FIG. 6 is a rear, side perspective view of FIG. 5.

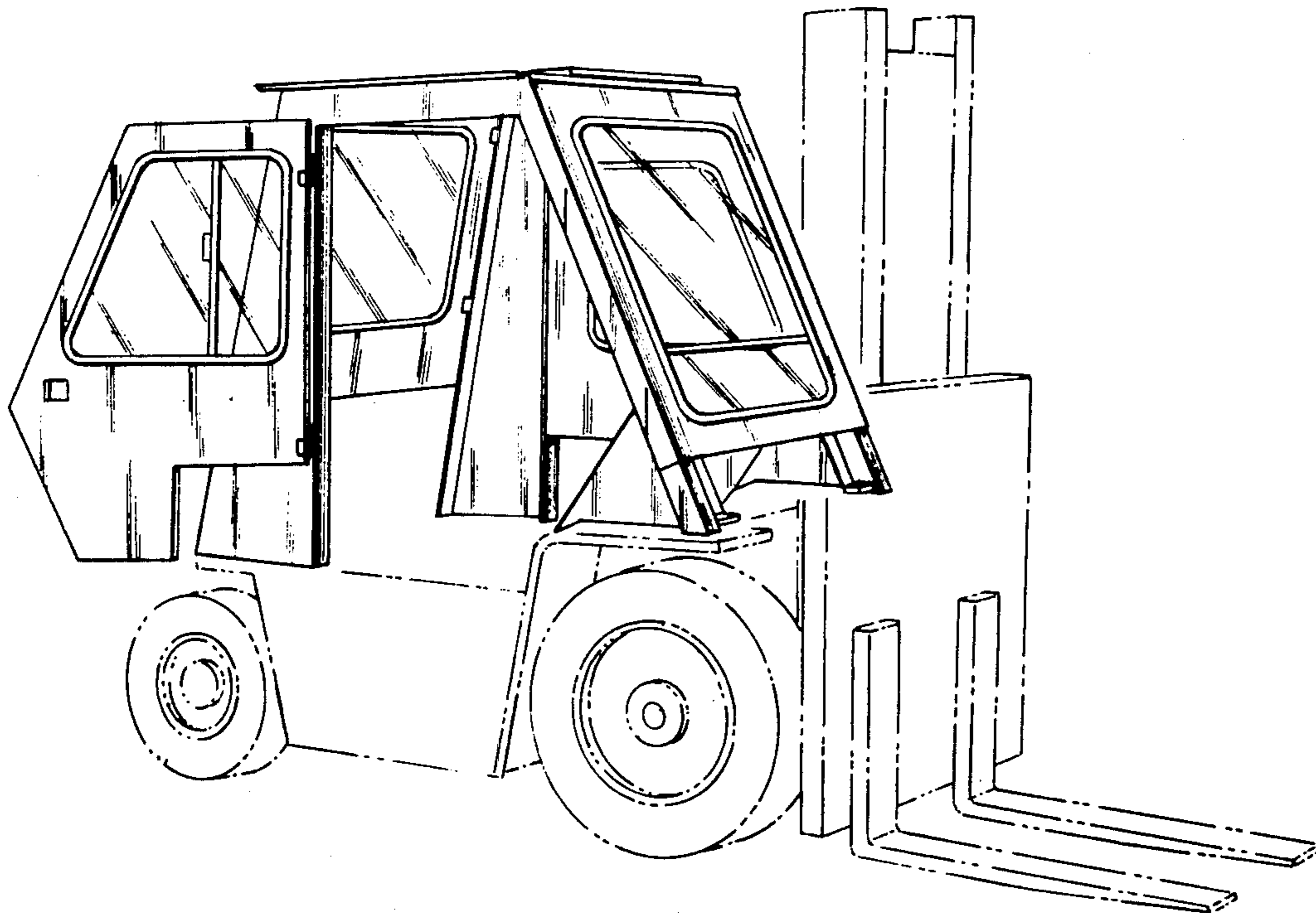

