[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cake mold, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the cake mold embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevation thereof as seen from the top of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is an end elevation thereof as seen from the bottom of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a cake mold showing a modification of our new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 9 is an end elevation as seen from the top of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is an end elevation as seen from the bottom of FIG. 6.

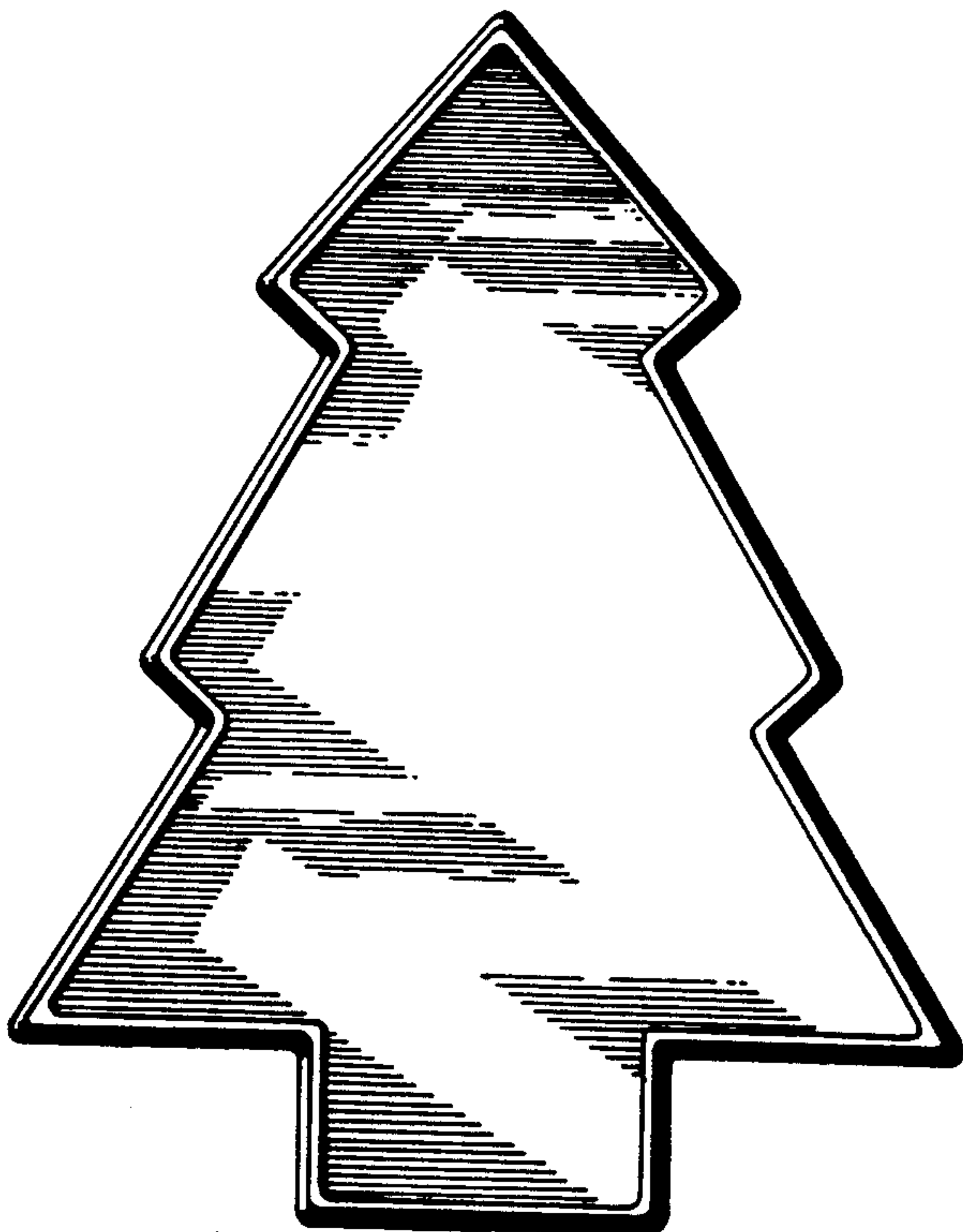
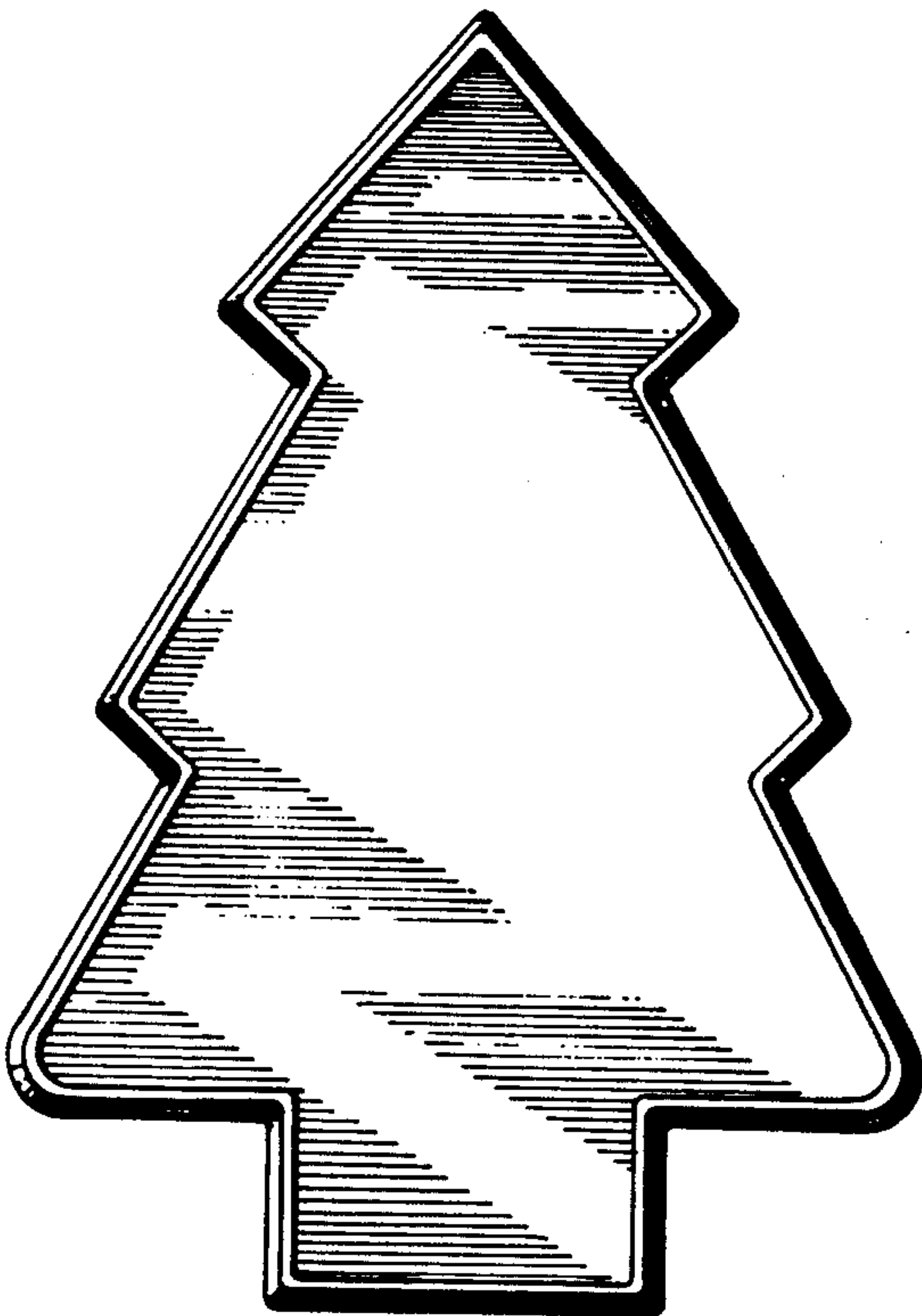

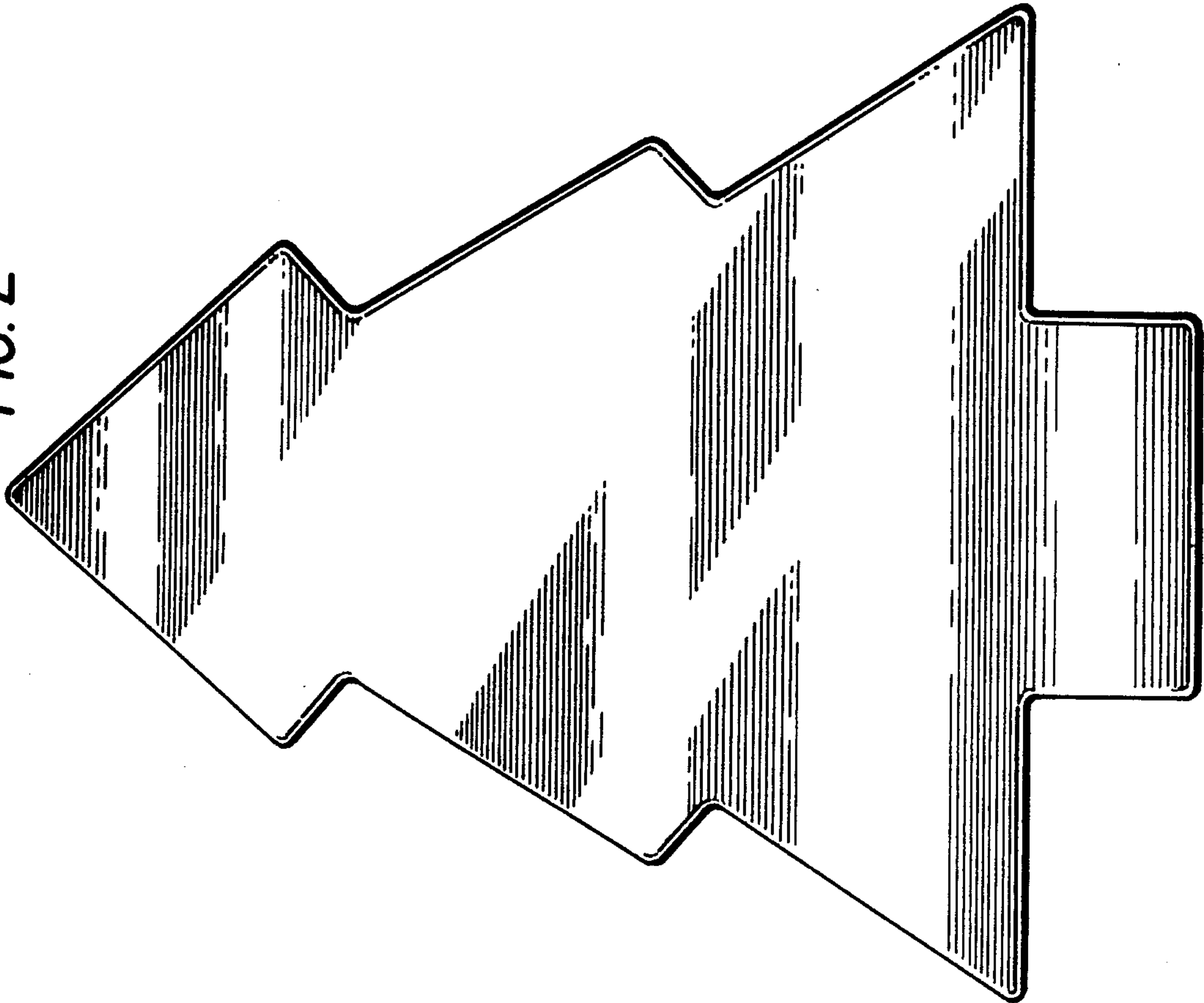
