[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy airplane, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a toy airplane showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof with portions of the right wing omitted for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

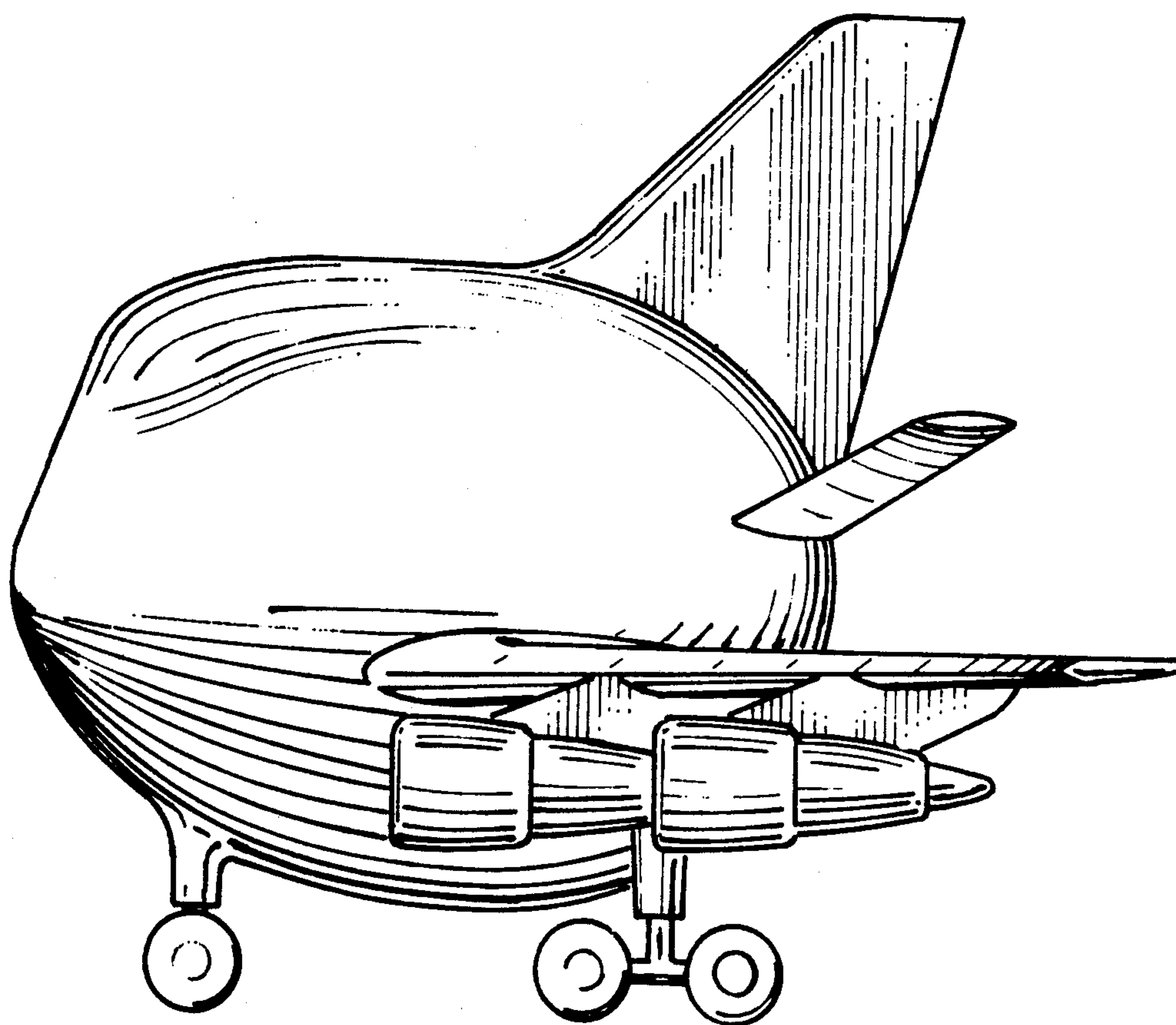

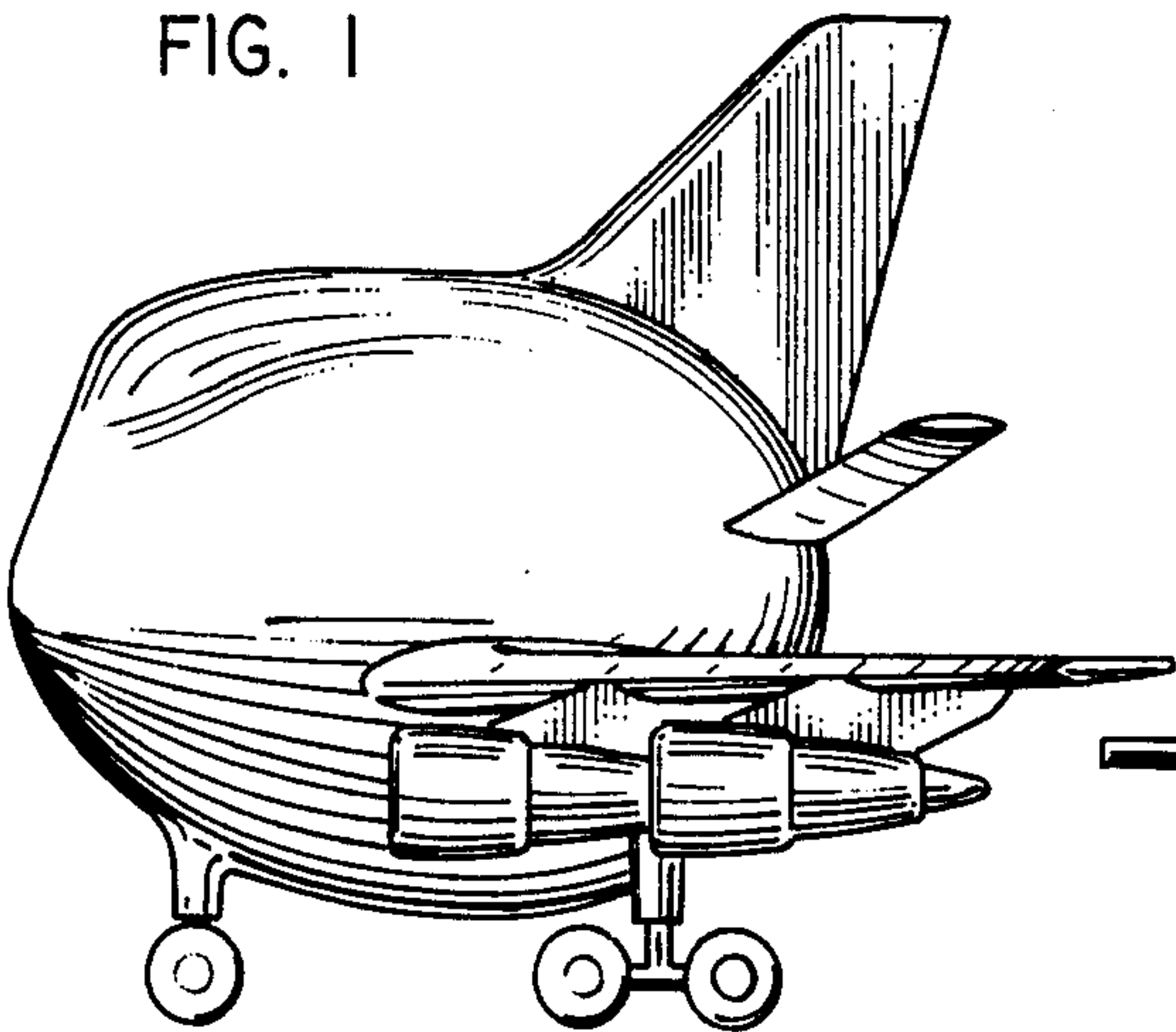

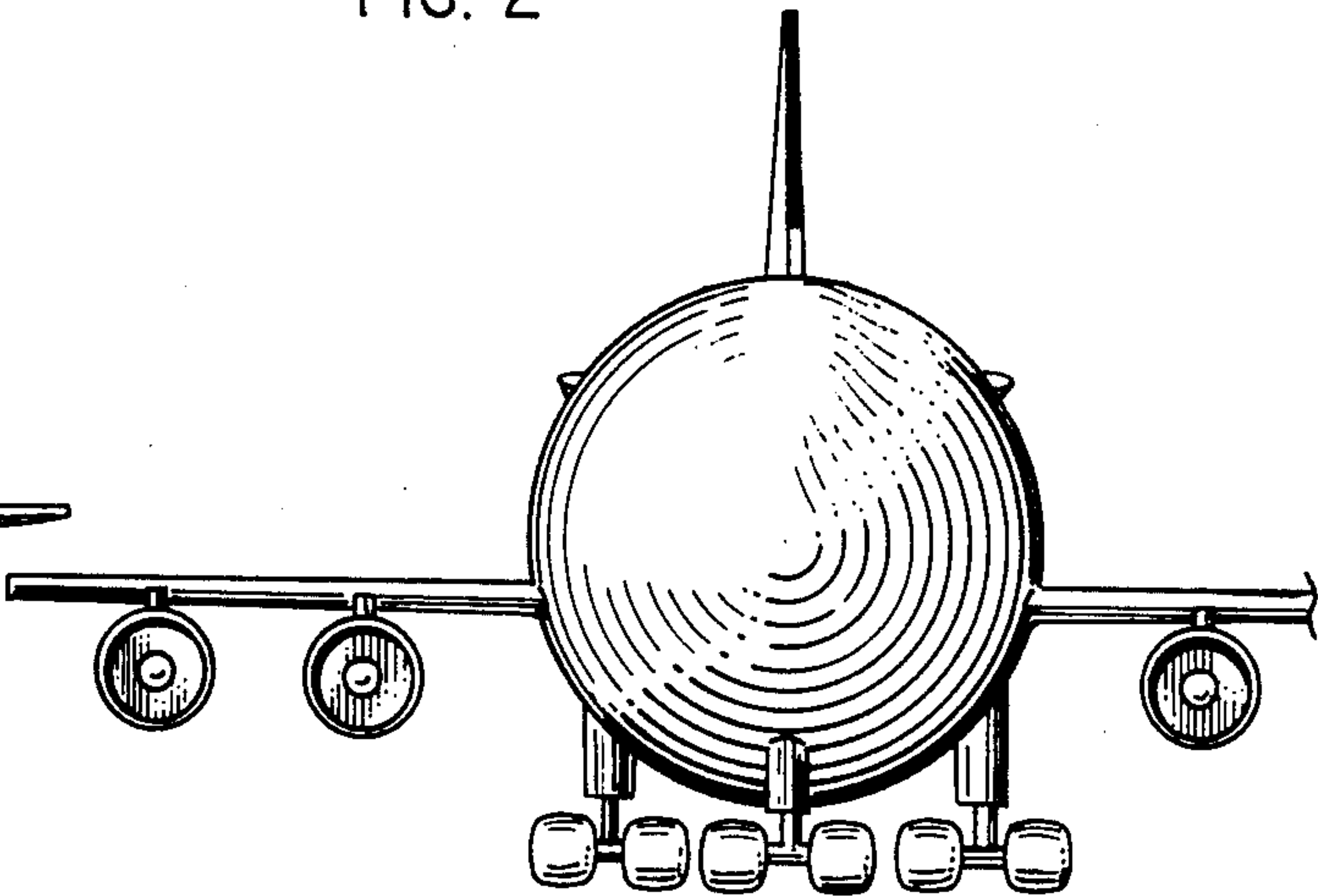