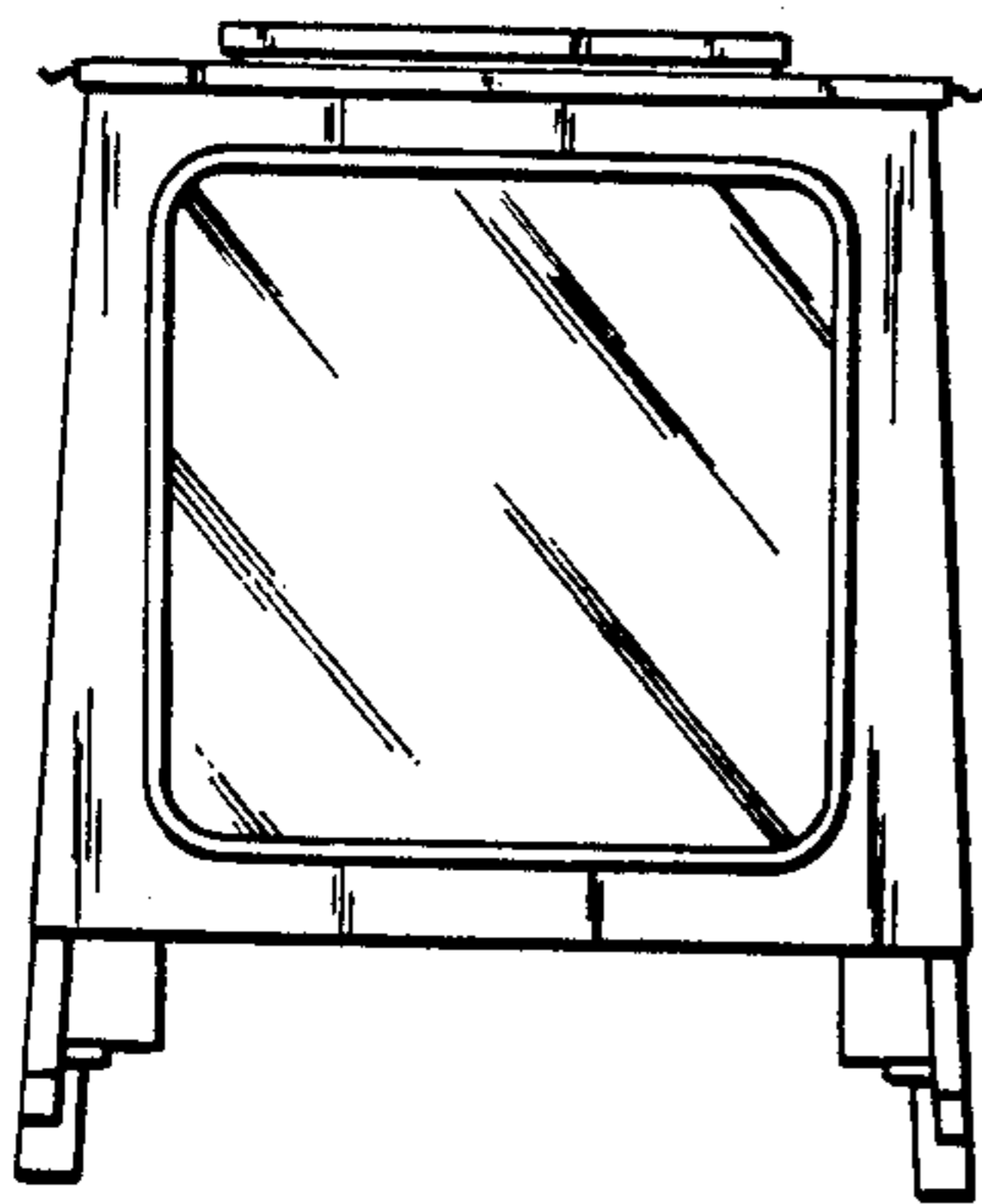
