FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view, as viewed from above.

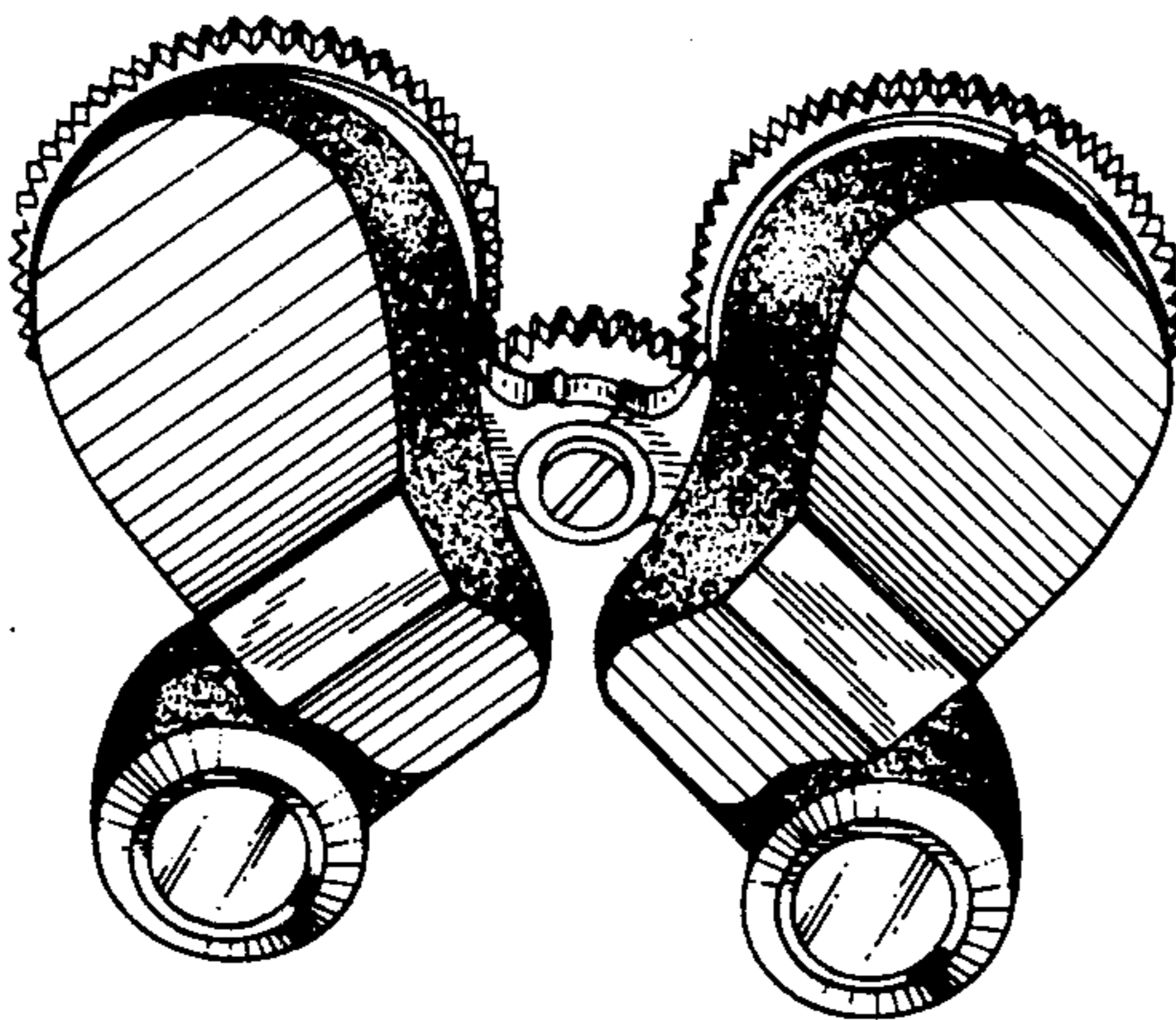
