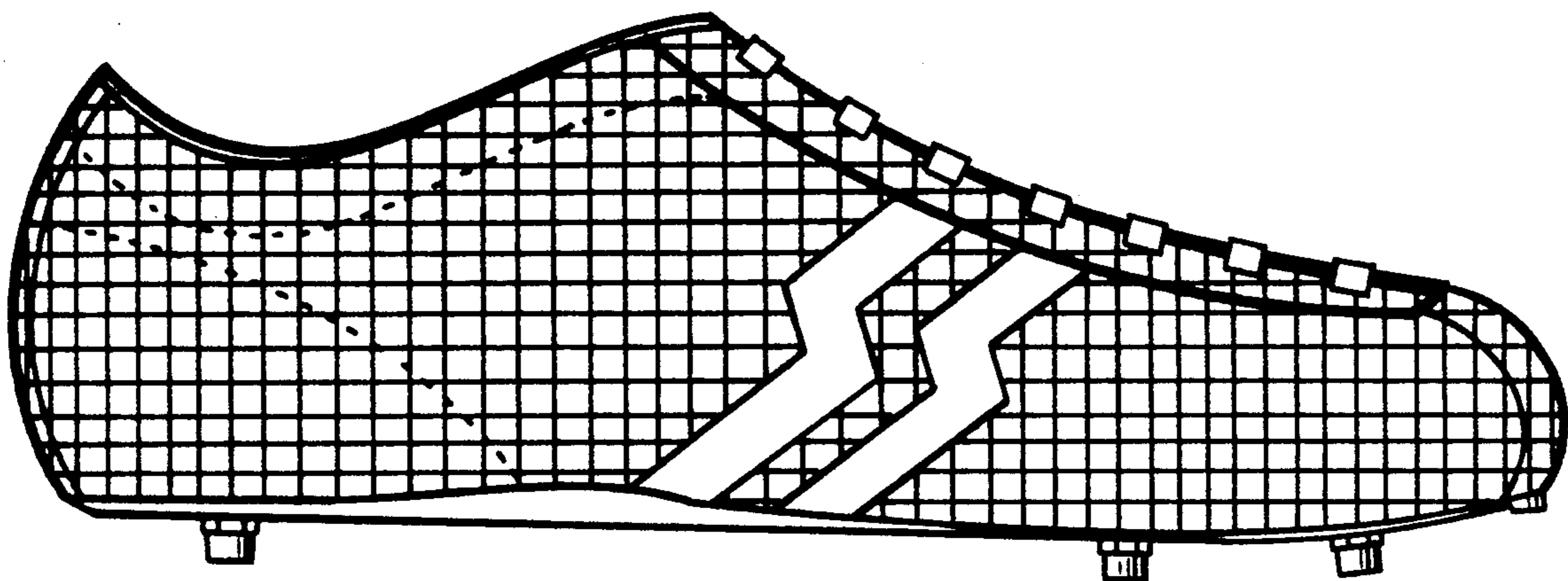

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an athletic shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a right side perspective view thereof.



