FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereto.

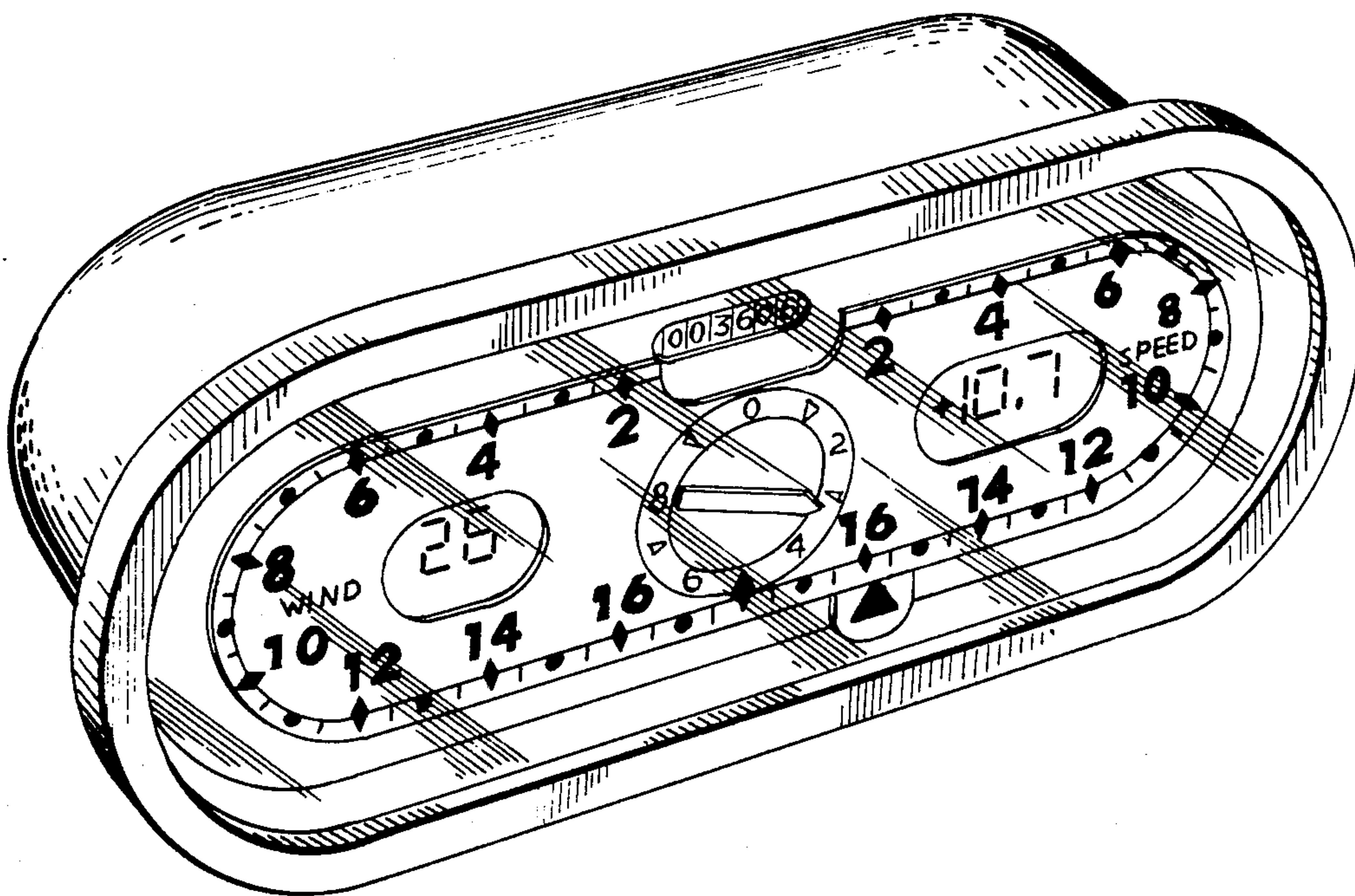

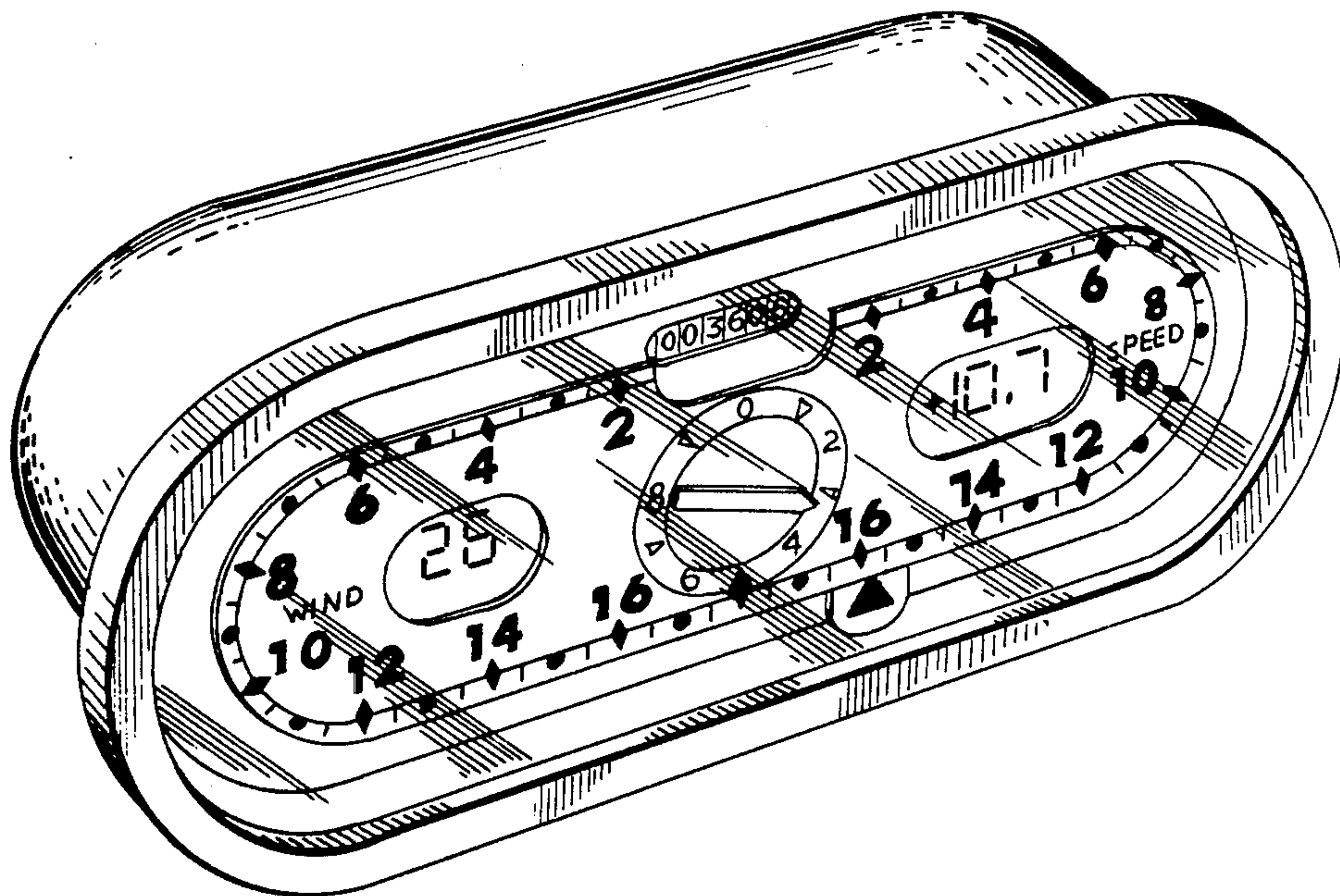

