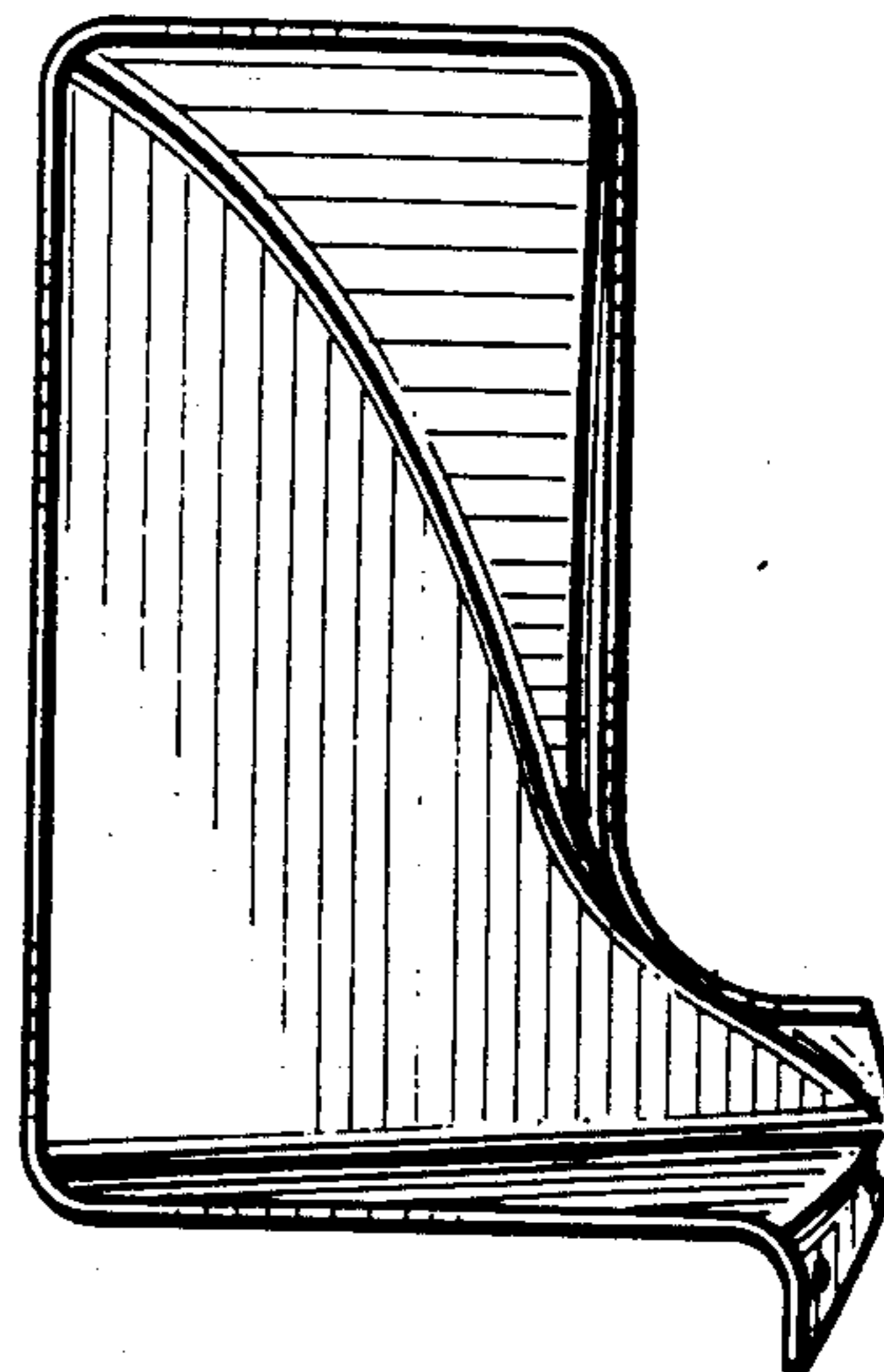
