DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a console for apparatus for performing mathematical functions showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.

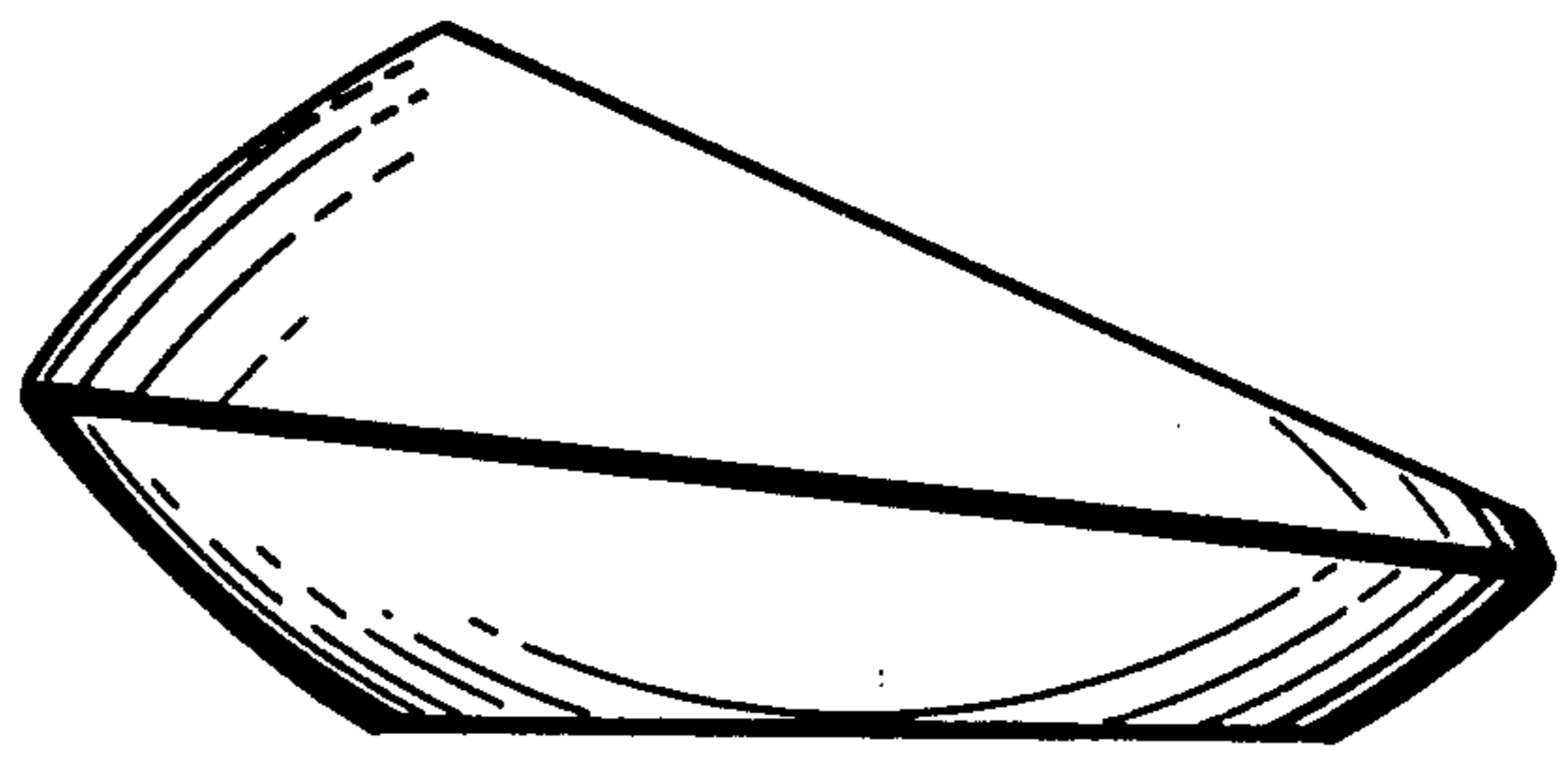
