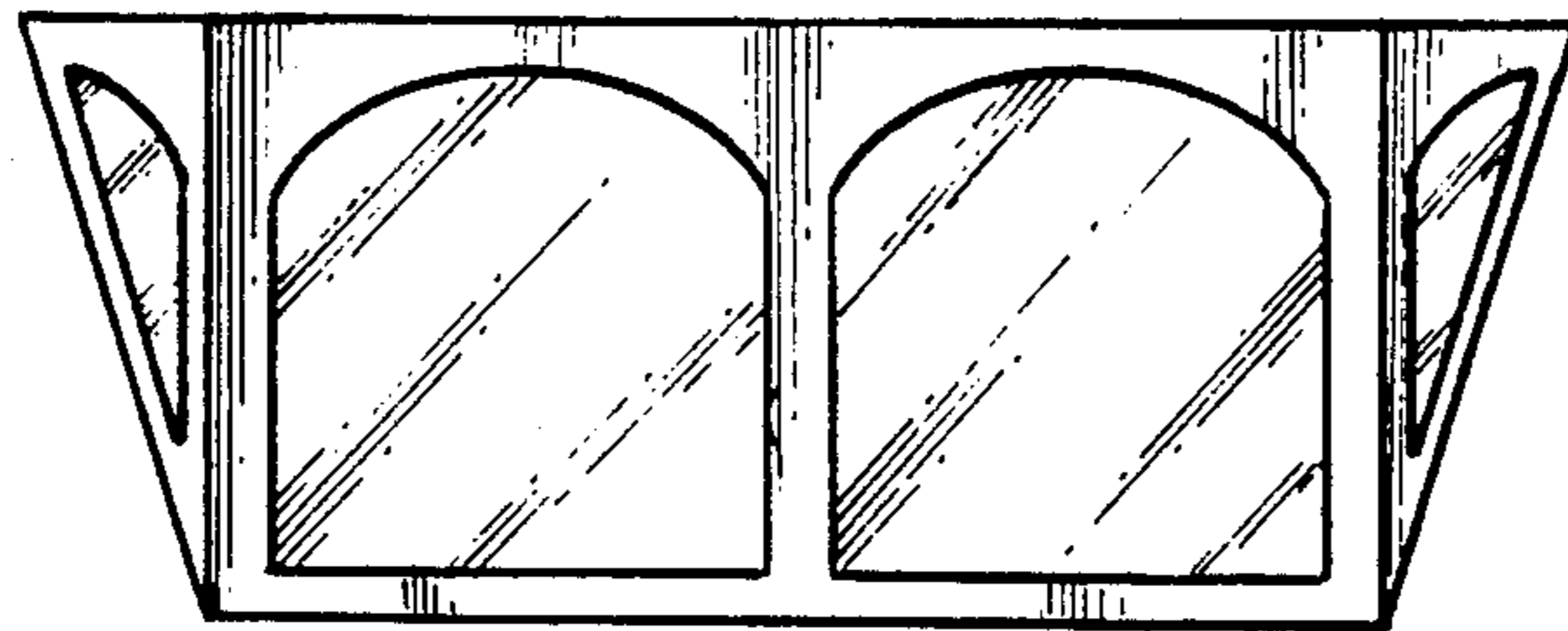
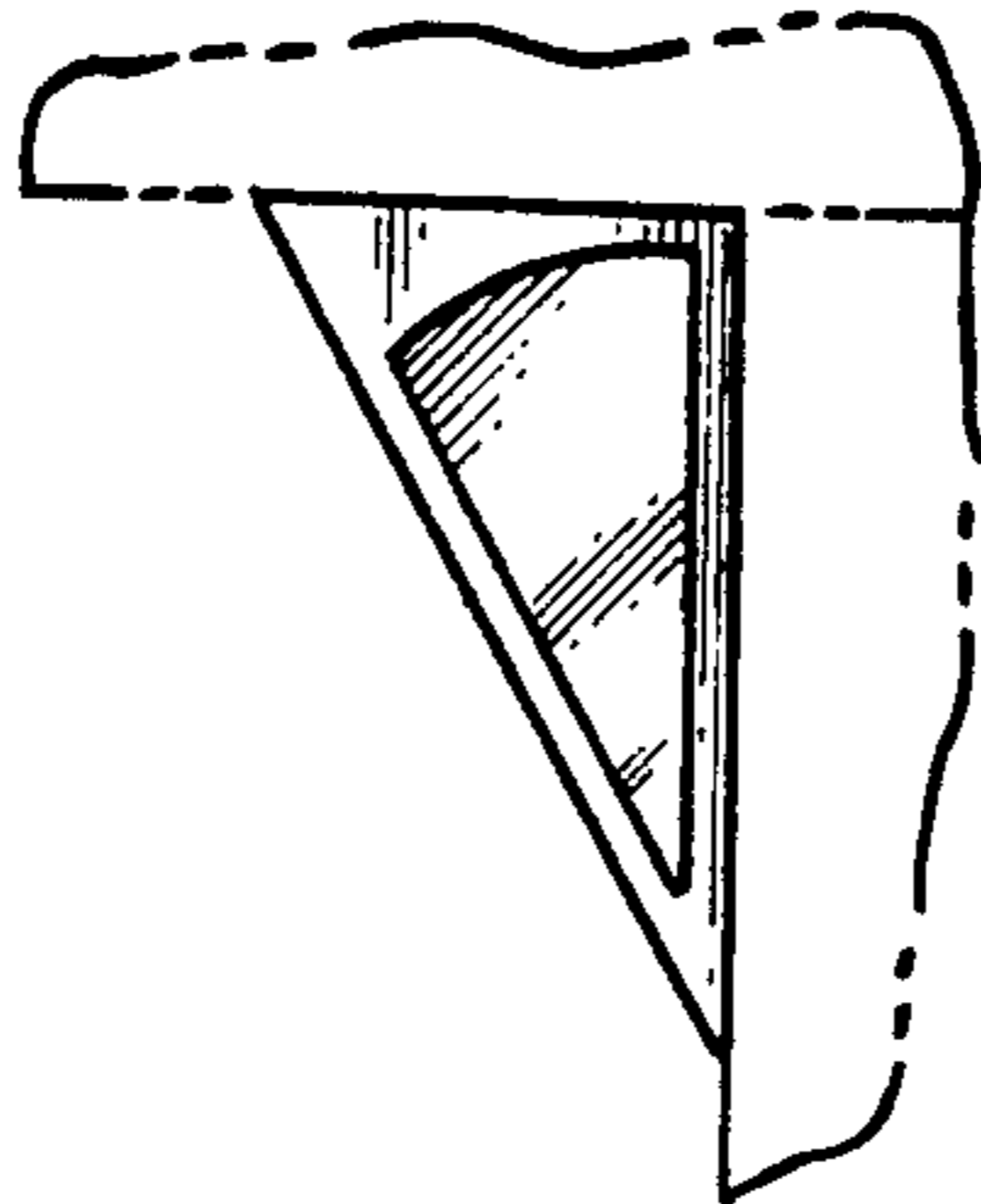