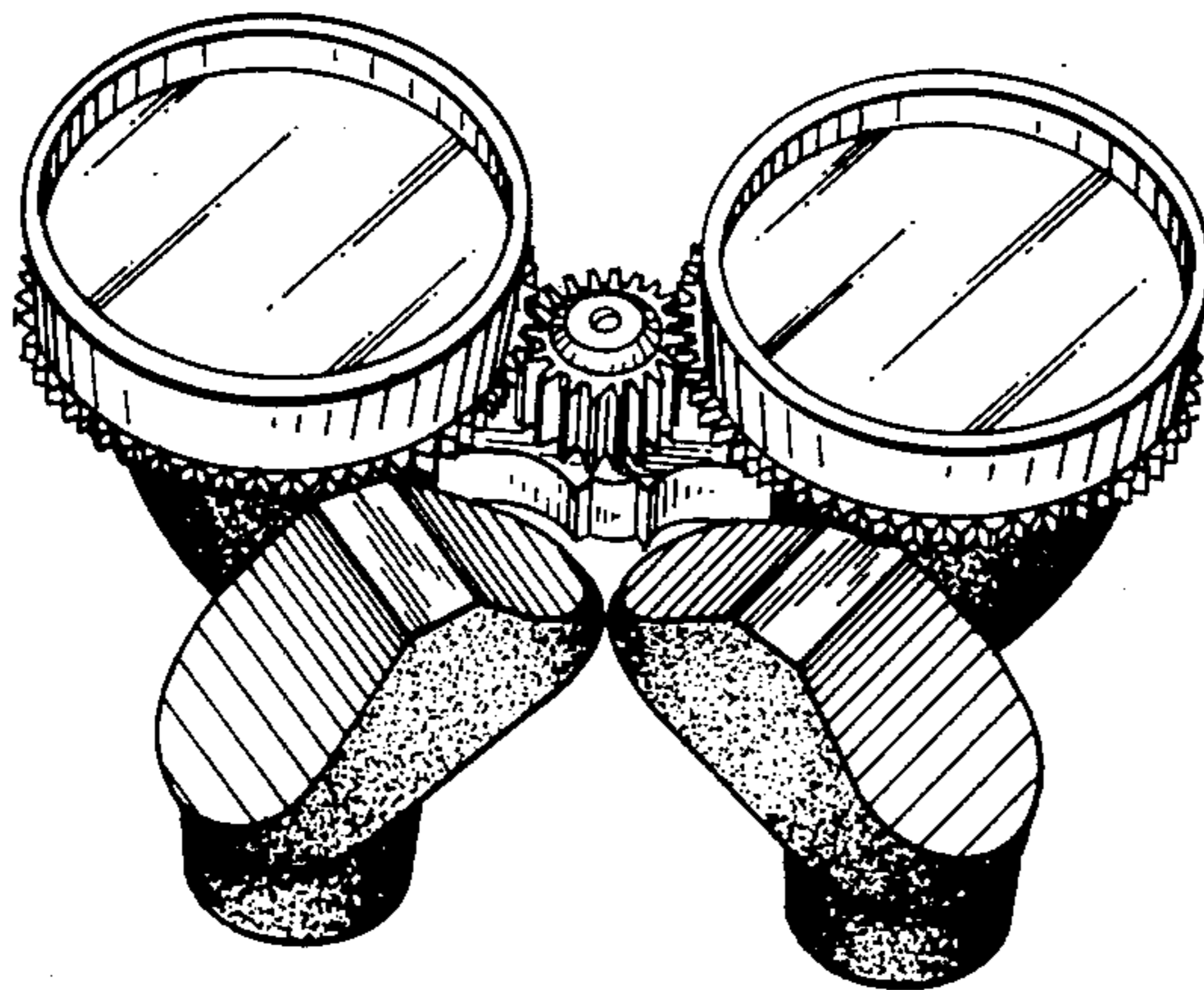