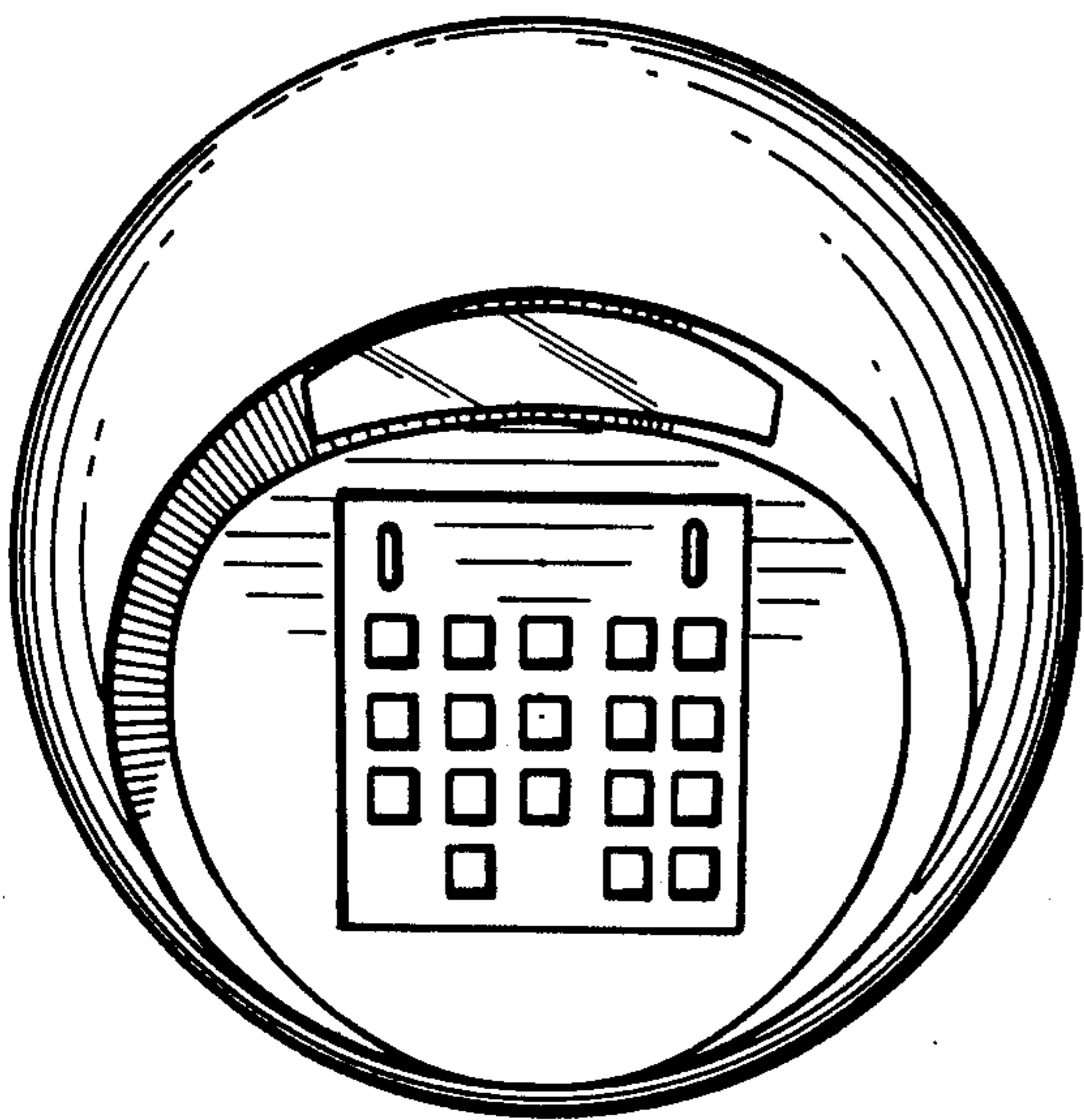

