[57] CLAIM

FIG. 4 is a top plan view.

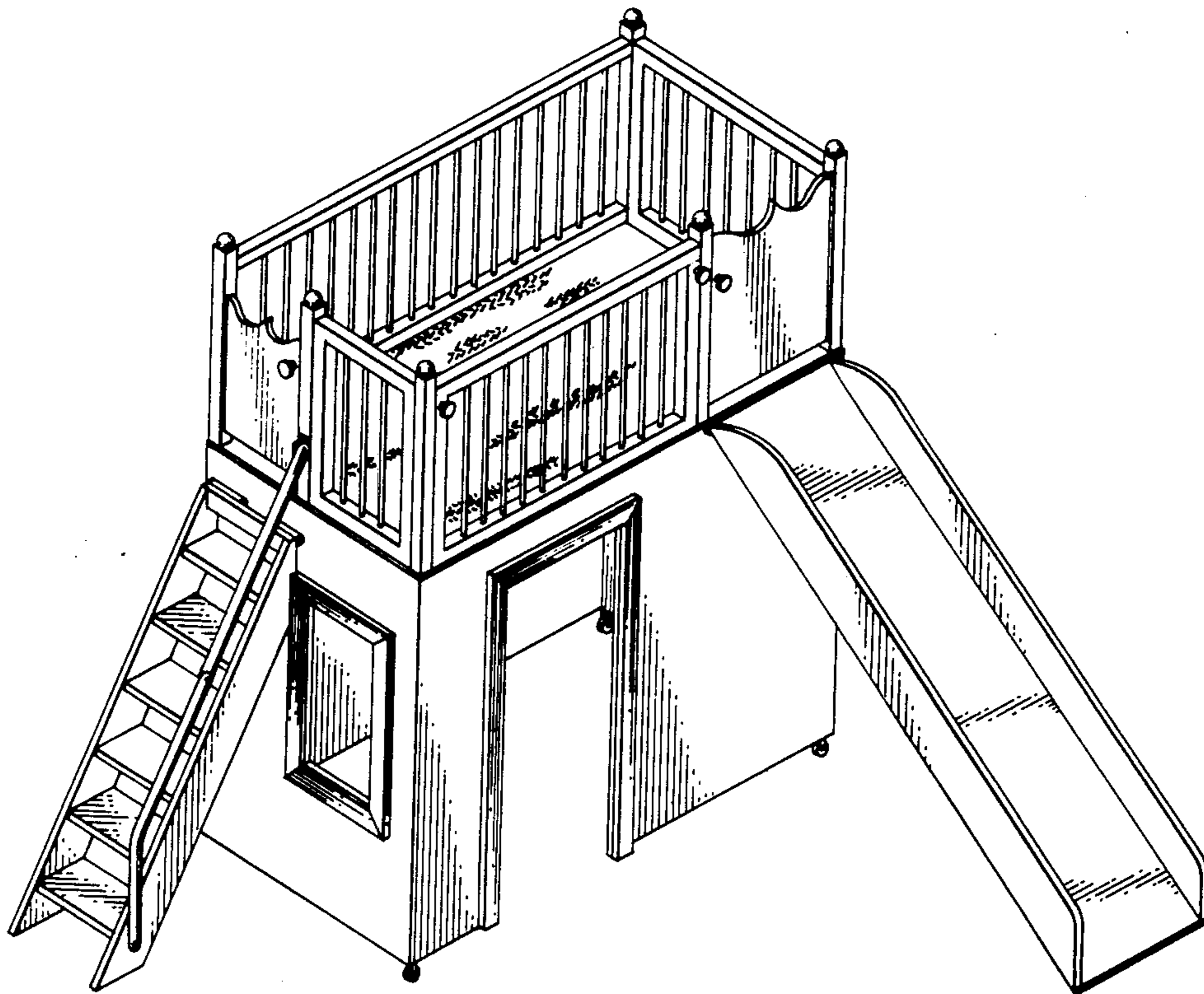

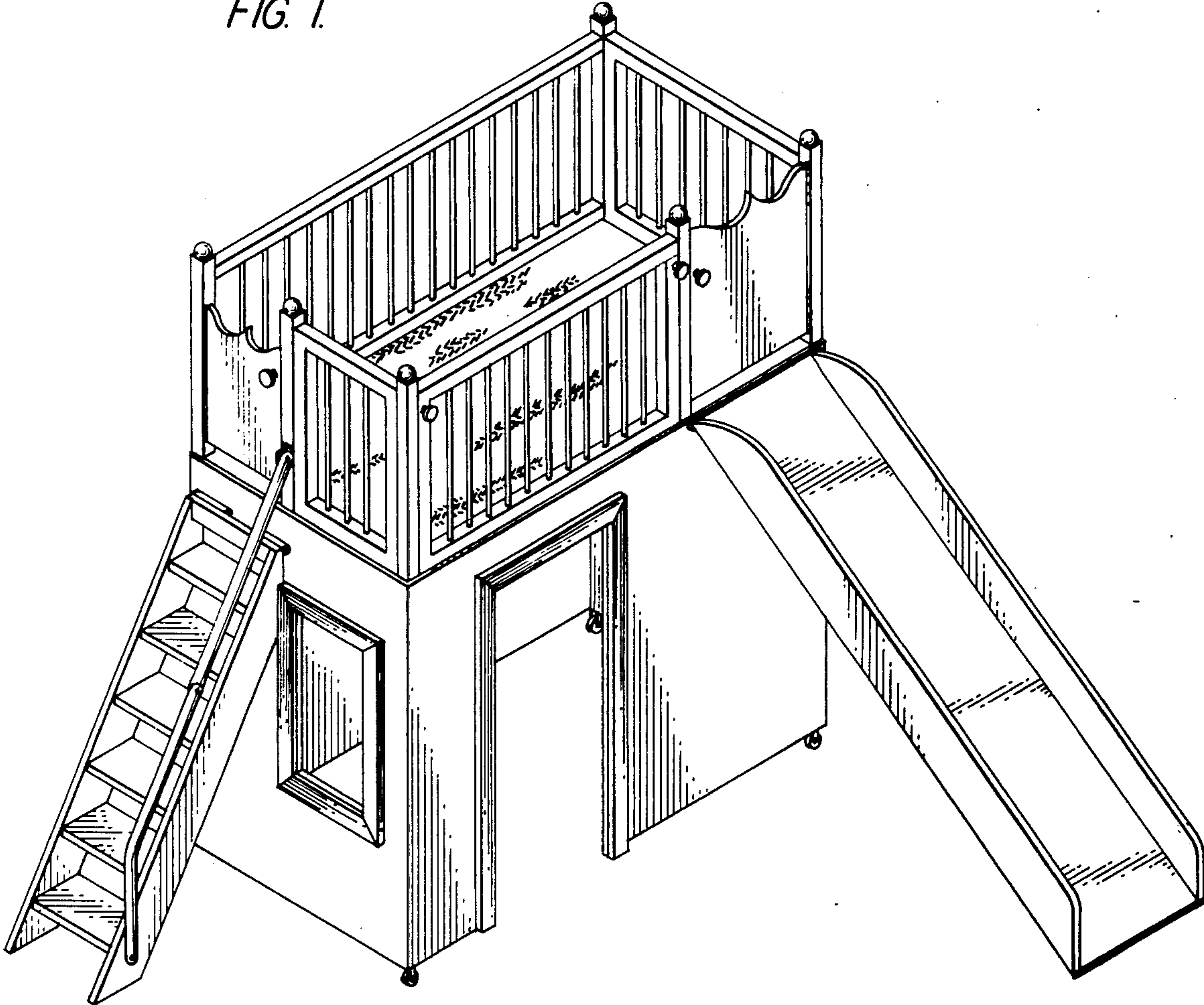