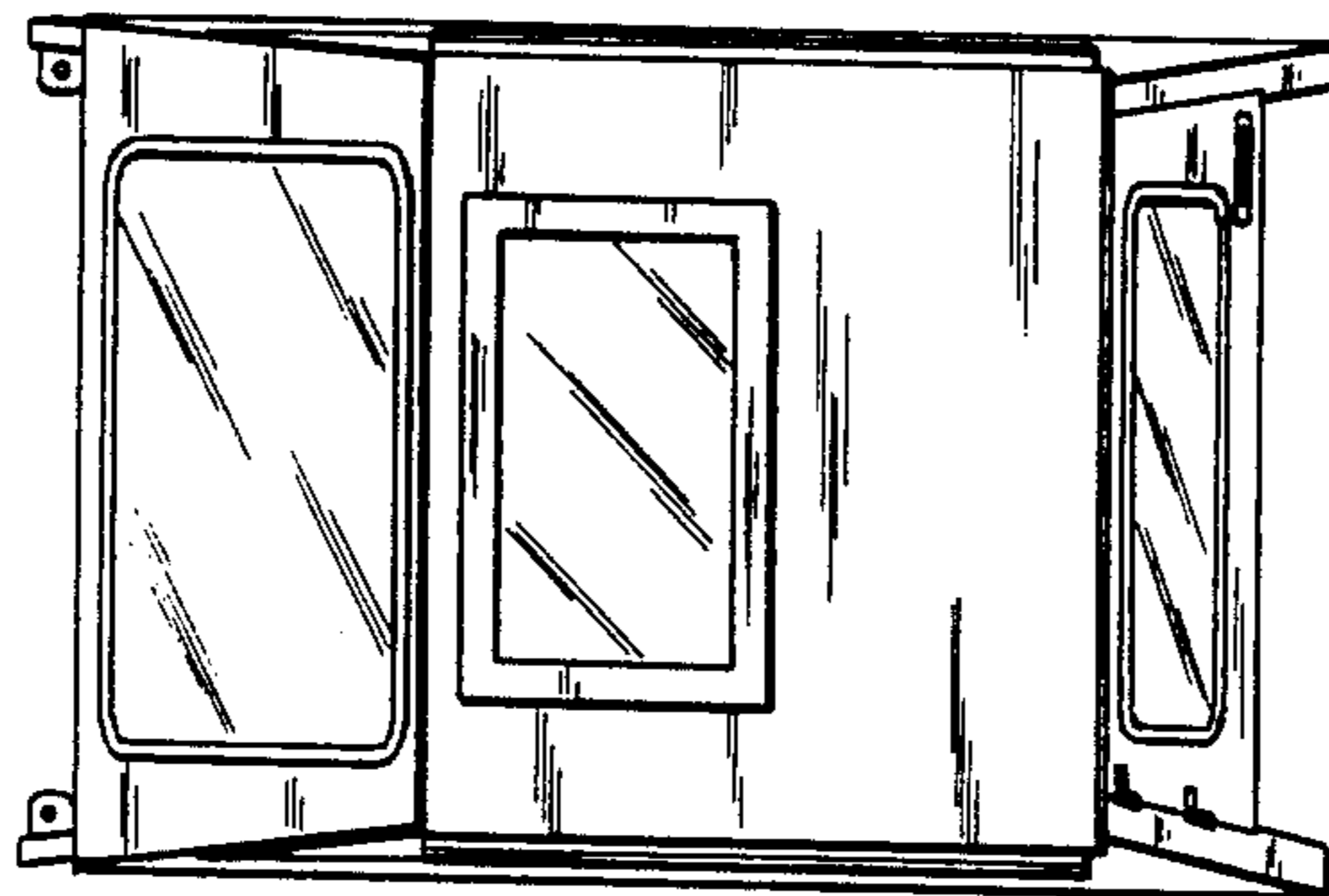

