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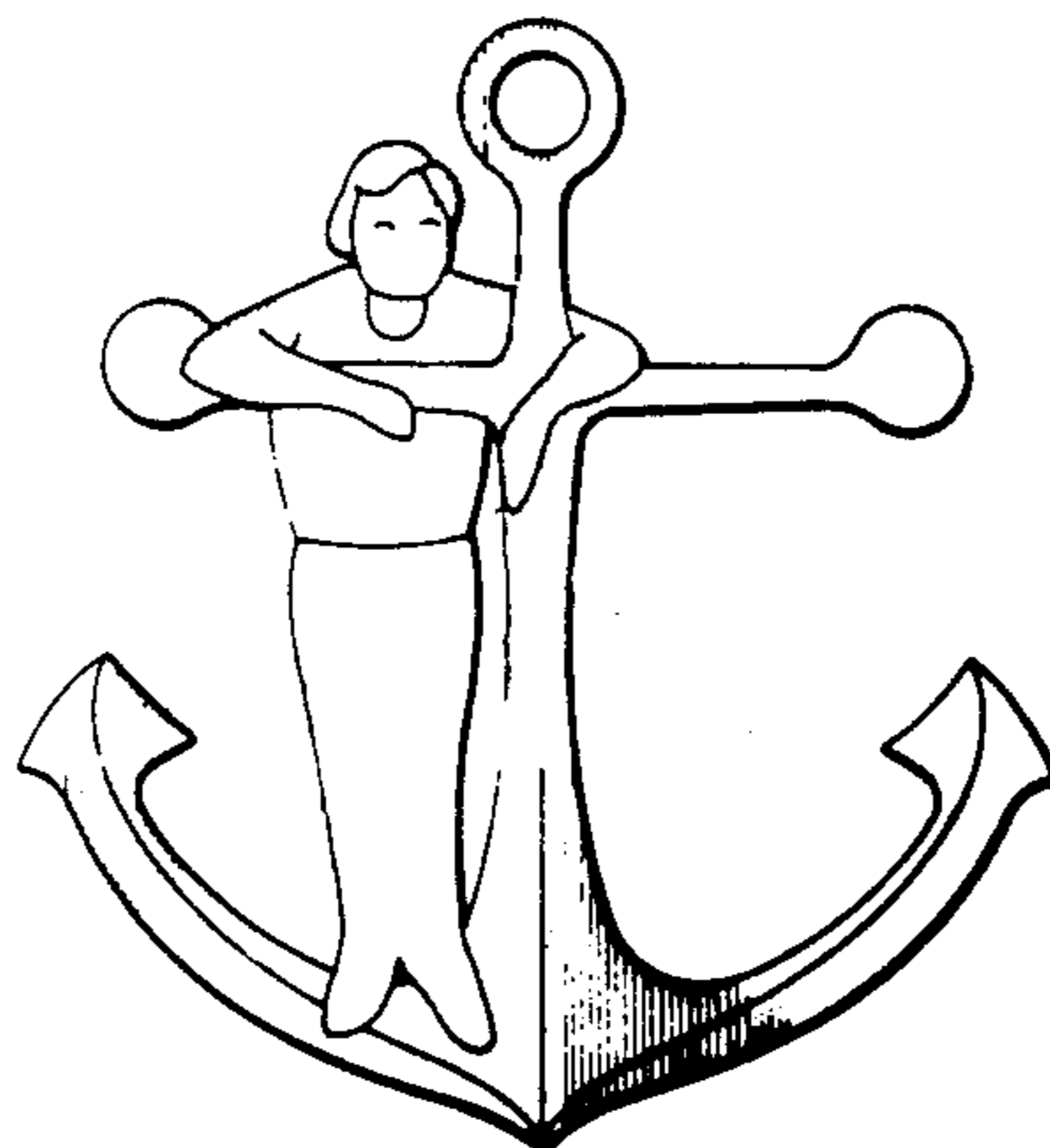
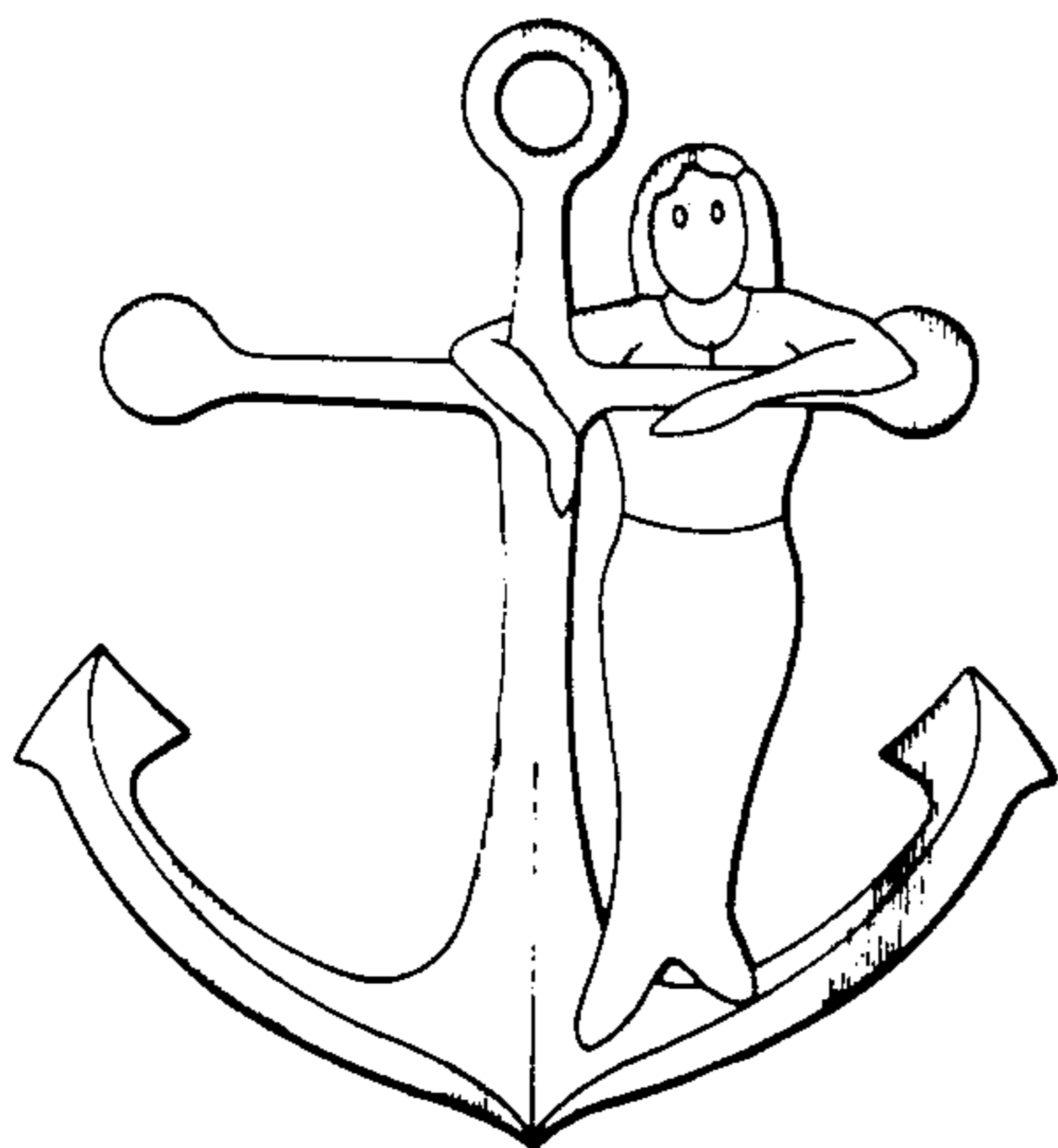
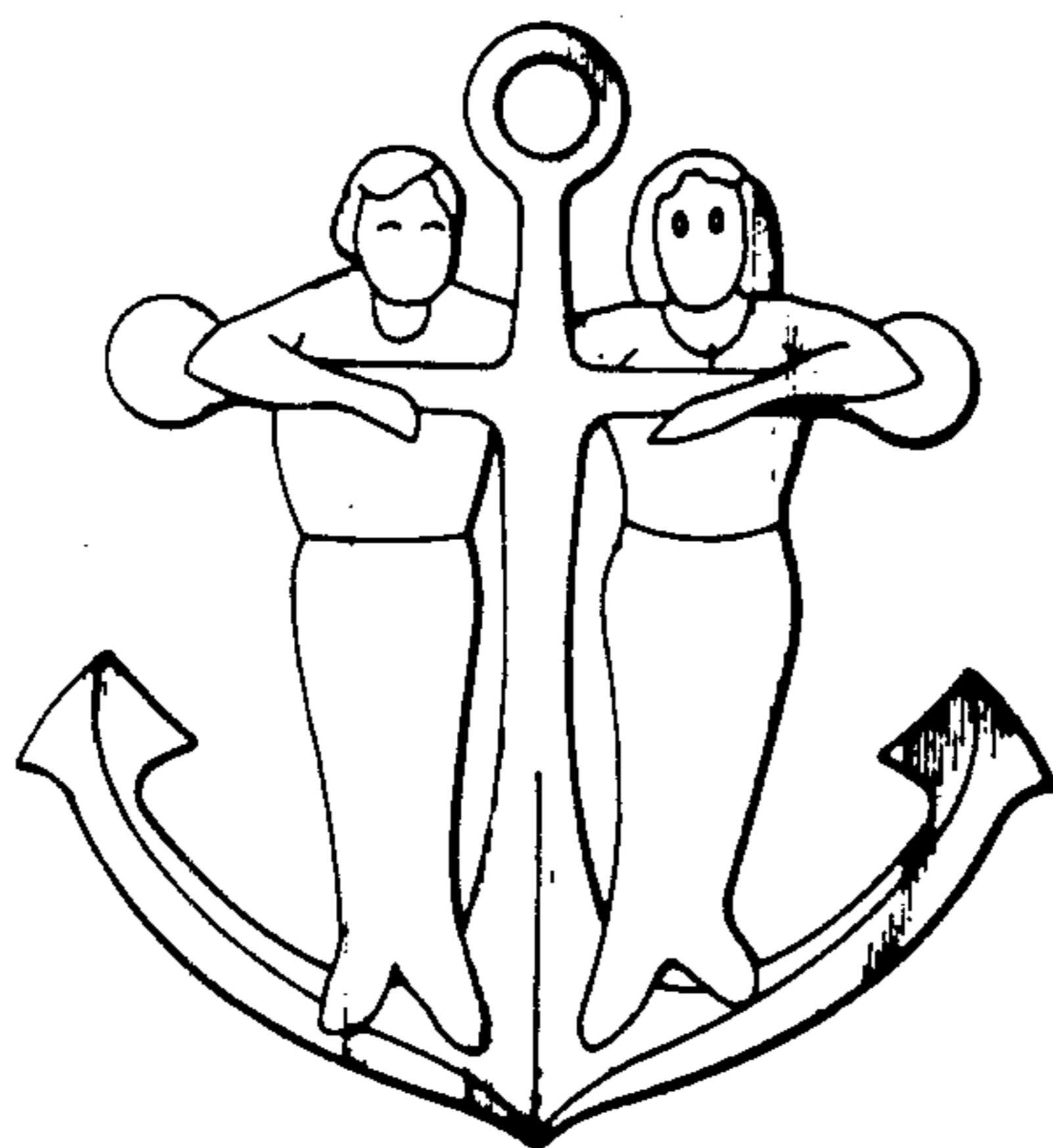

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a face view of an emblem showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a face view of an emblem showing a modified form of my new design;
FIG. 3 is a face view of an emblem showing another modified form of my new design; and
FIG. 4 is an edge view of the emblem shown in FIG. 1. The rear of each embodiment is unornamented, and each embodiment is of the same uniform thickness shown in FIG. 4.



