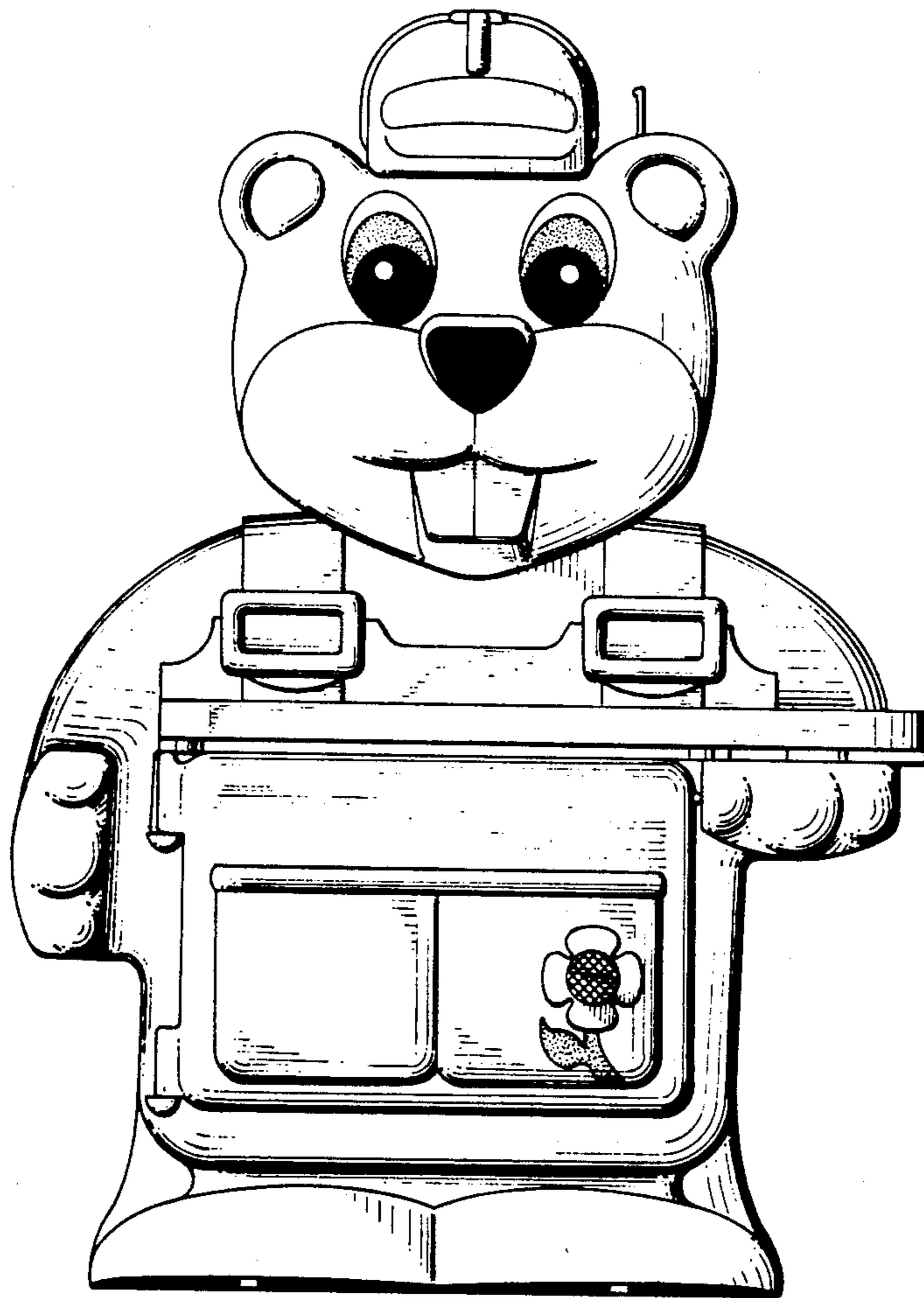

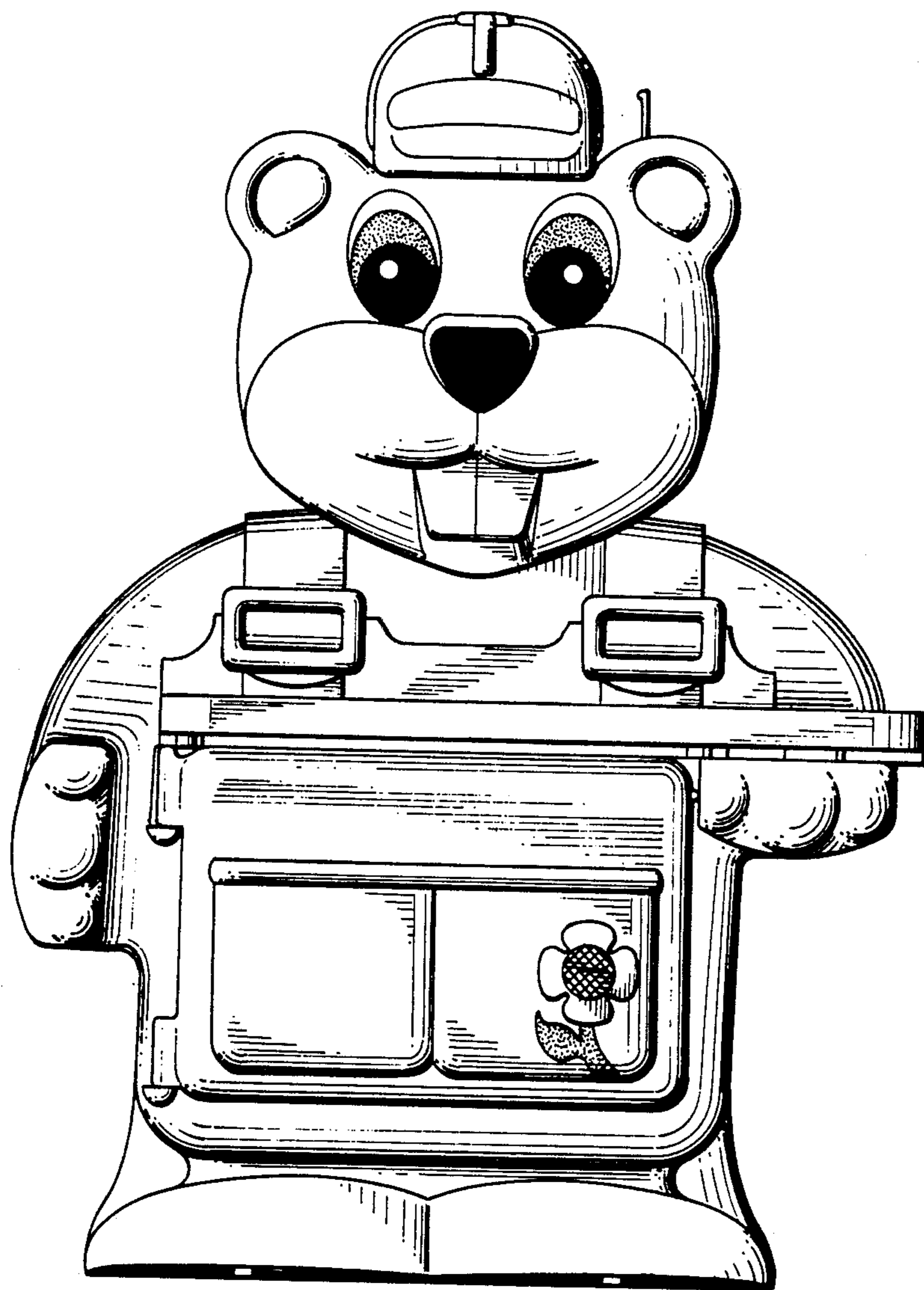
The ornamental design for a toy work bench, as shown.