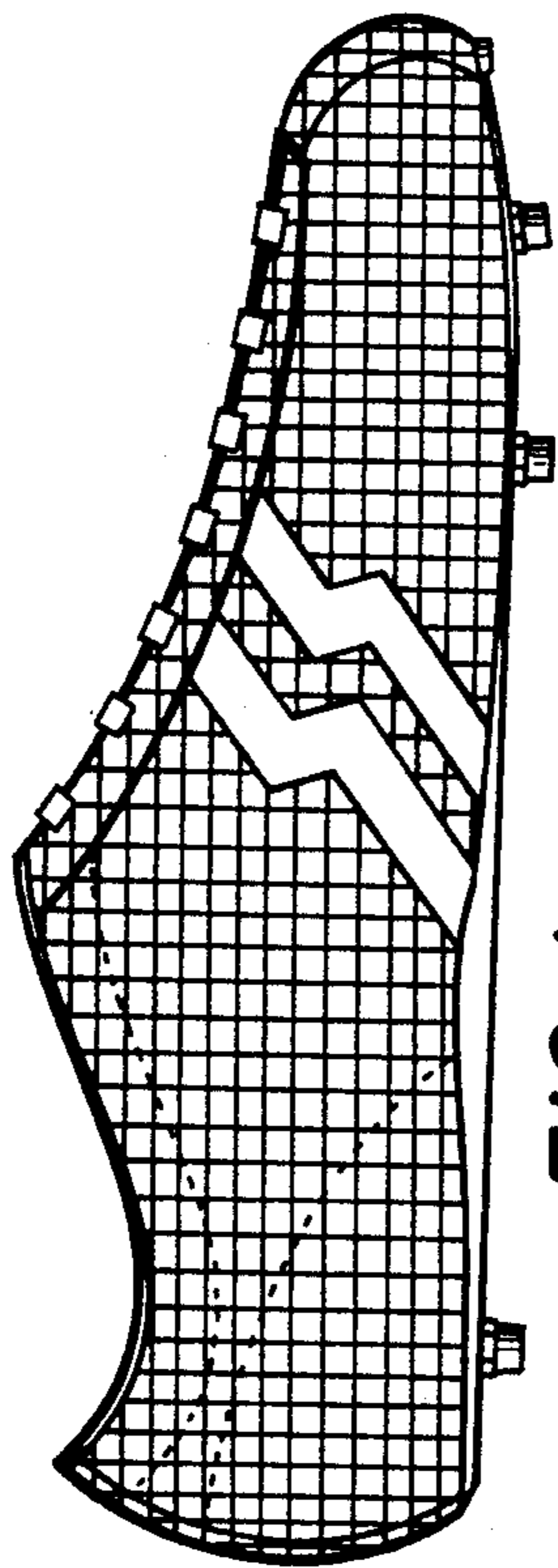

