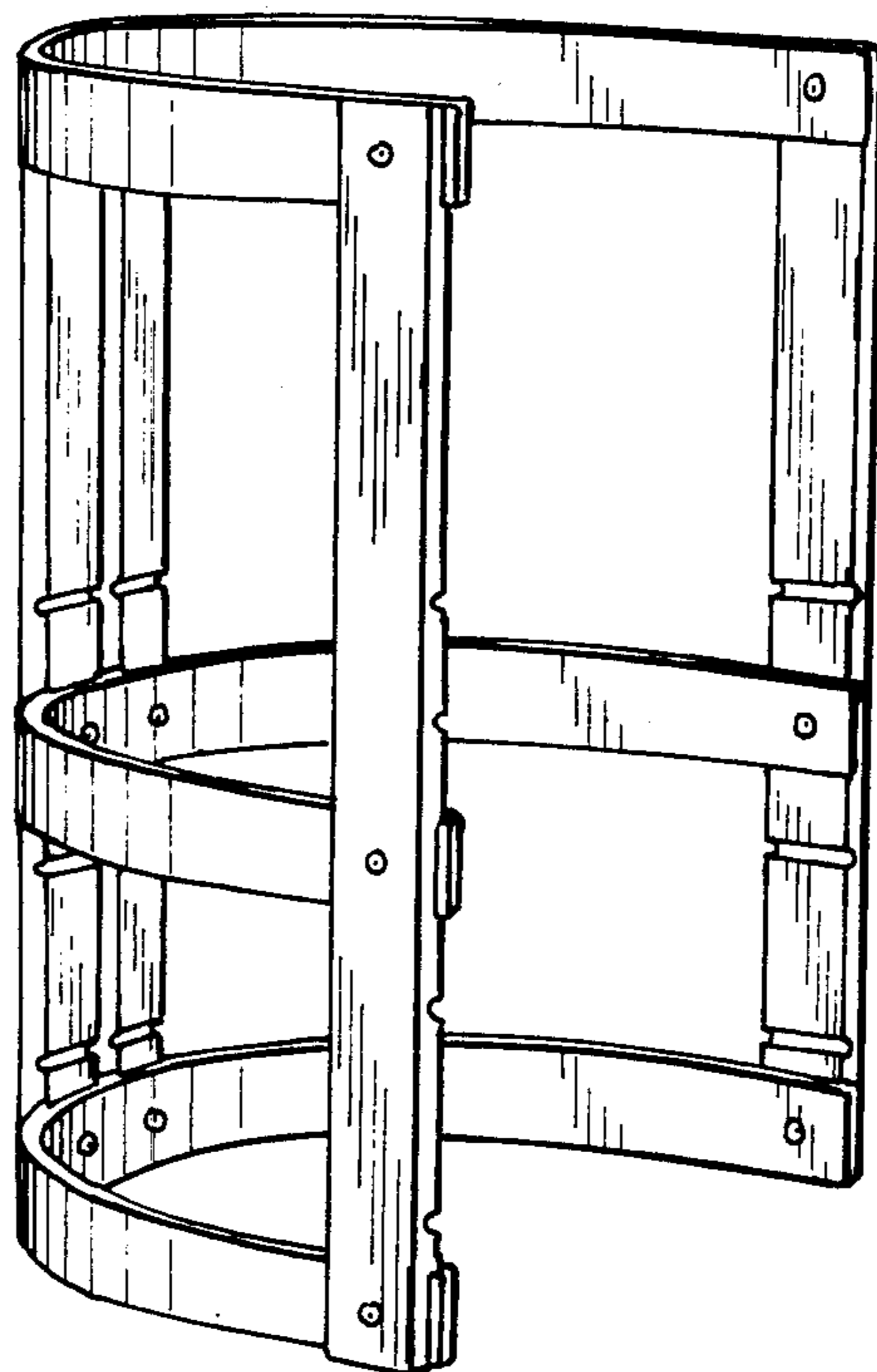
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a perspective view from the front of a frame for a chair.