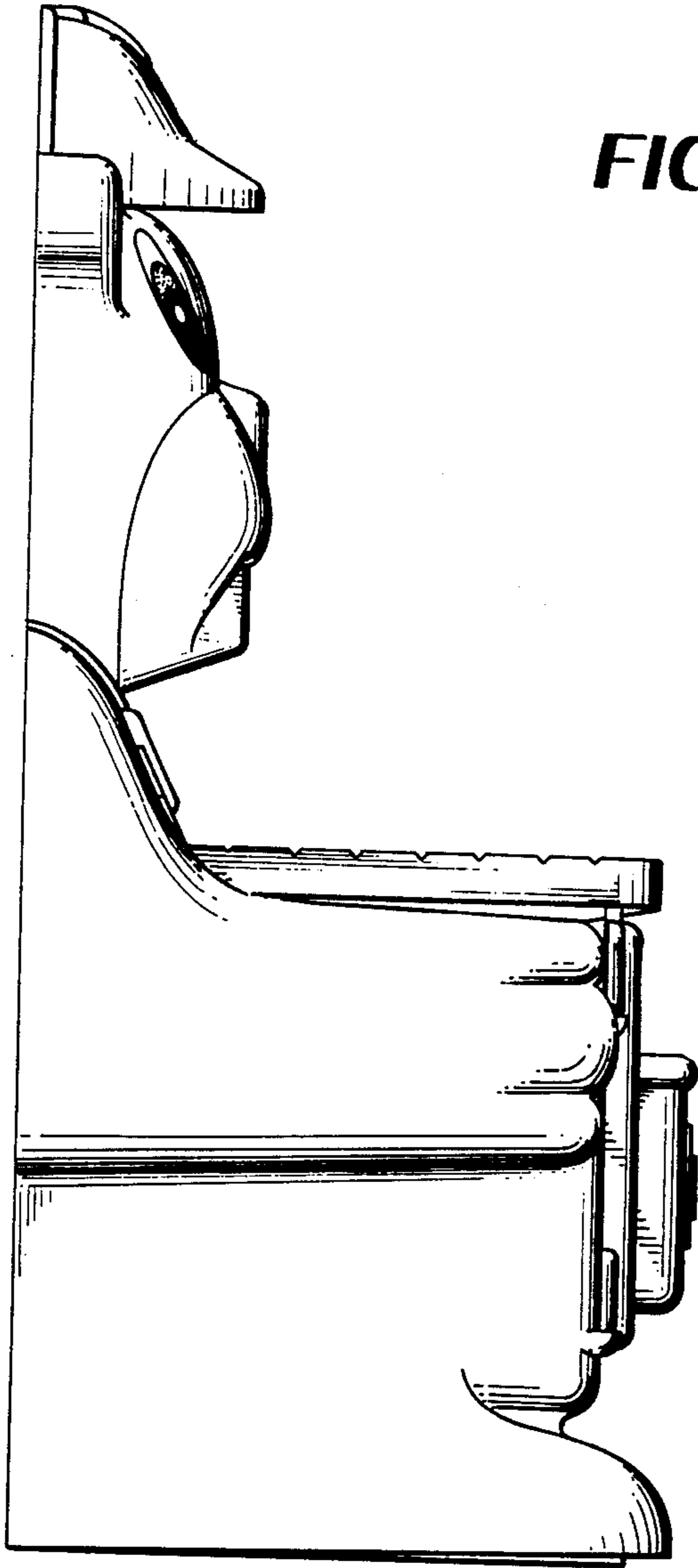
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