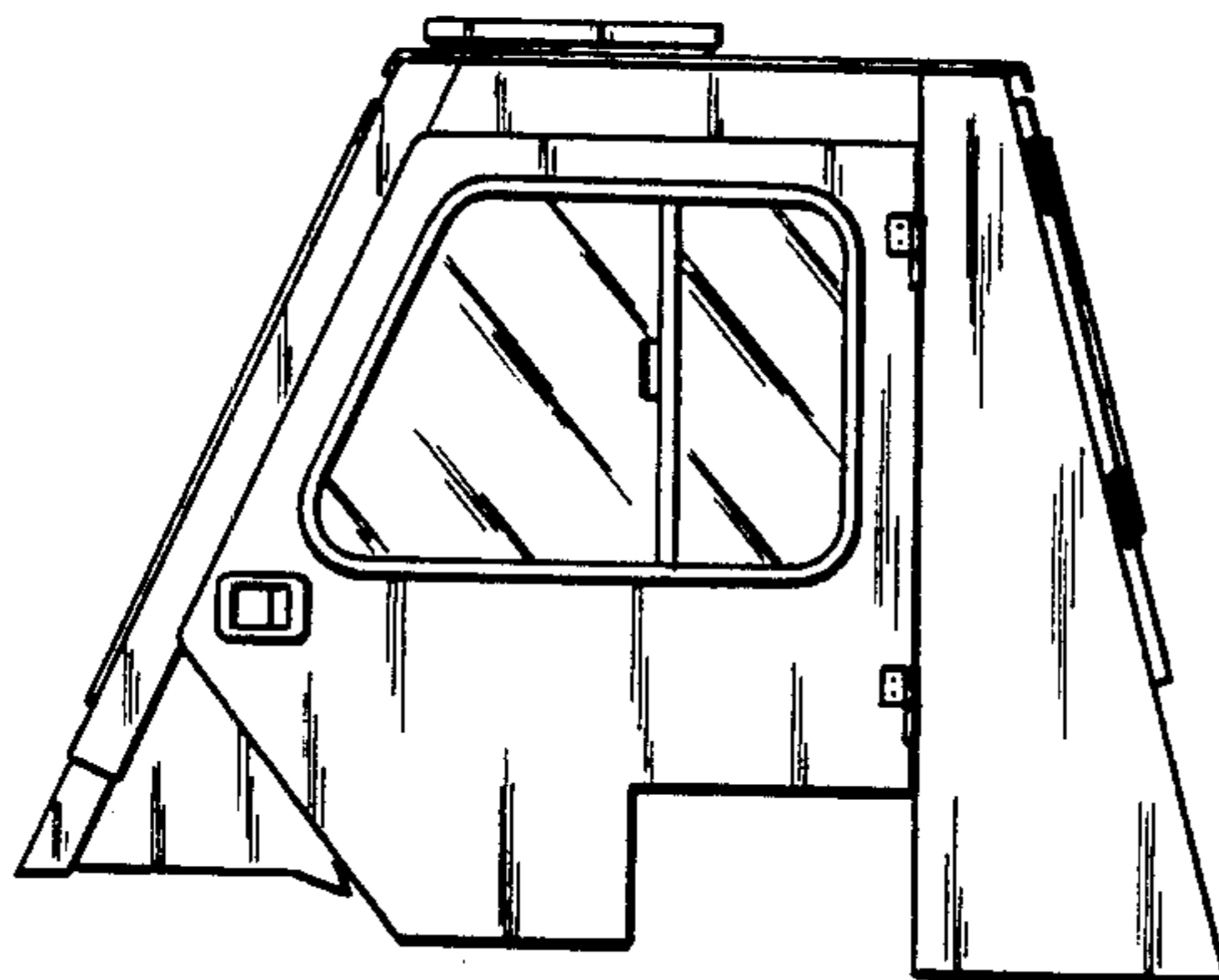

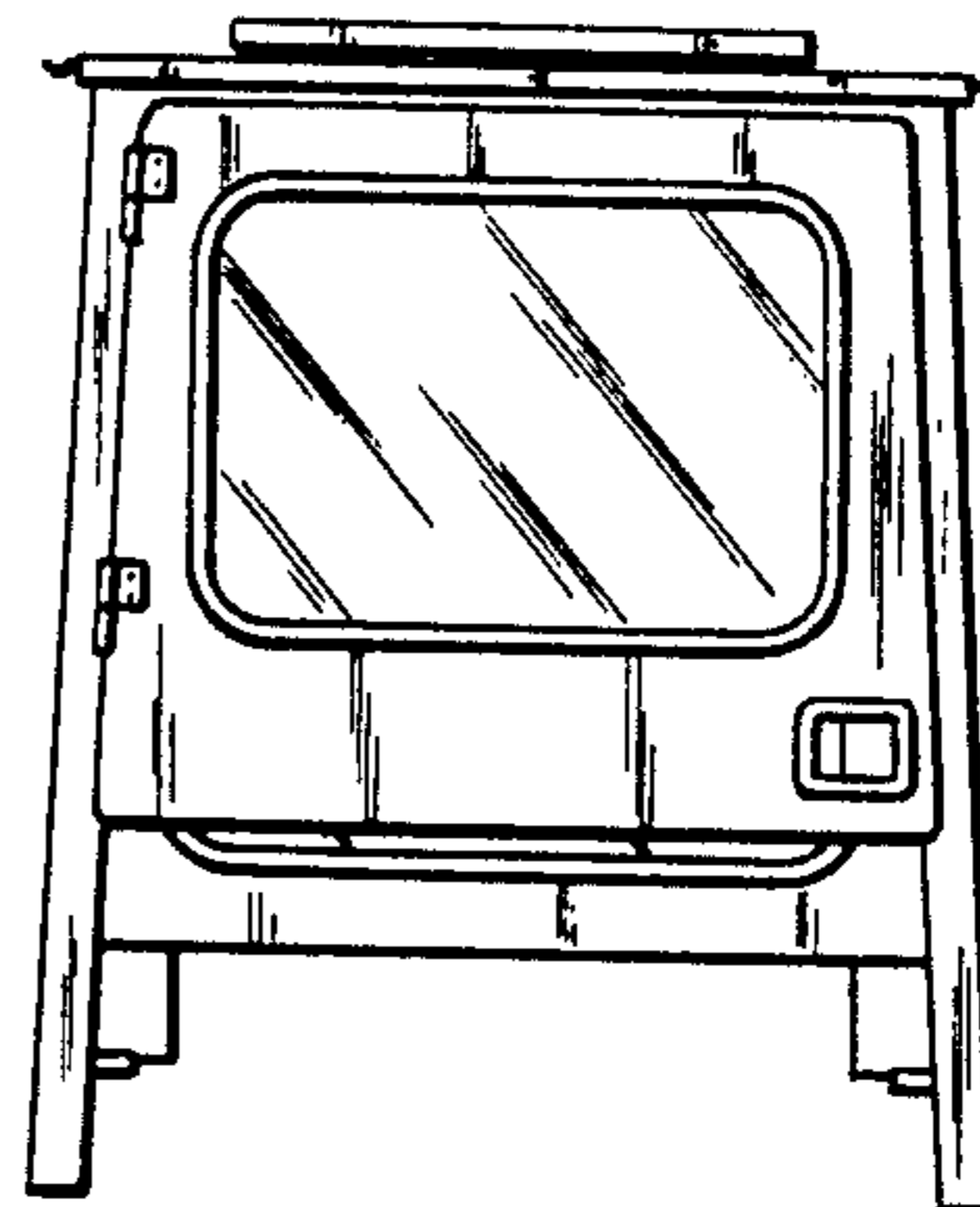

