
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a casing for an electronic calculator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a casing for an electronic calculator;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the casing of FIG. 1. The rear and bottom surfaces of the casing are flat and unornamented.






