[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for holder for cards or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first embodiment of the front elevational view of the holder for cards or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment of the holder for cards or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a back elevational view thereof;


FIG. 10 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;


FIG. 11 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;