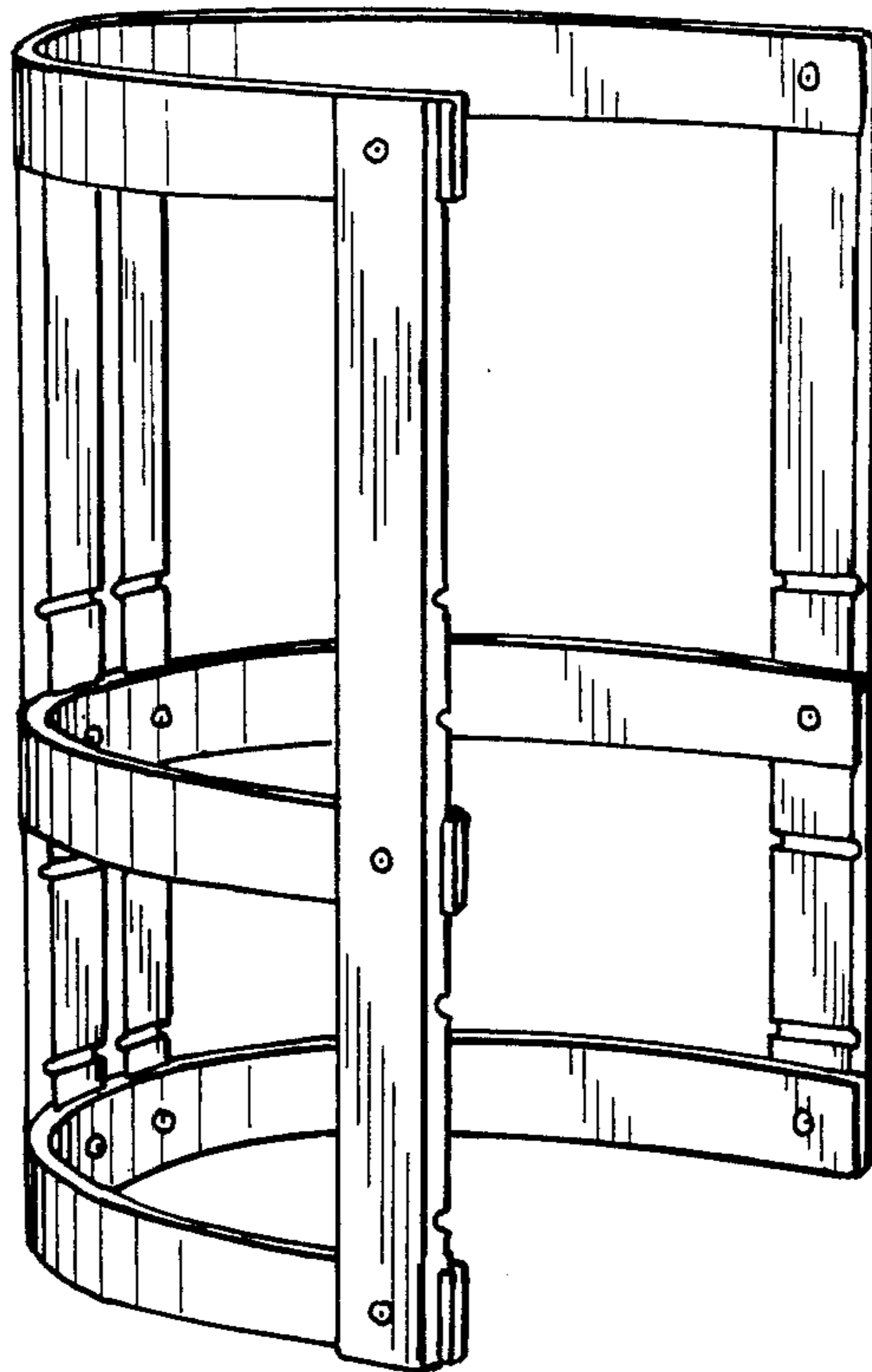