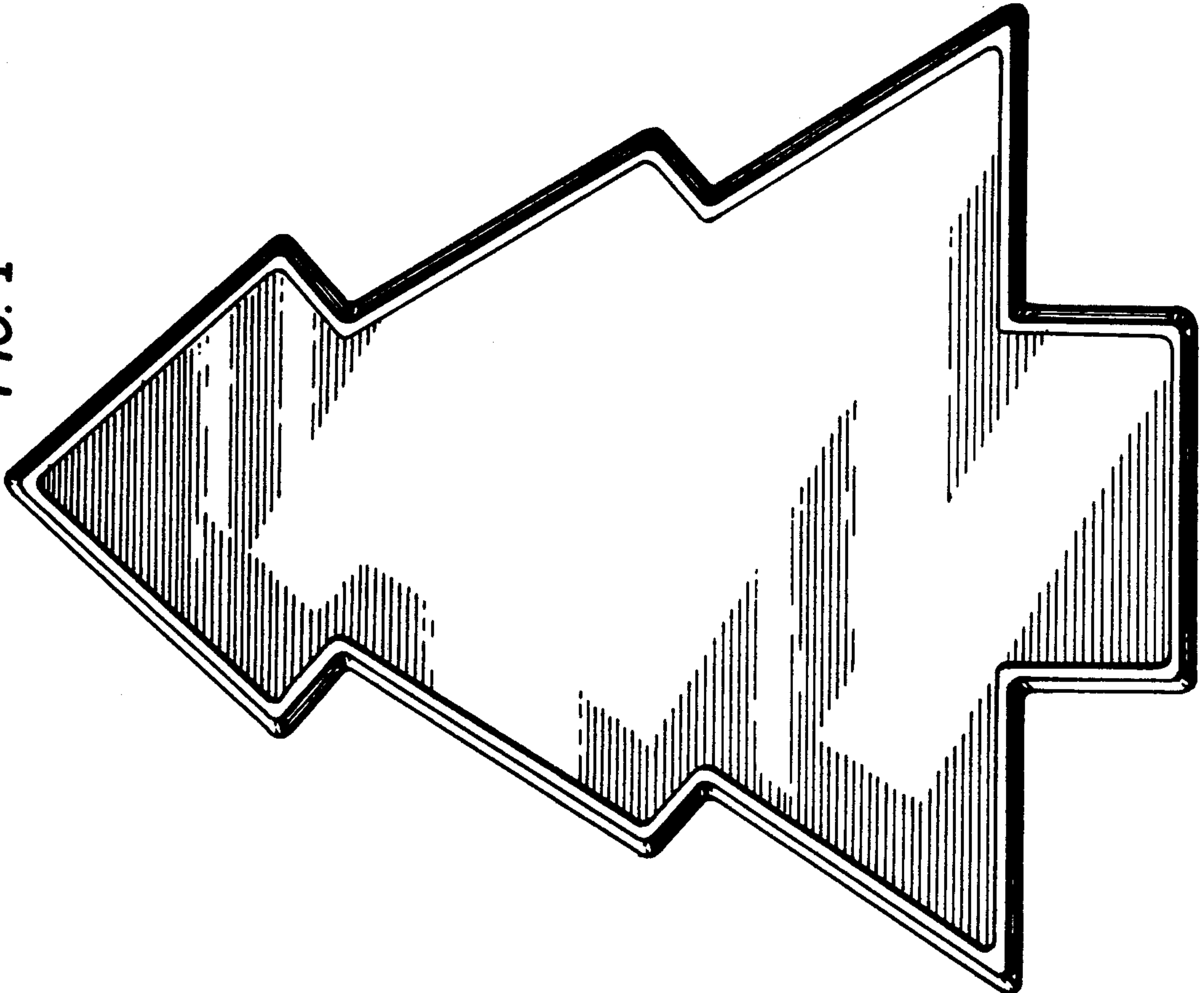

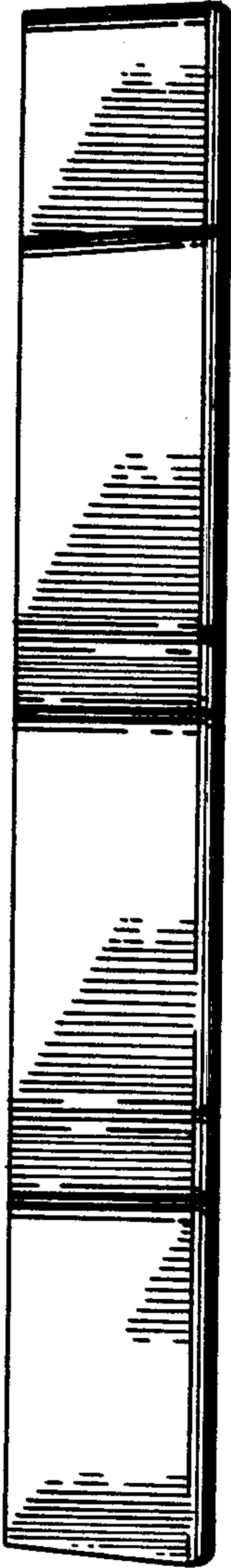

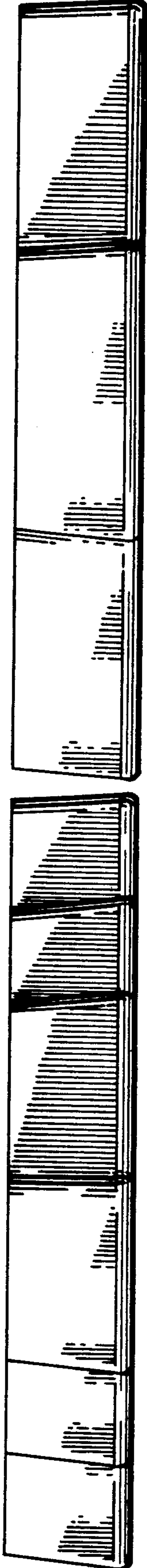

