CLAIM

The ornamental design for a modular track assembly for a 200-unit biological sample changer, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a modular track assembly for a 200-unit biological sample changer; and FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the track assembly illustrated in FIG. 1.

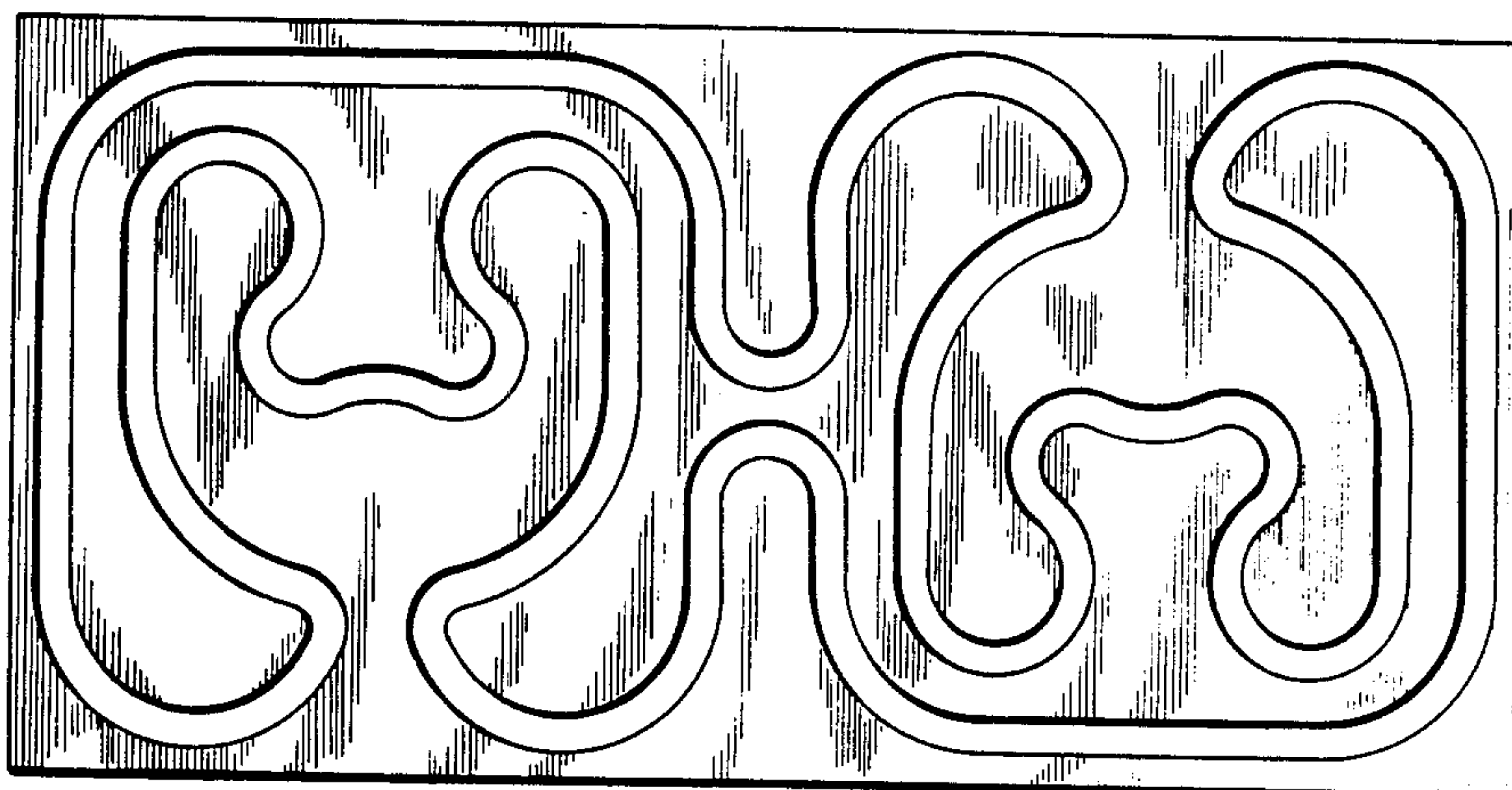

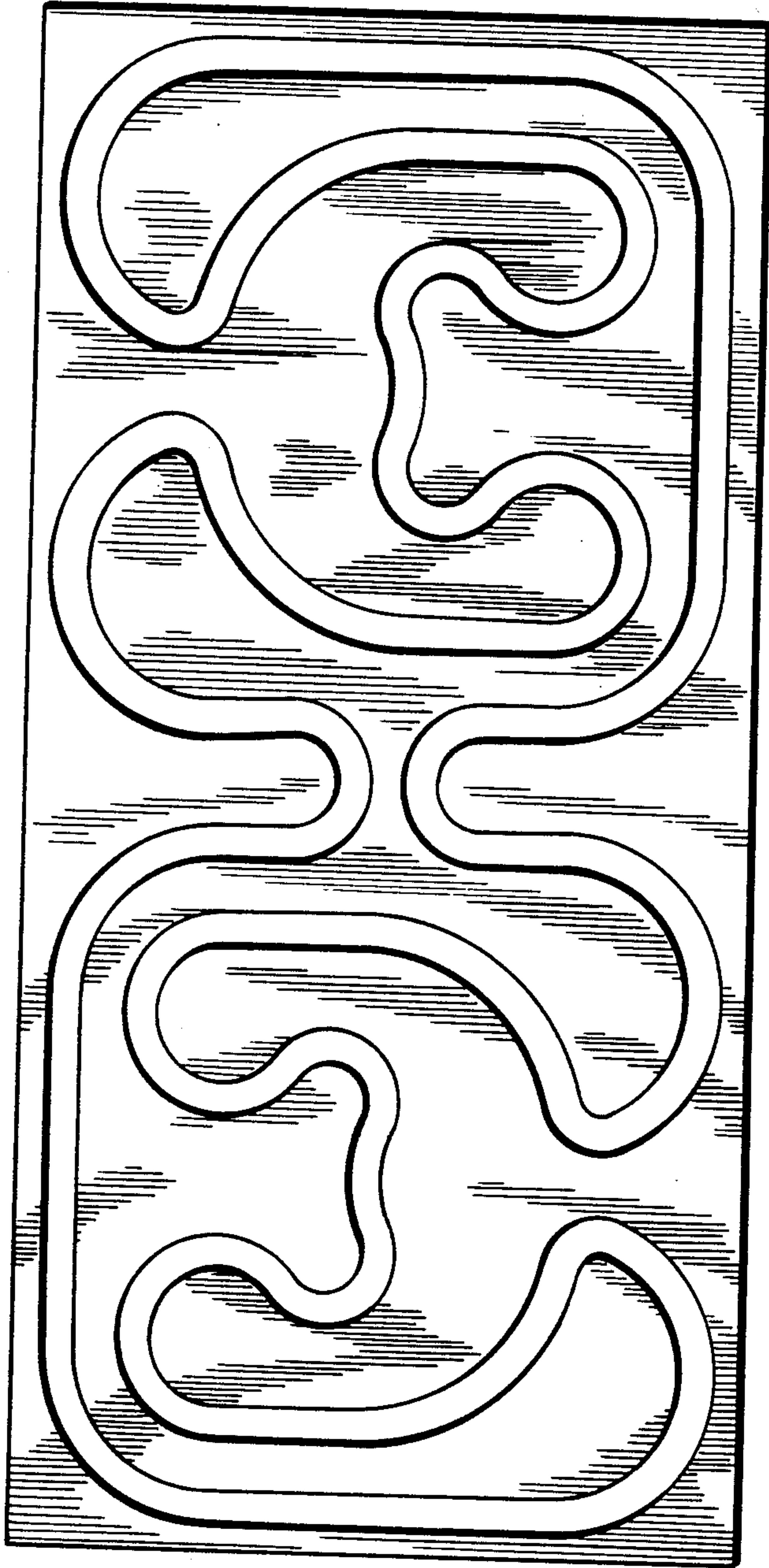
