DESCRIPTION

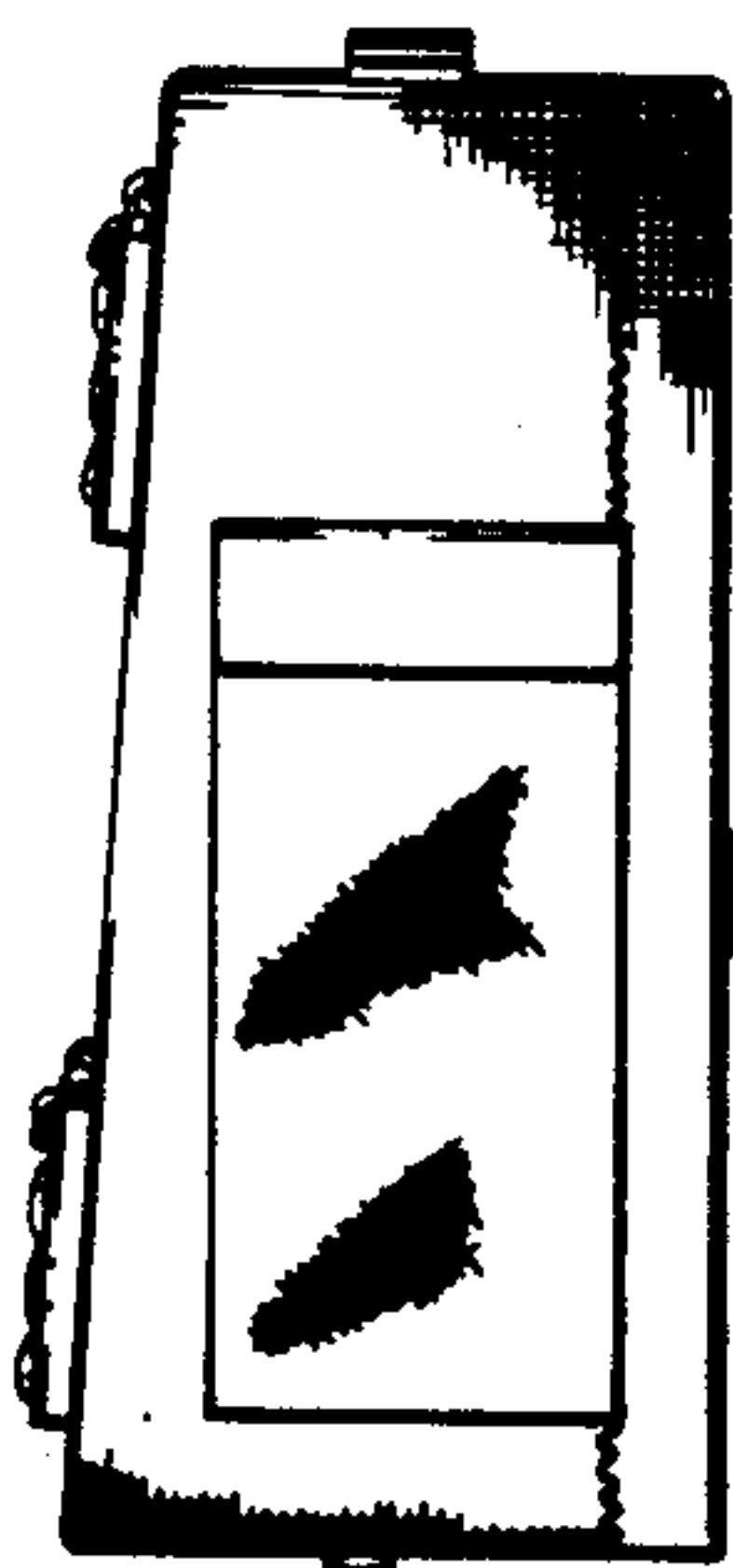