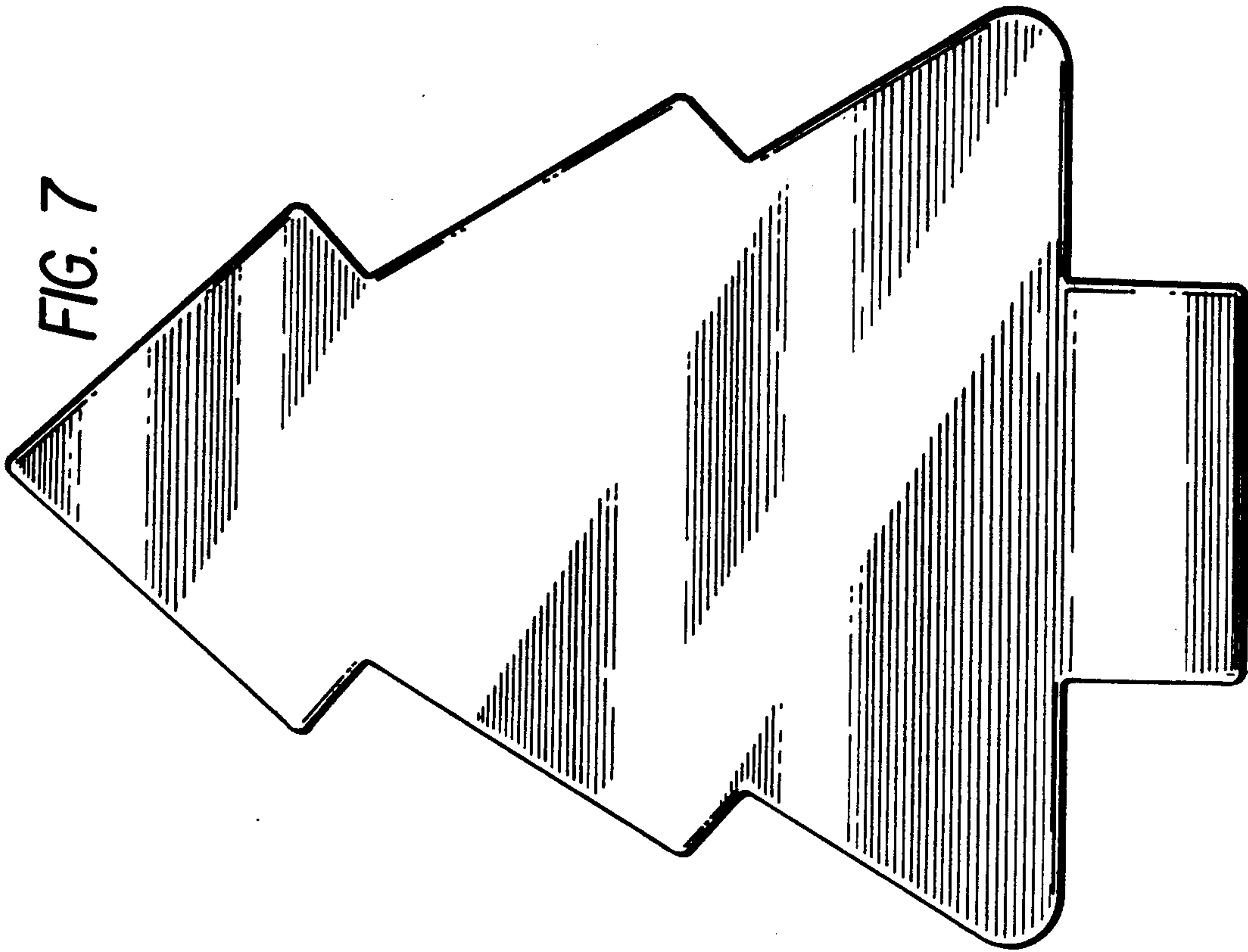
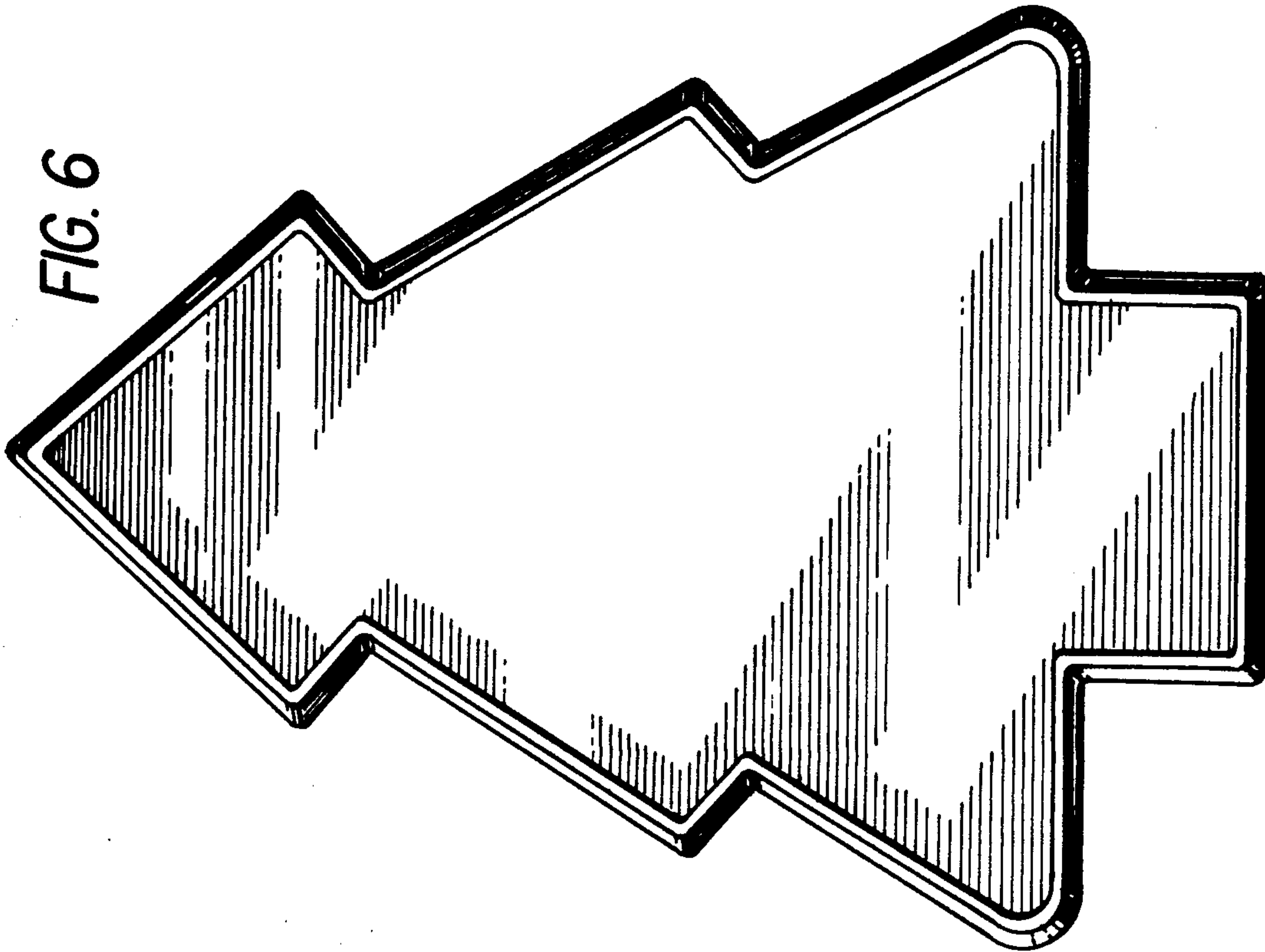

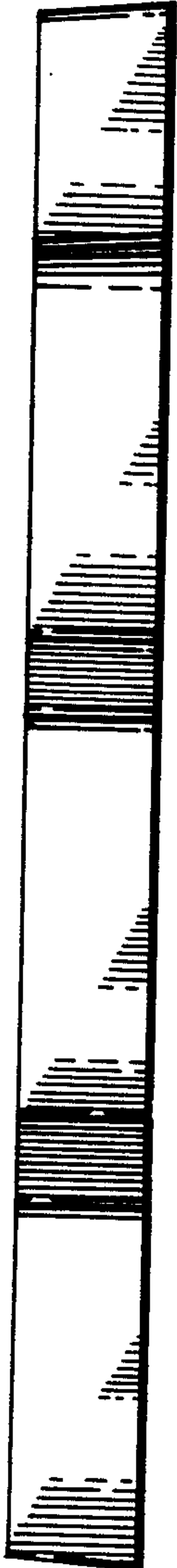

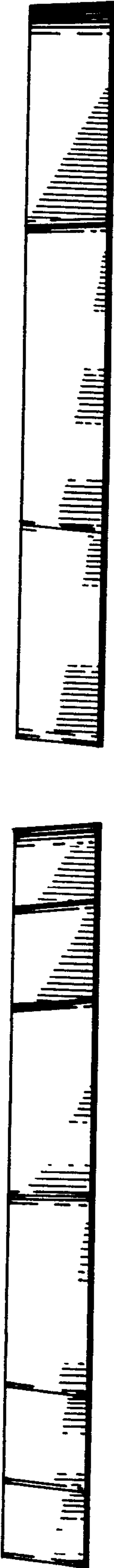
