DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a chair incorporat-
ing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of
FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a second embodi-
ment of the chair incorporating my new design;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of
FIG. 4;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of a third embodiment
of the chair incorporating my new design; and
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of
FIG. 6.
The sides of the chair embodiments not shown are mir-
ror images of the respective sides shown while the rear
surfaces of the backrest members are plain and unorna-
mented.

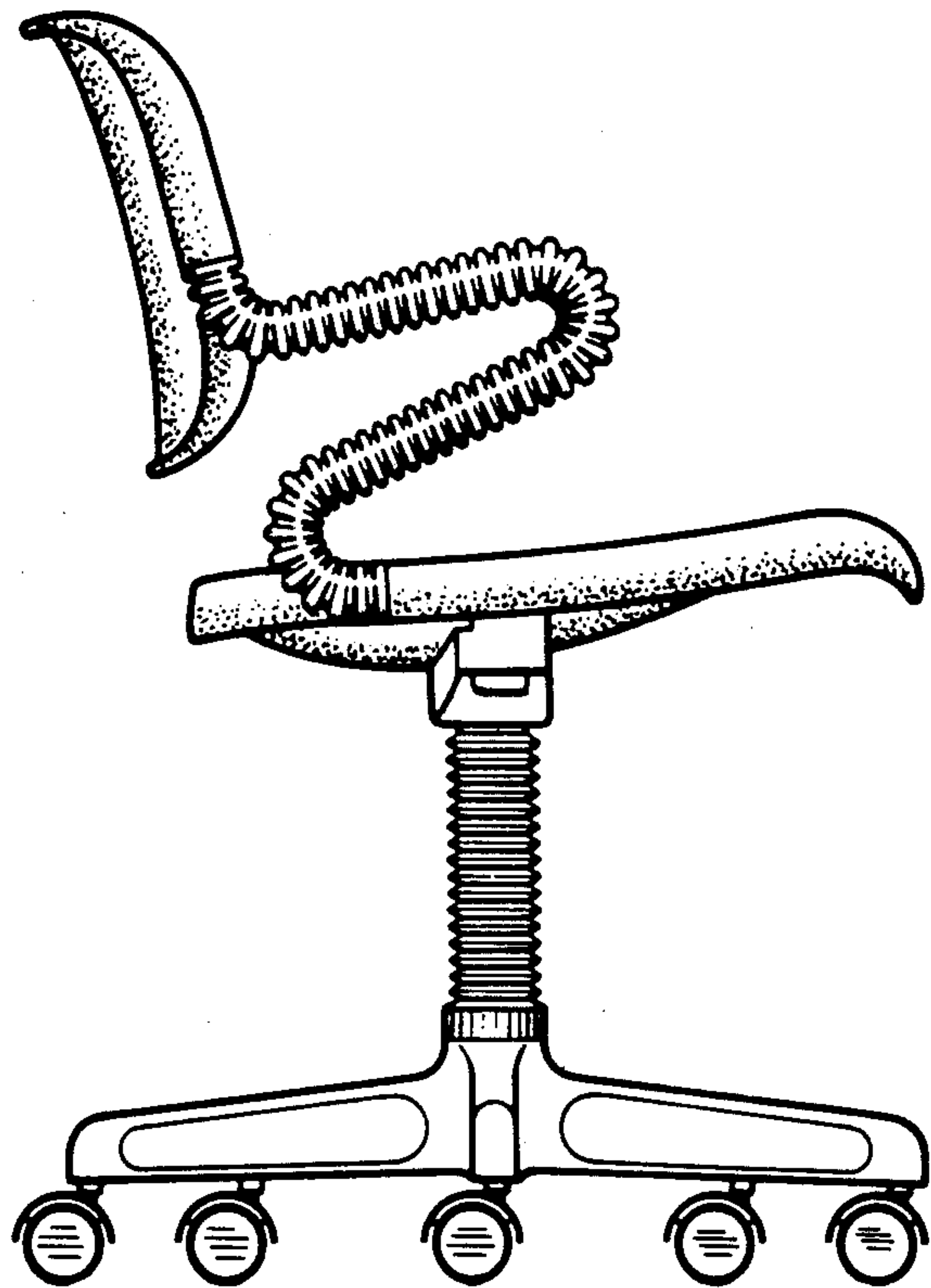

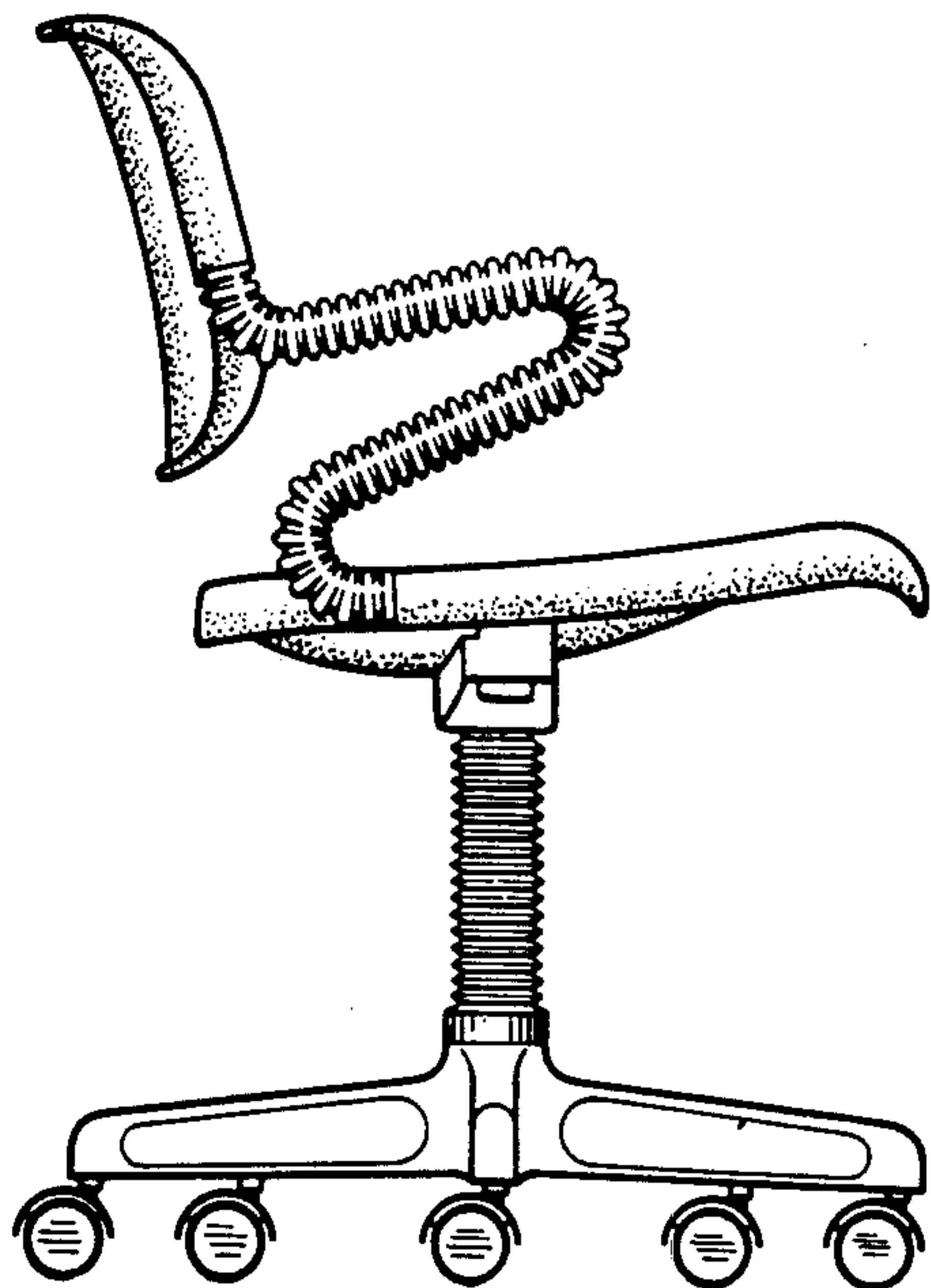

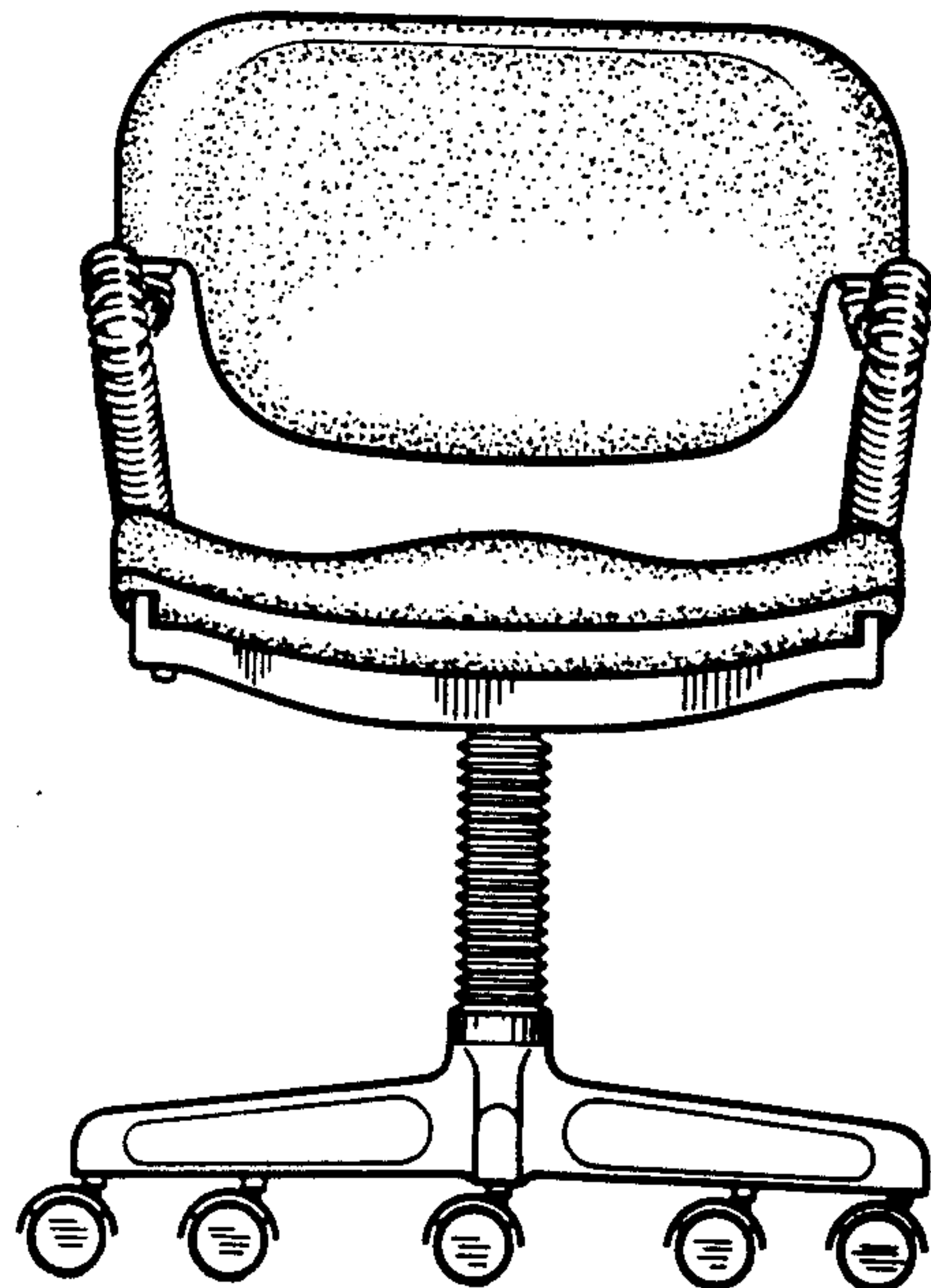

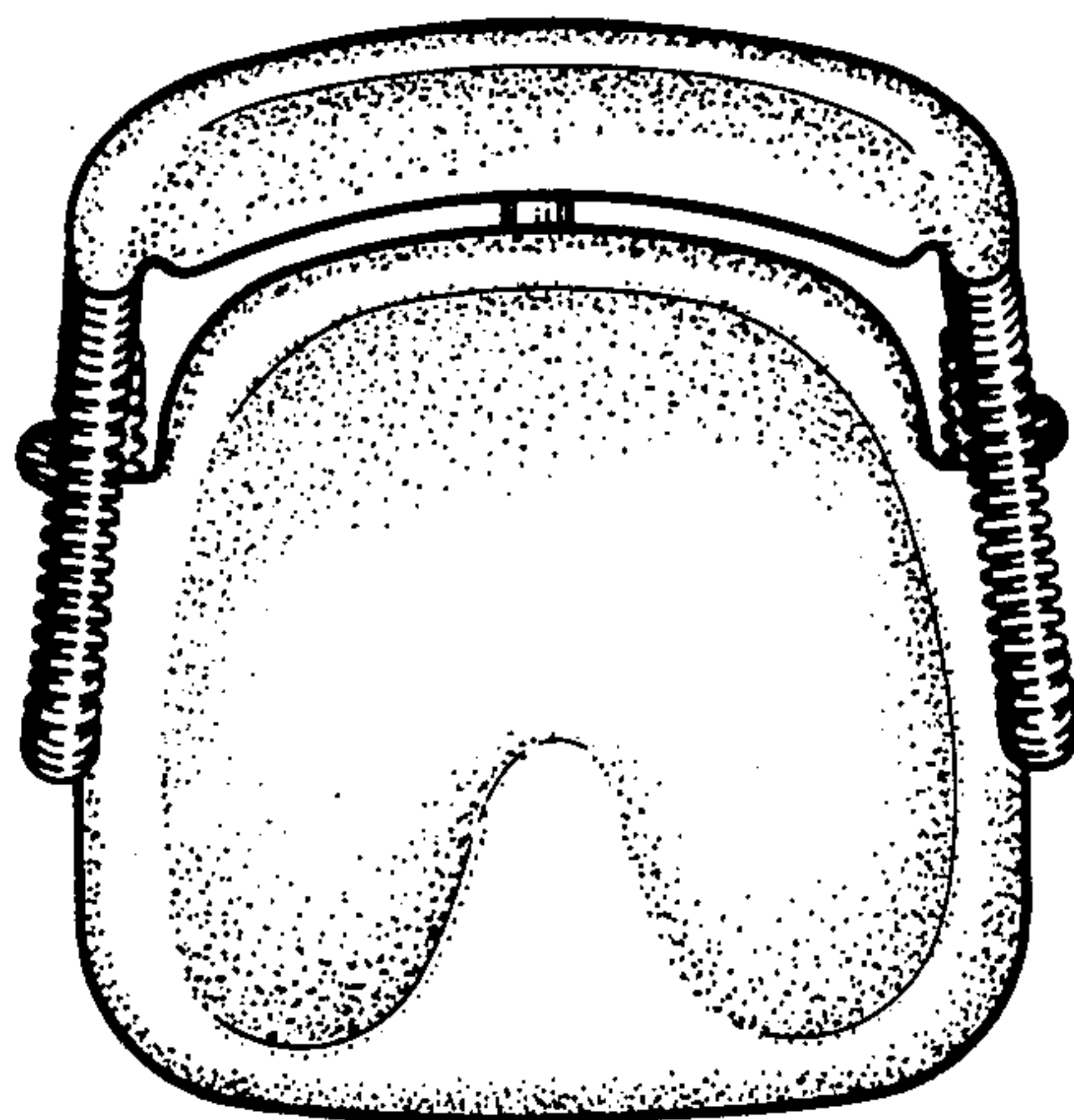