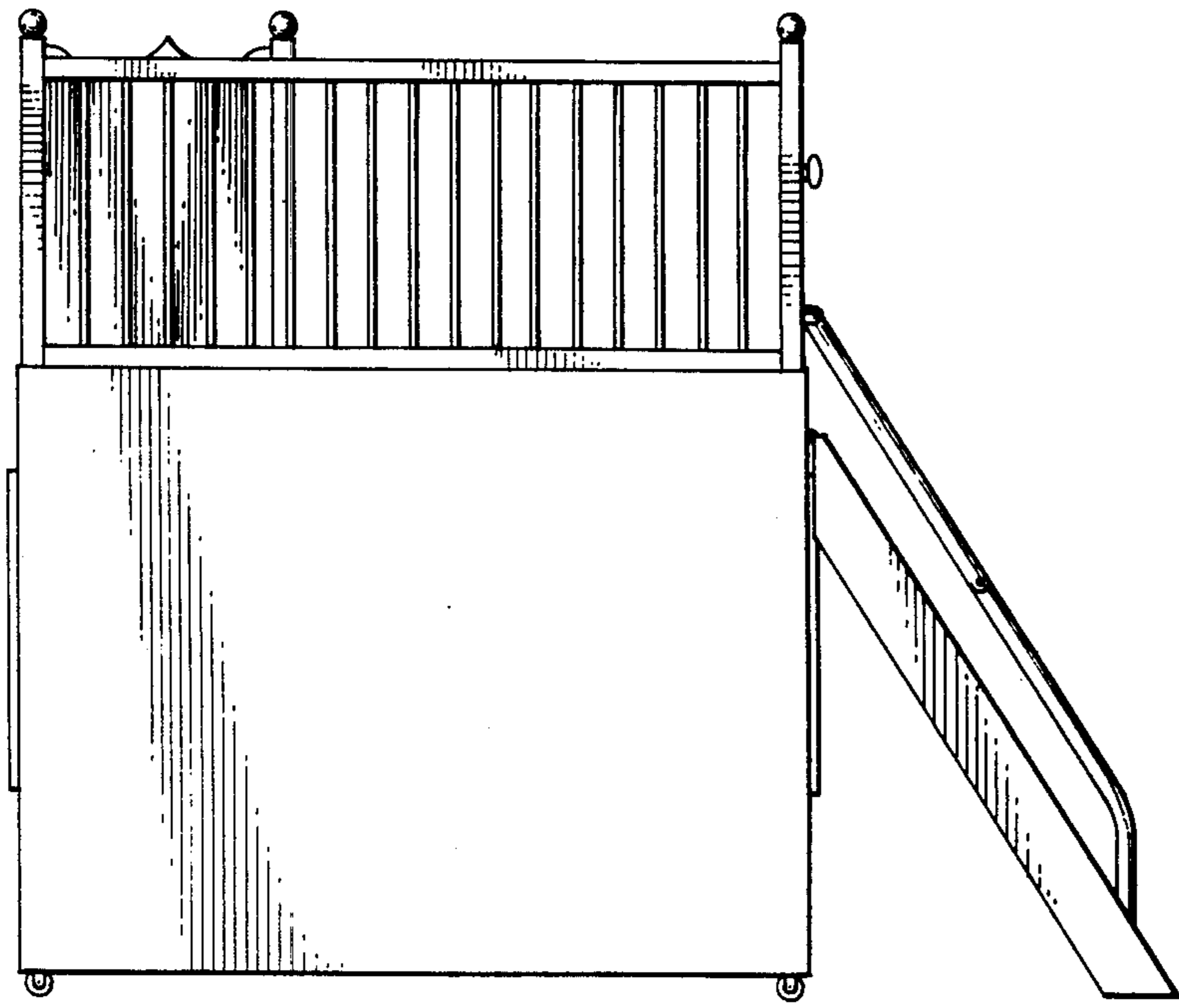