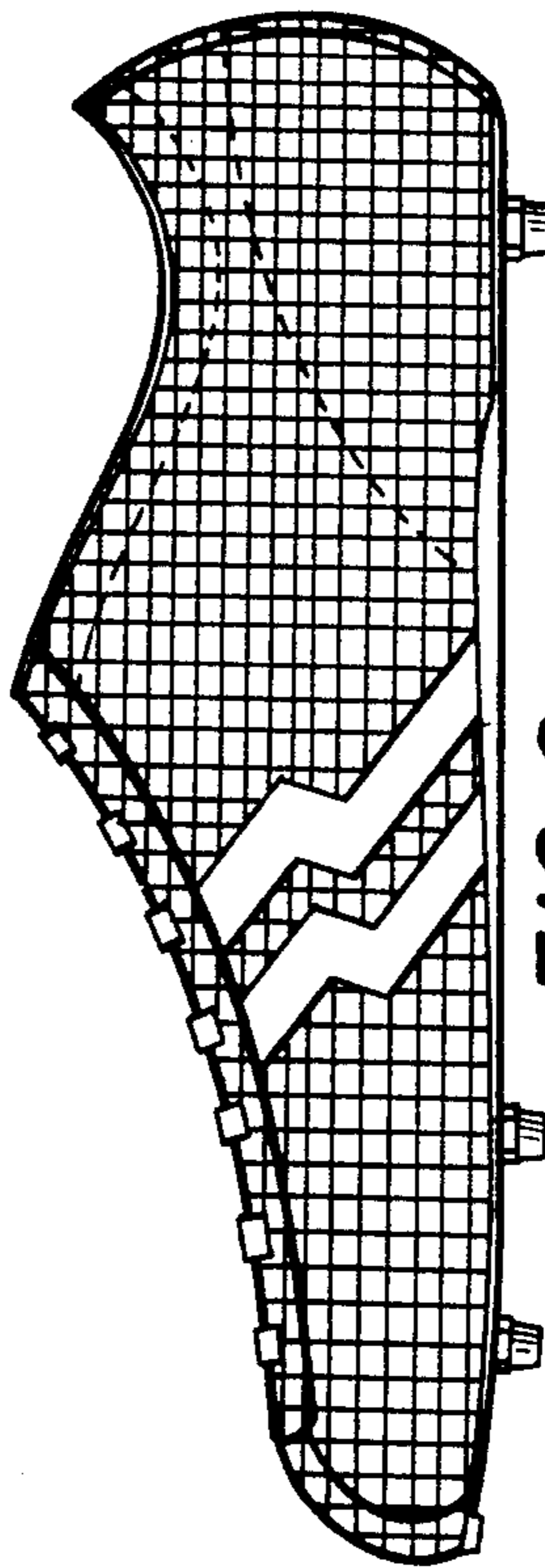

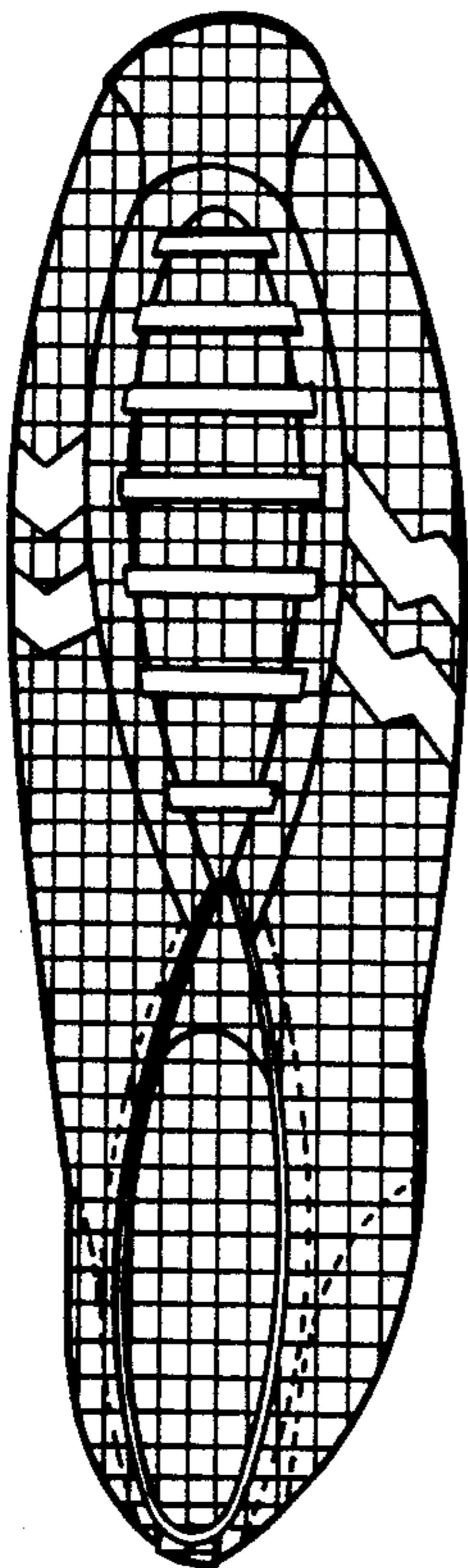