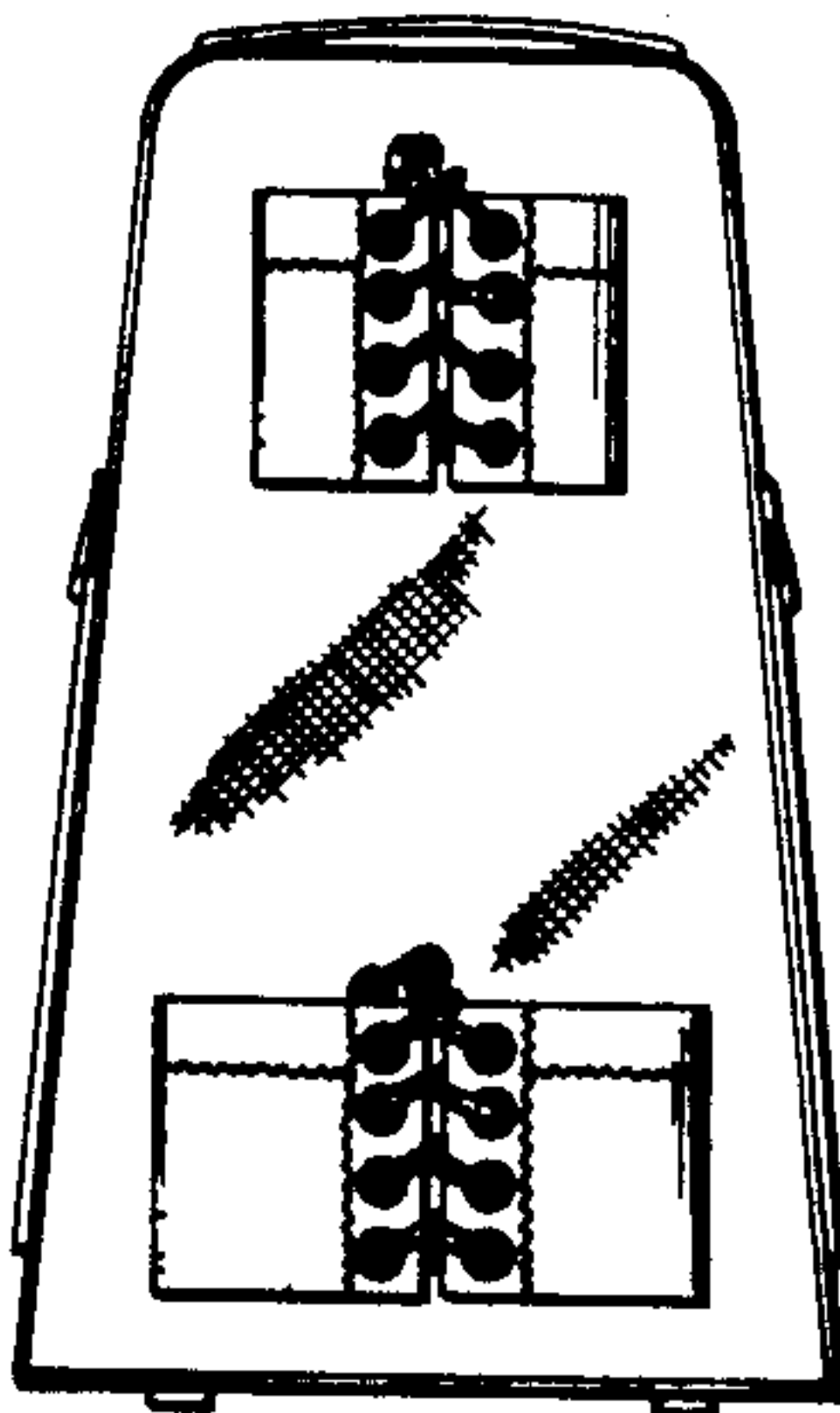
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