The ornamental design for a doll, as shown.

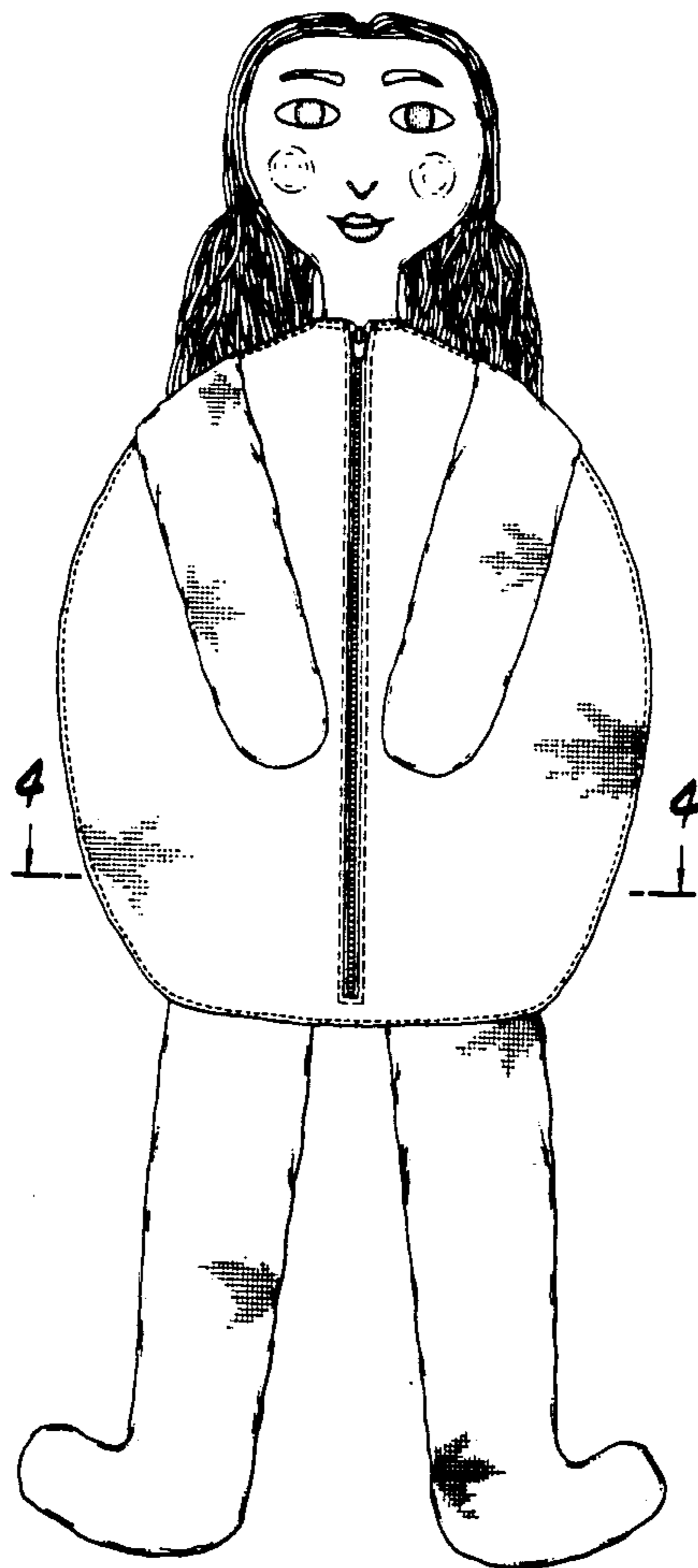
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view showing my new design for a doll;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the right side thereof, as viewed in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; and

FIG. 4 is a transverse sectional view thereof, taken substantially on line 4-4 of FIG. 1.



