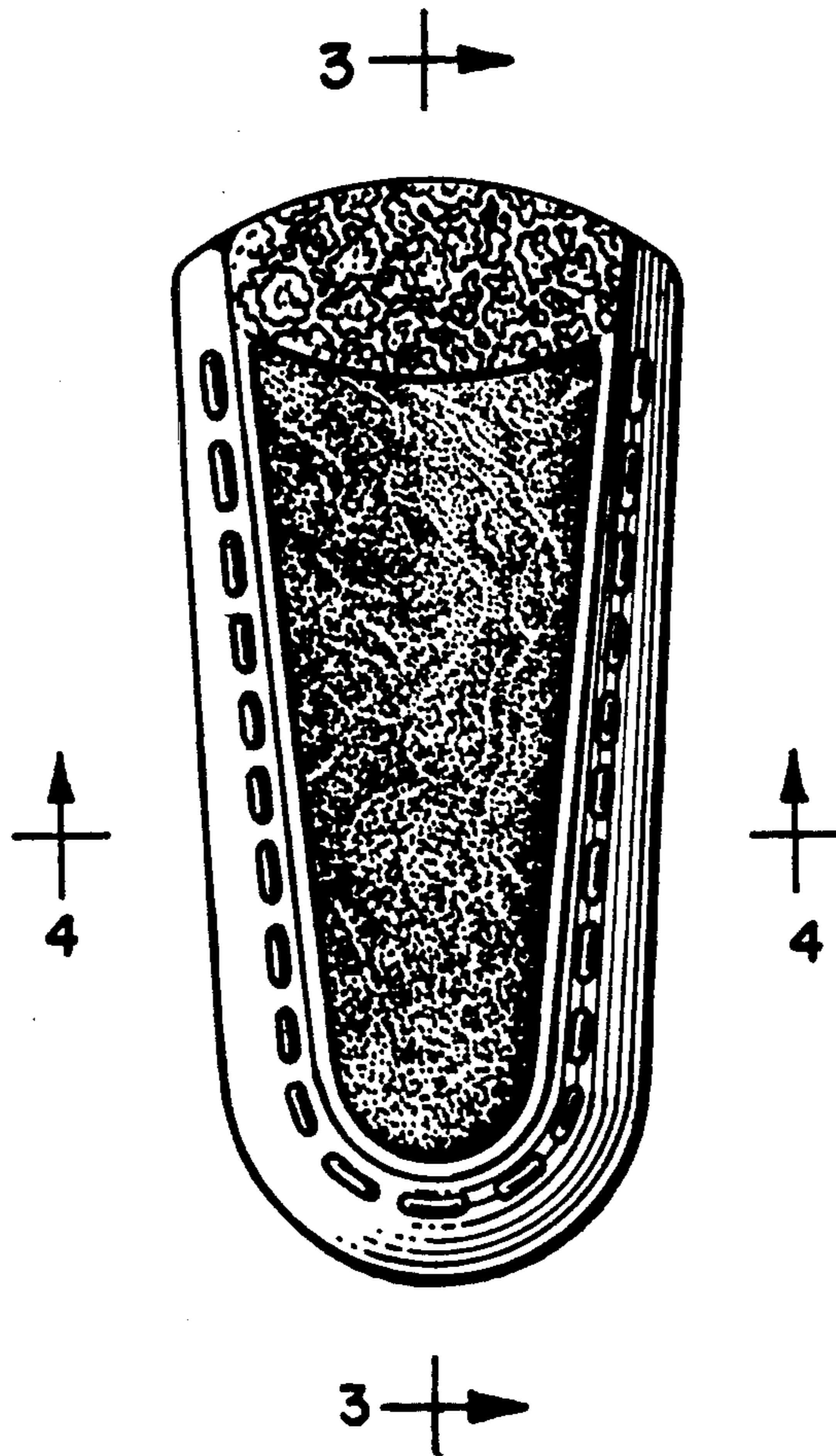

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a shoe closure