[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for shirt or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a front elevational view of a shirt or similar article showing my new design. The lines at the neck, sleeve ends and waist indicate ribs, which continue on the rear of the shirt. The rear of the shirt is otherwise plain and unornamented.