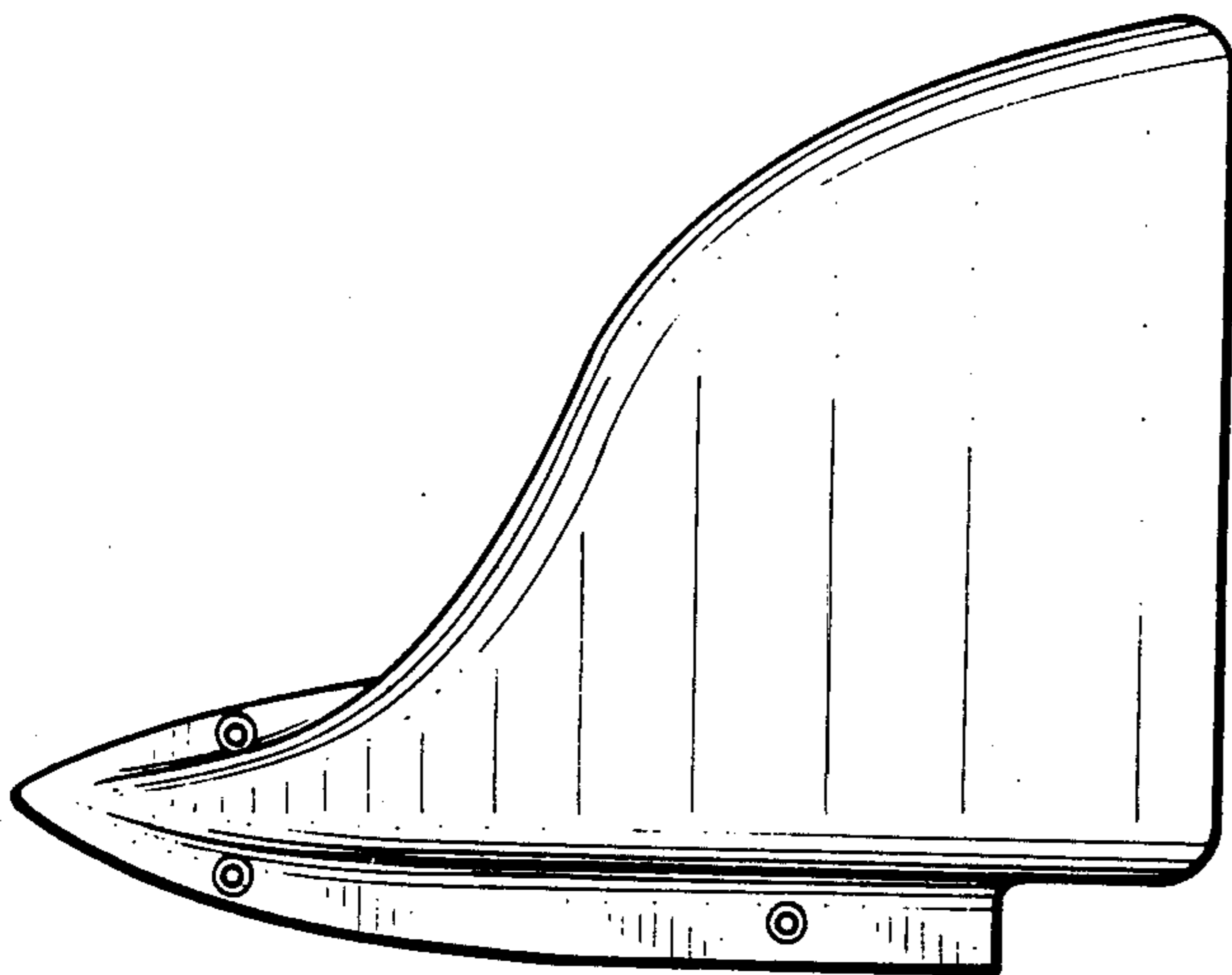

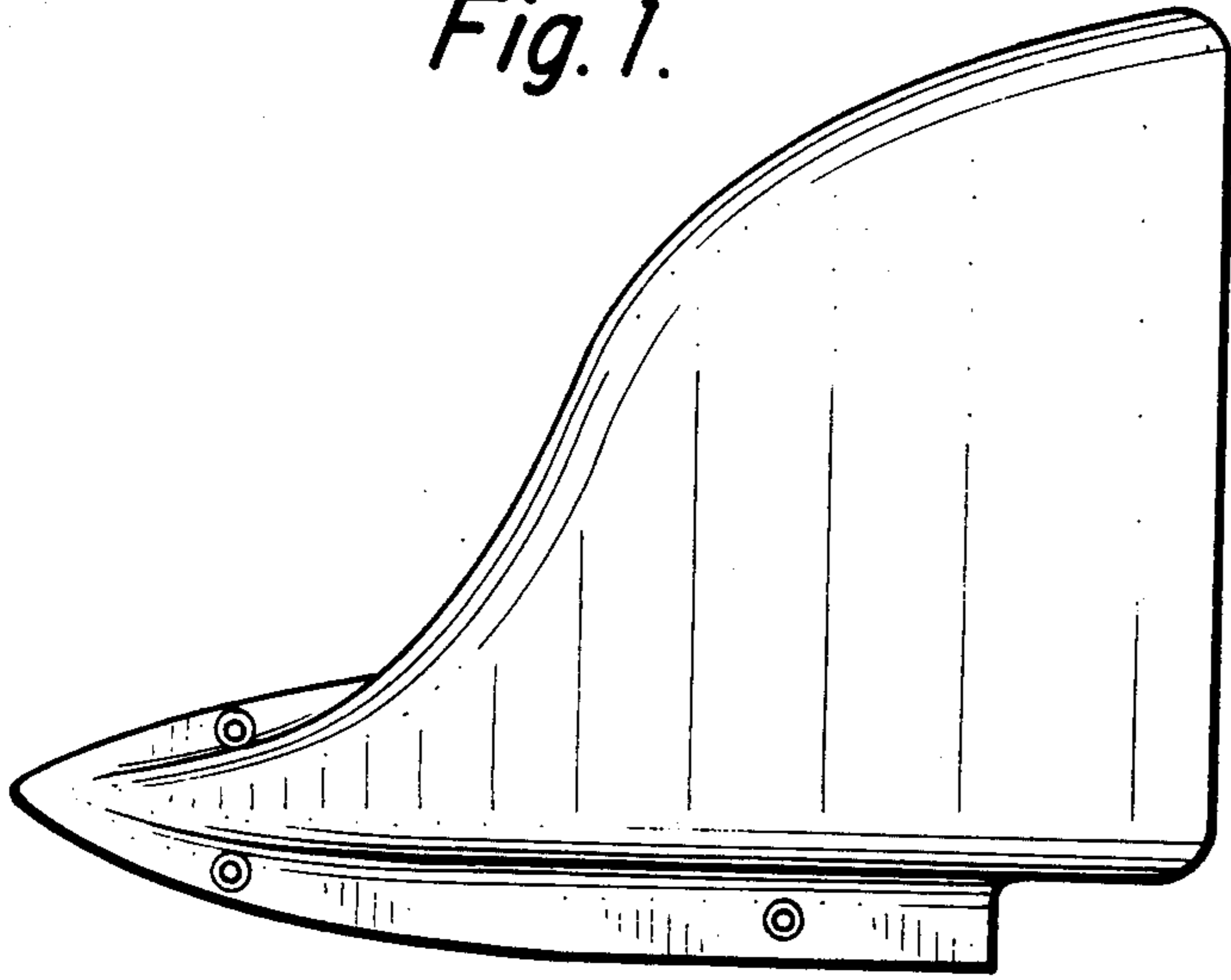
