

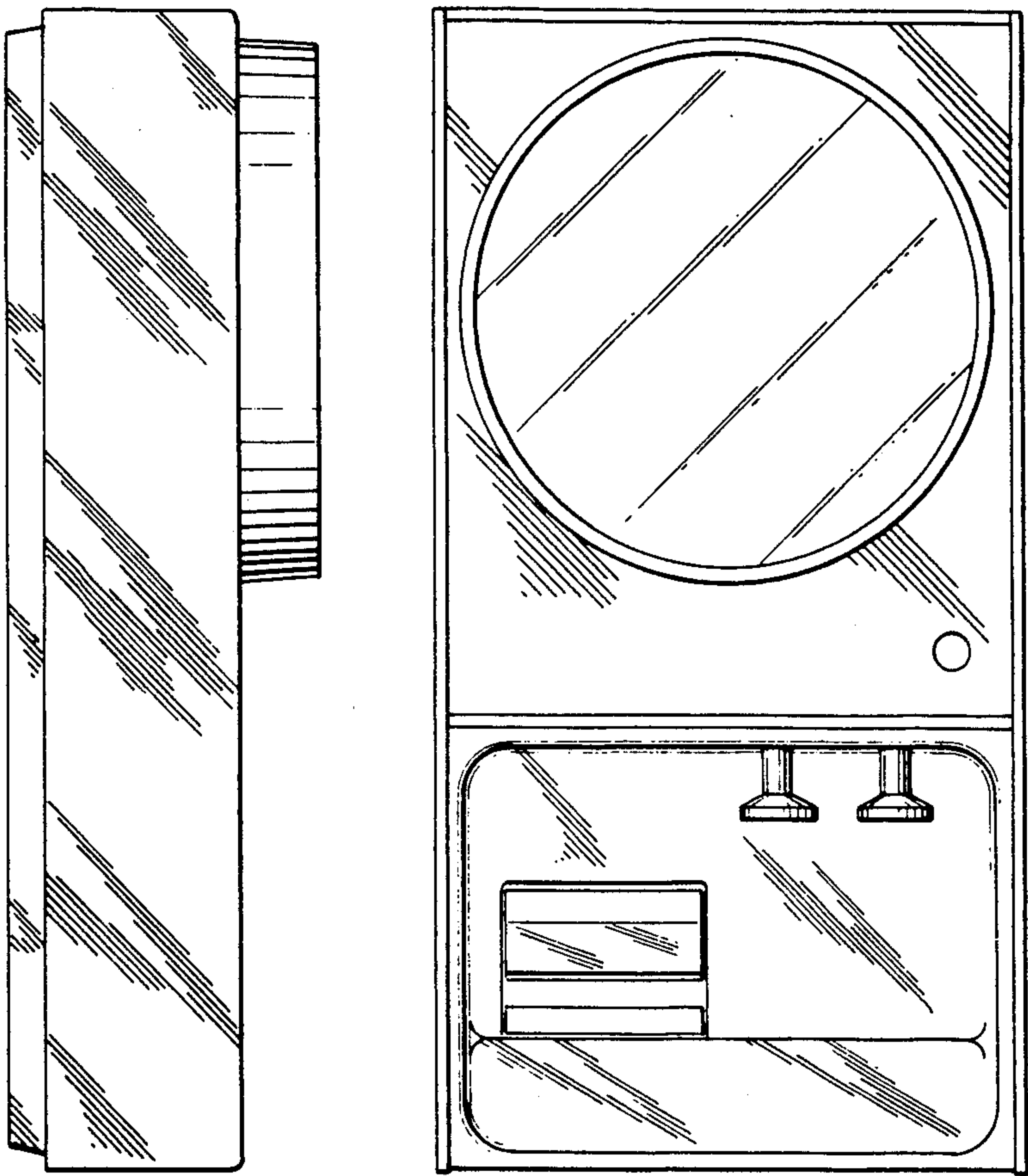

dryer showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.



