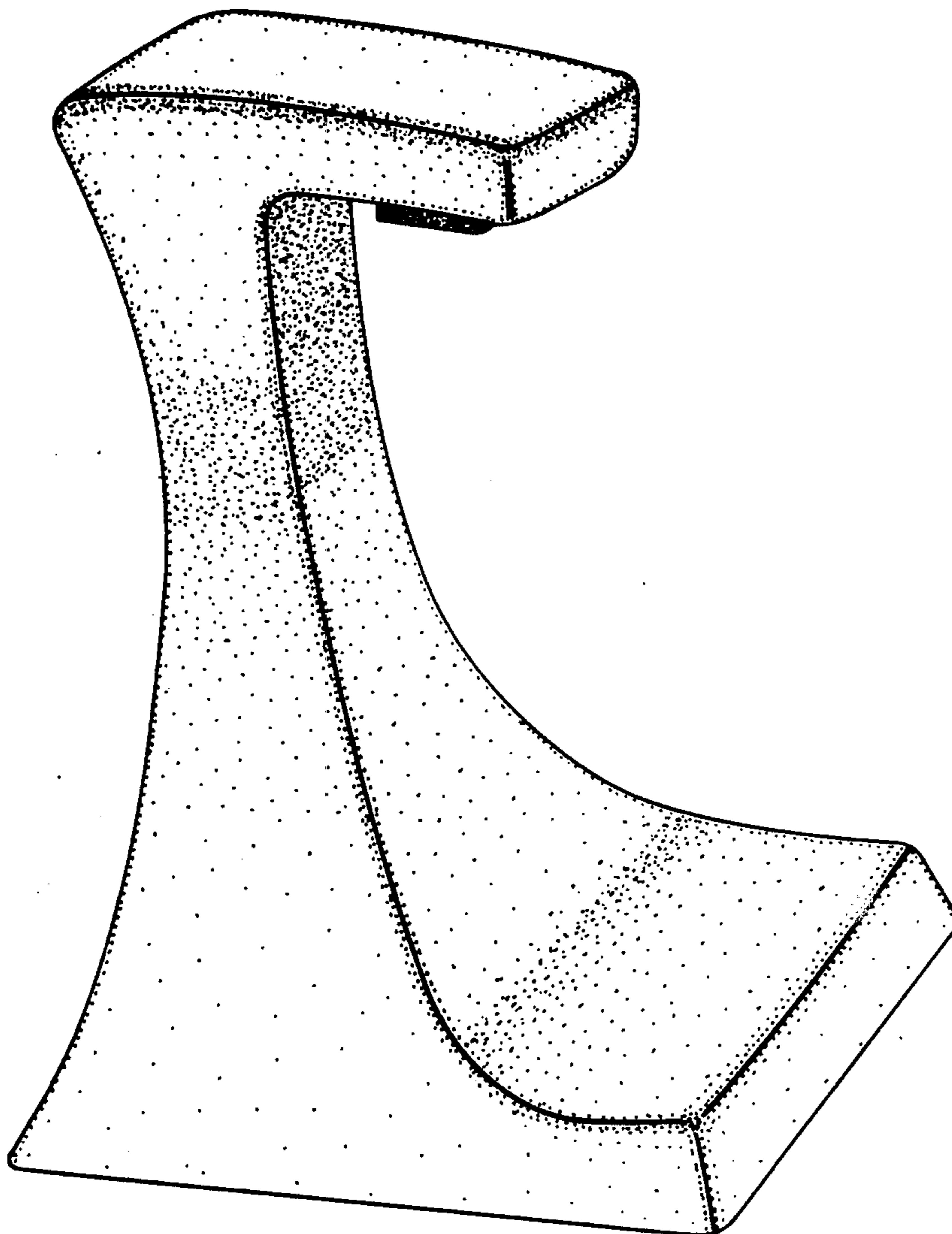

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