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cabinet for a light source embodying my new design;

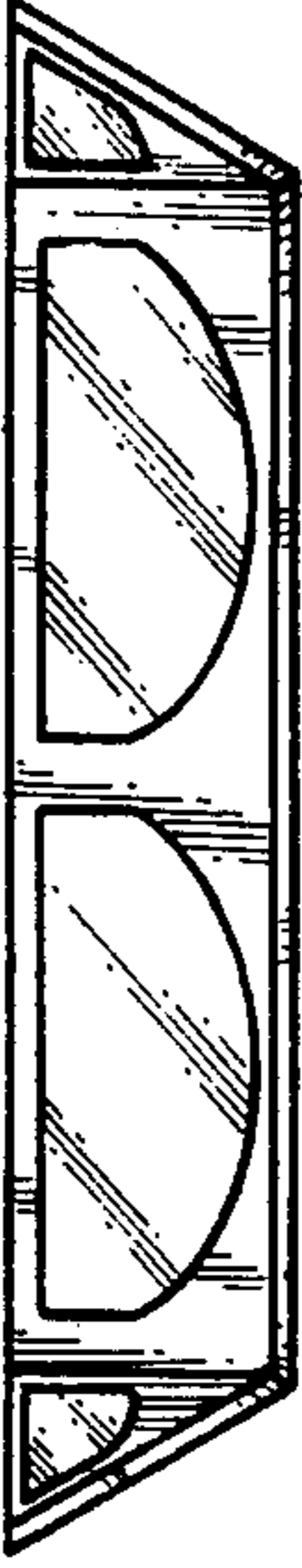

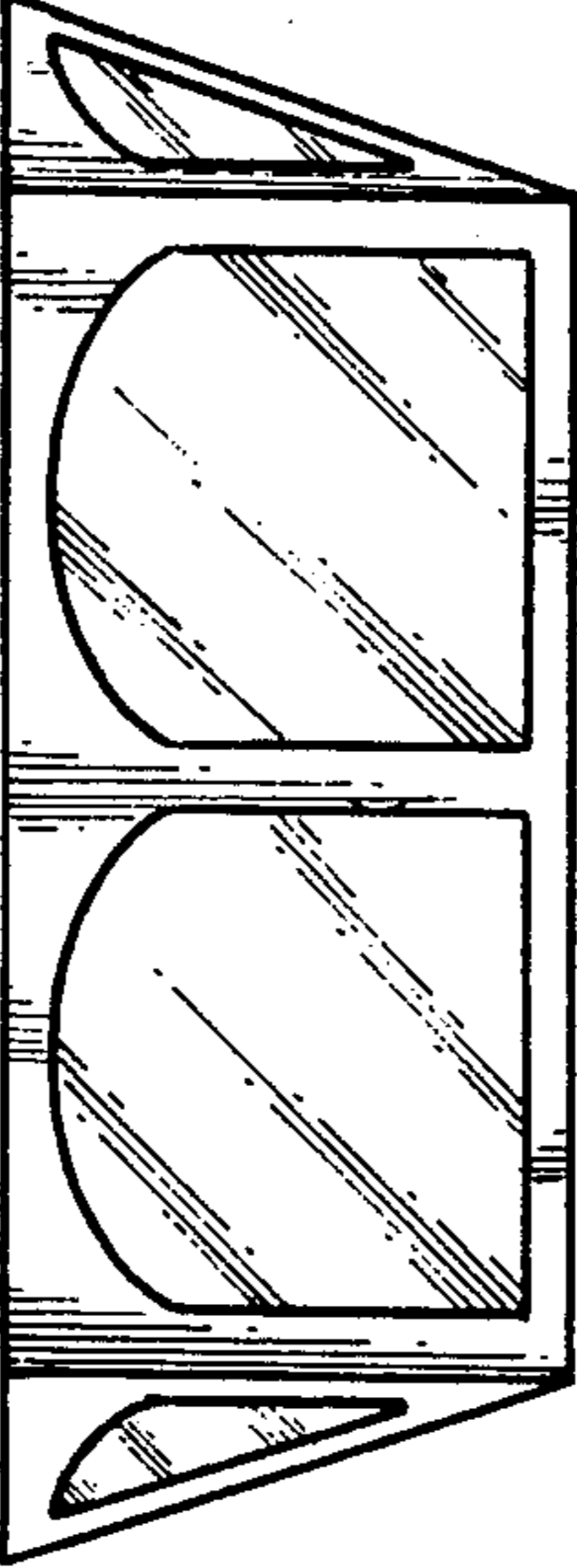