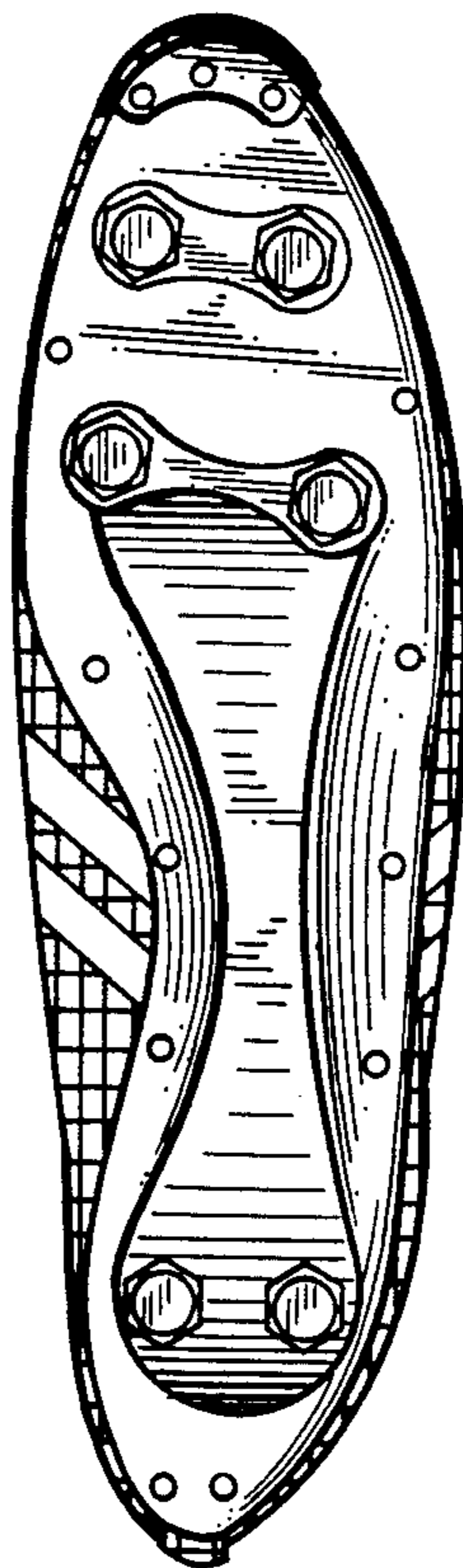