The ornamental design for a cover for a vehicle mirror housing, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

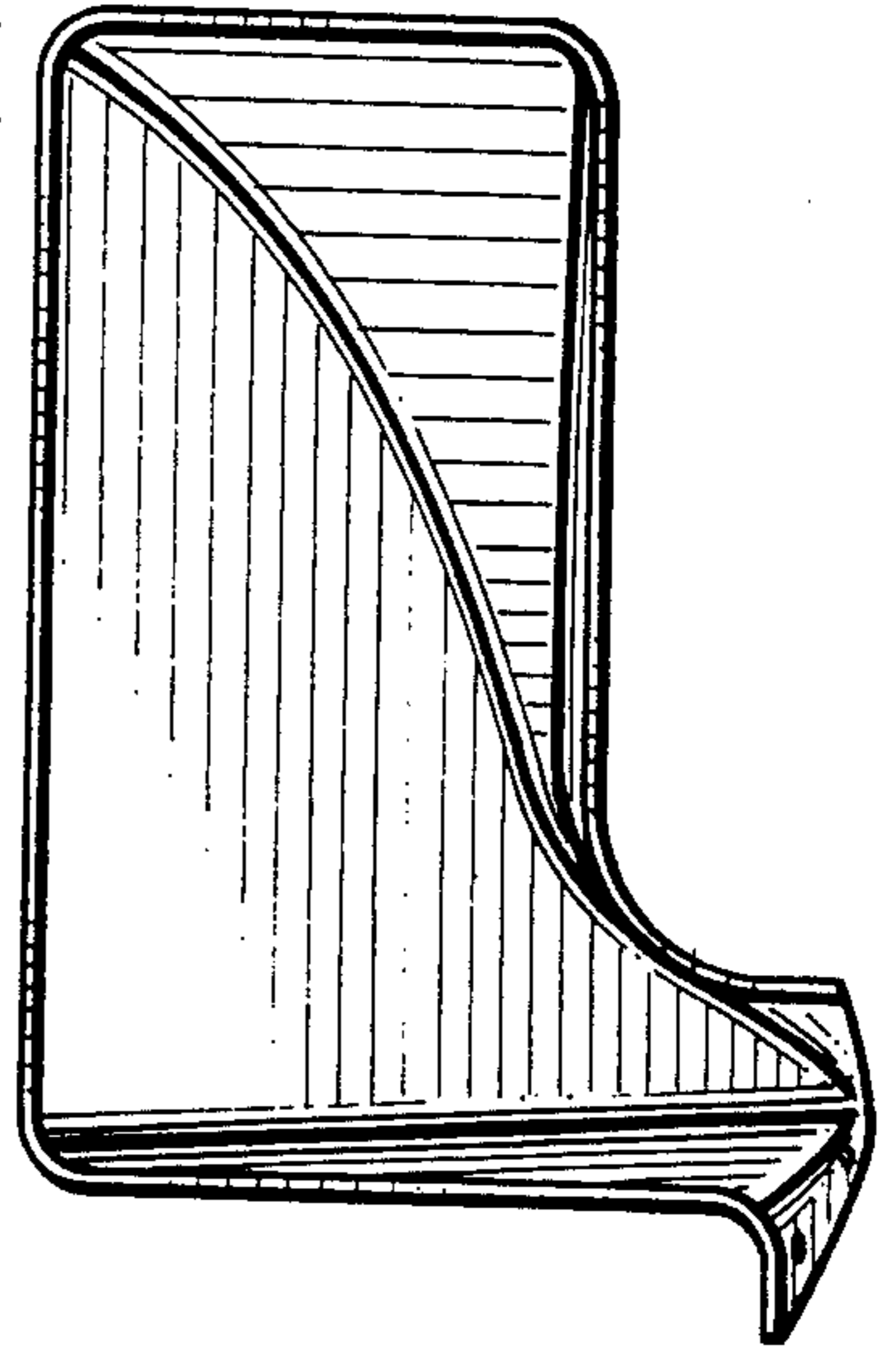