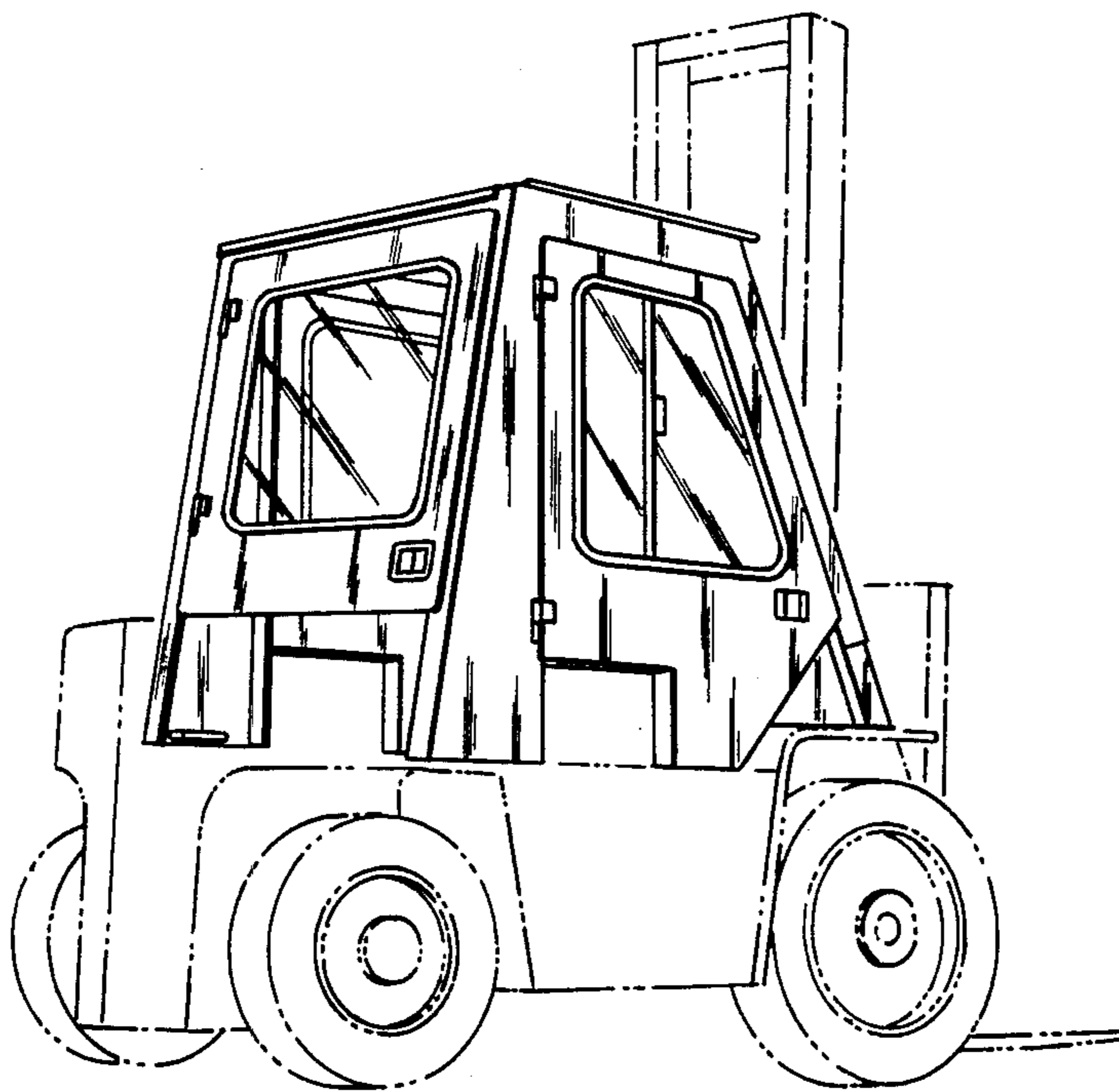