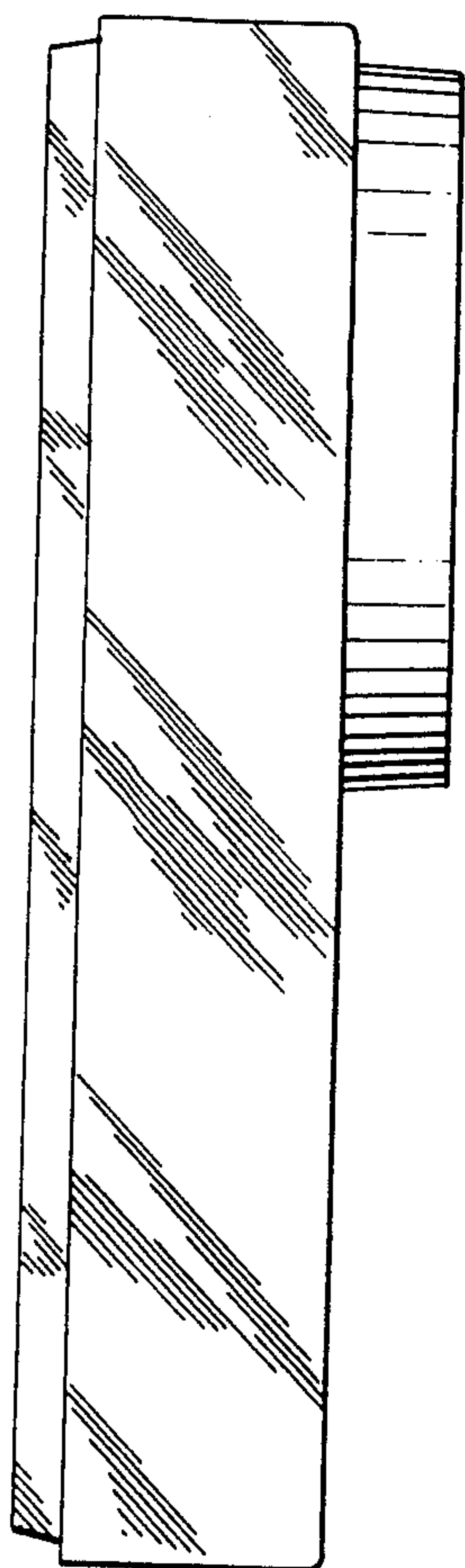