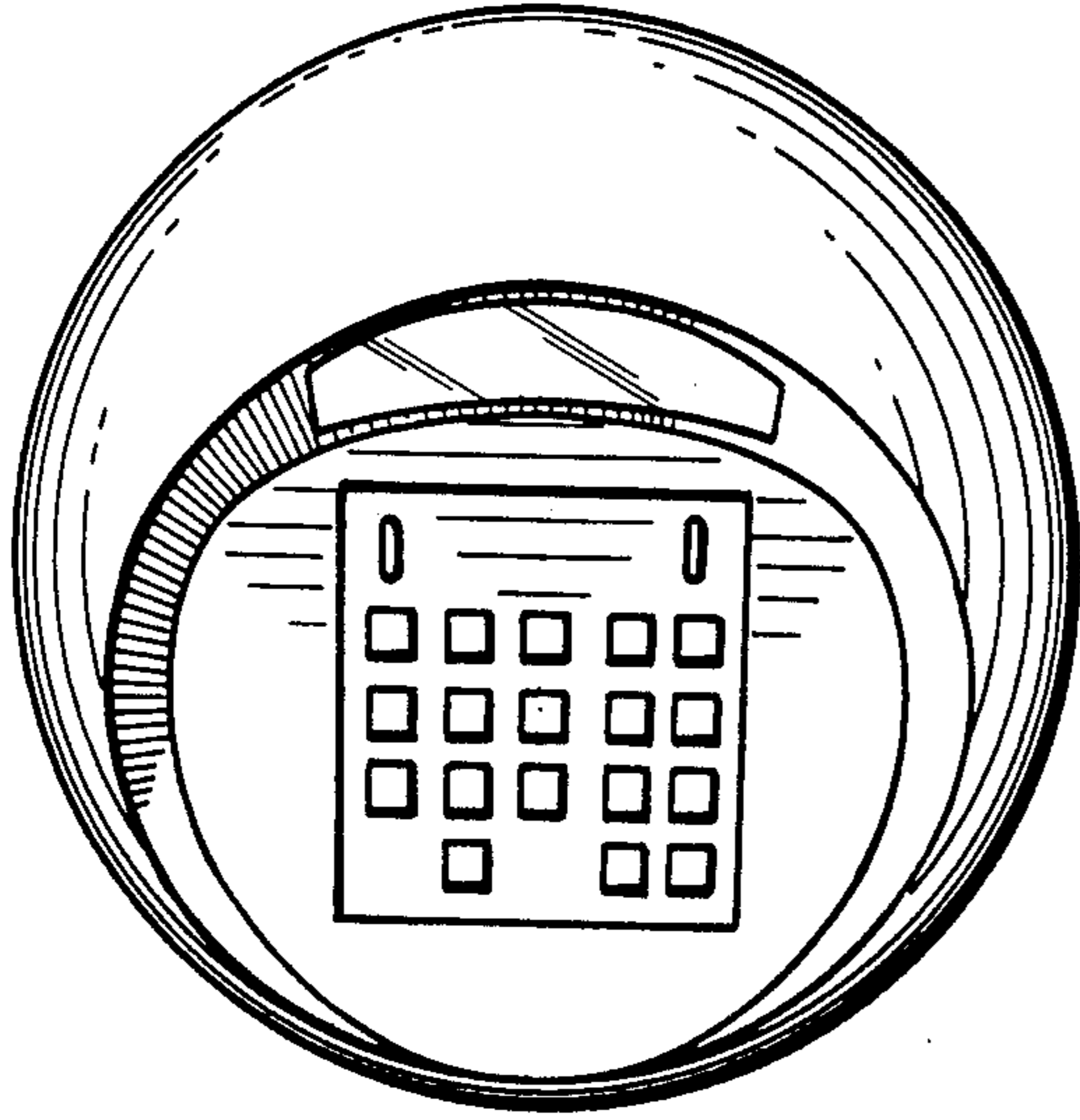

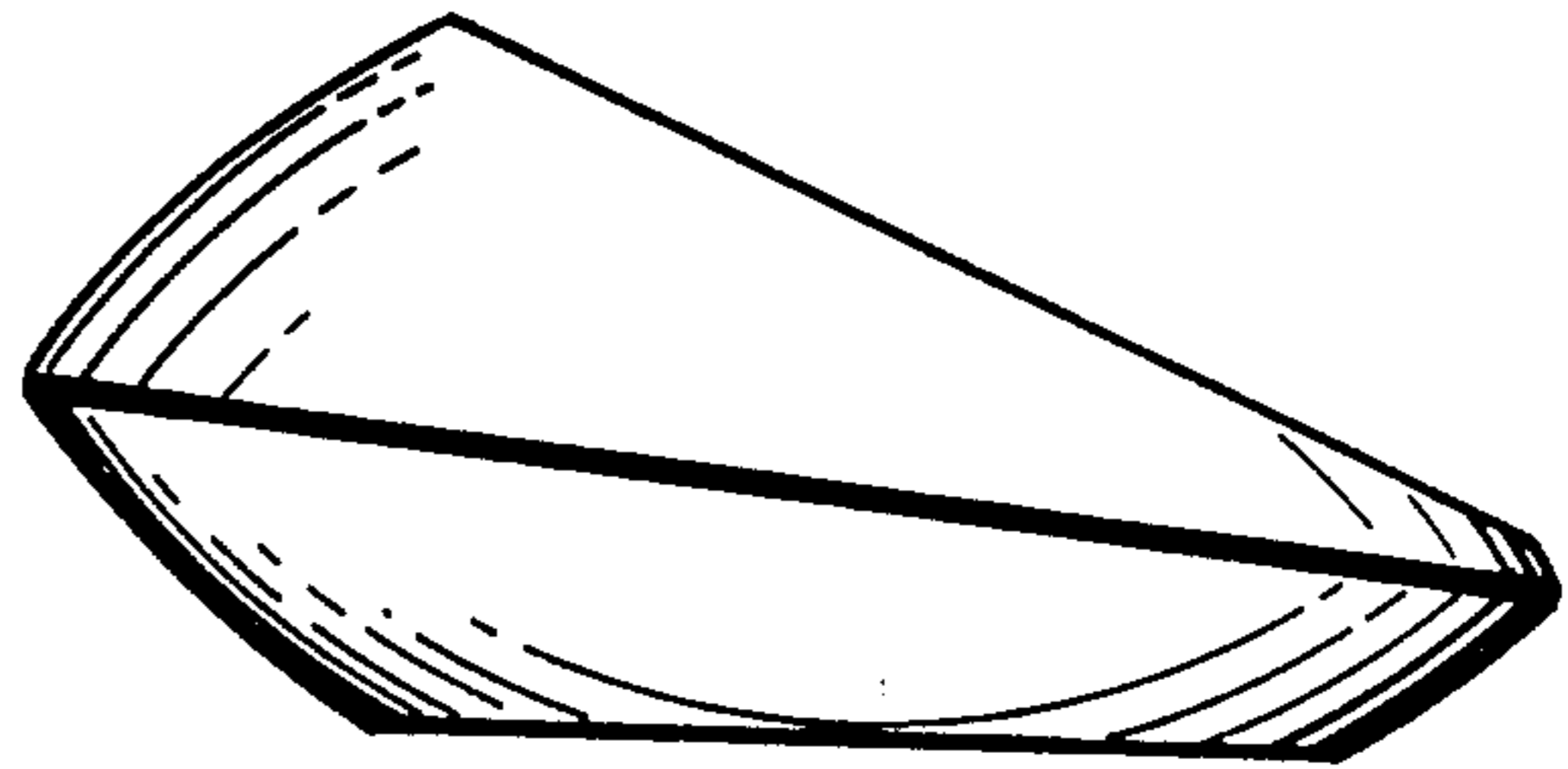