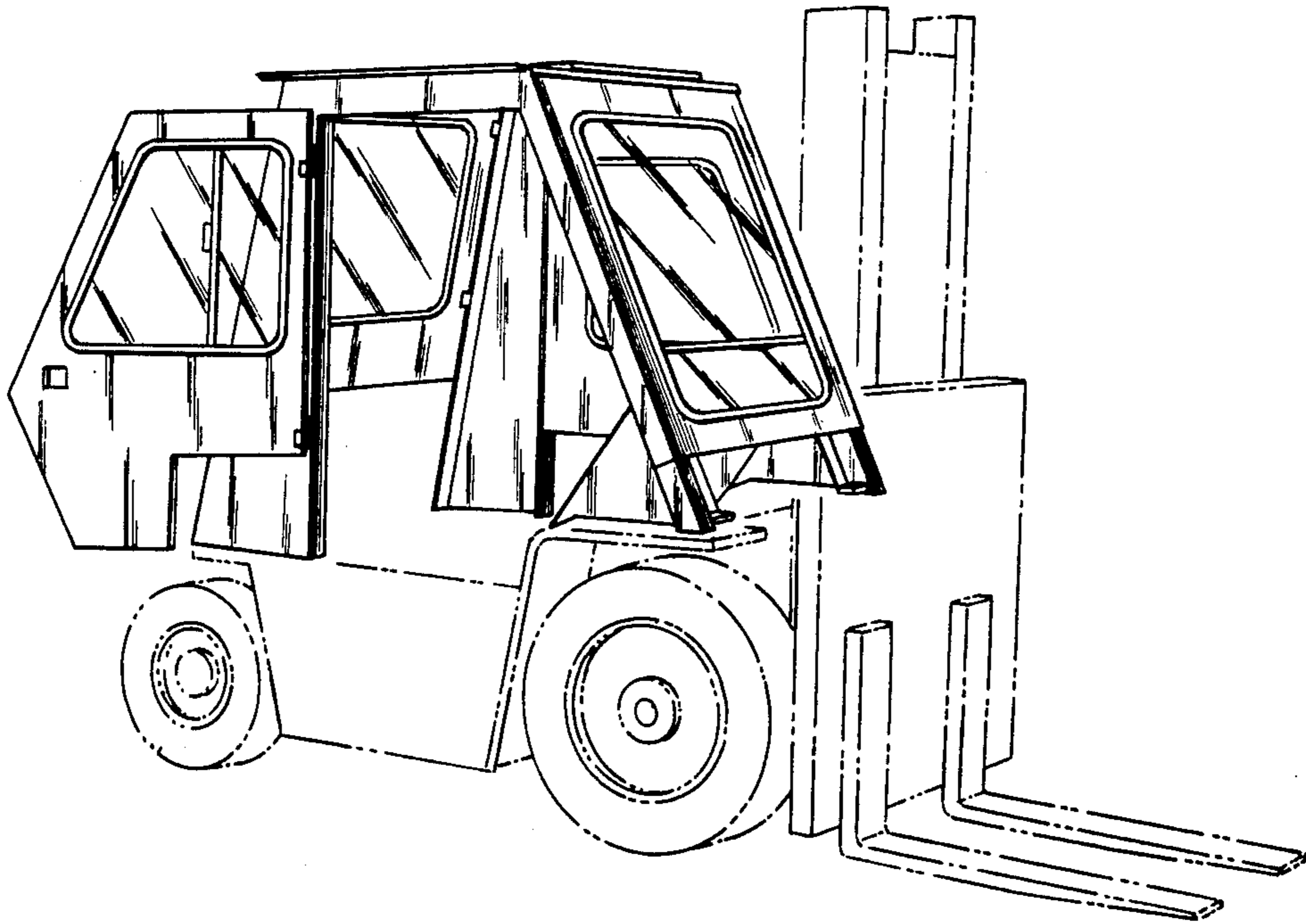