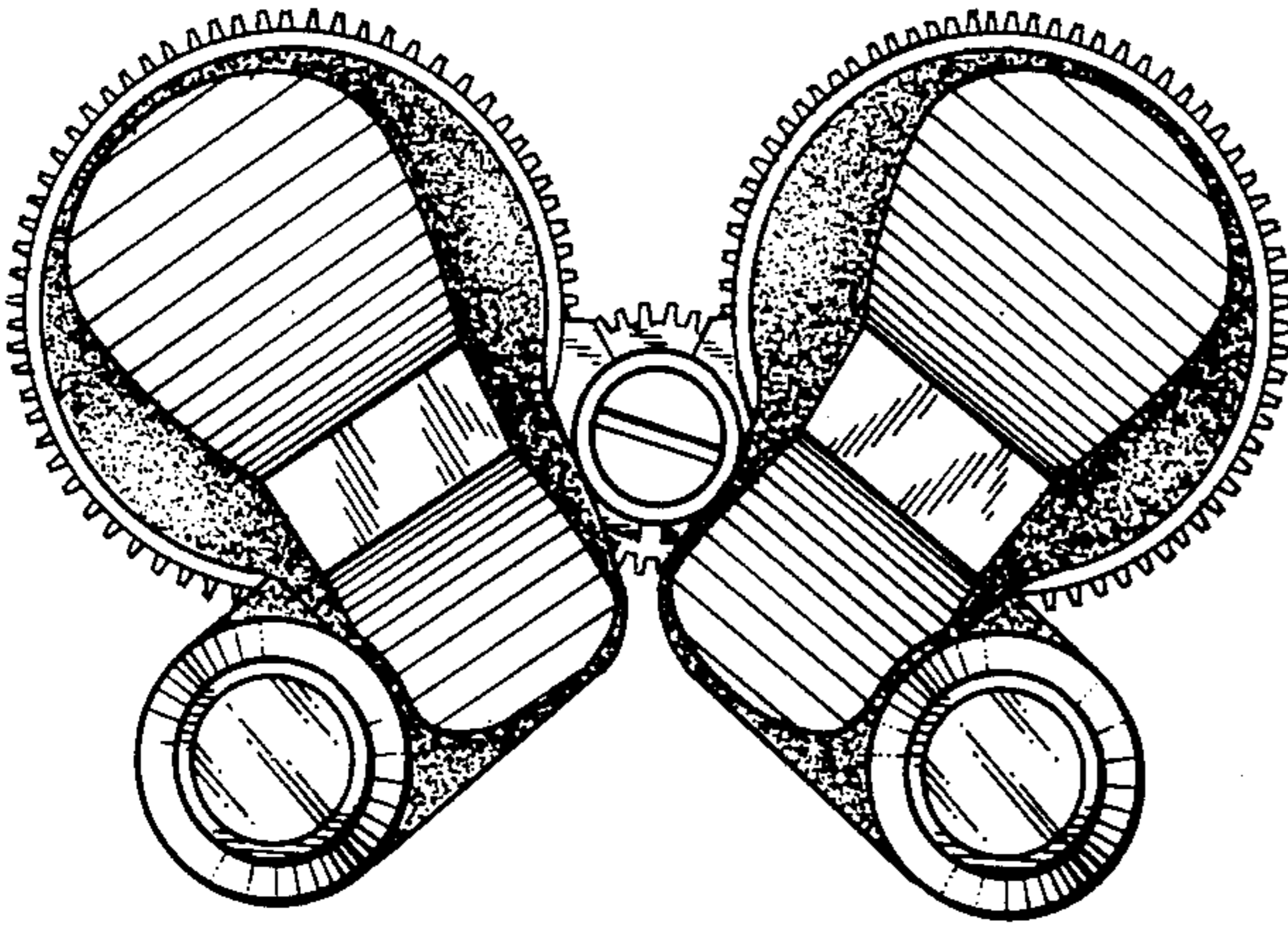