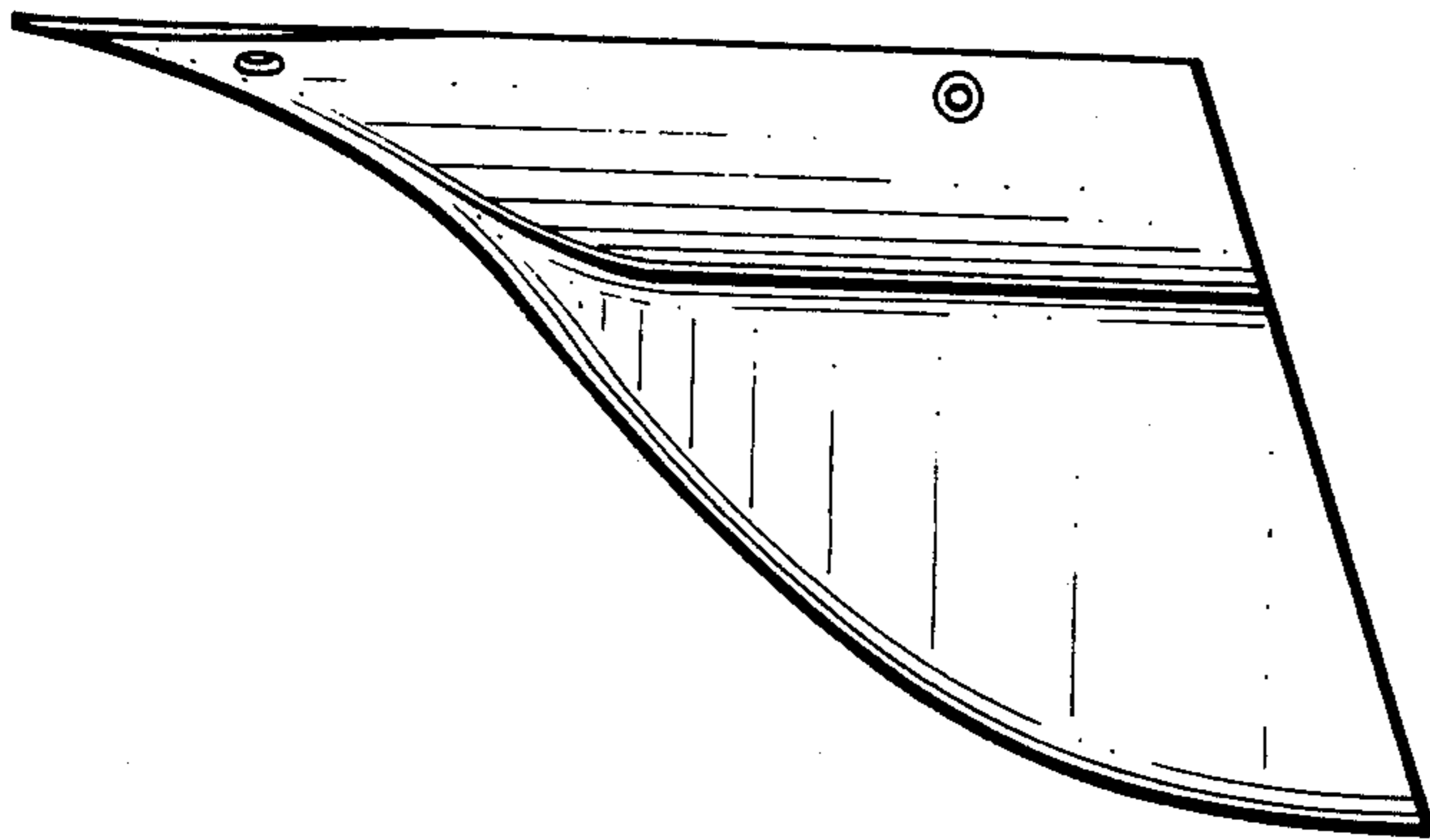

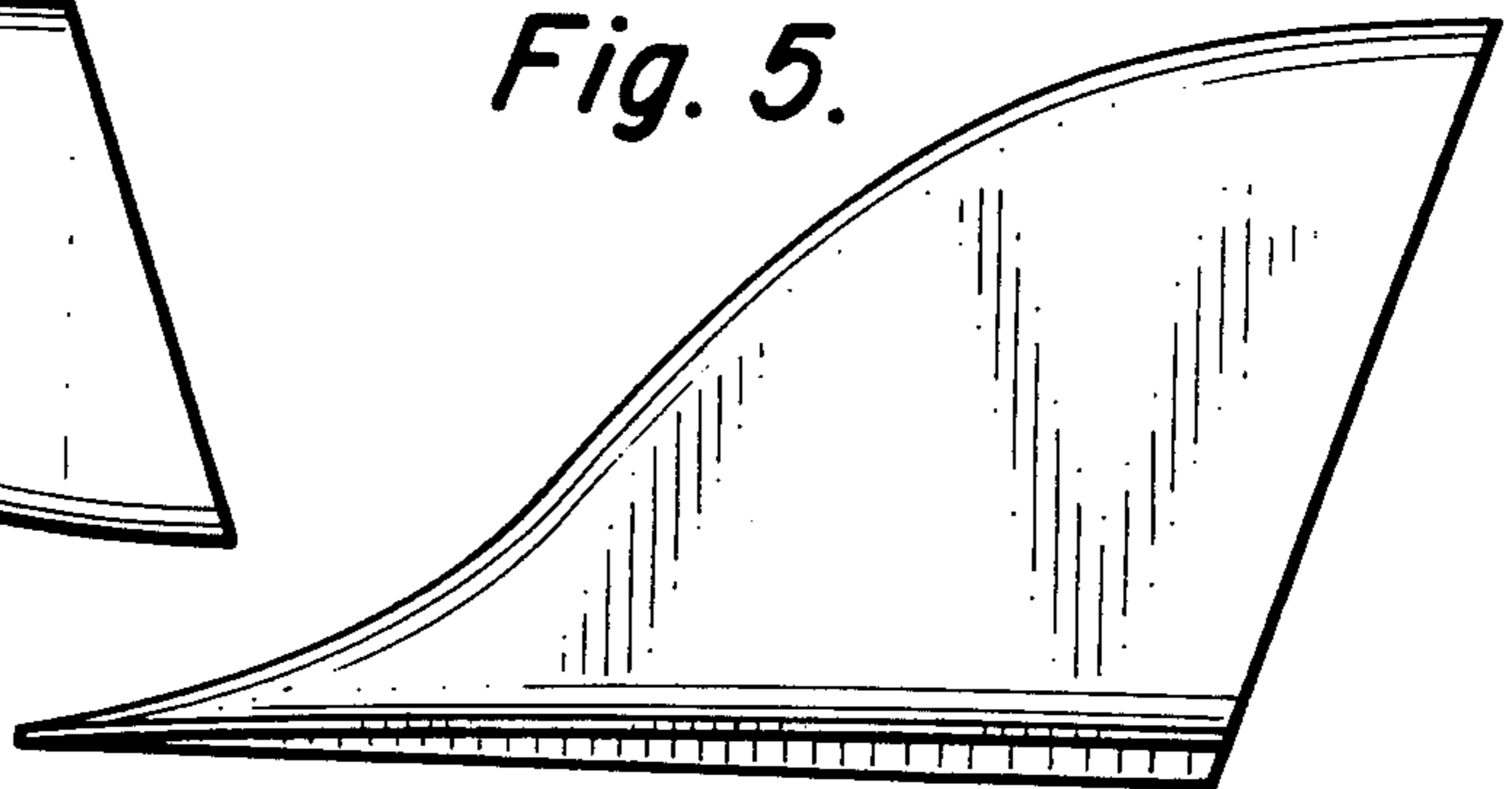