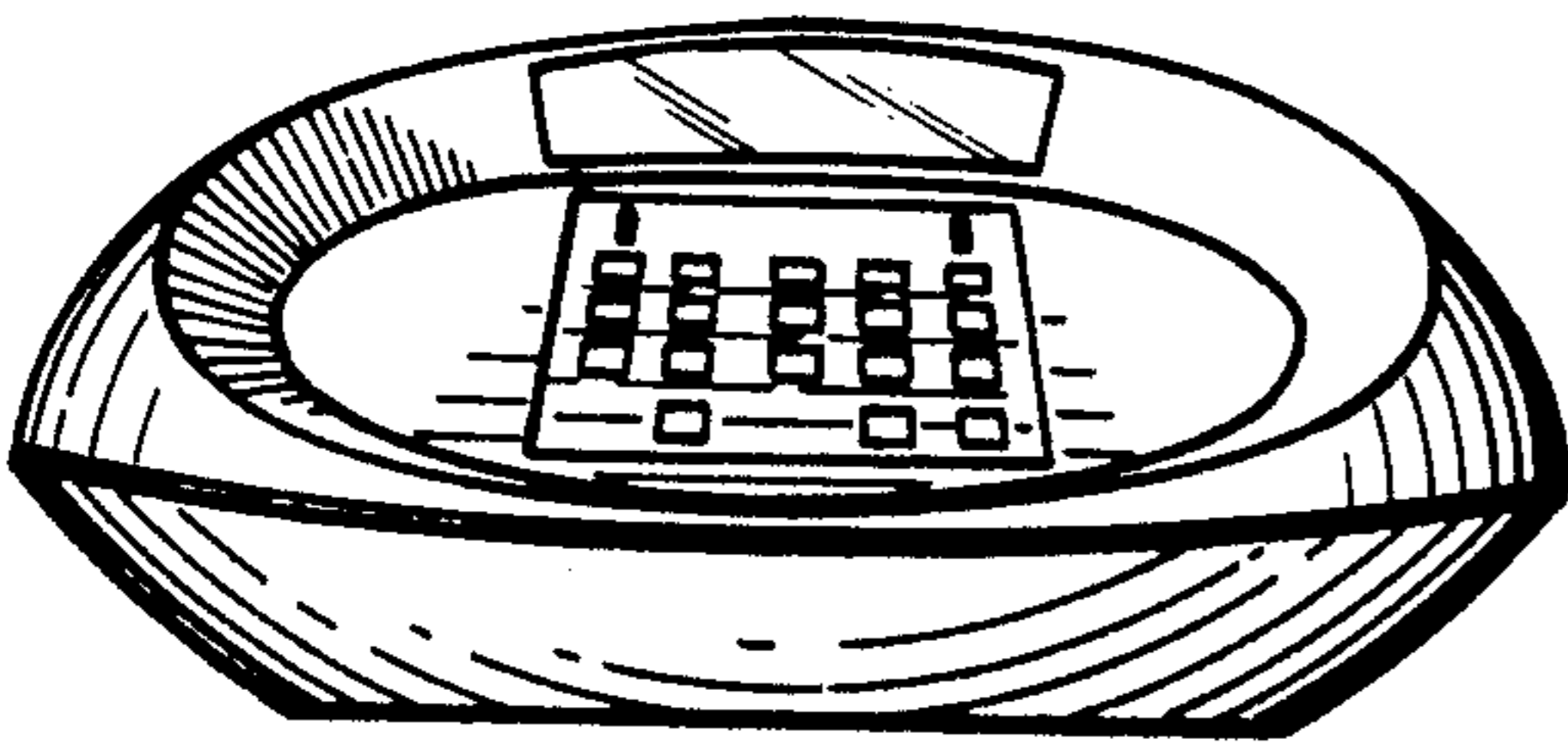