pedestal for magnetically suspending a bar of soap.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pedestal for magnetically suspending a bar of soap showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



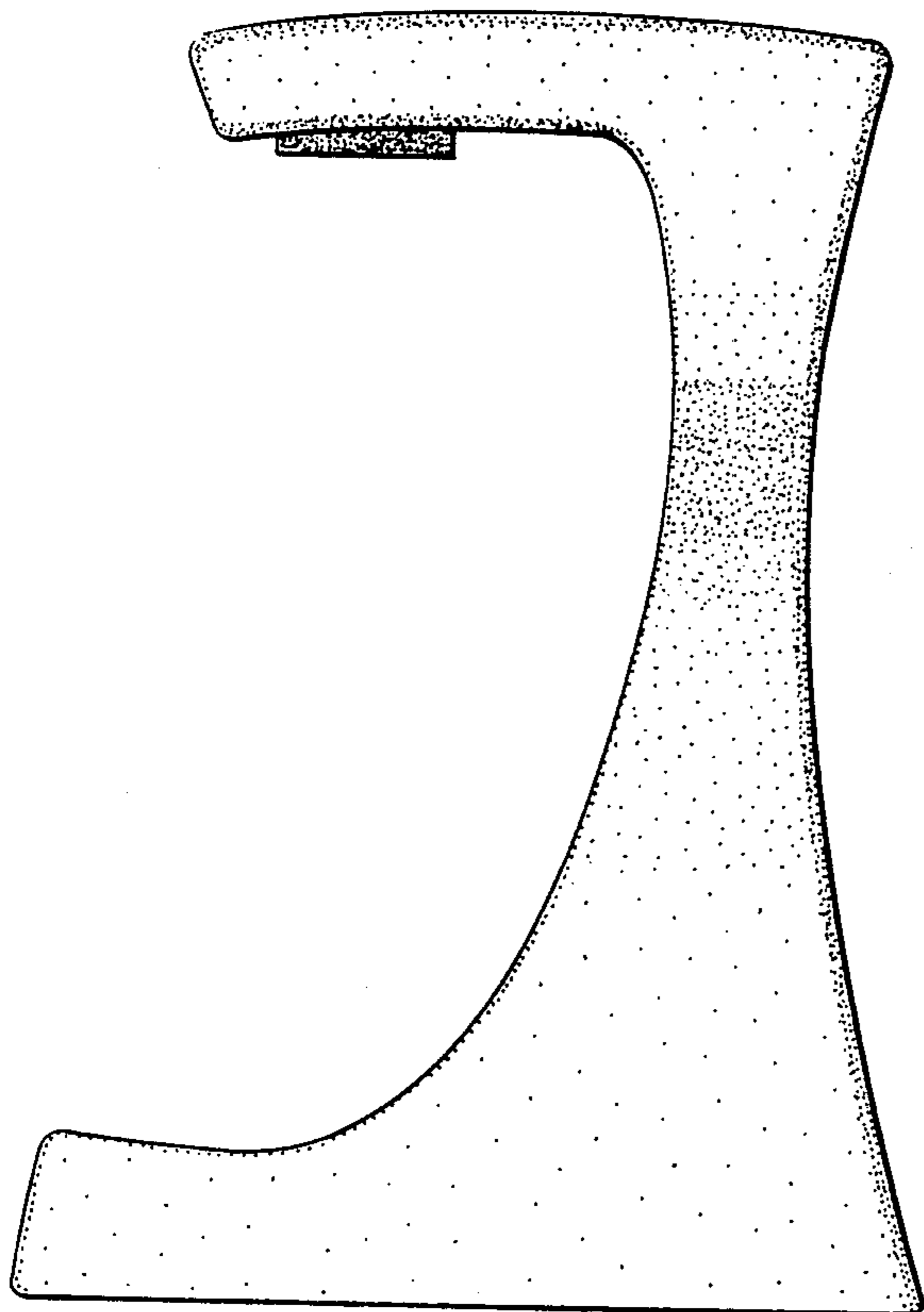

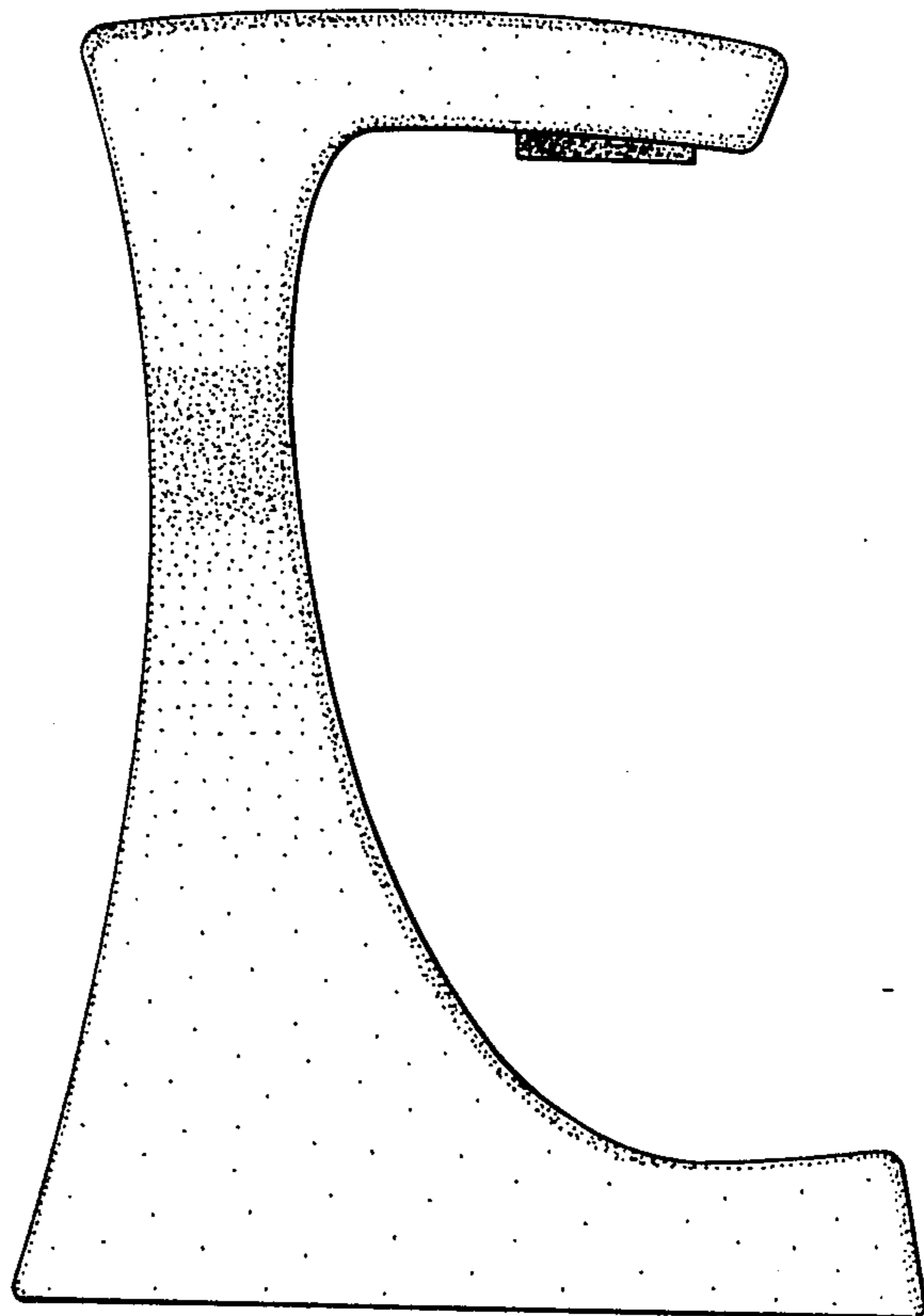