a knapsack for a motorcycle sissy bar showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



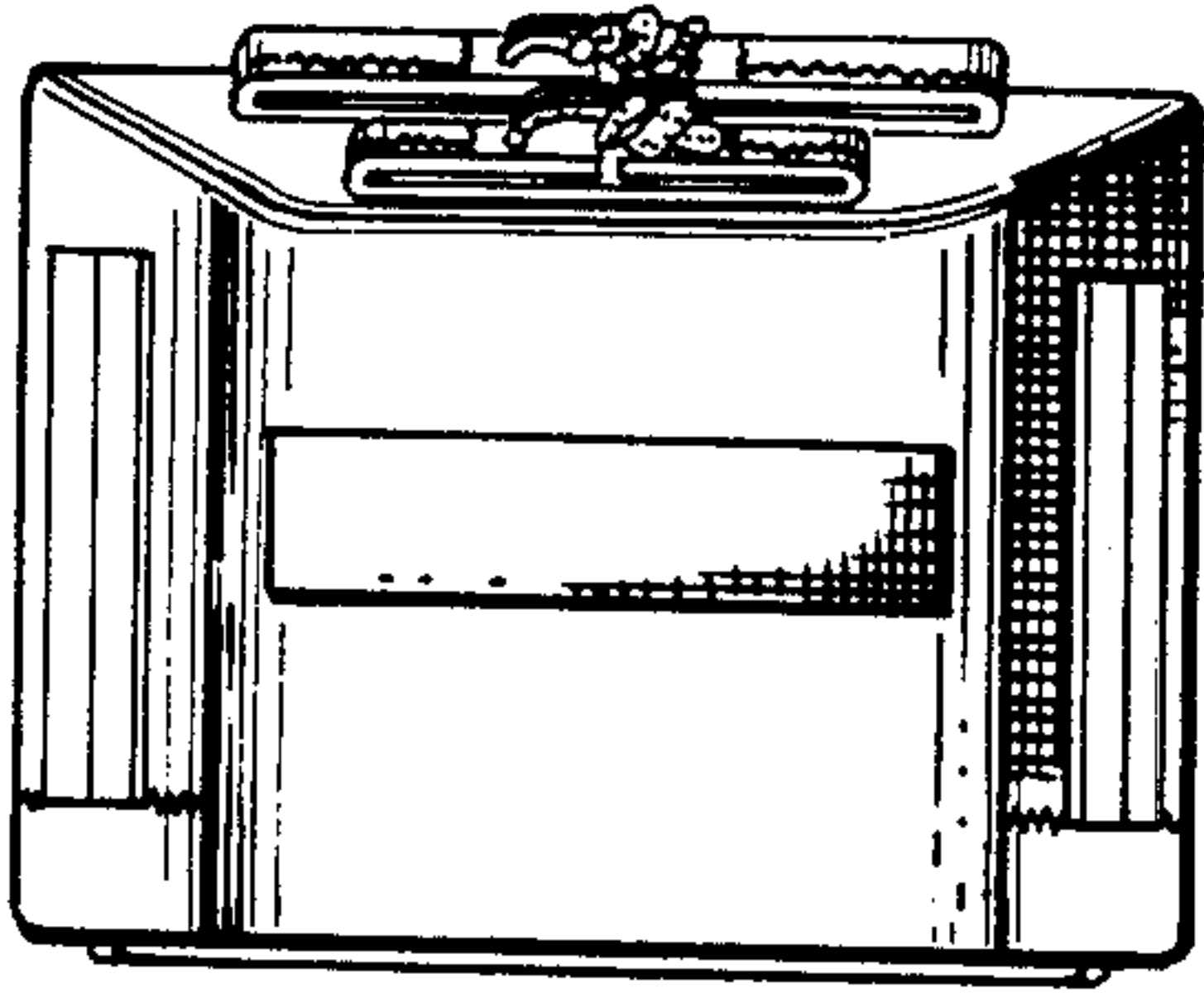

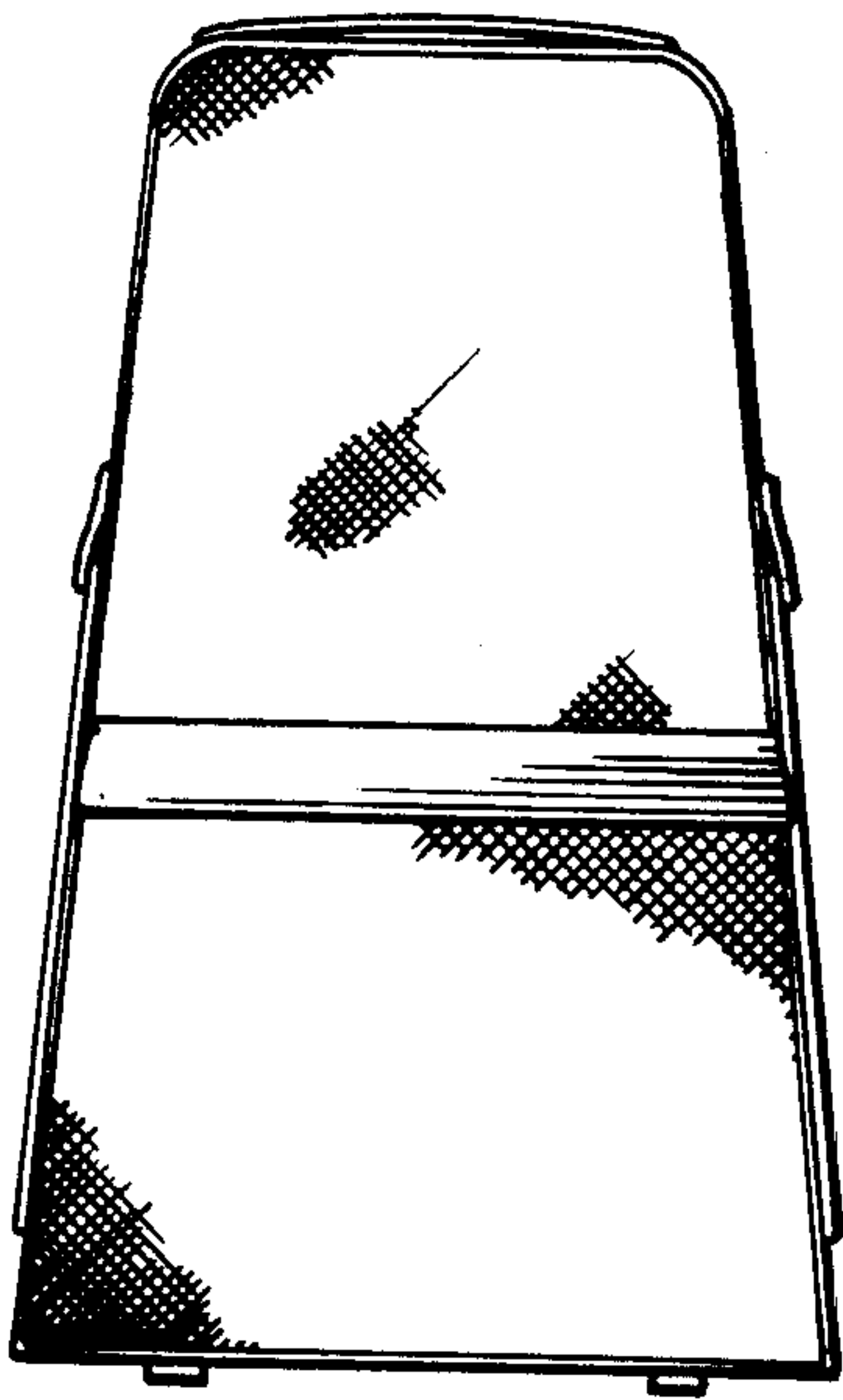

