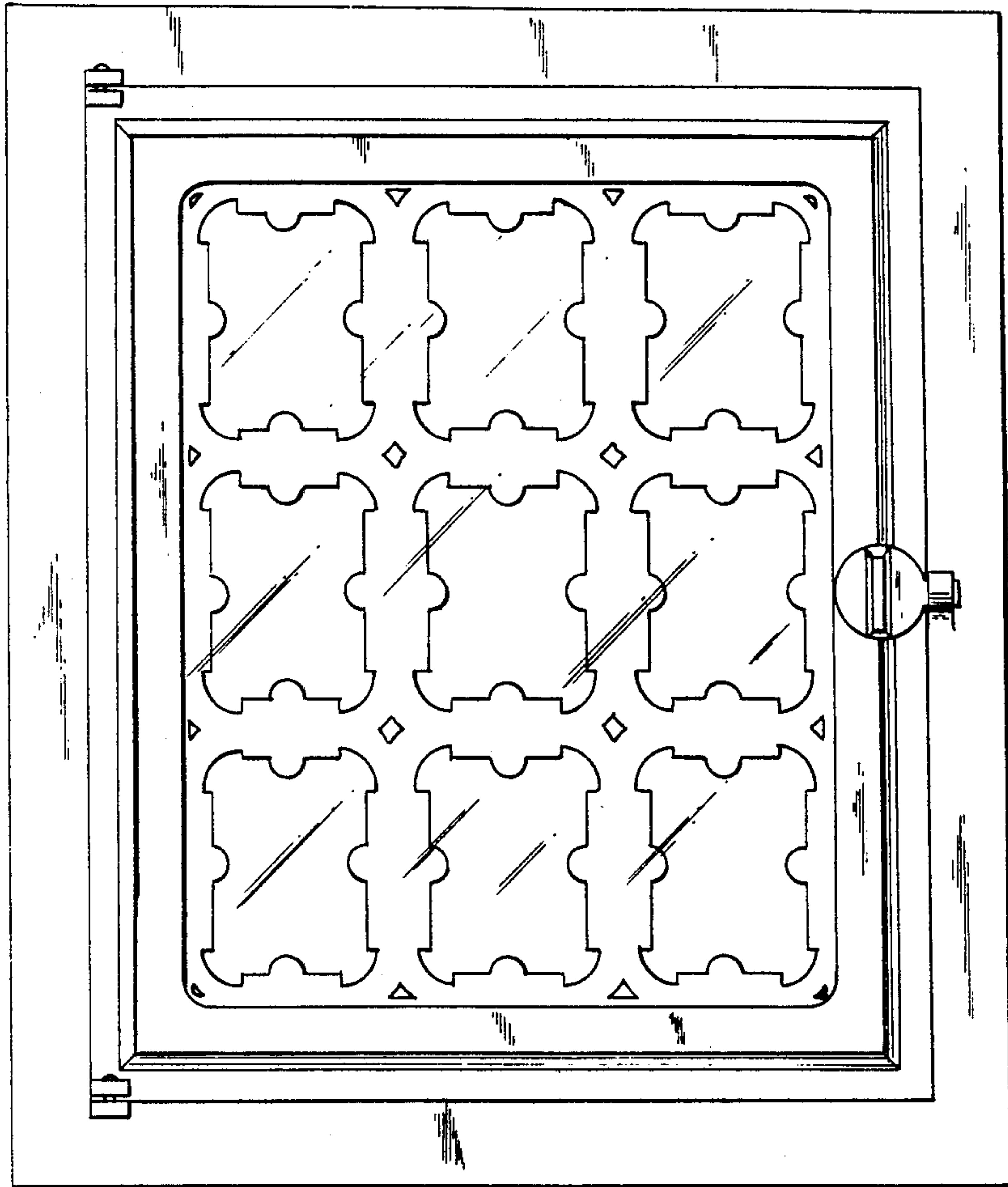