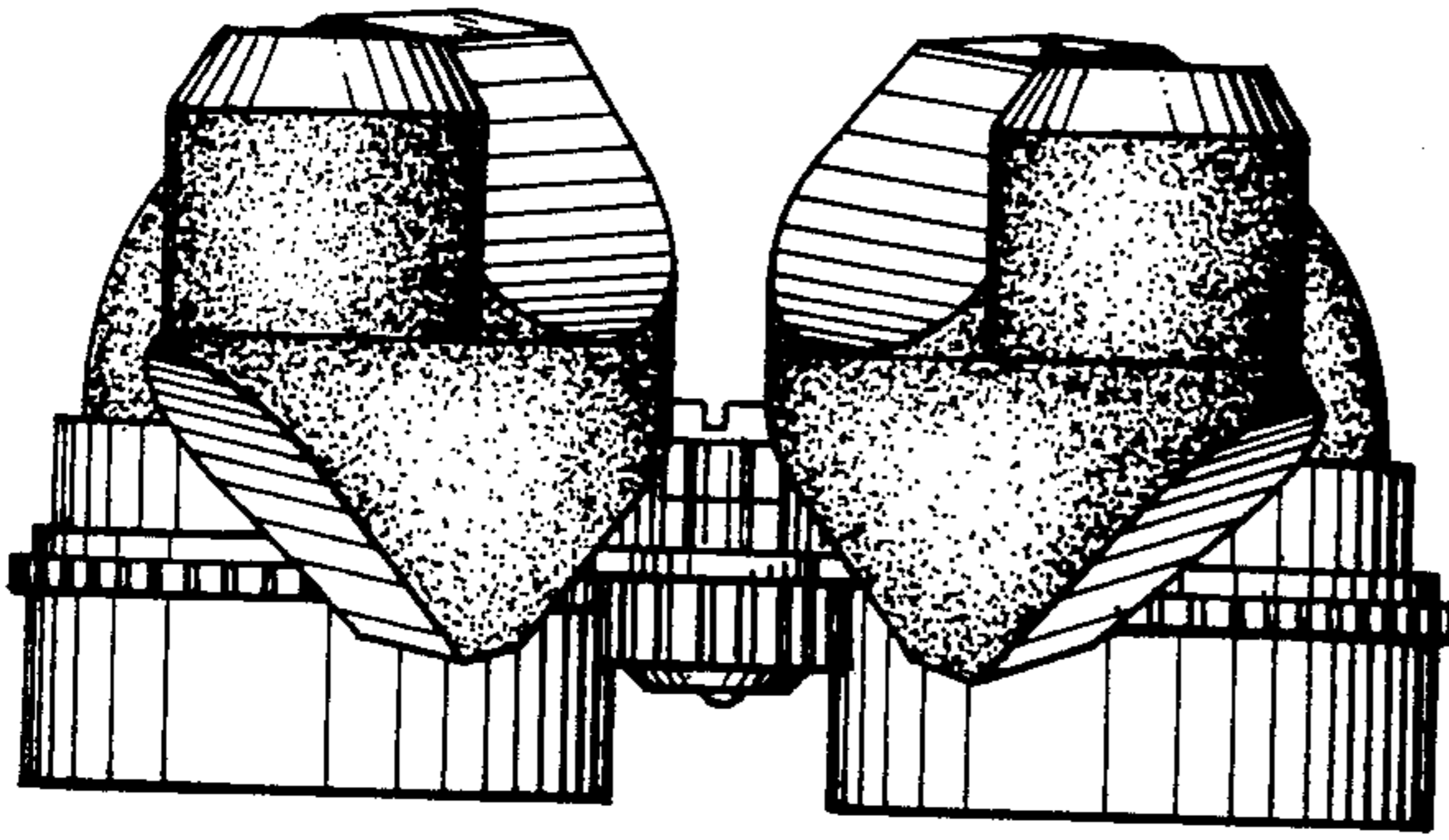