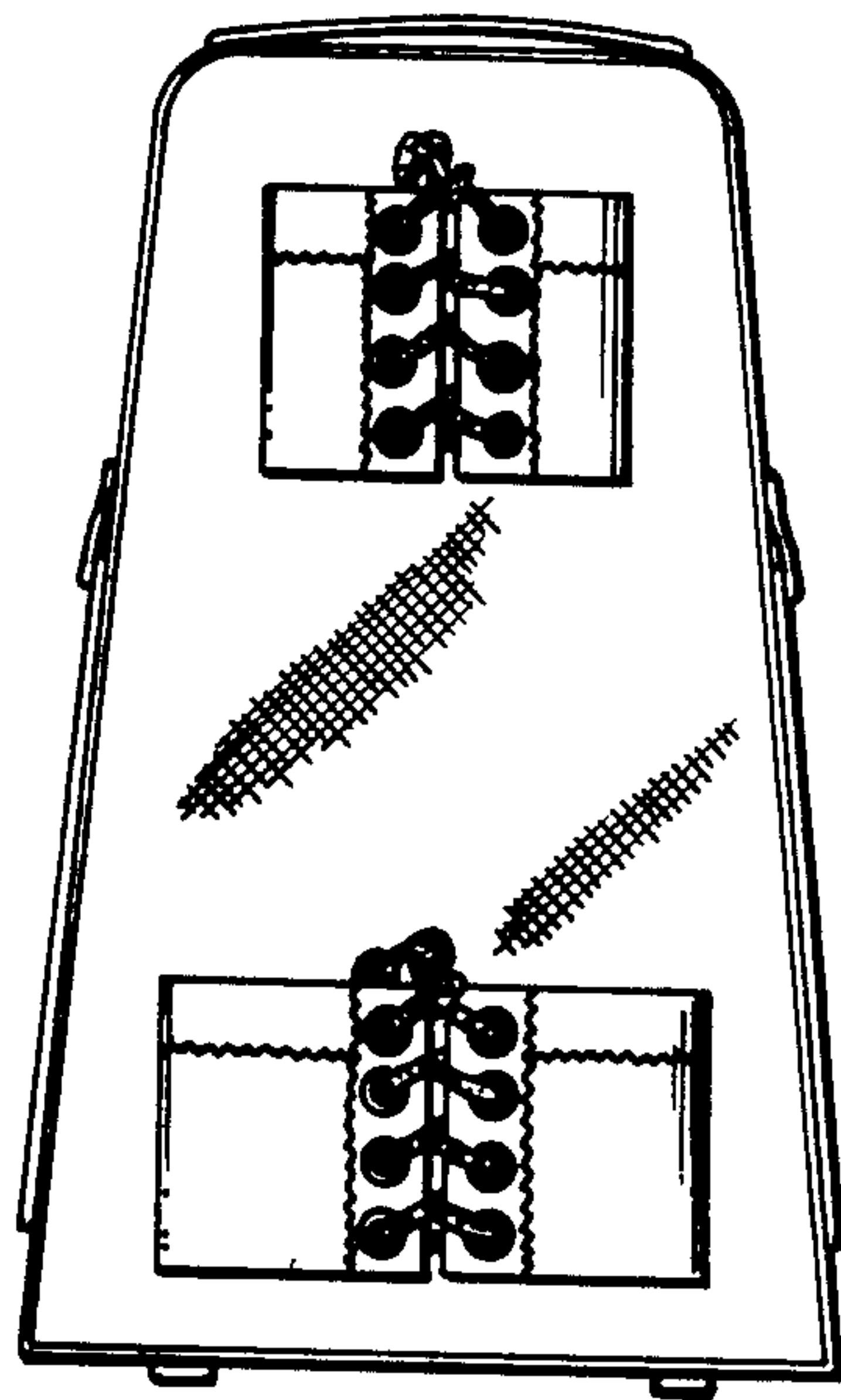