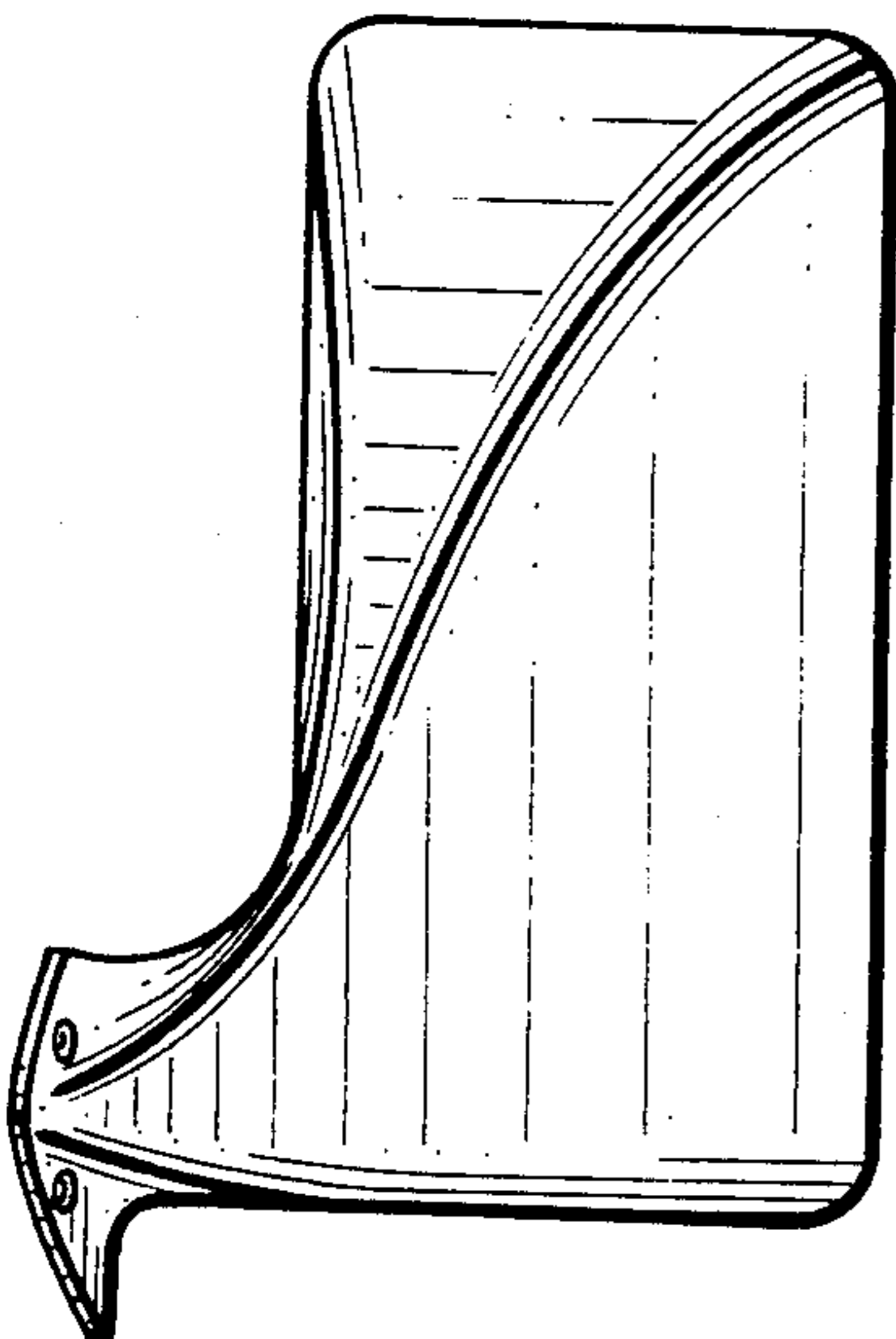