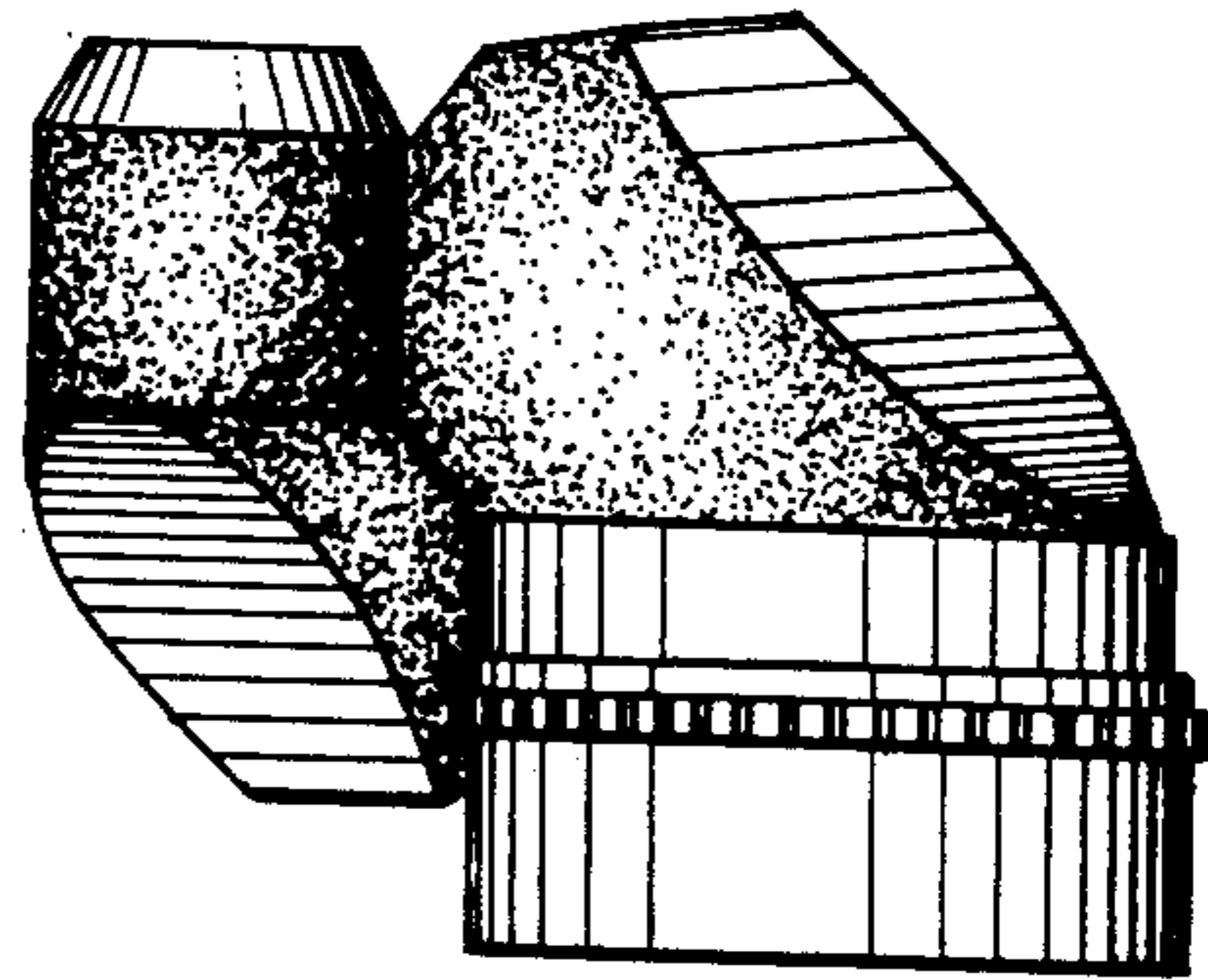

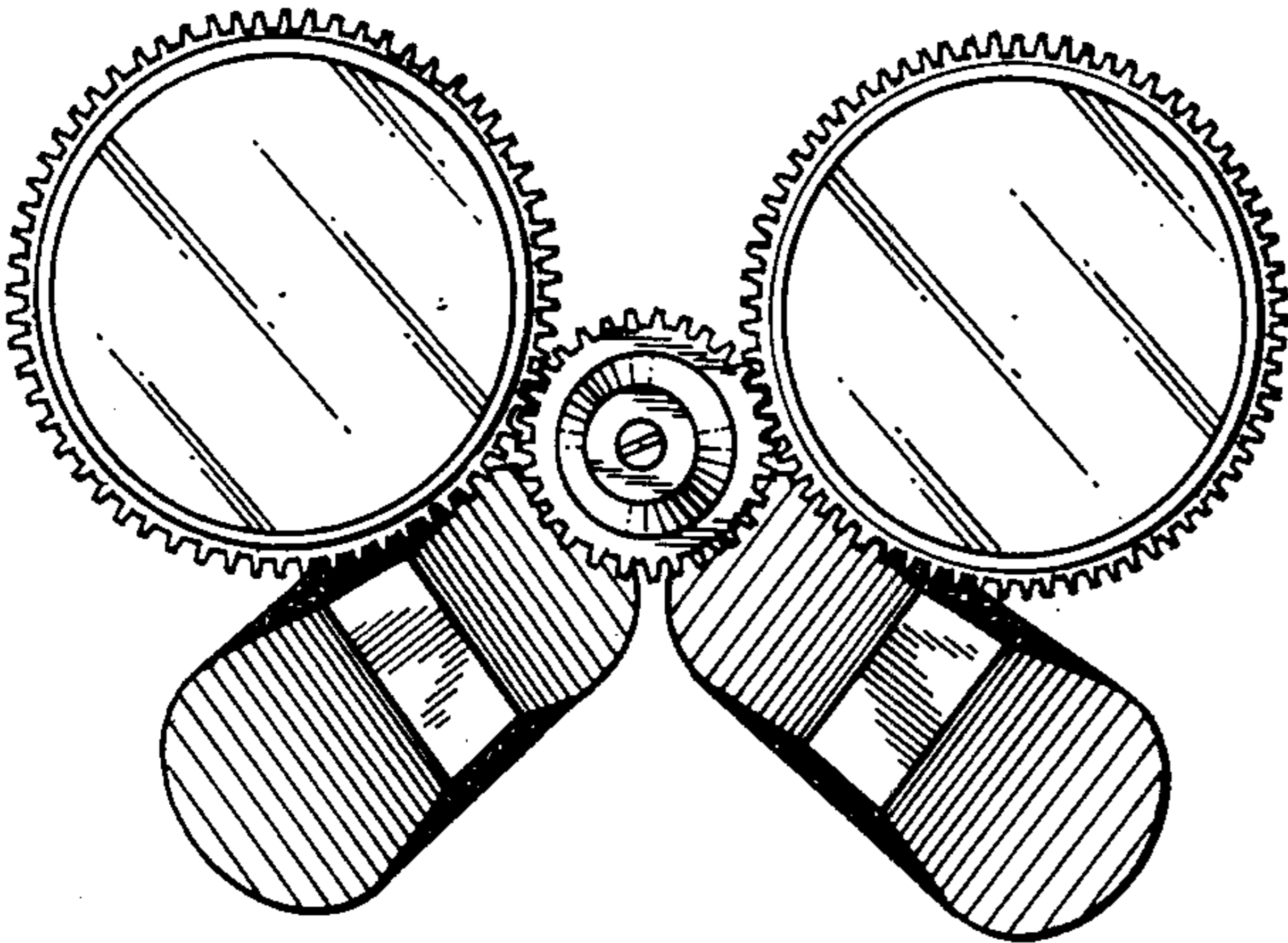