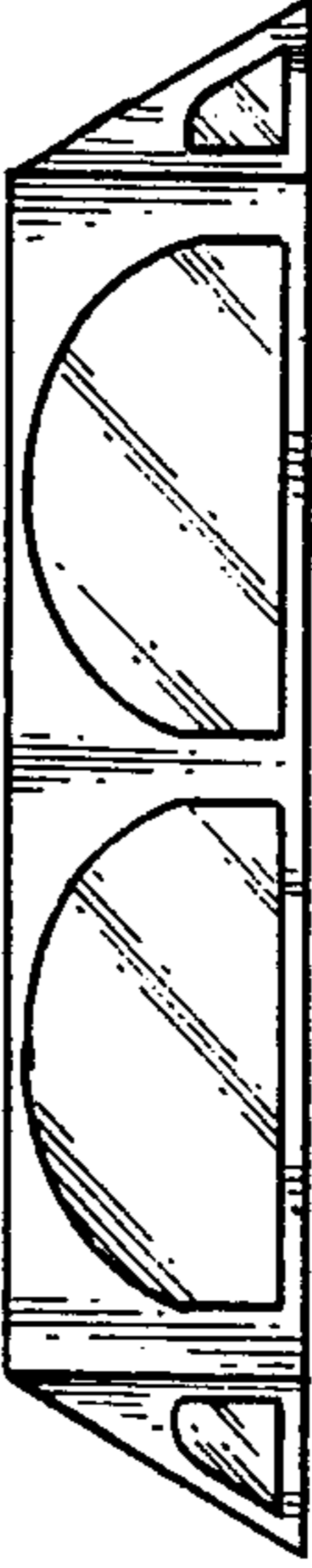

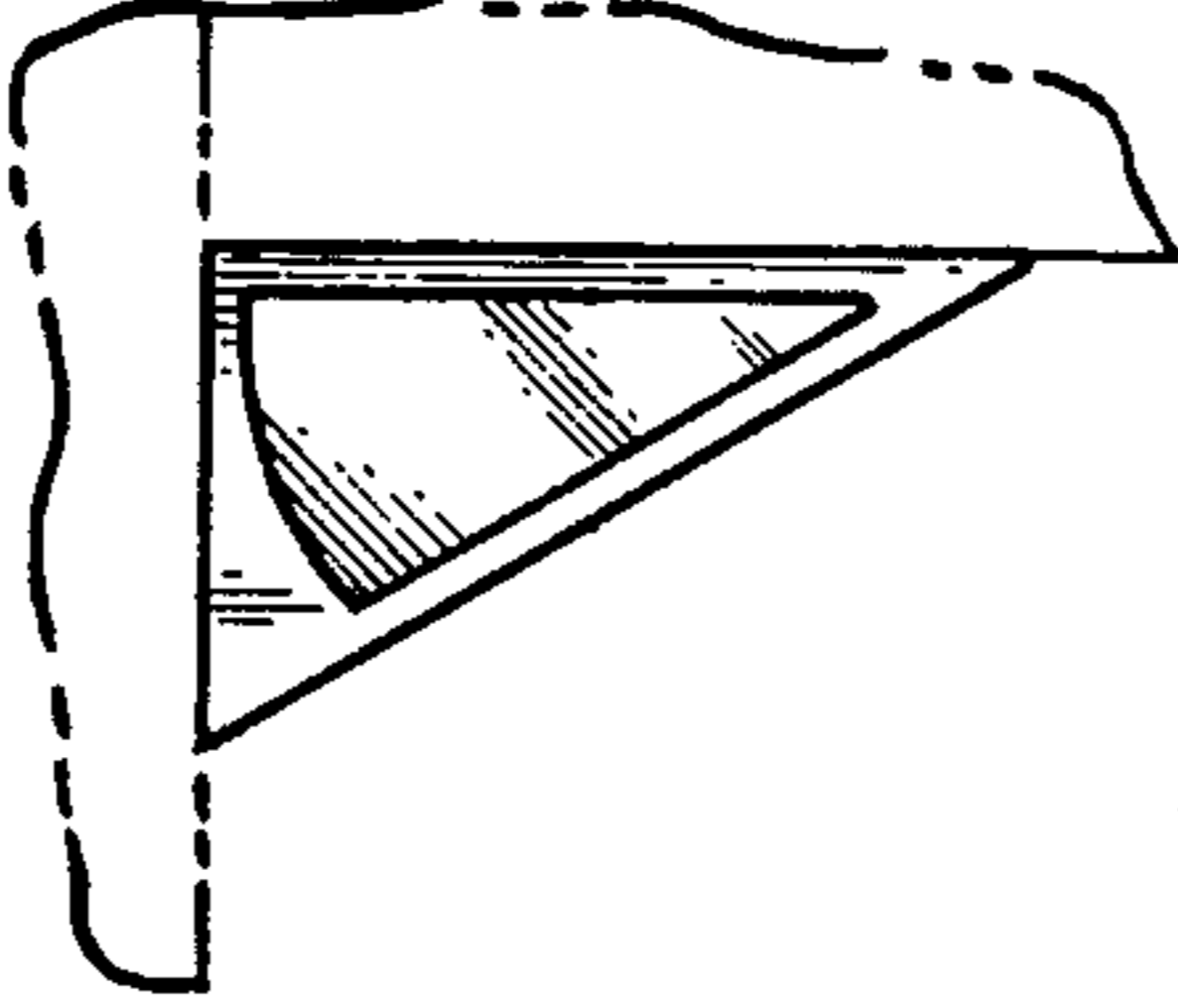