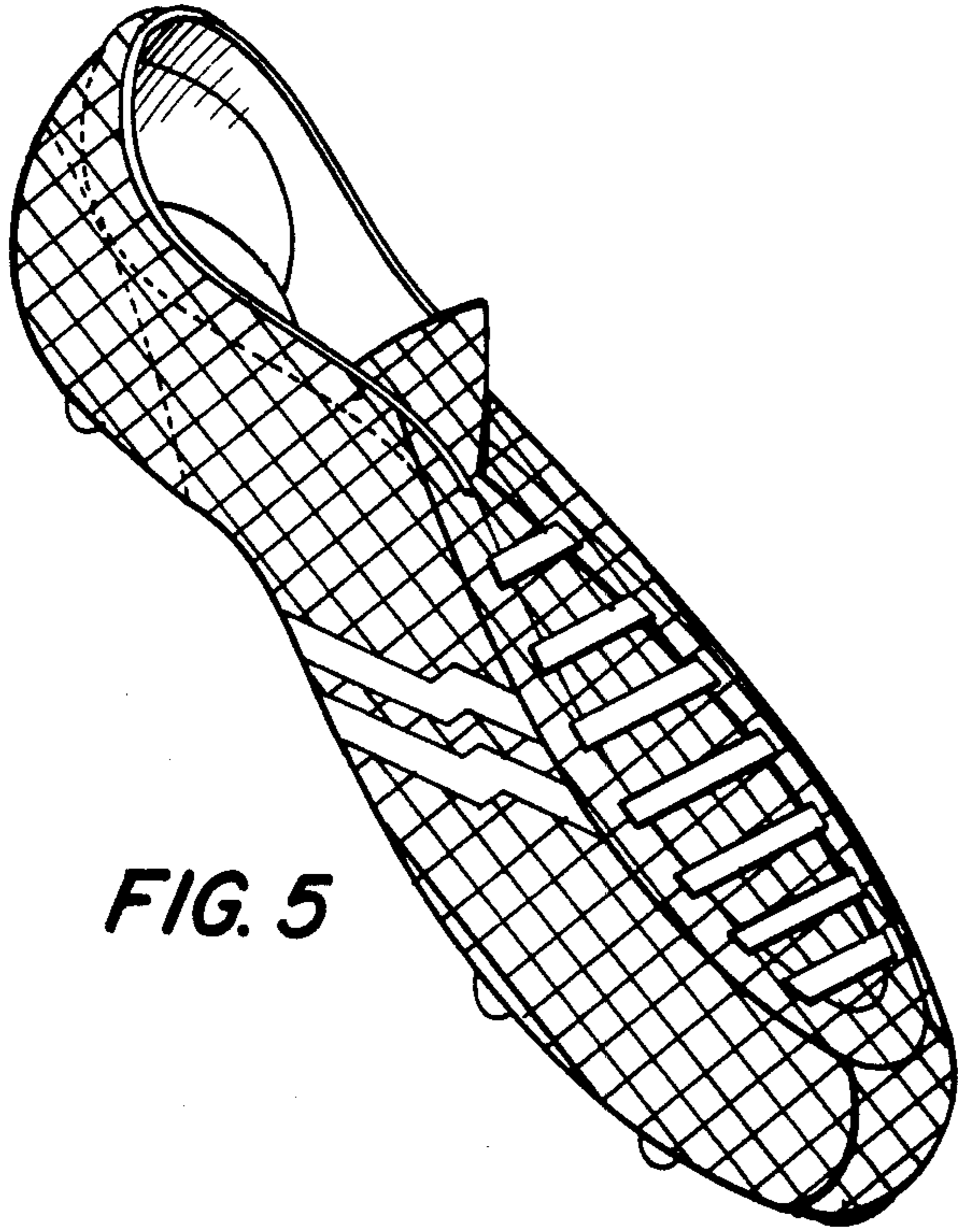

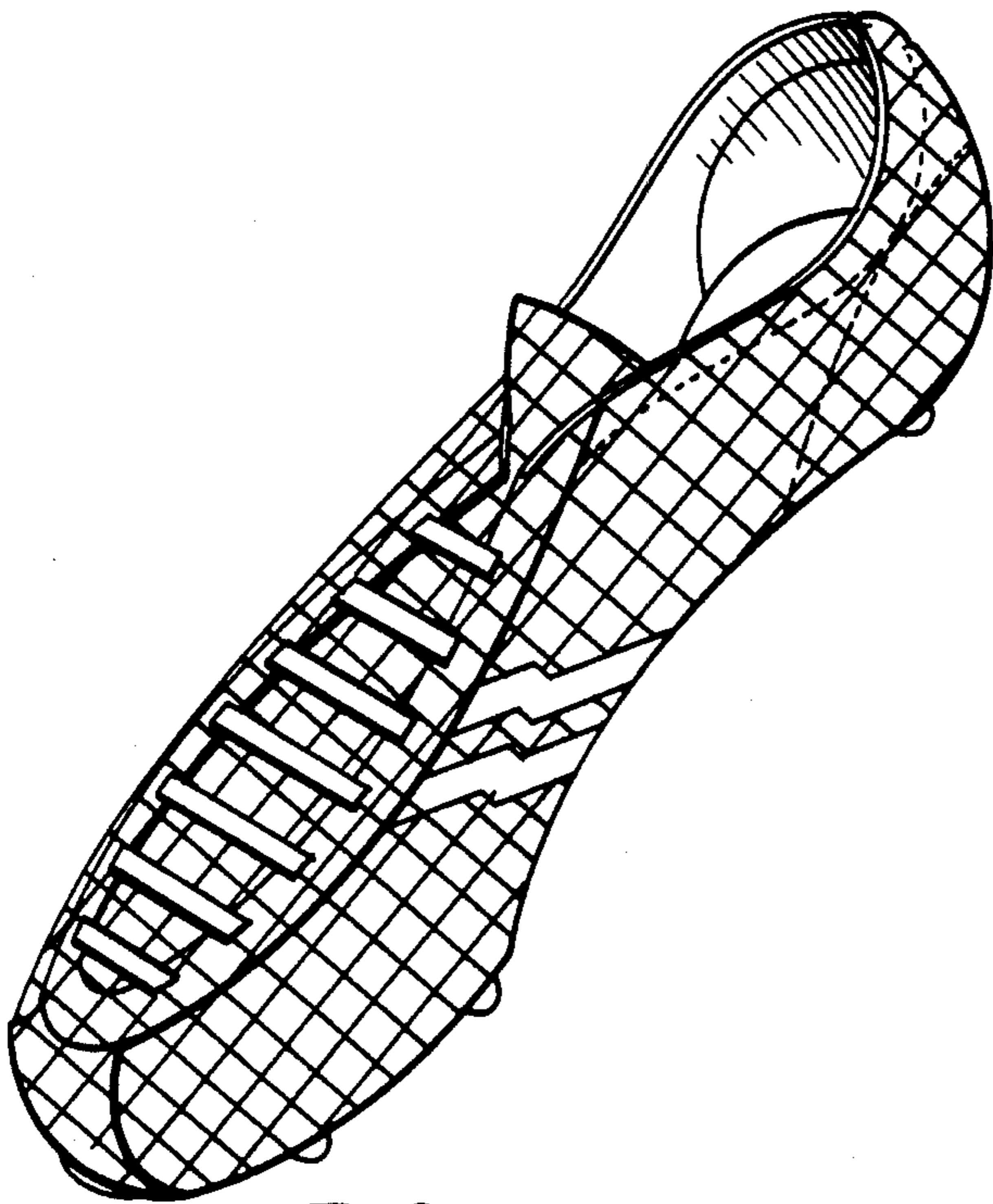