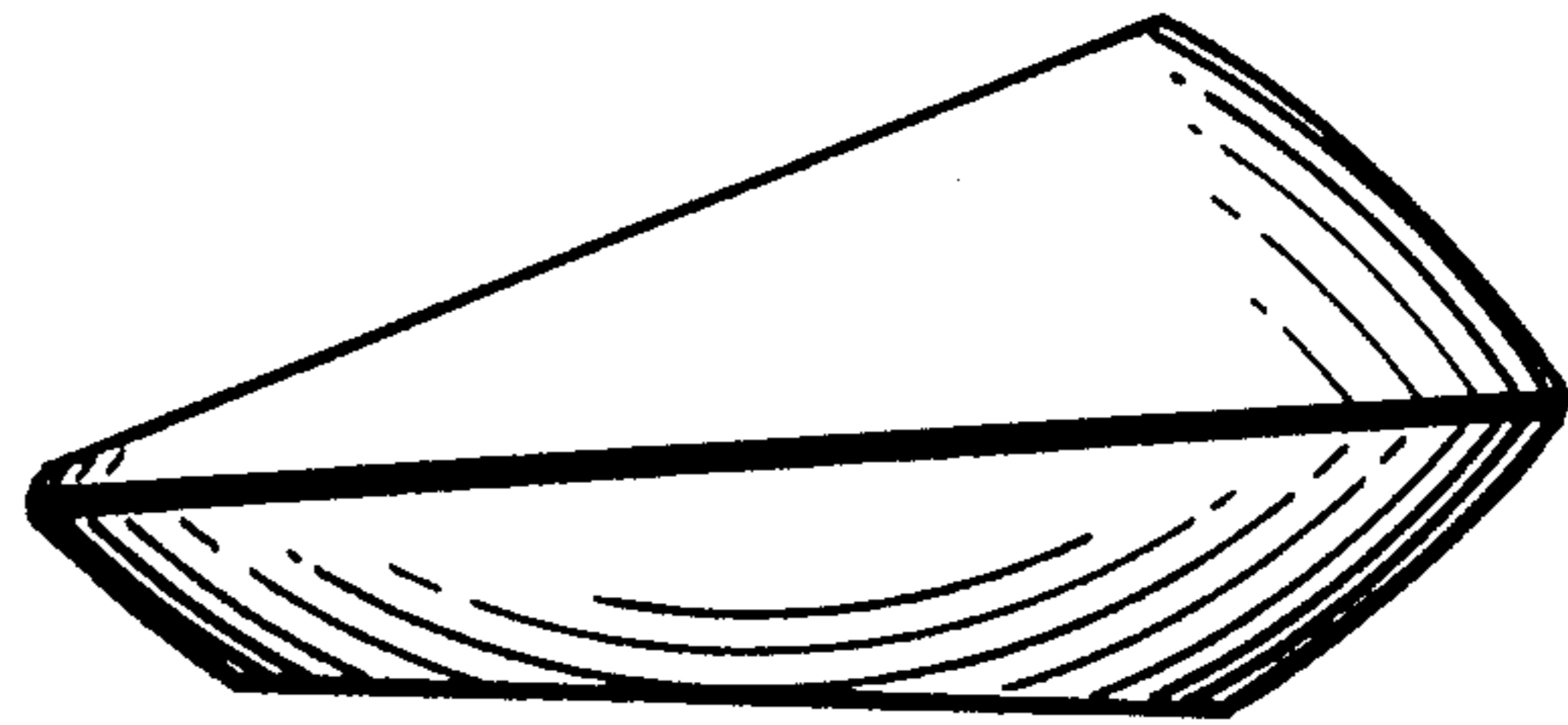

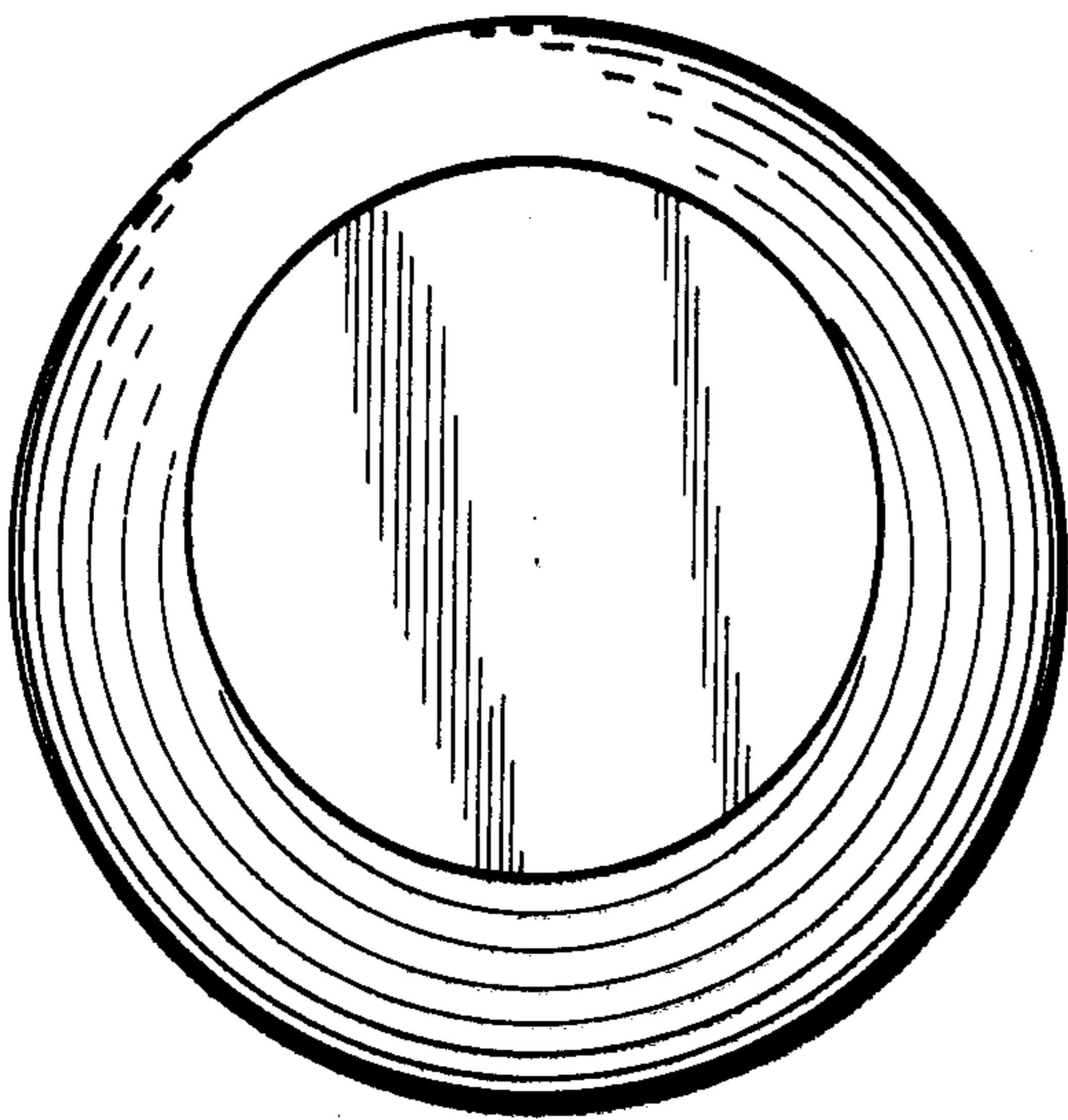