device showing my new design;

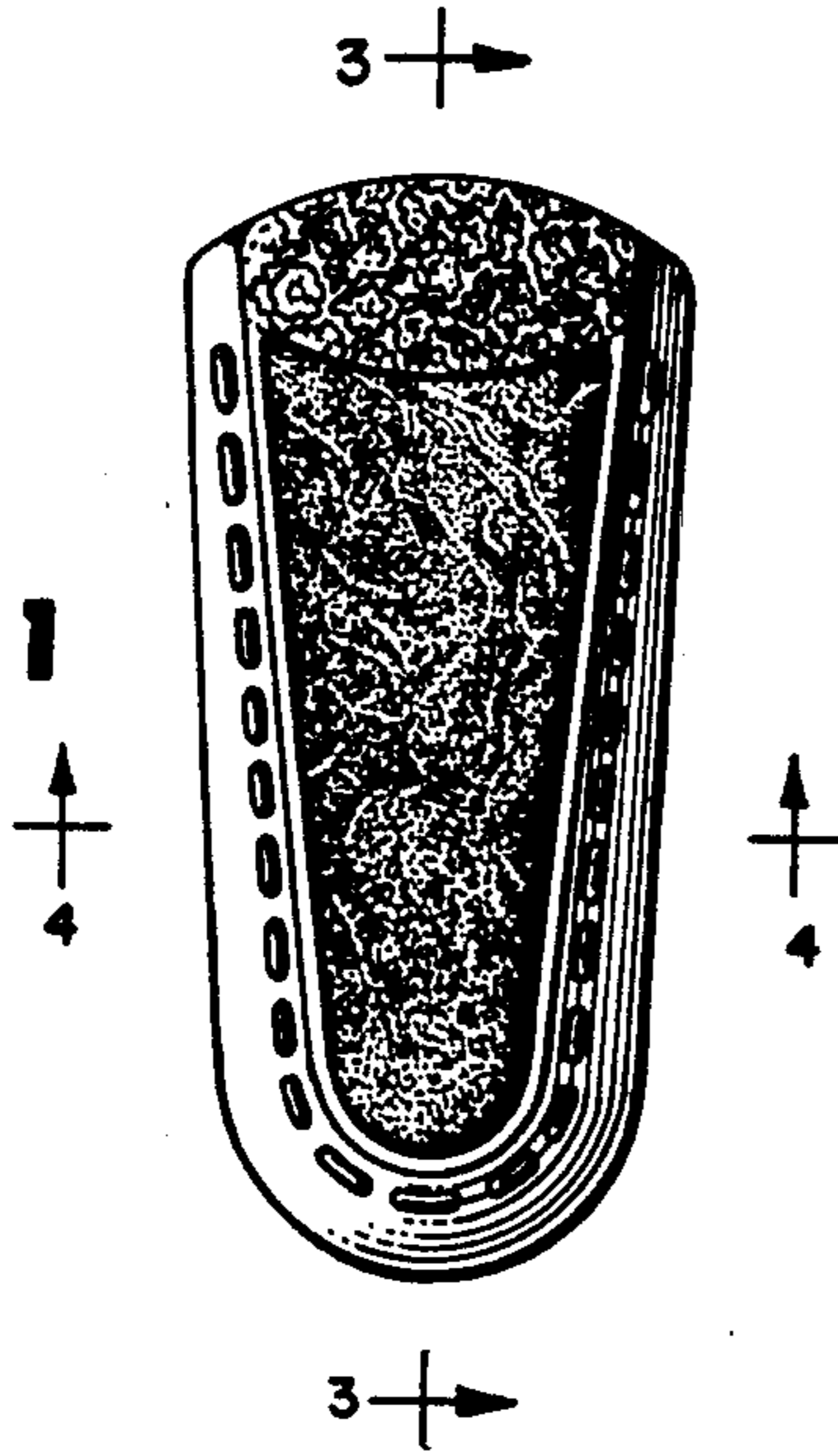
FIG. 2 is a side view of FIG. 1;