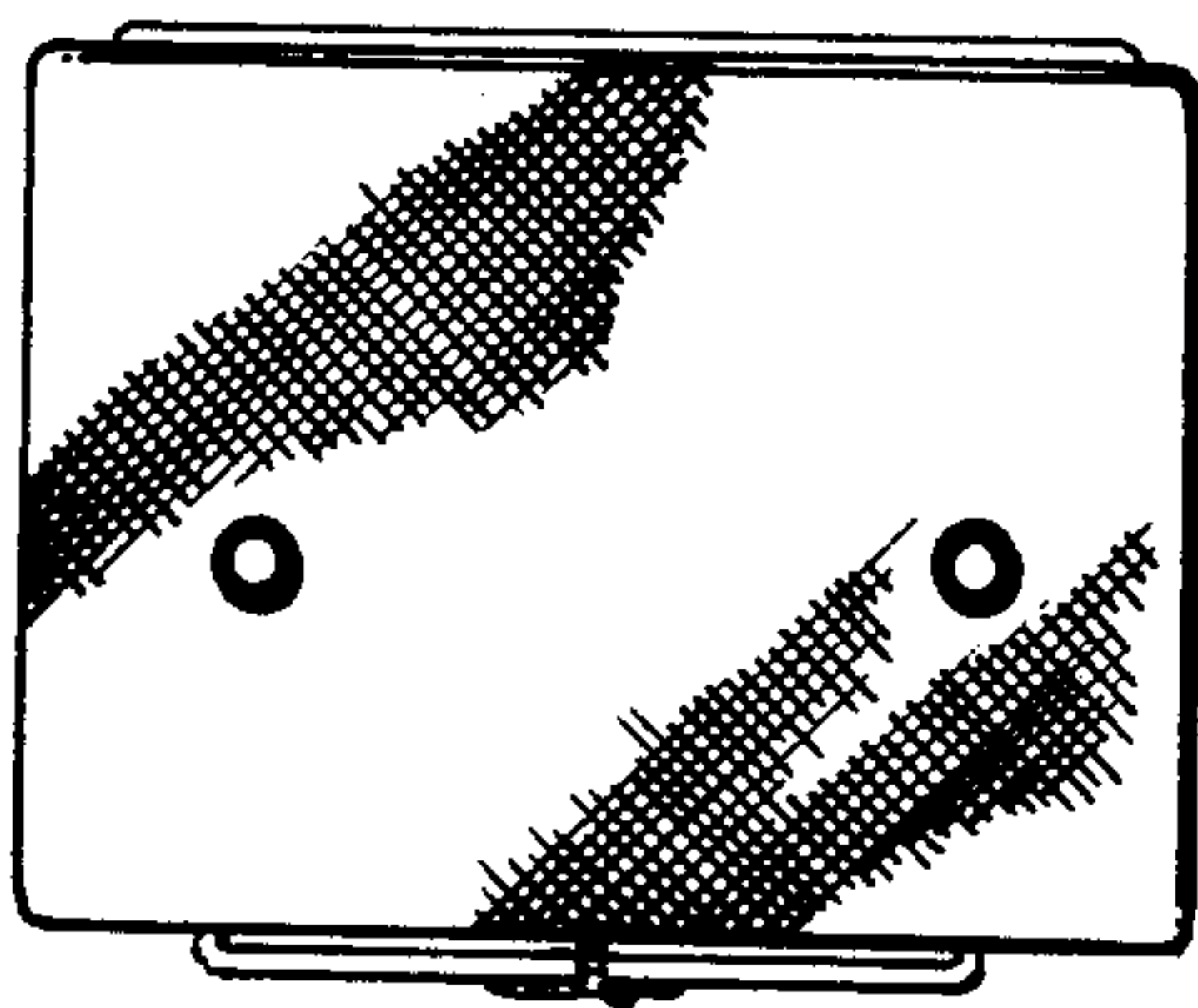

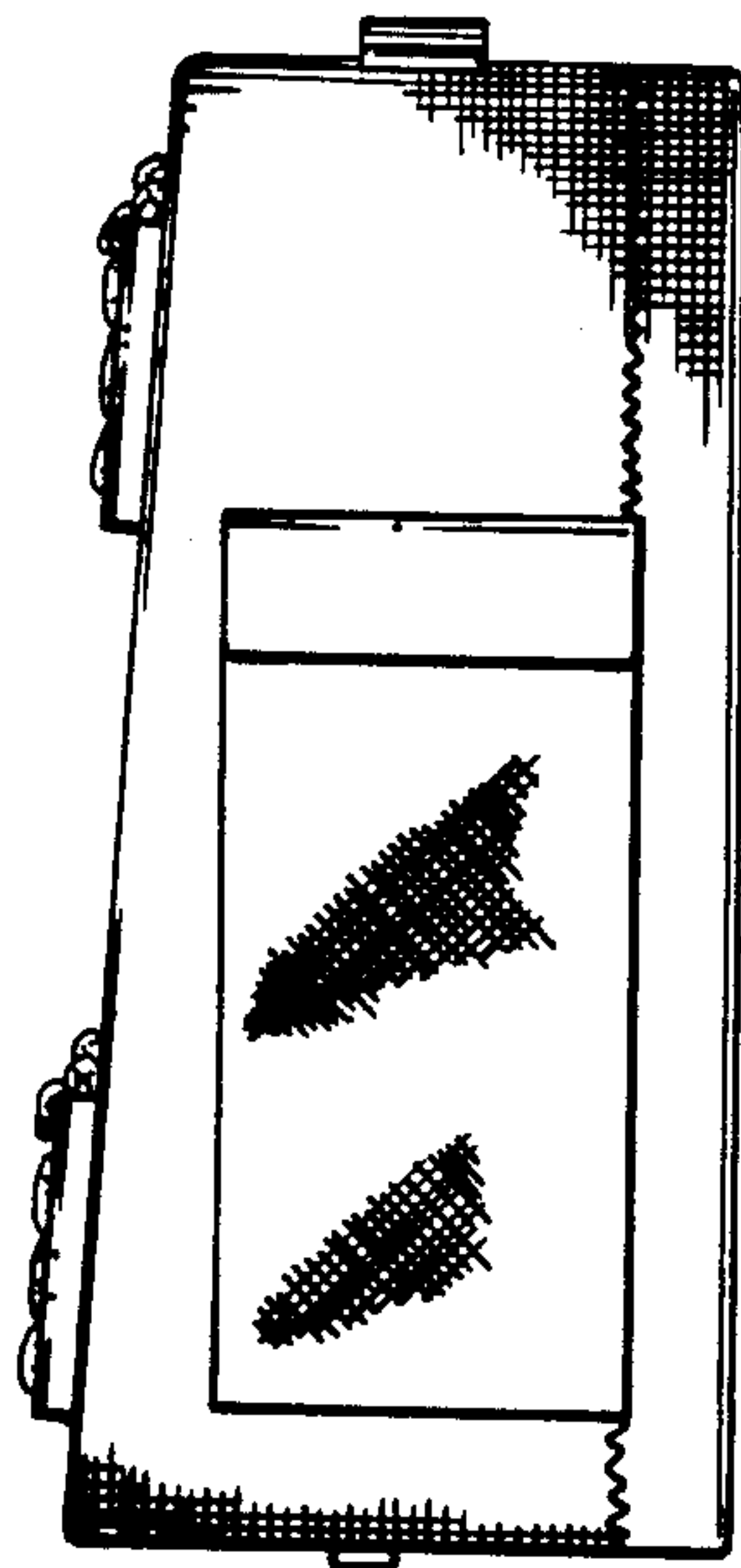