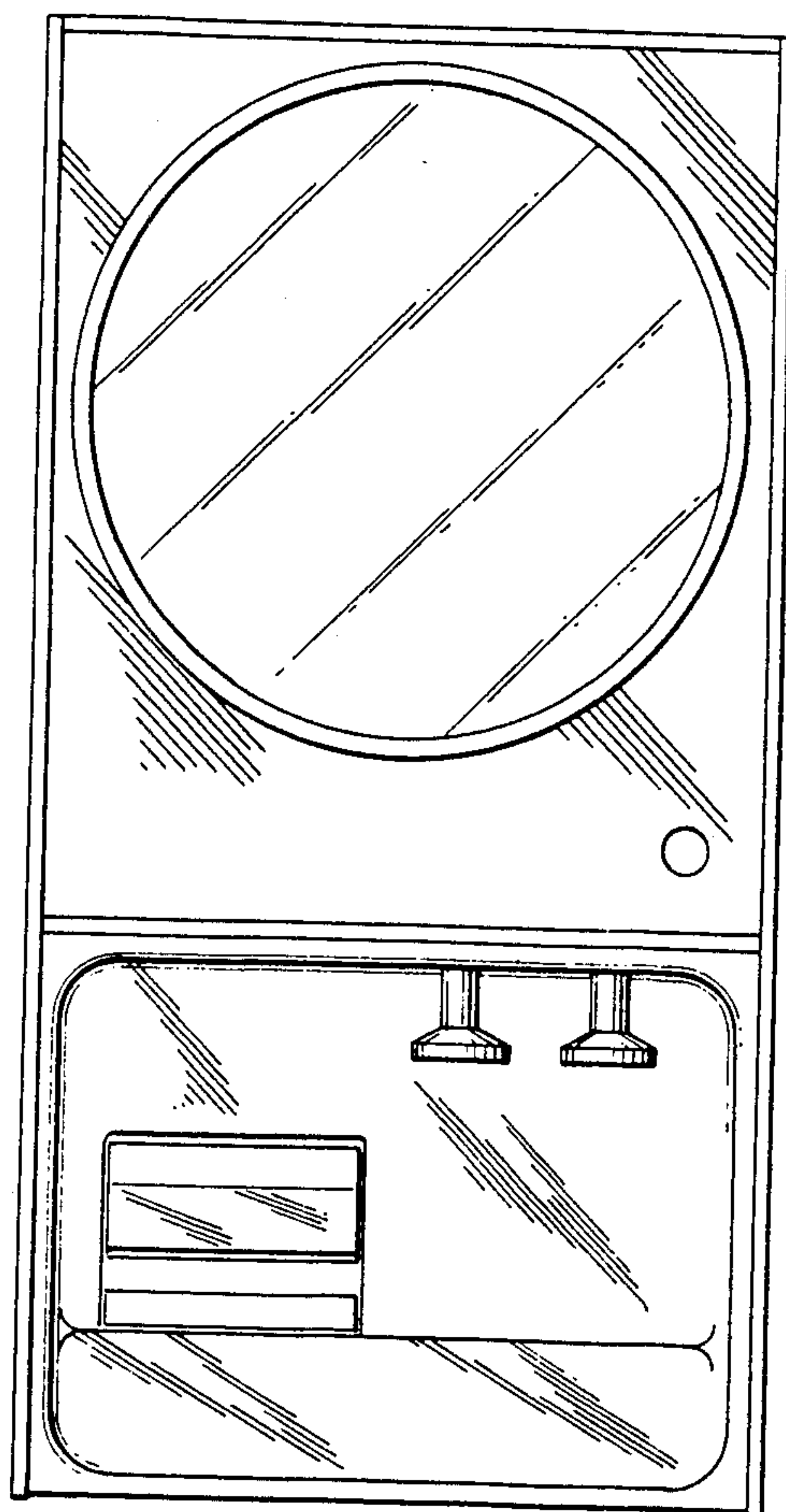

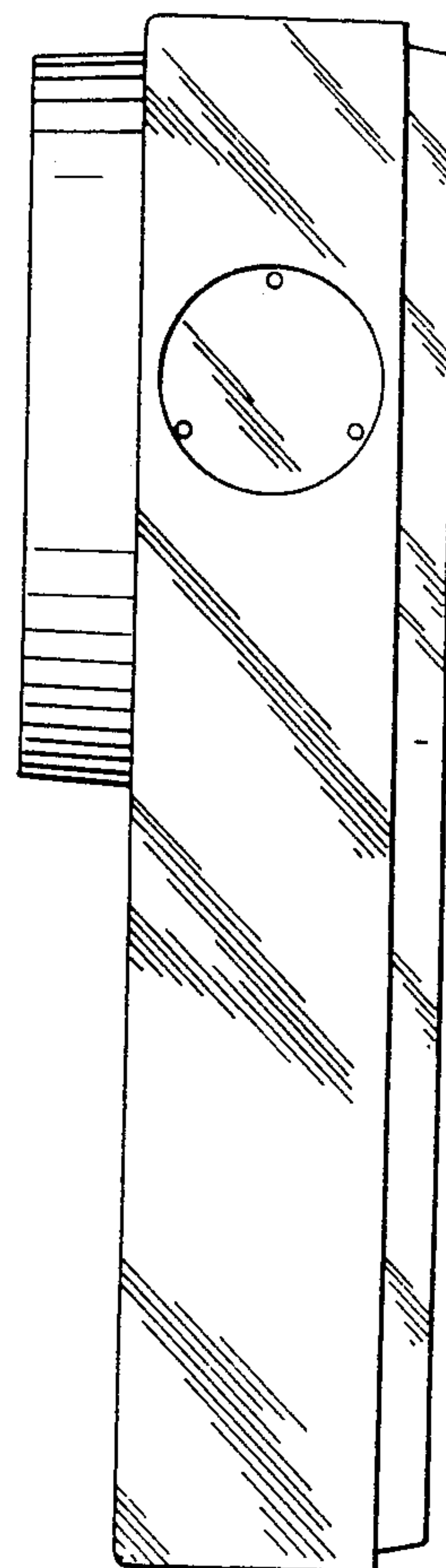