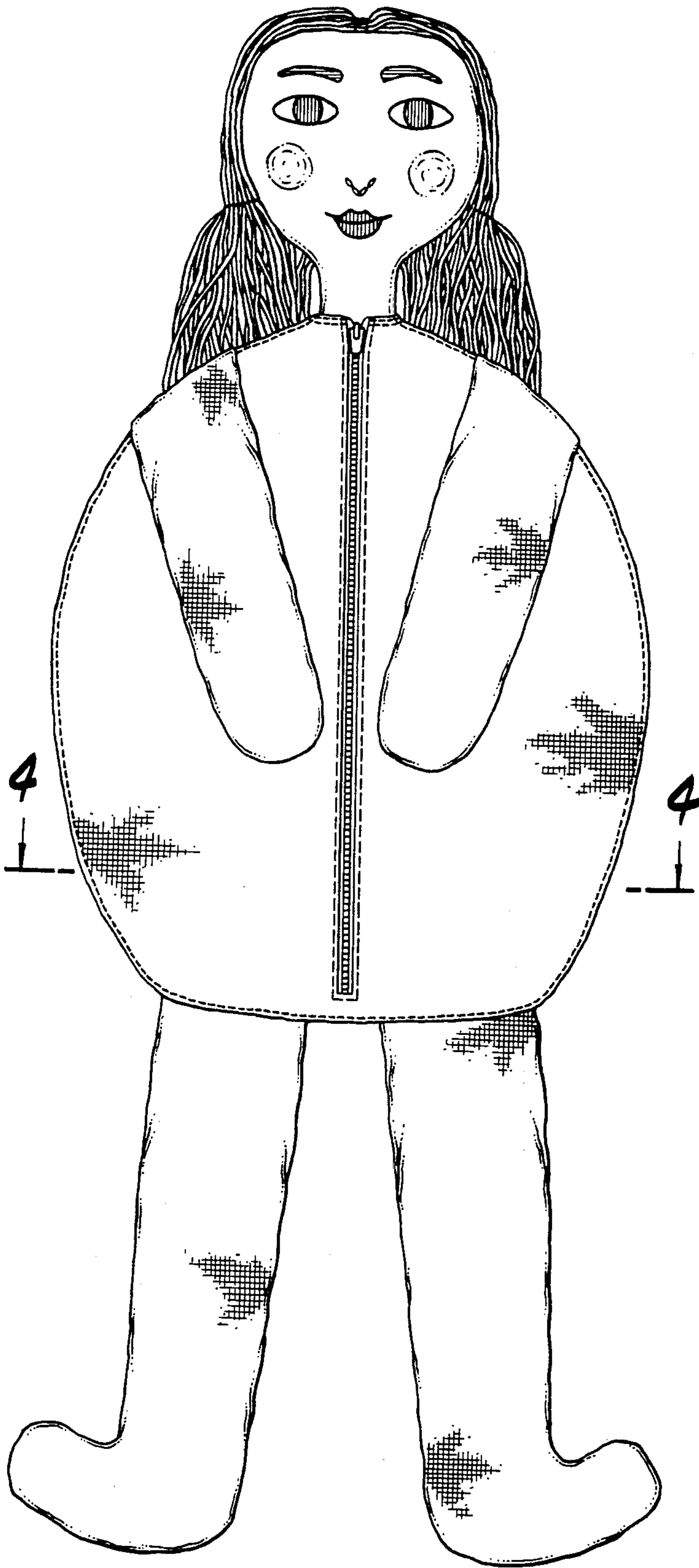

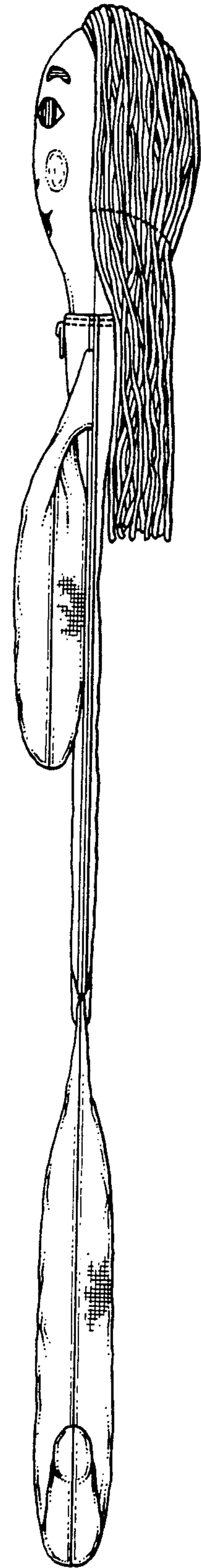