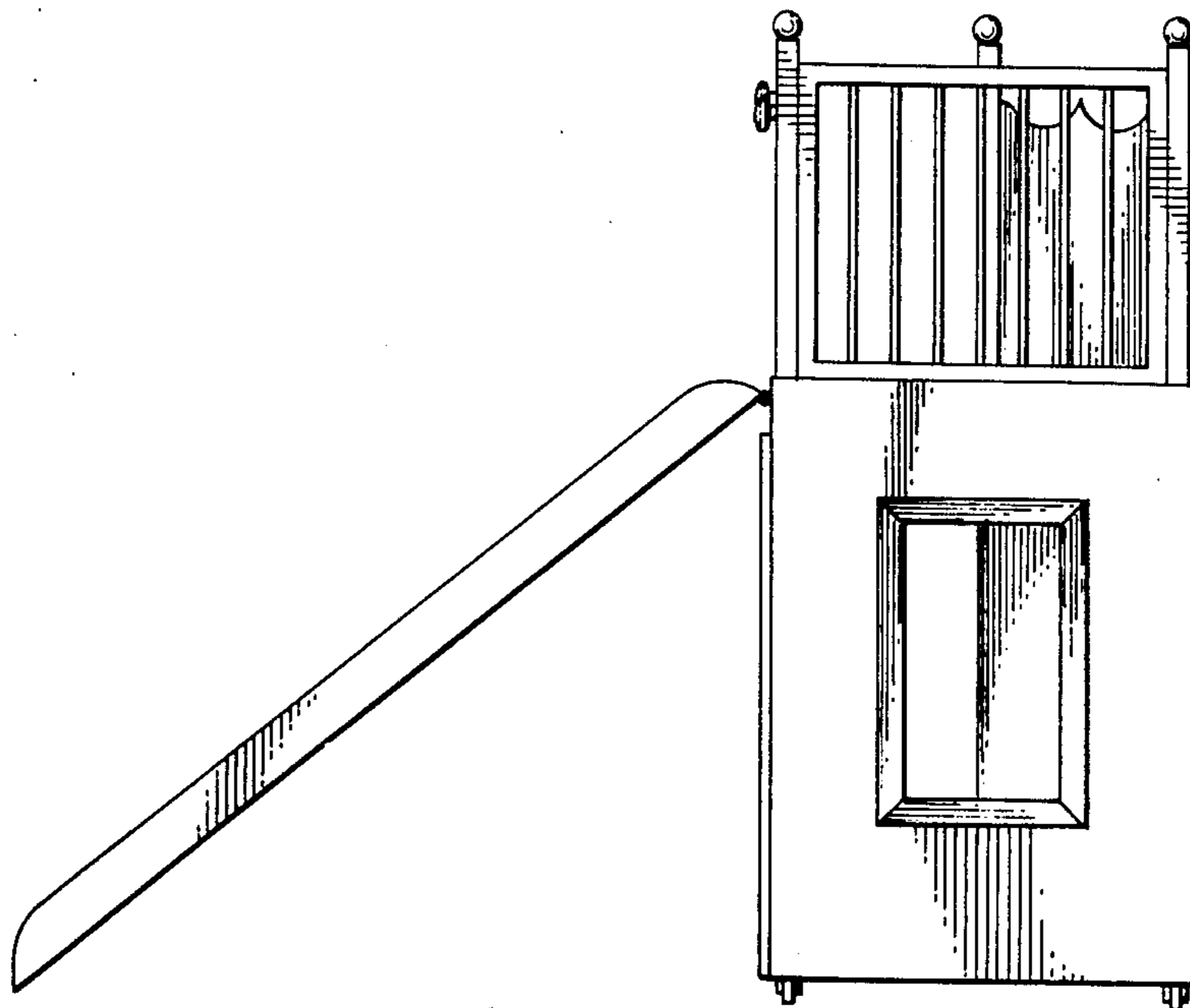