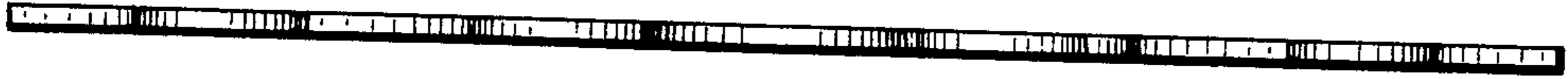

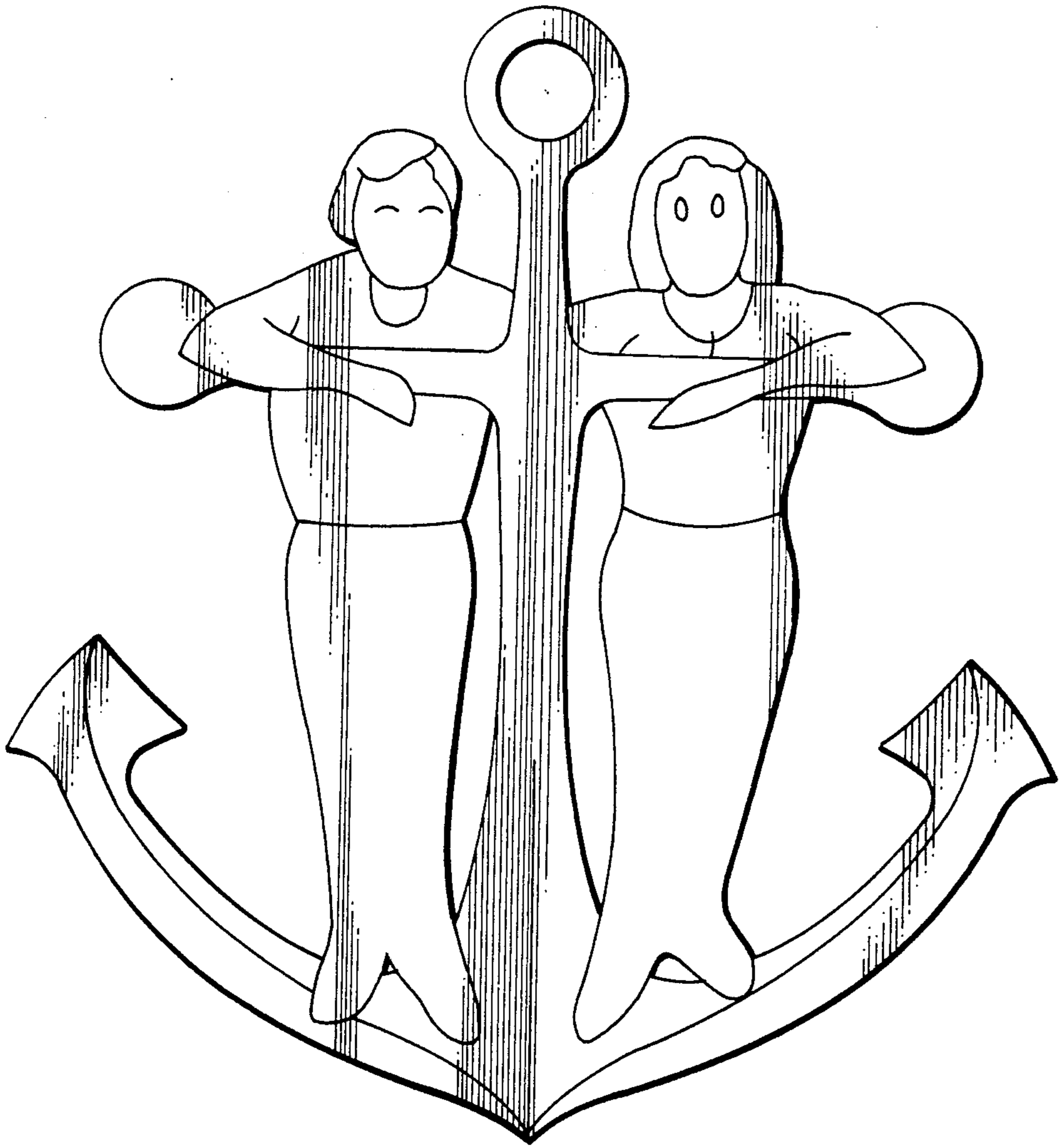

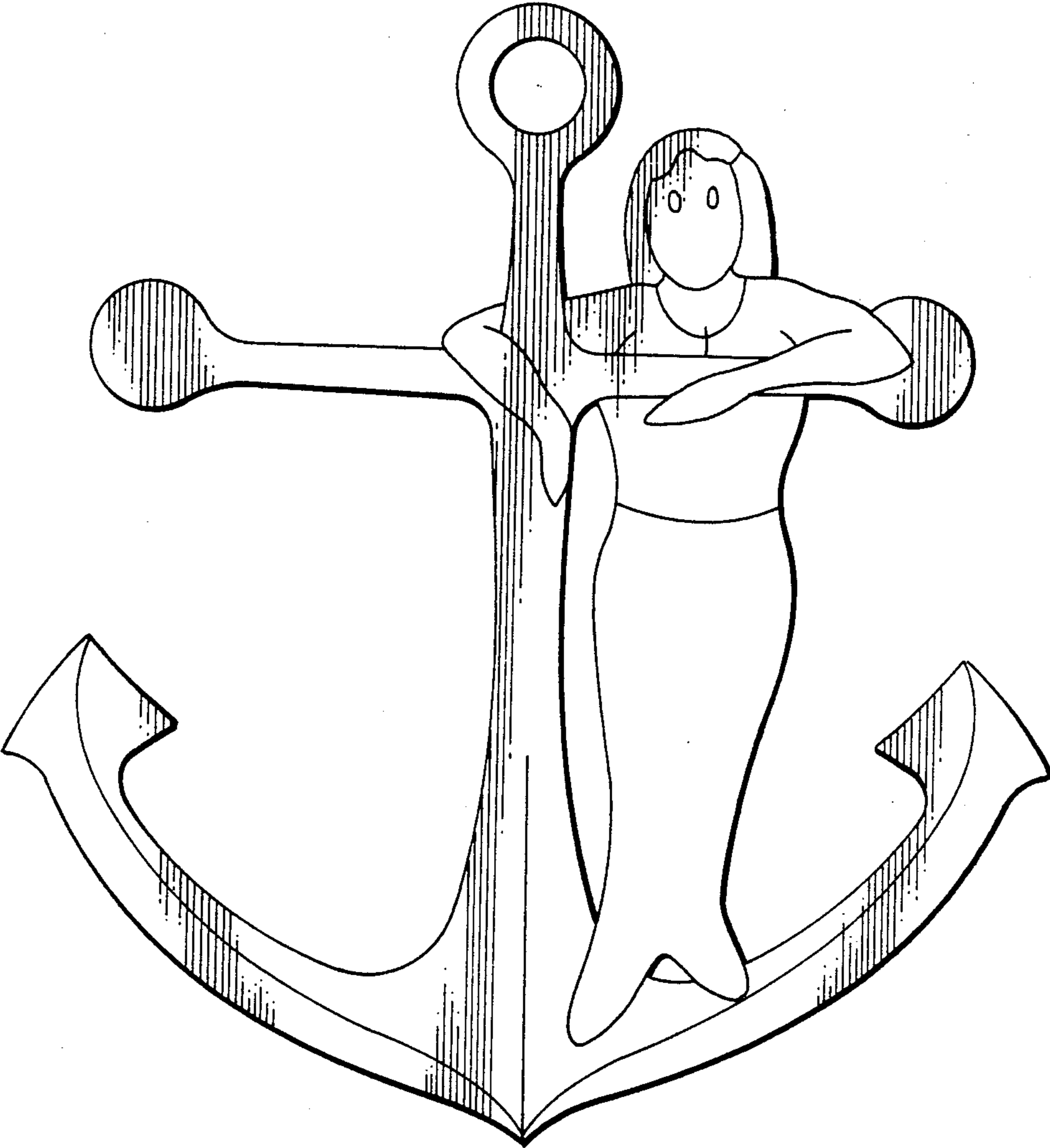