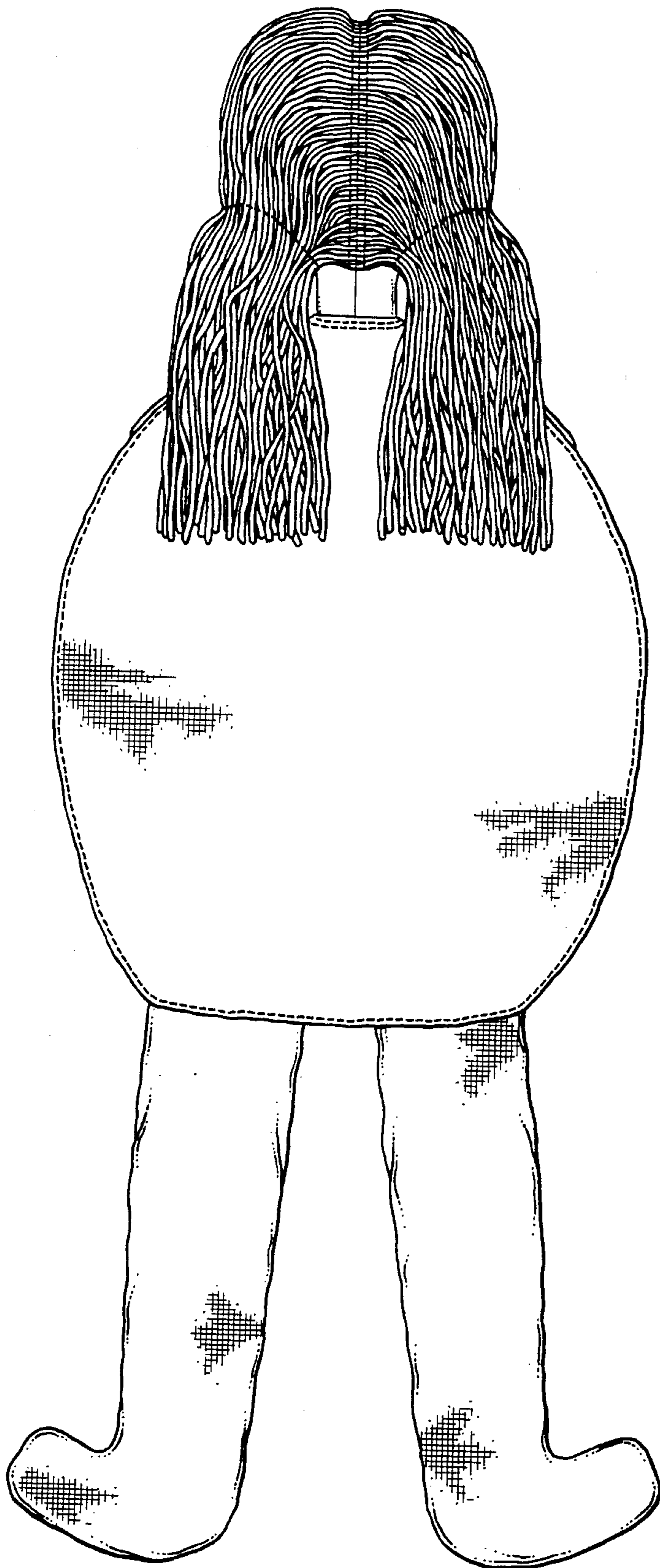

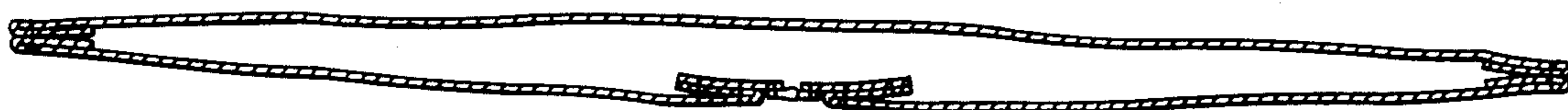