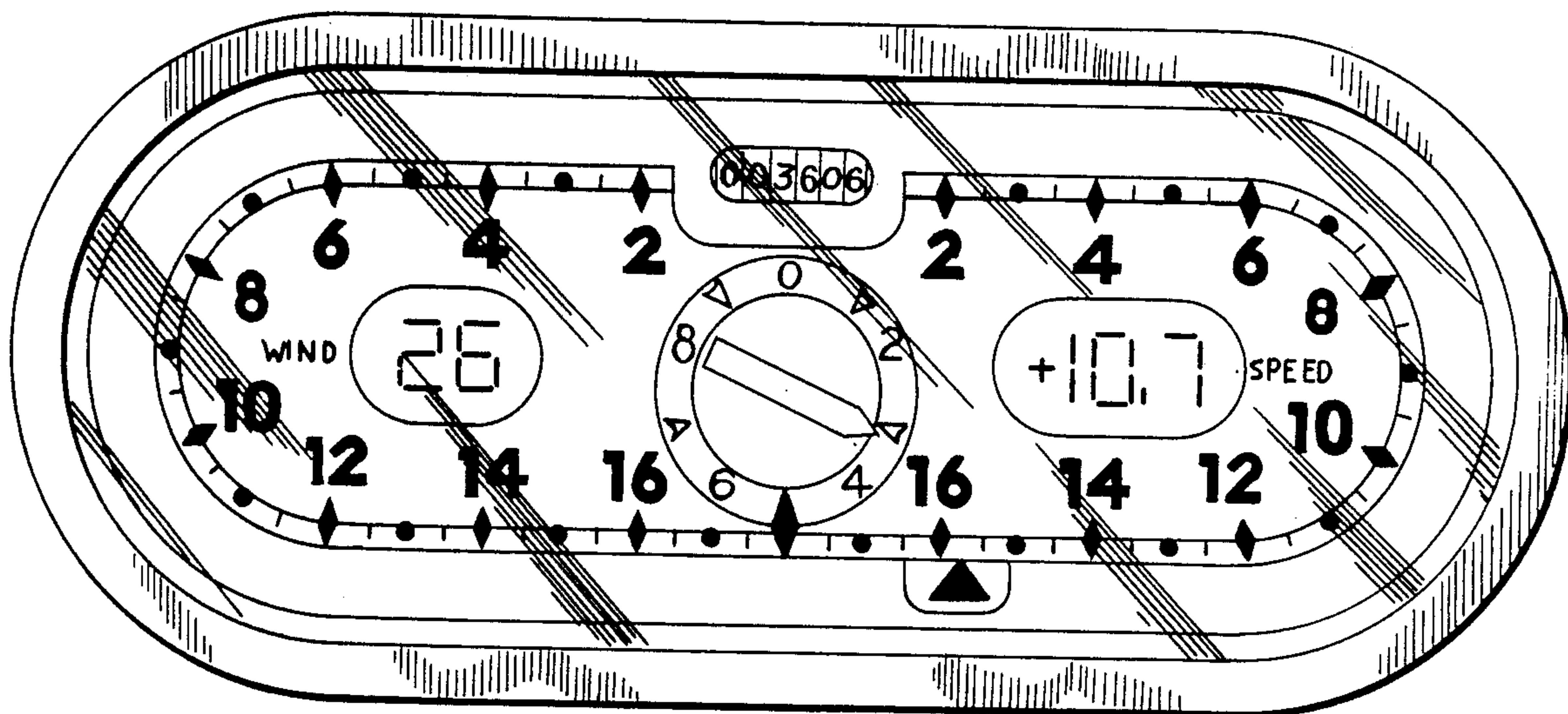

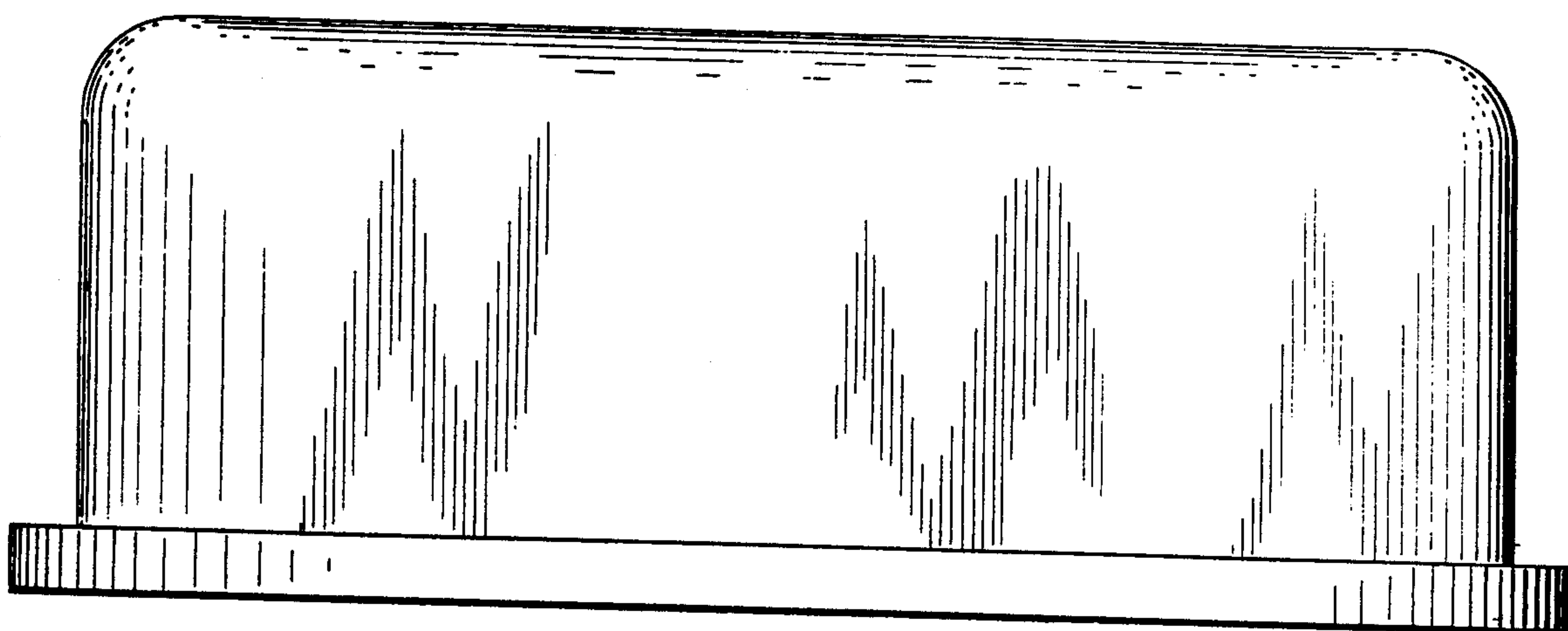