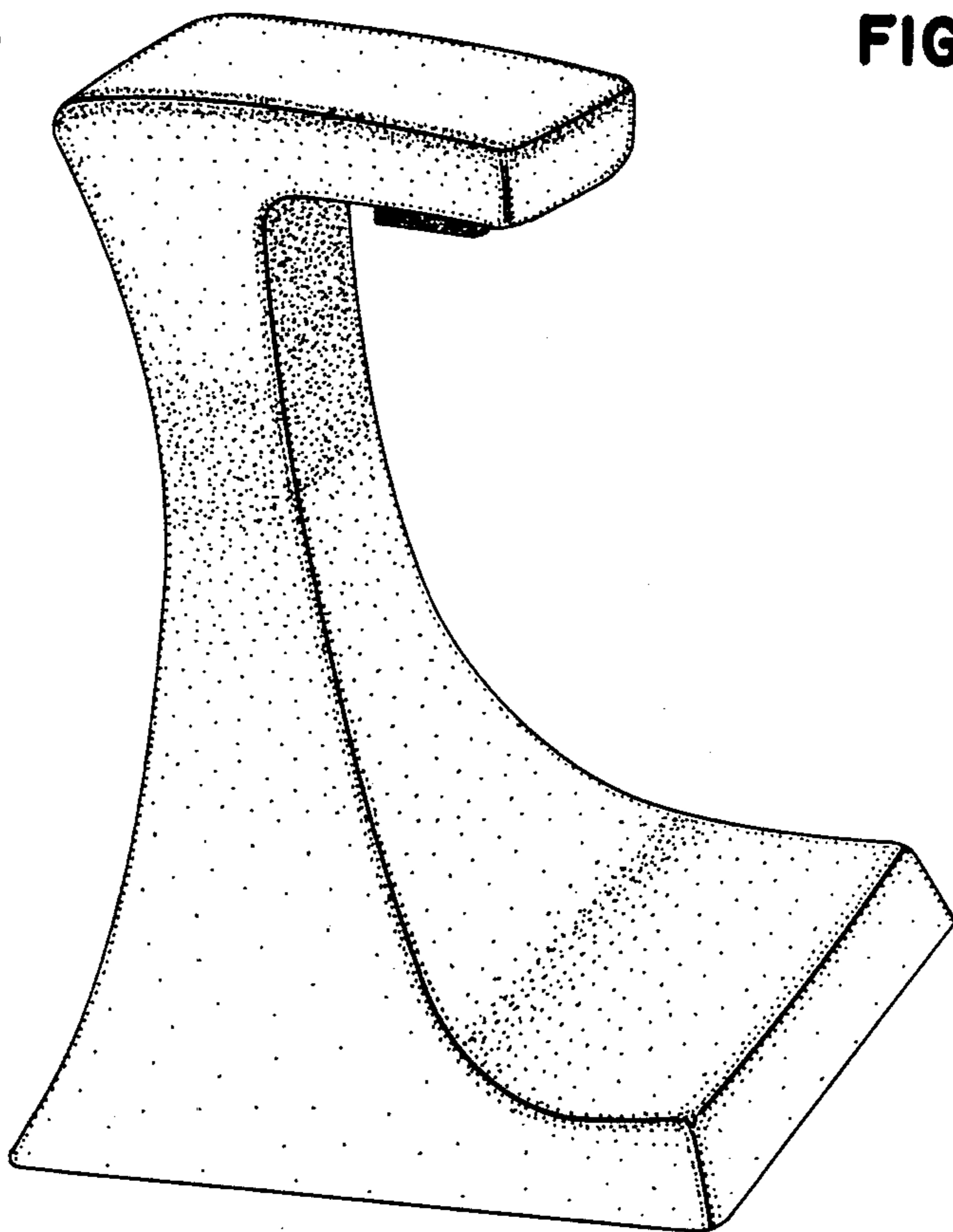

