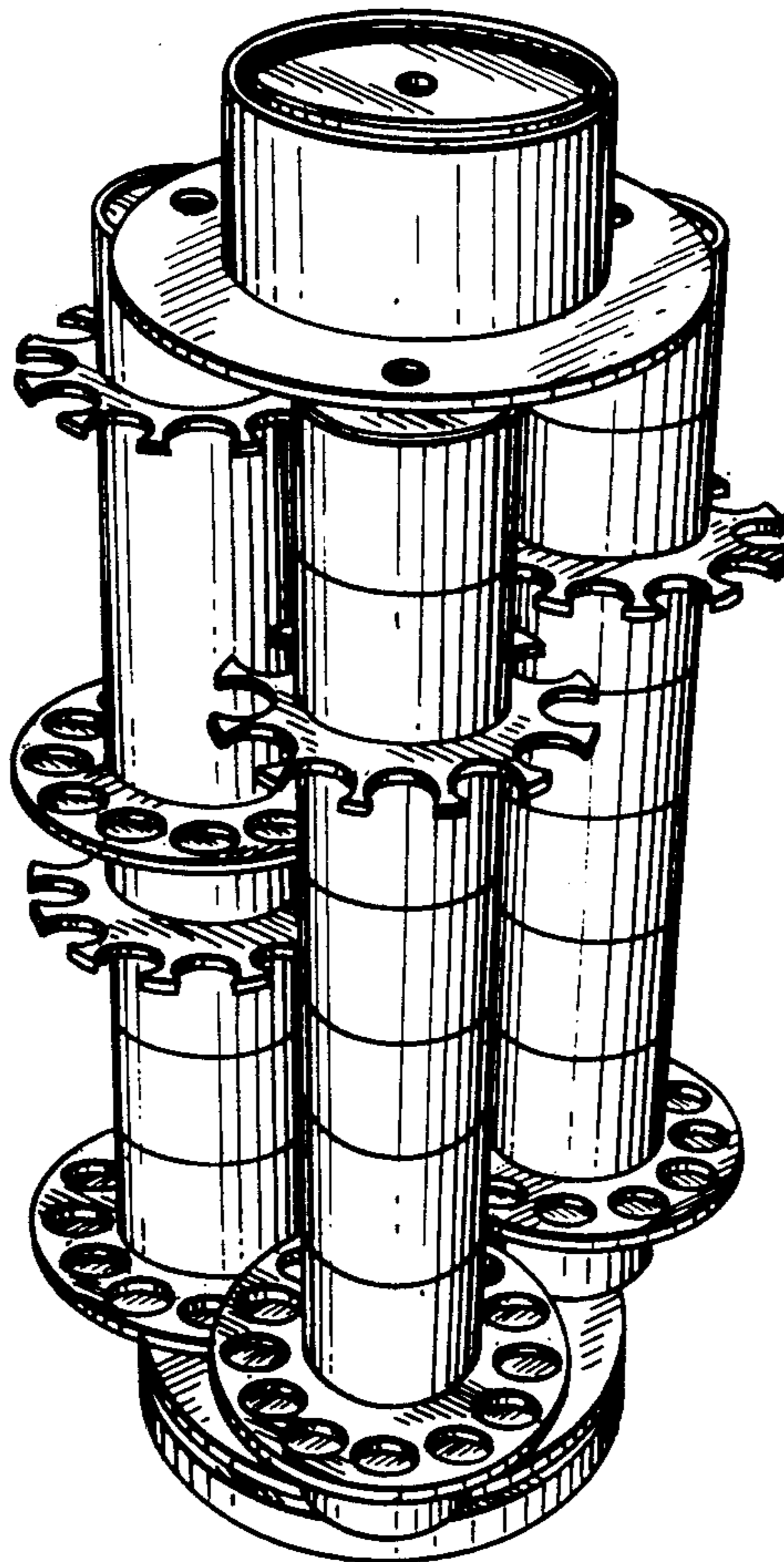

The ornamental design for a jewelry display support, or similar article, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced front perspective view of a jewelry display support, or similar article, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view taken from slightly to the left of the center of the front;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view taken from slightly to the left of the center of the rear;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



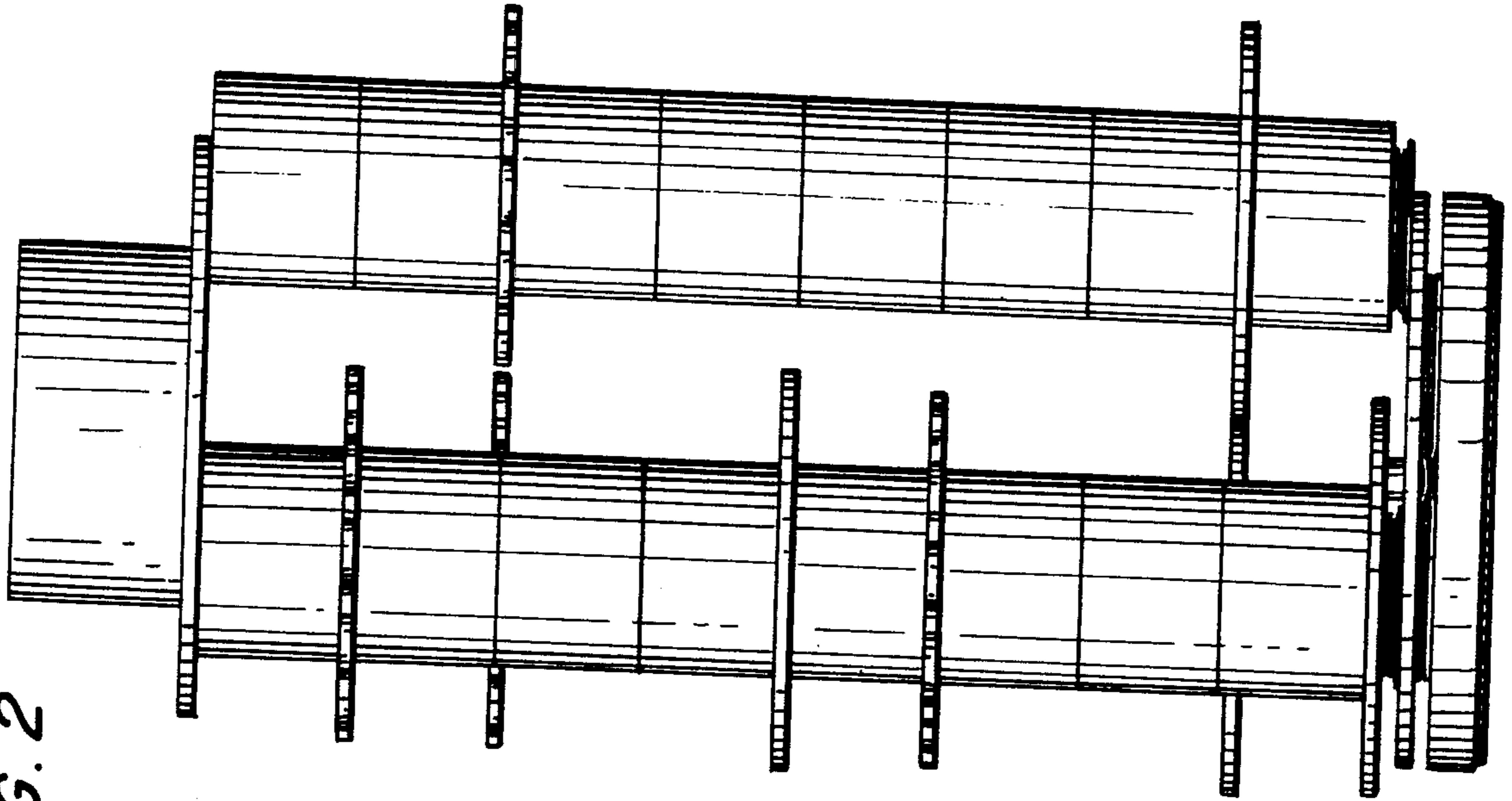