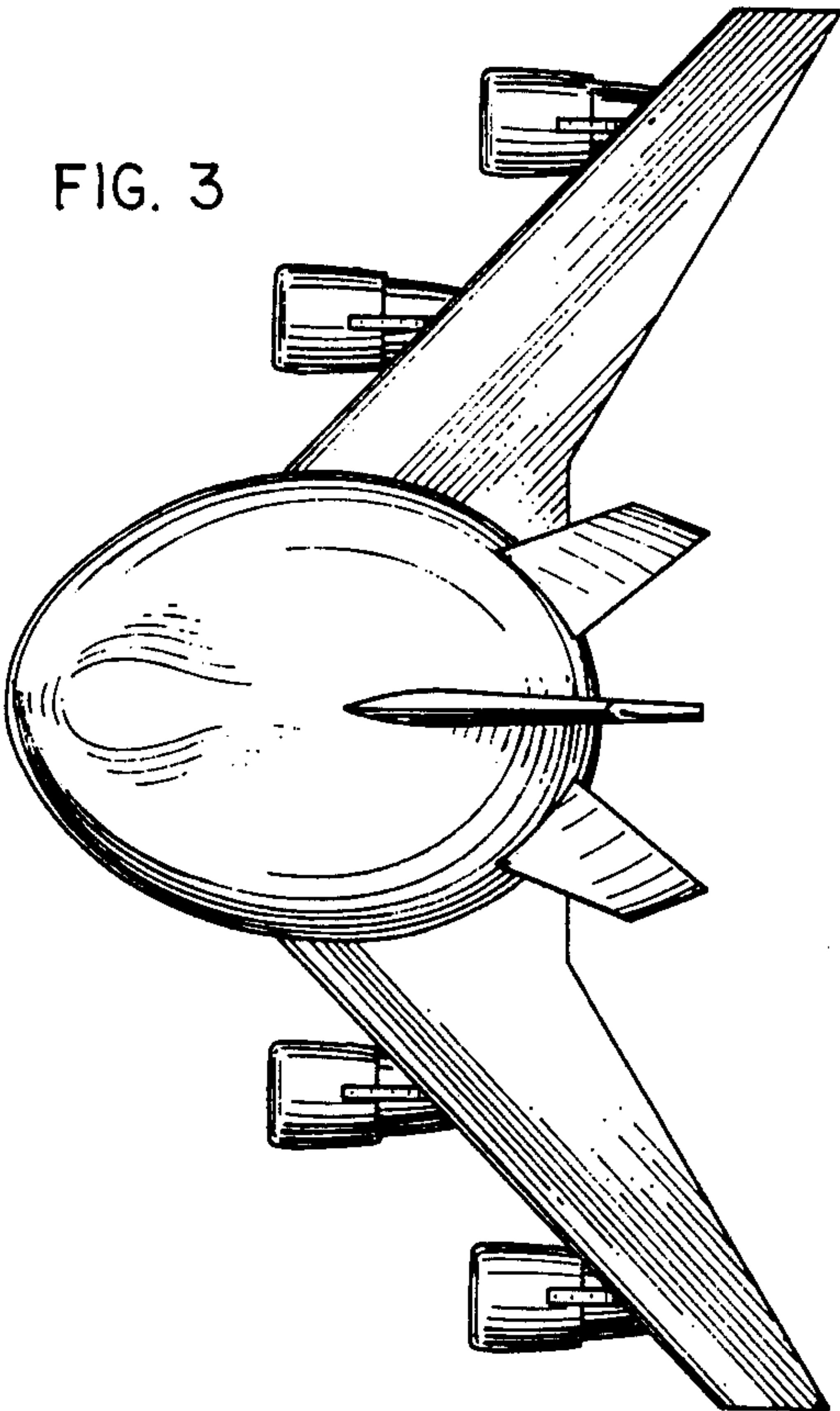

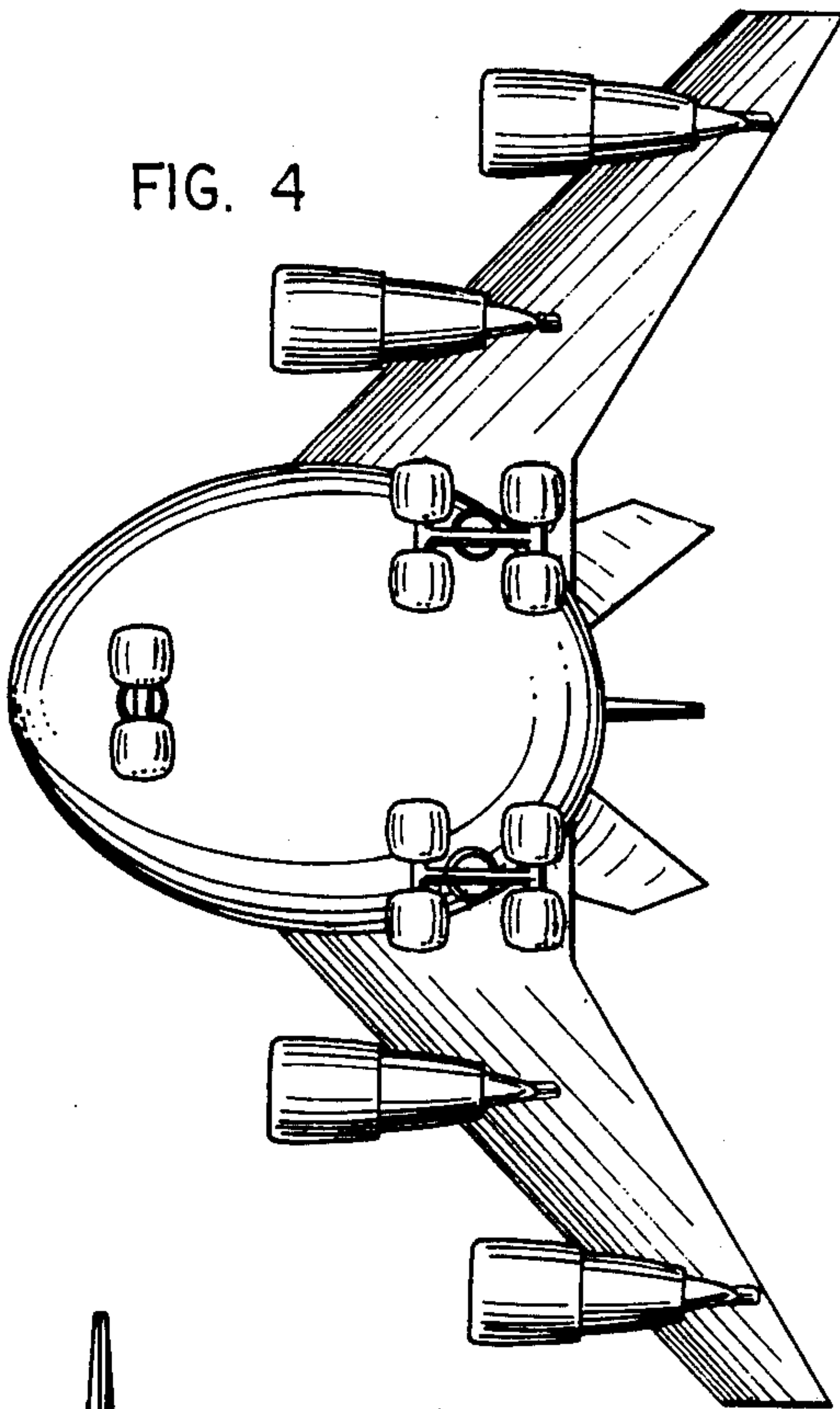