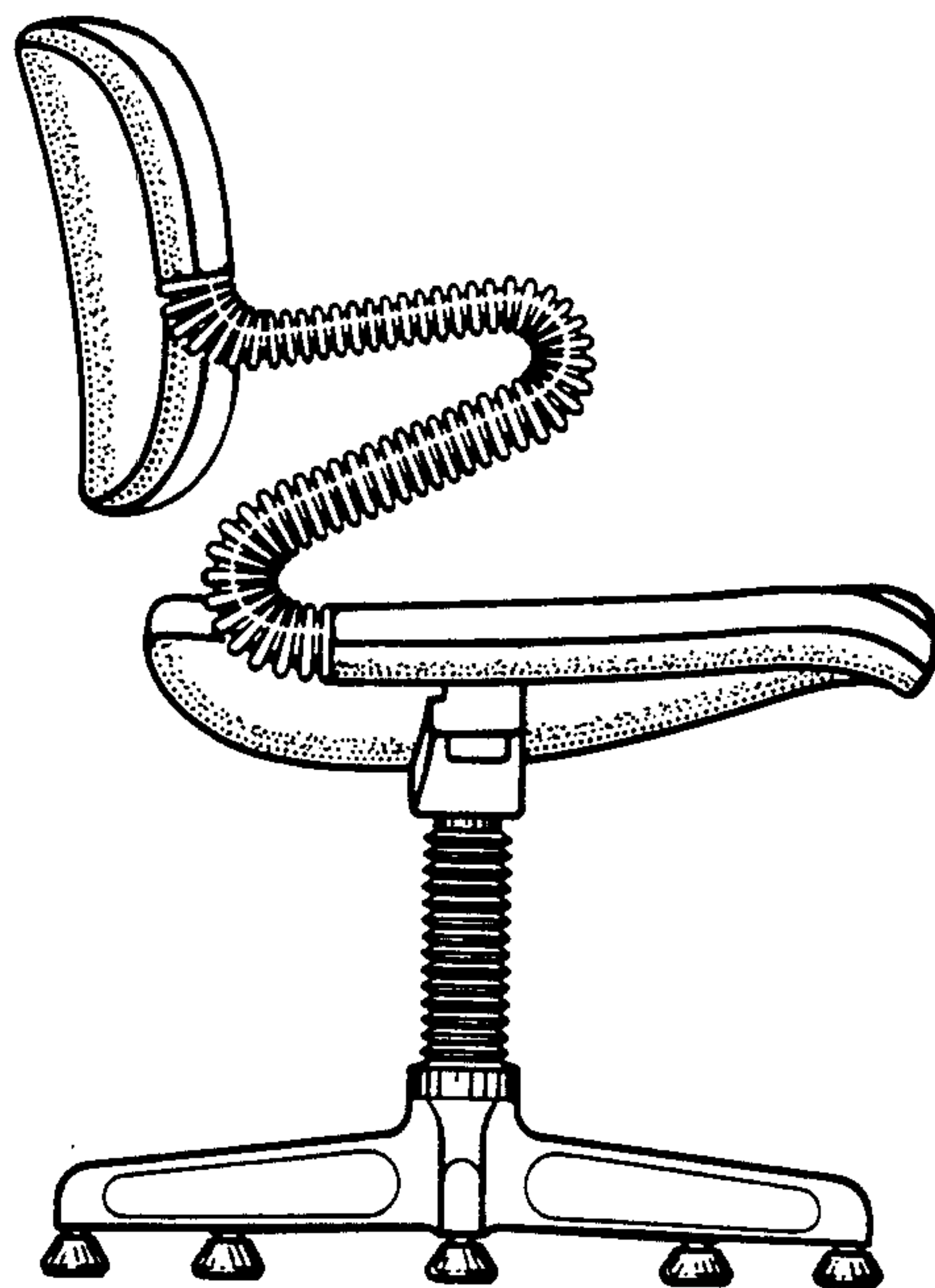

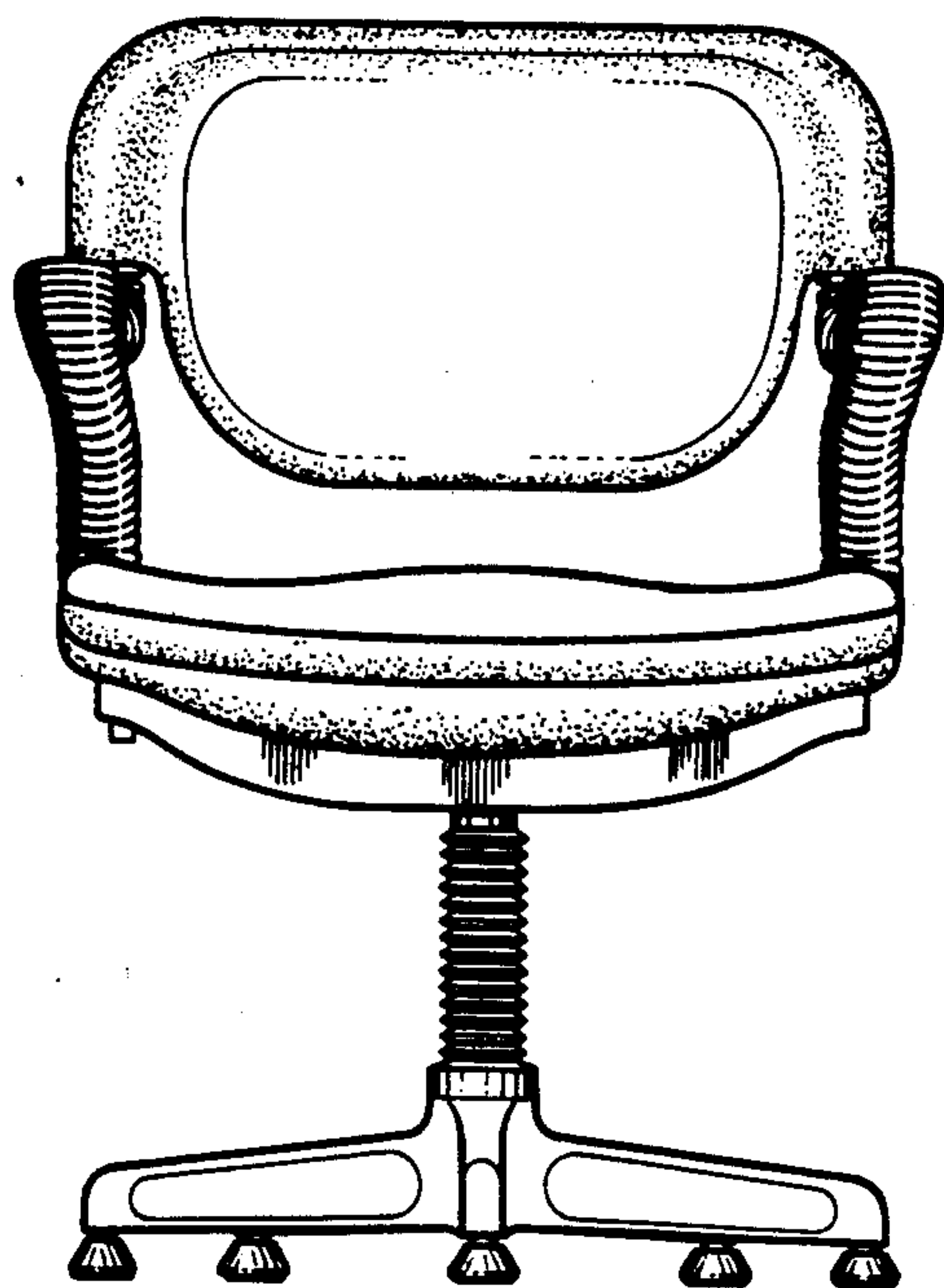

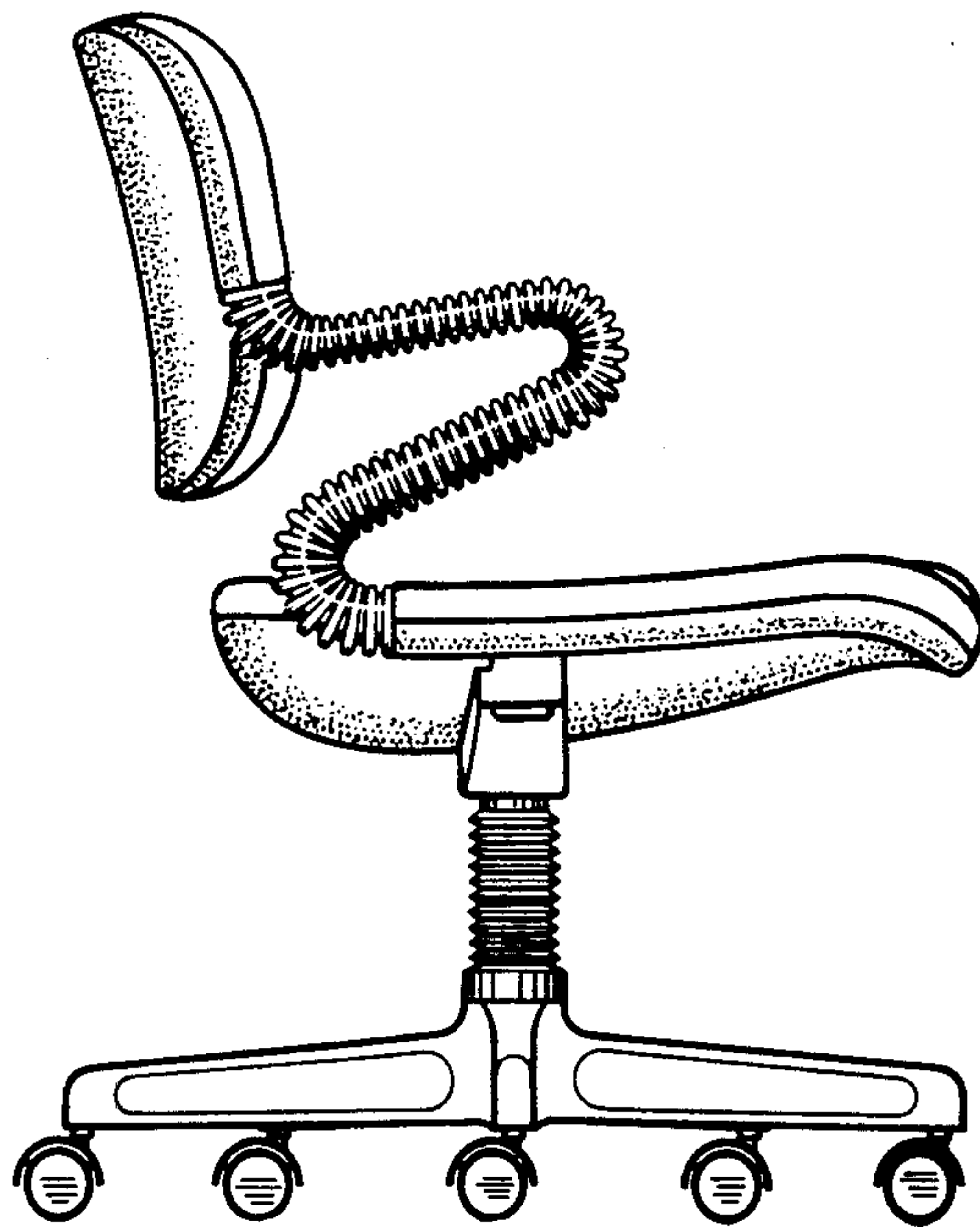