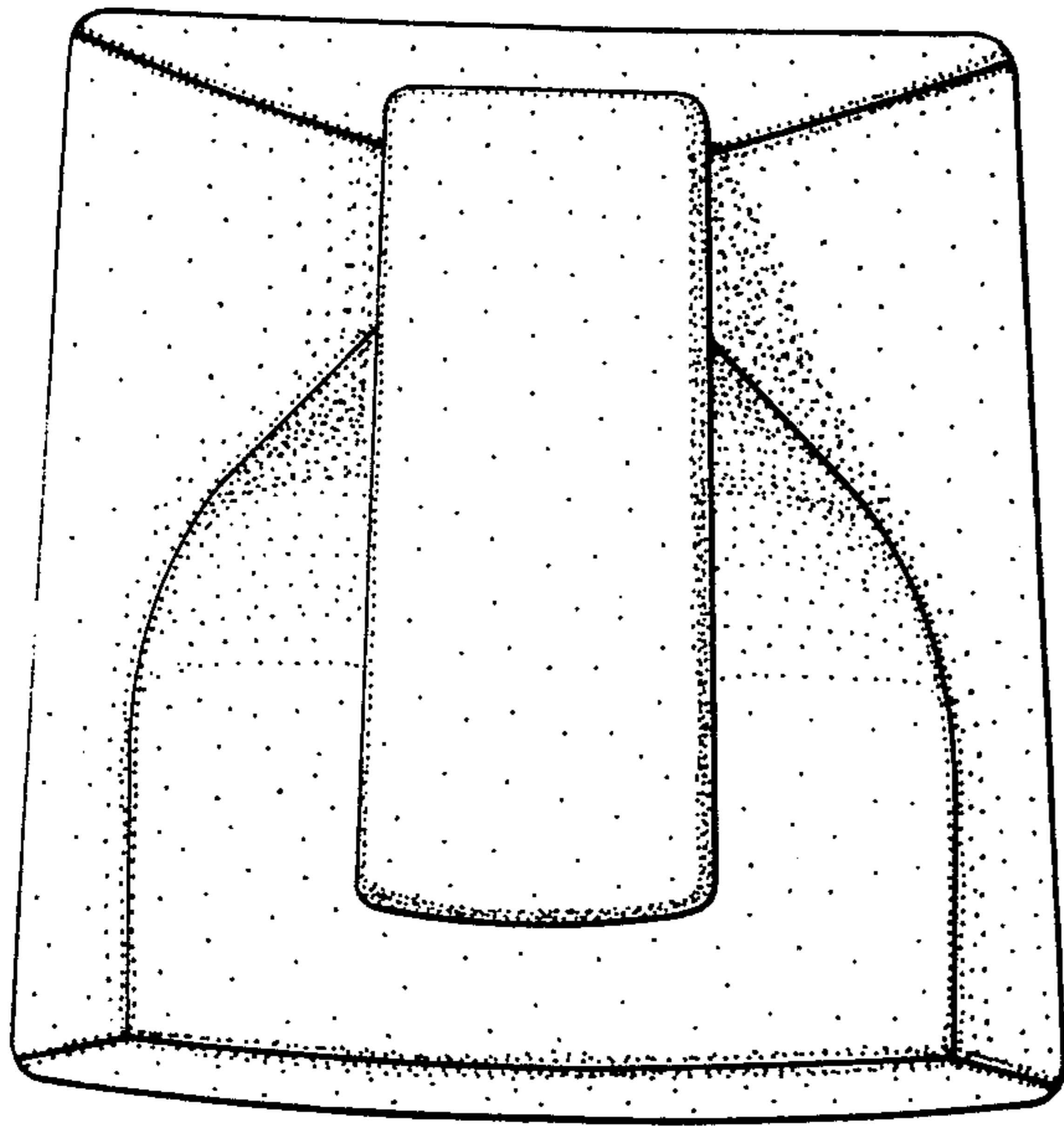

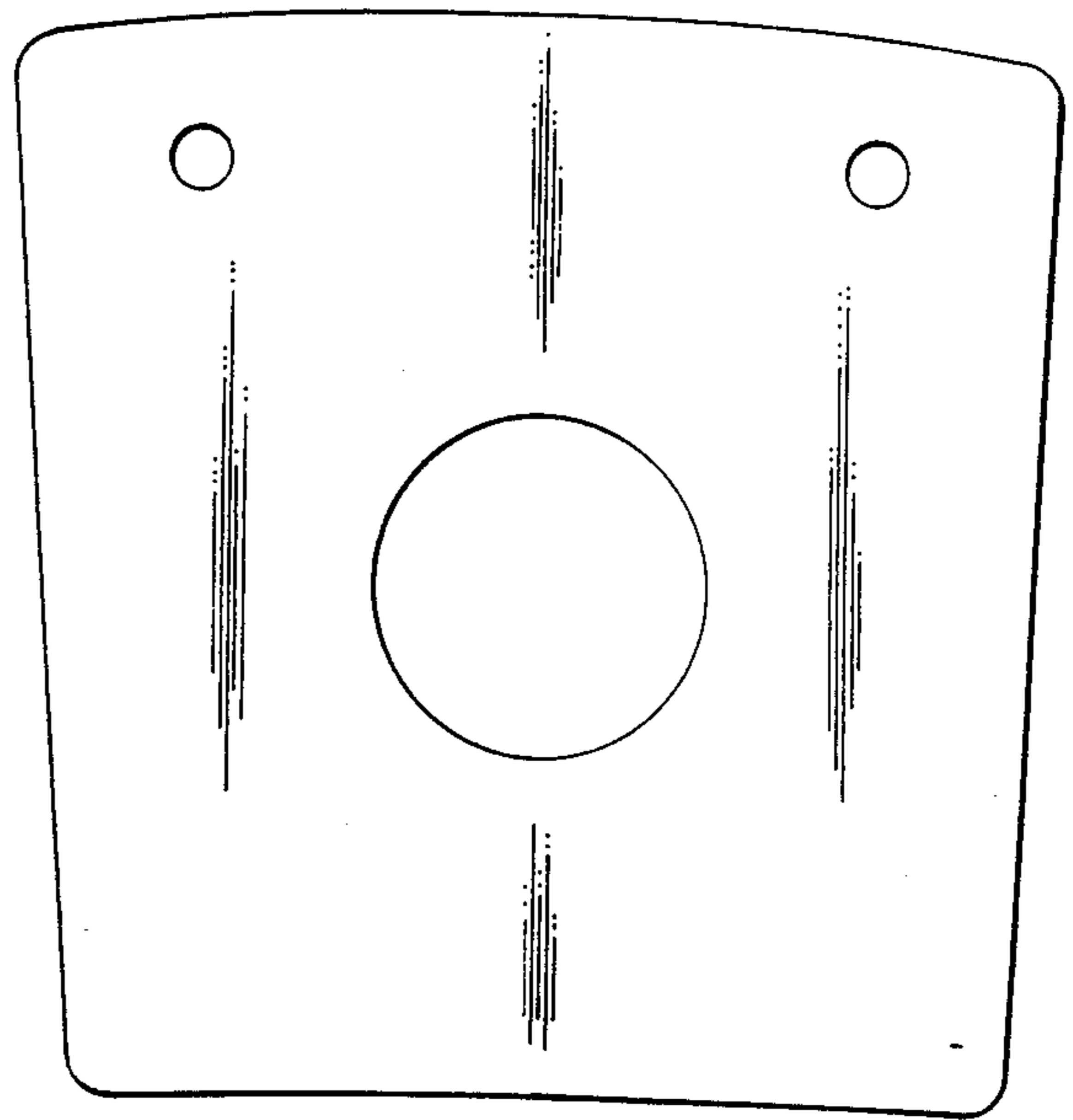