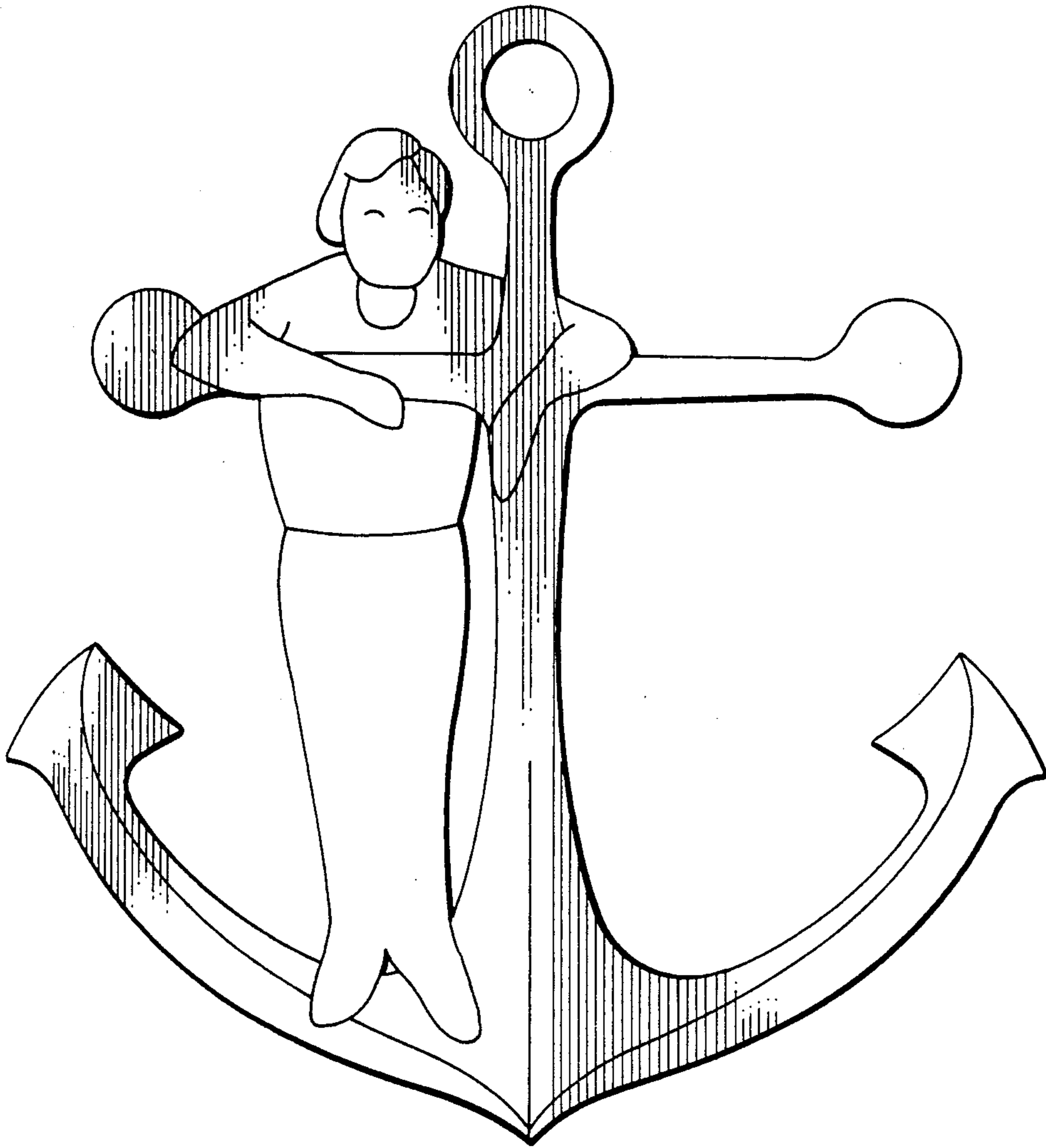
