DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy CB radio showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof with the microphone and cord members removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof with the microphone and cord members removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof of the microphone member;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the design of FIG. 1 partially in fragment with the microphone and cord members removed.