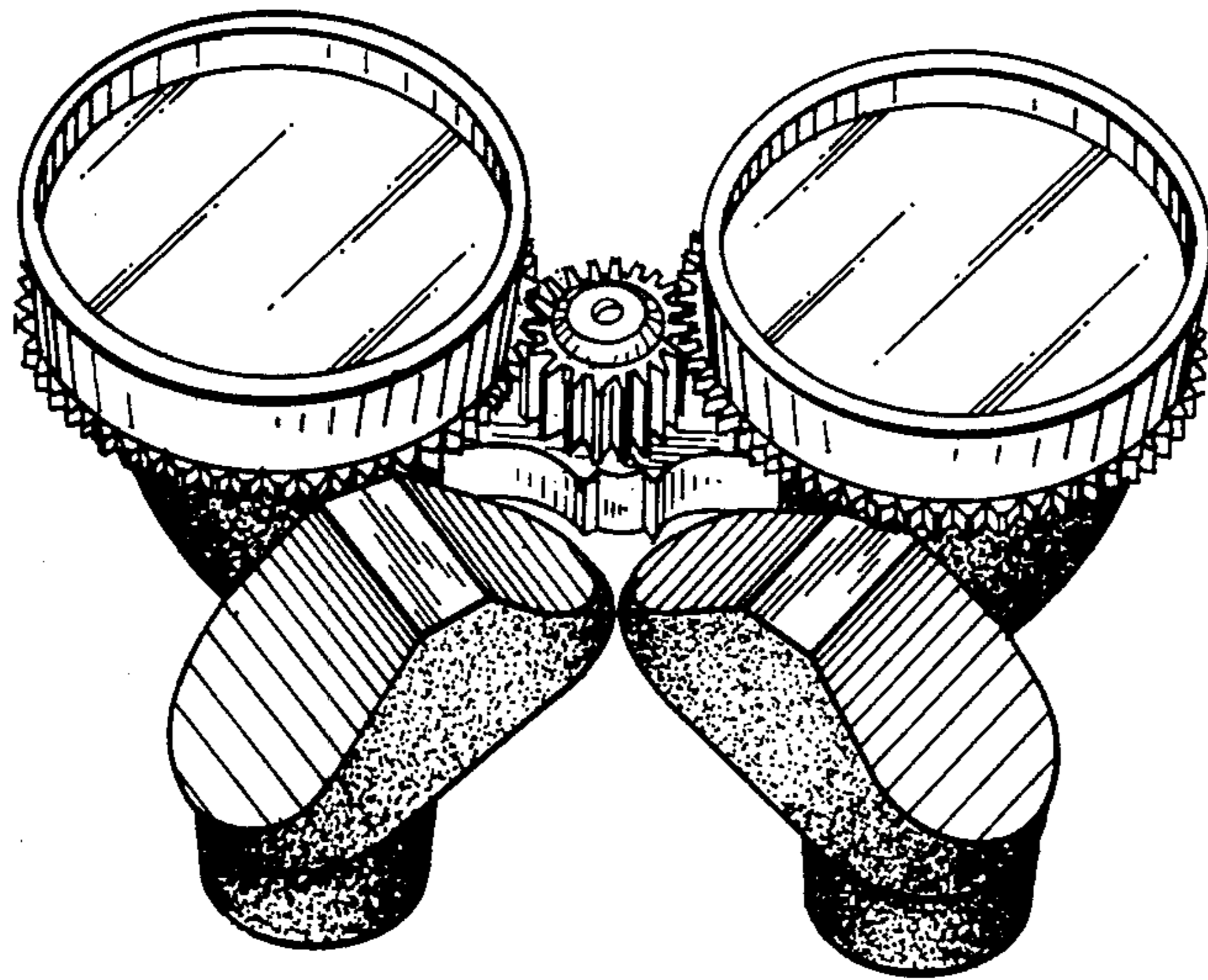