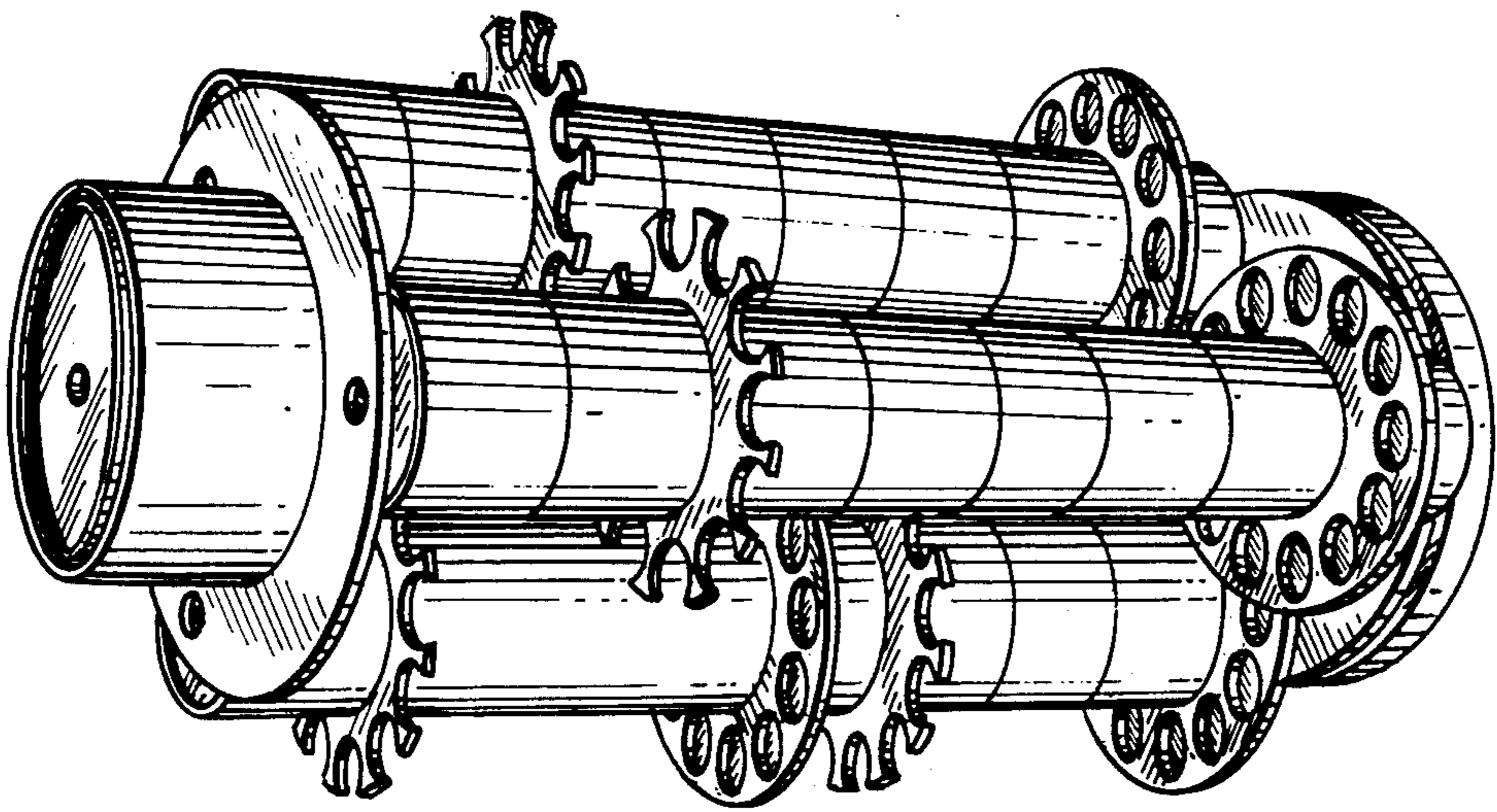

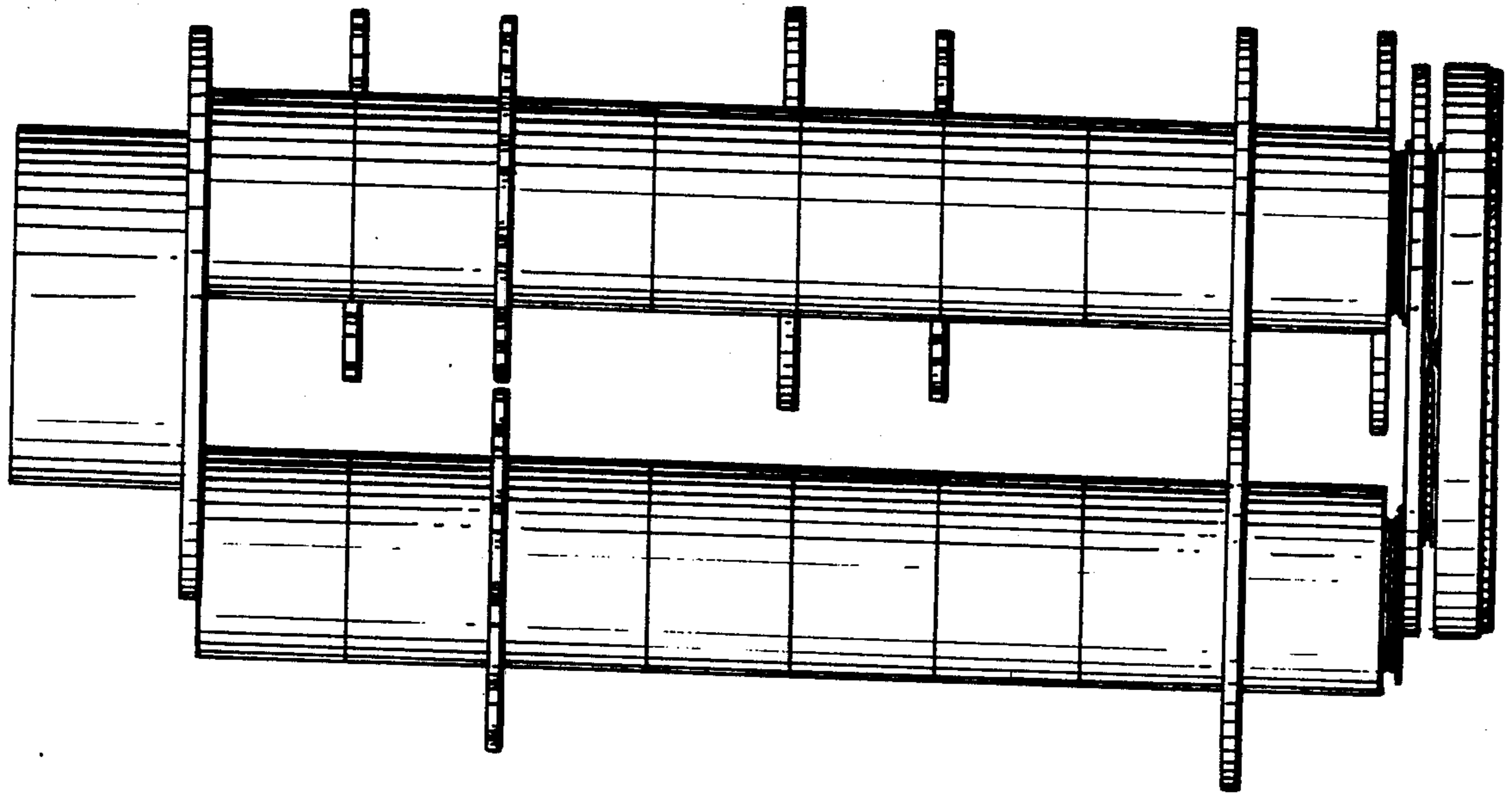

