[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for shirt or similar article,  
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a front elevational view of a shirt or  
similar article showing my new design. The lines at the  
neck, sleeve ends and waist indicate ribs, which con-  
tinue on the rear of the shirt. The rear of the shirt is  
otherwise plain and unornamented.