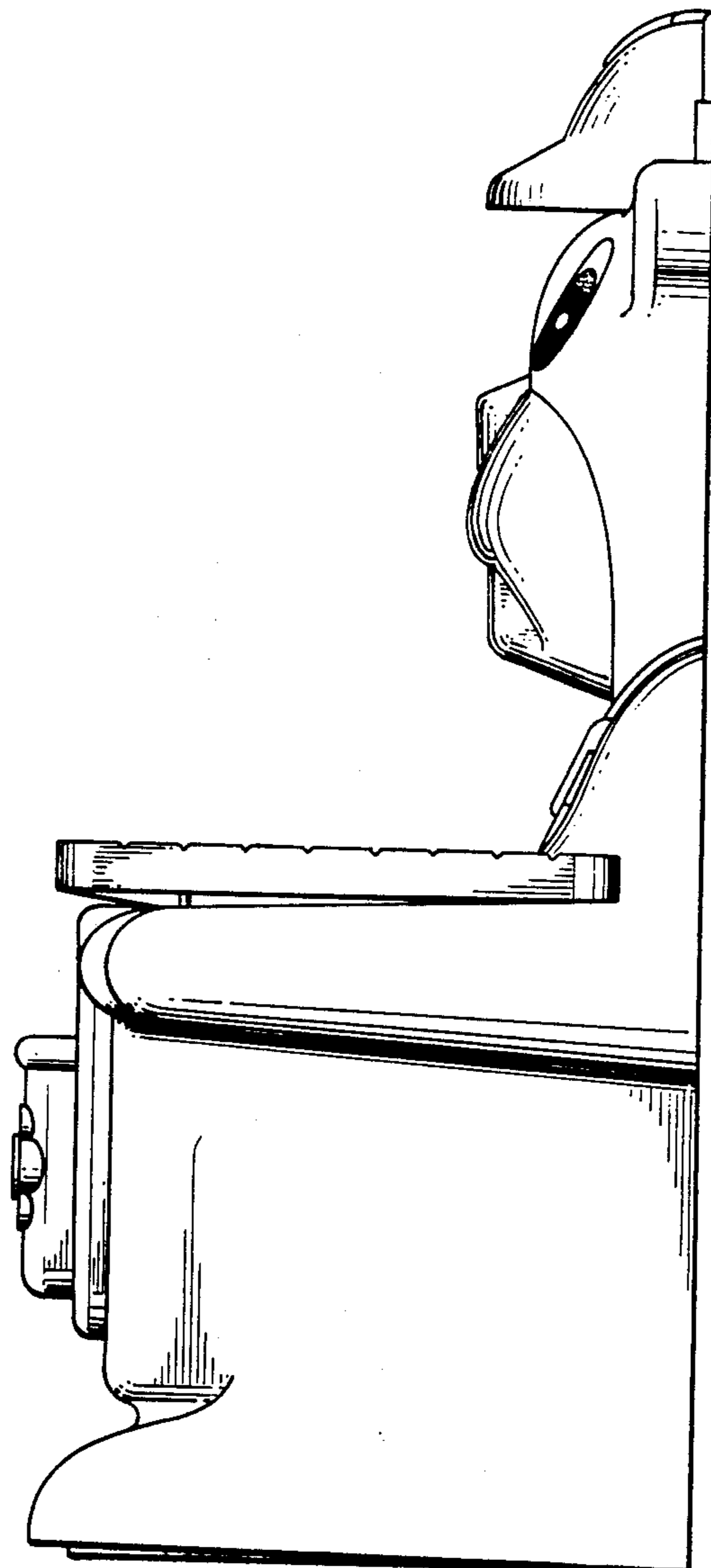