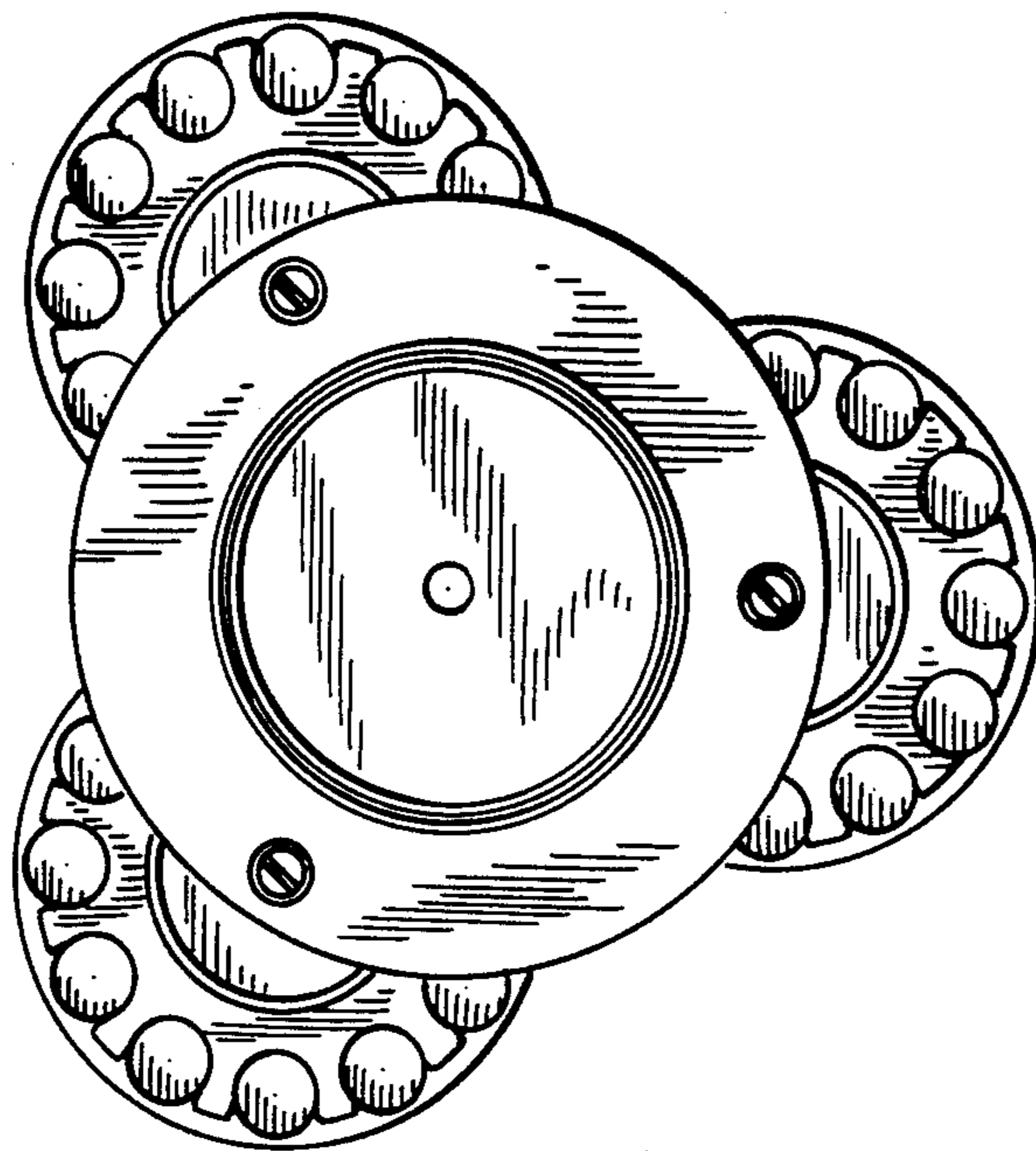

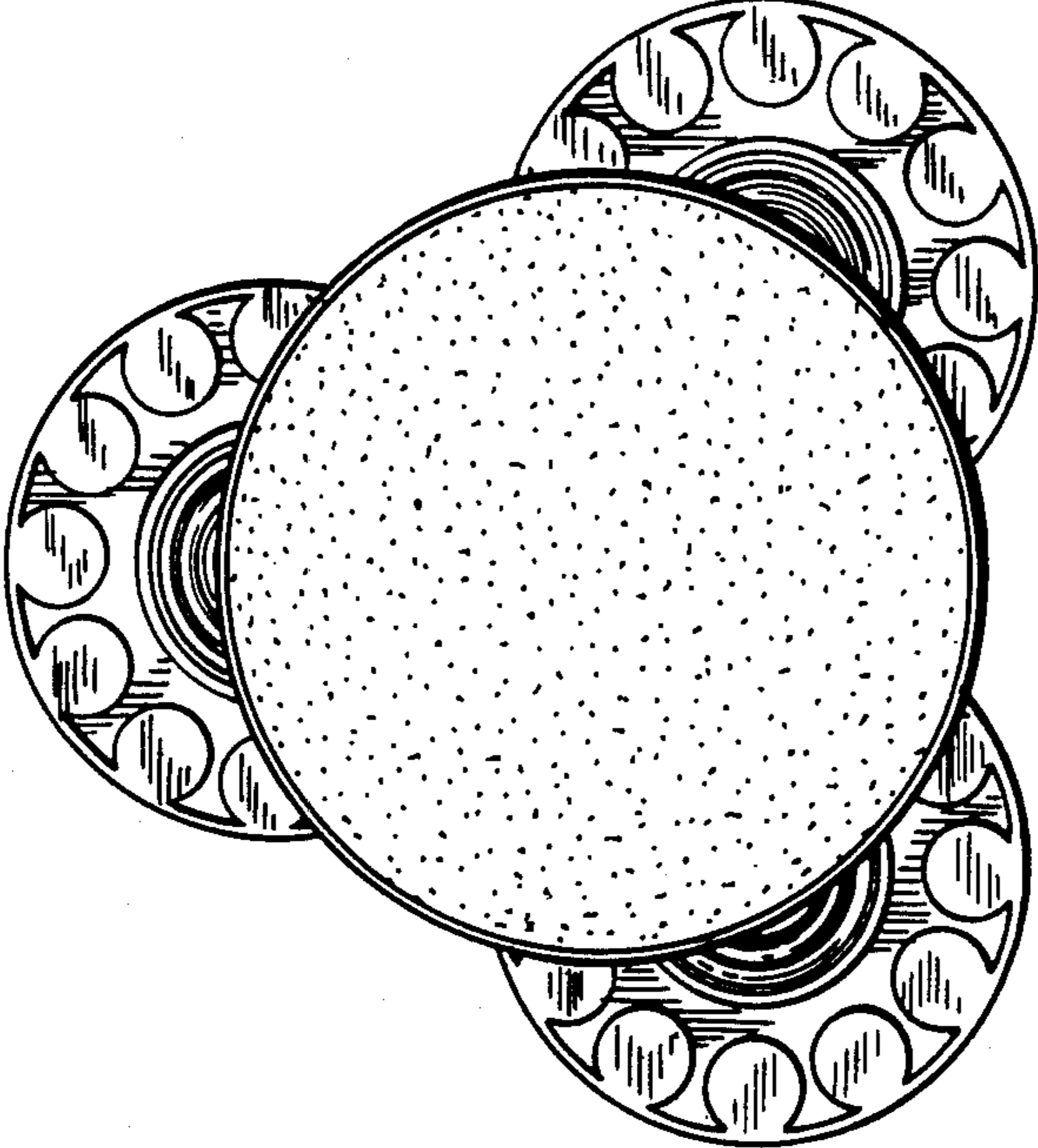

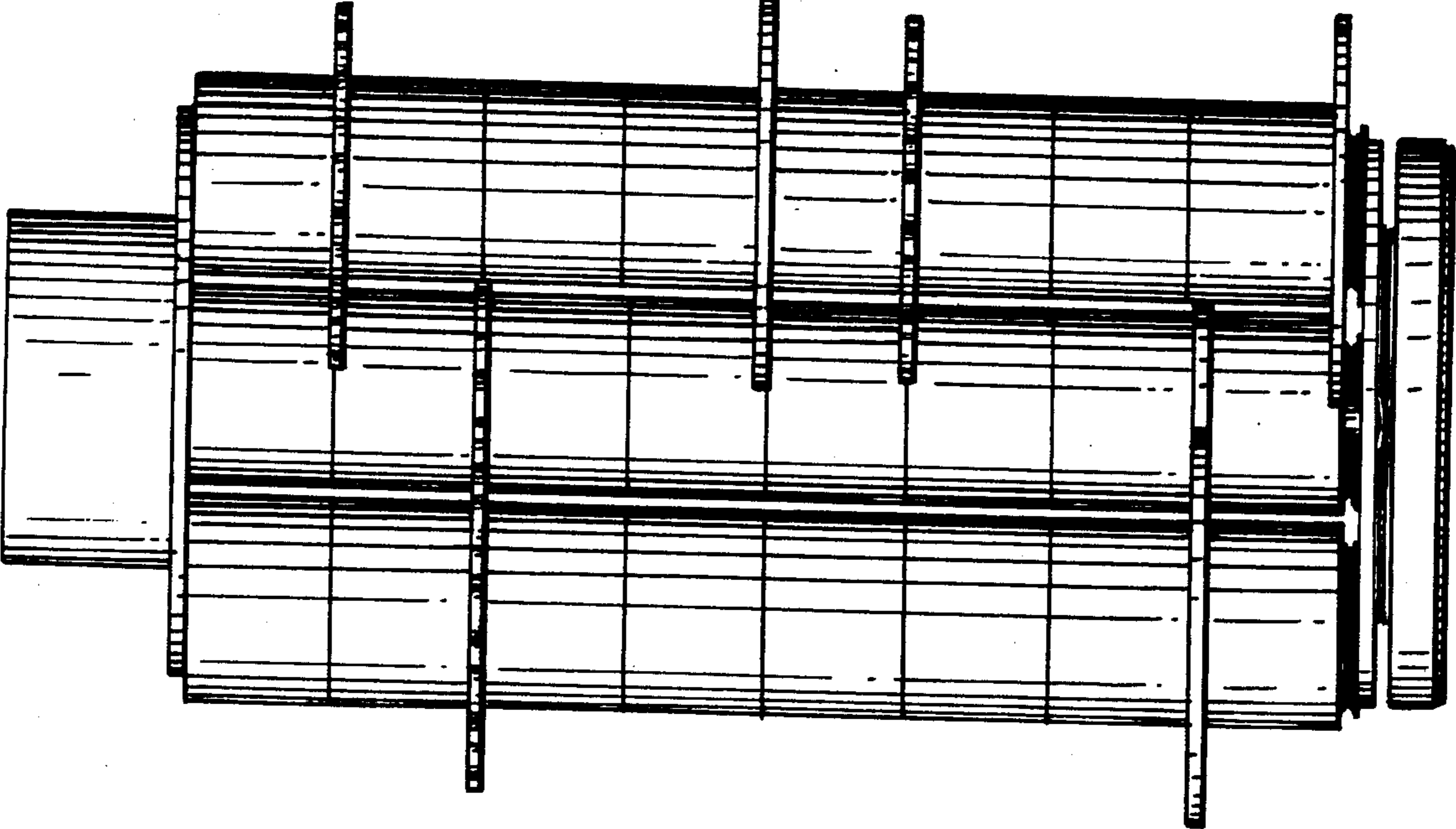