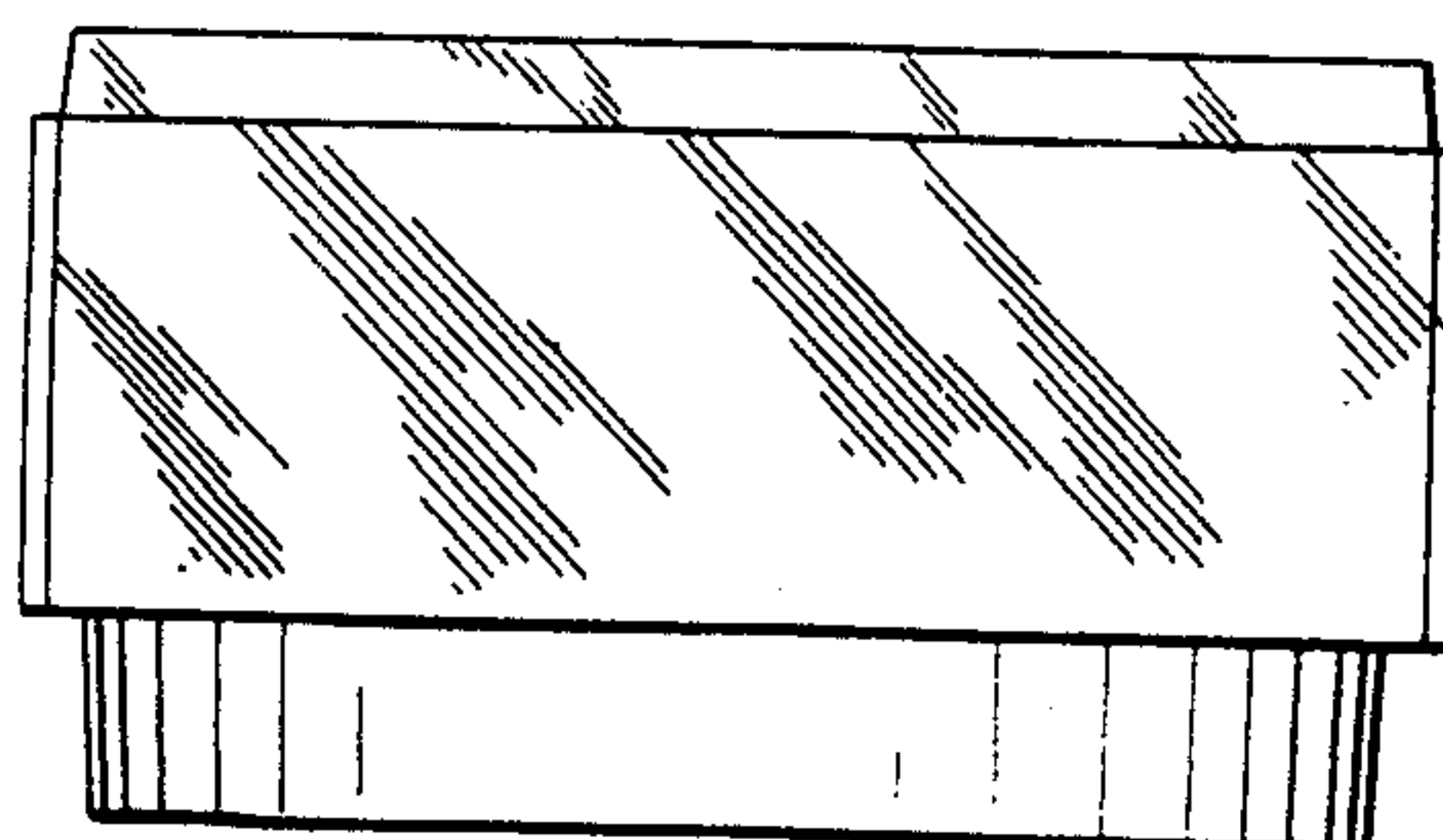