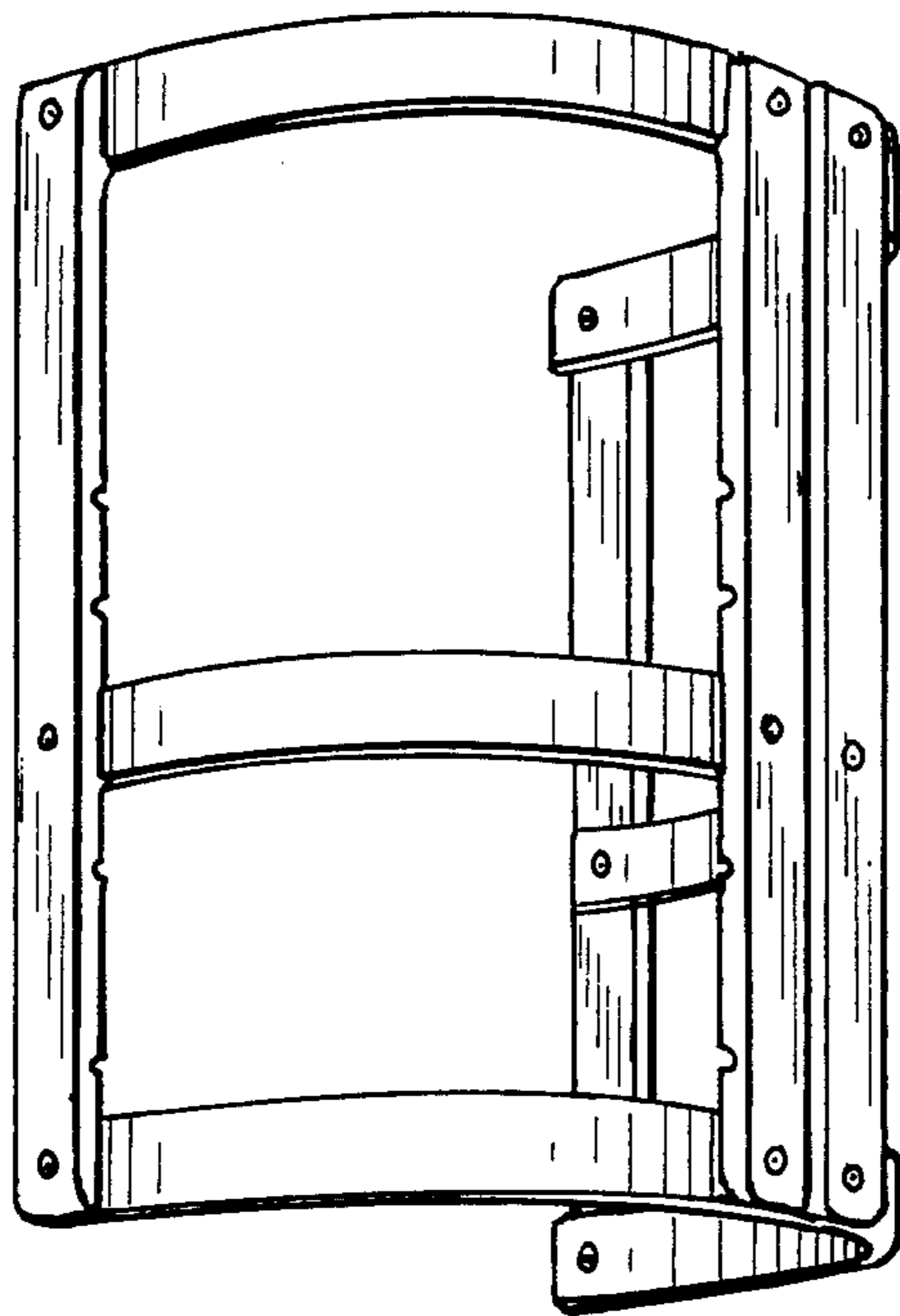