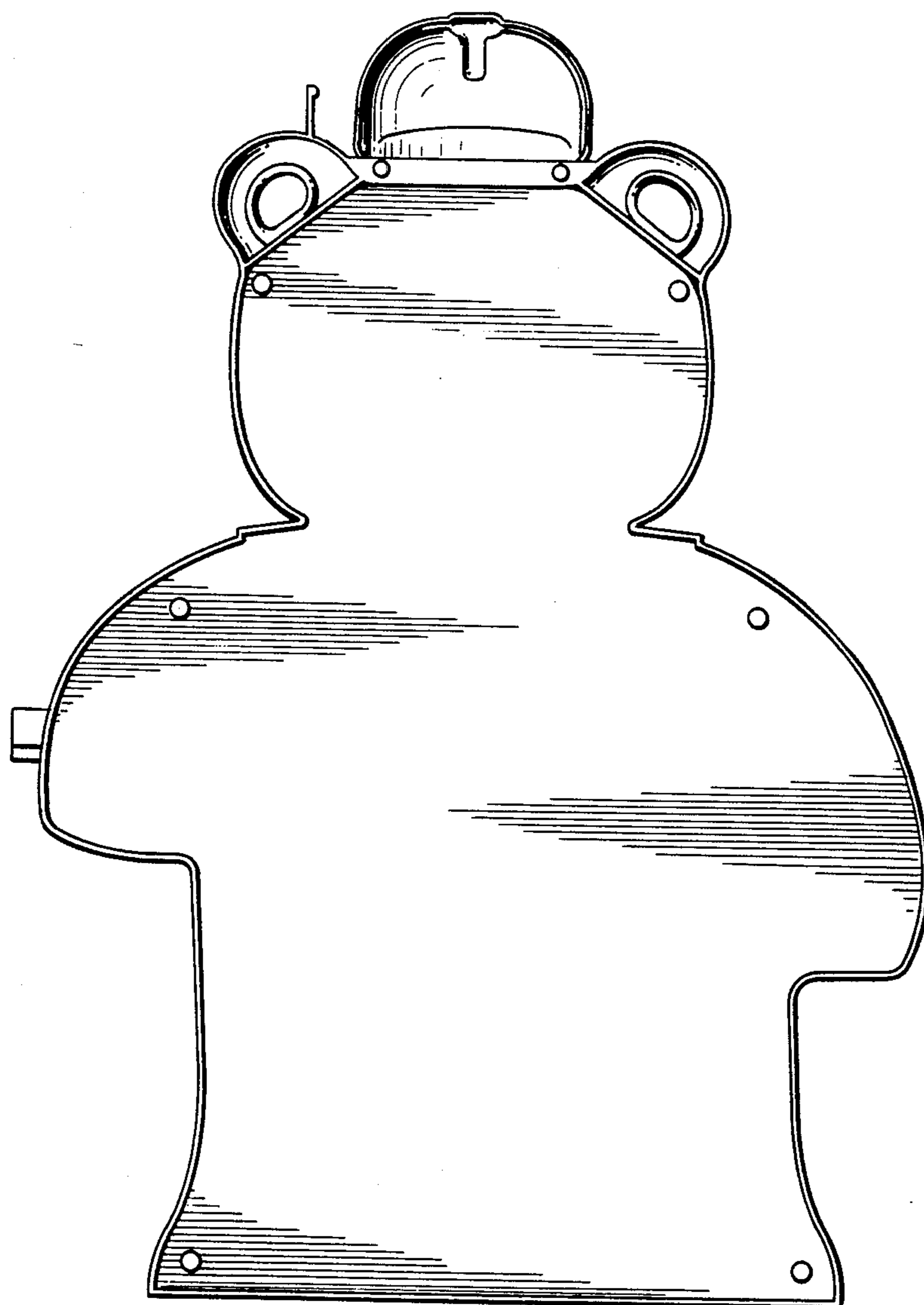
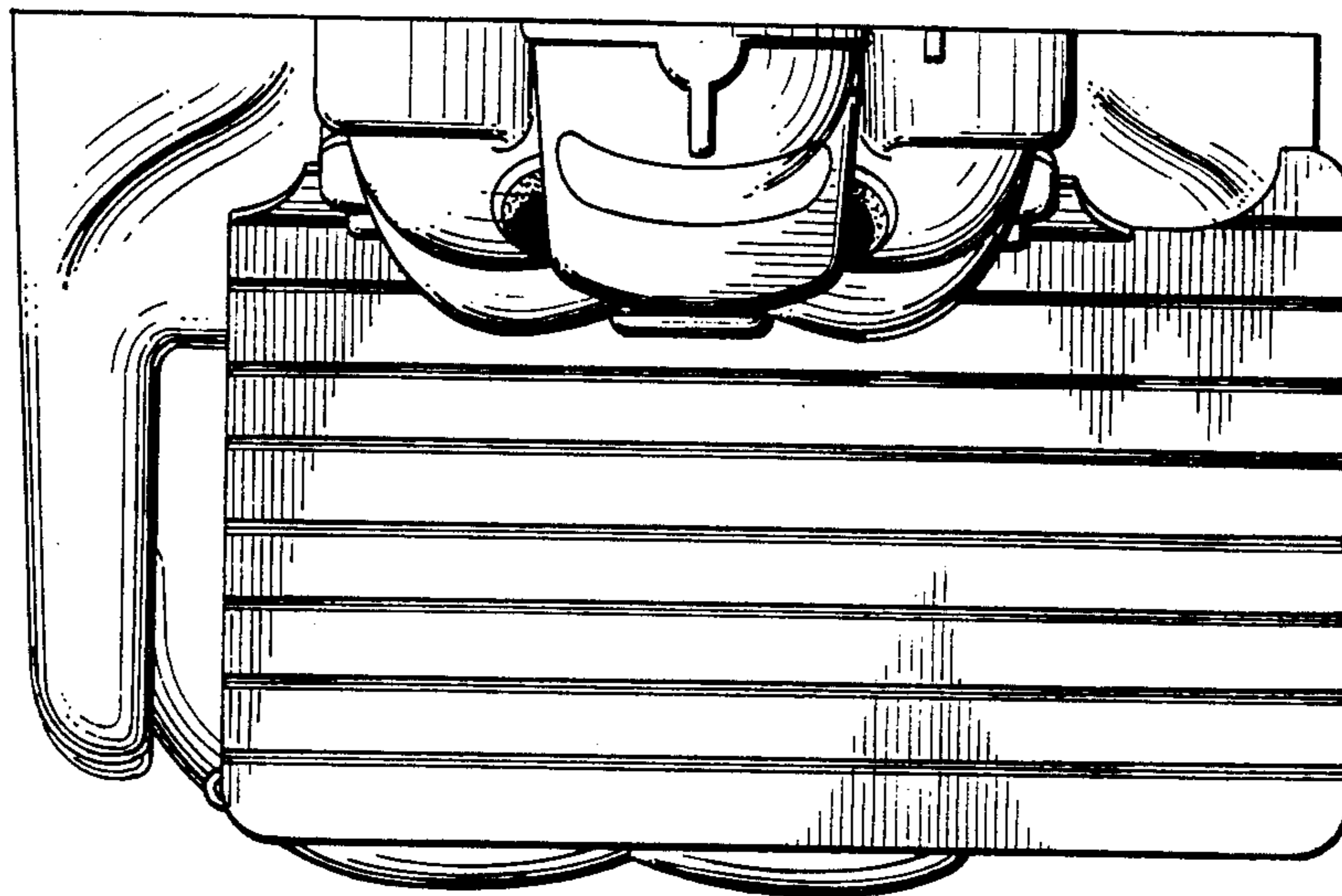