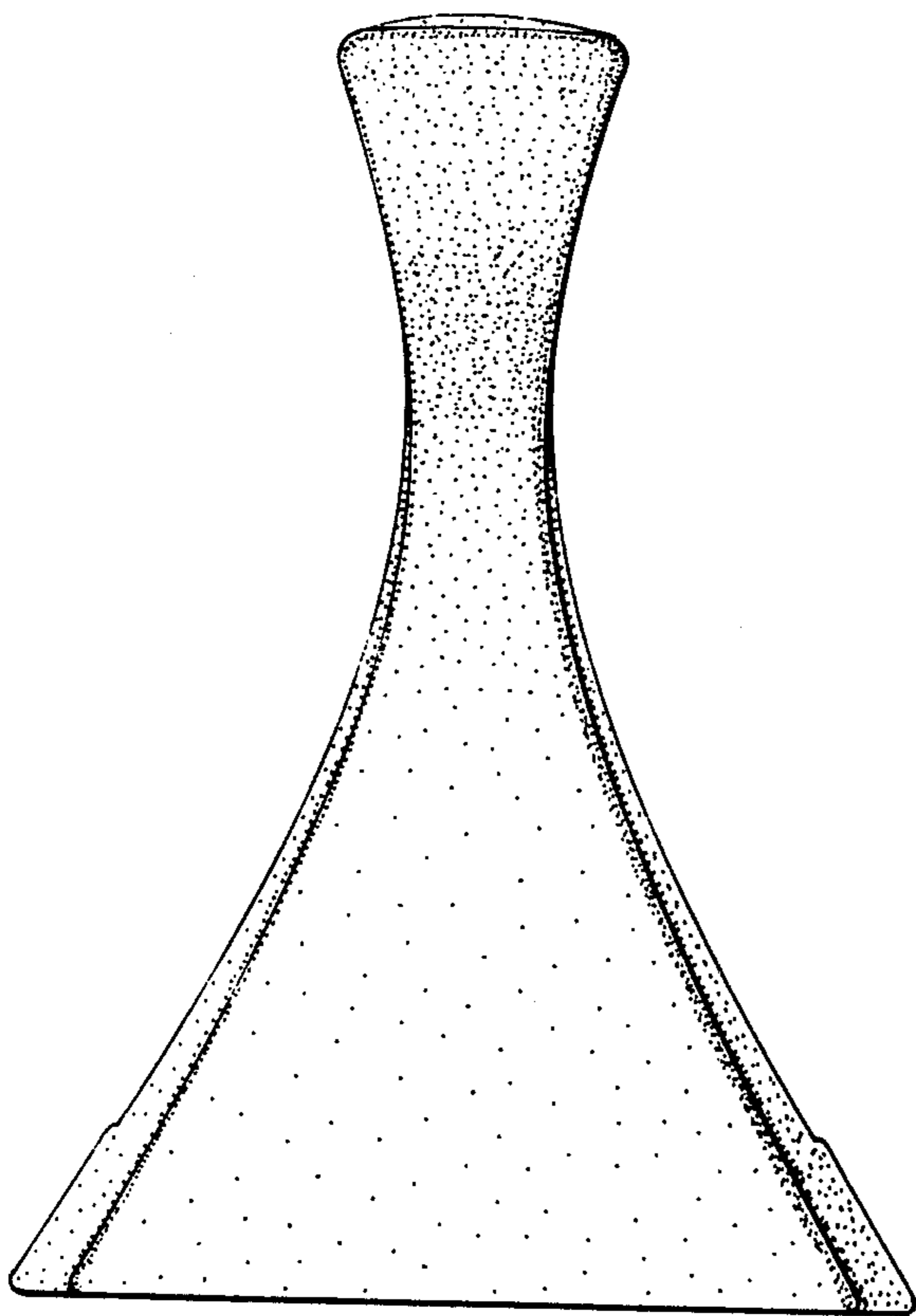

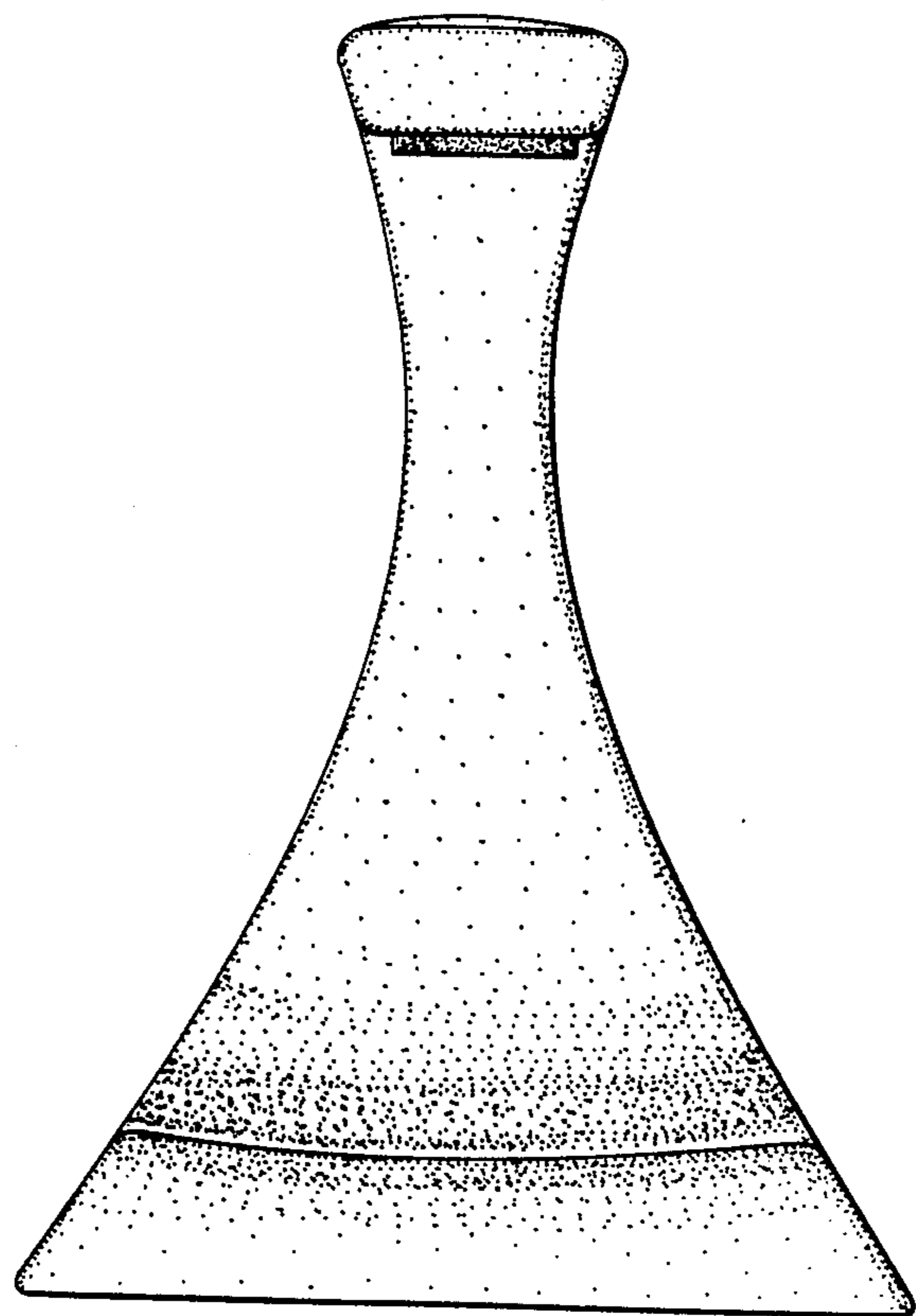
