FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a stem for supporting a soap dish or the like, the stem incorporating my new design.

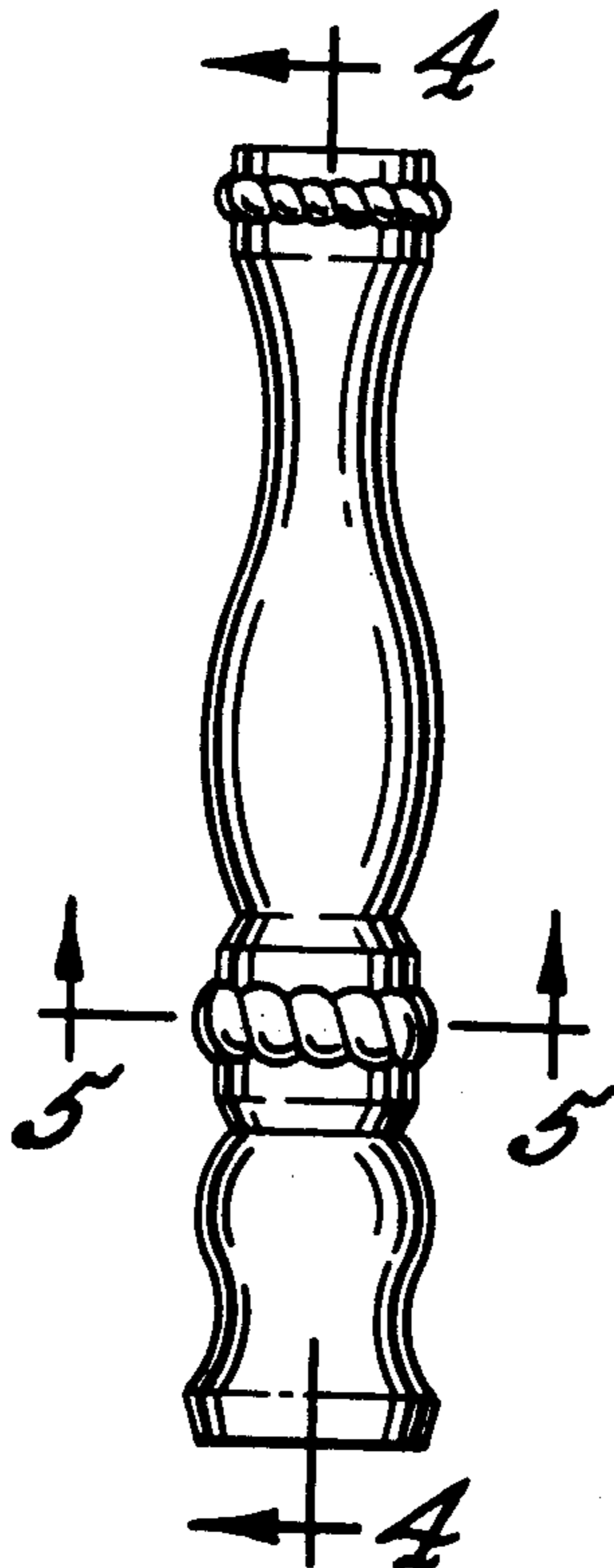
FIG. 2 is a top plan view.

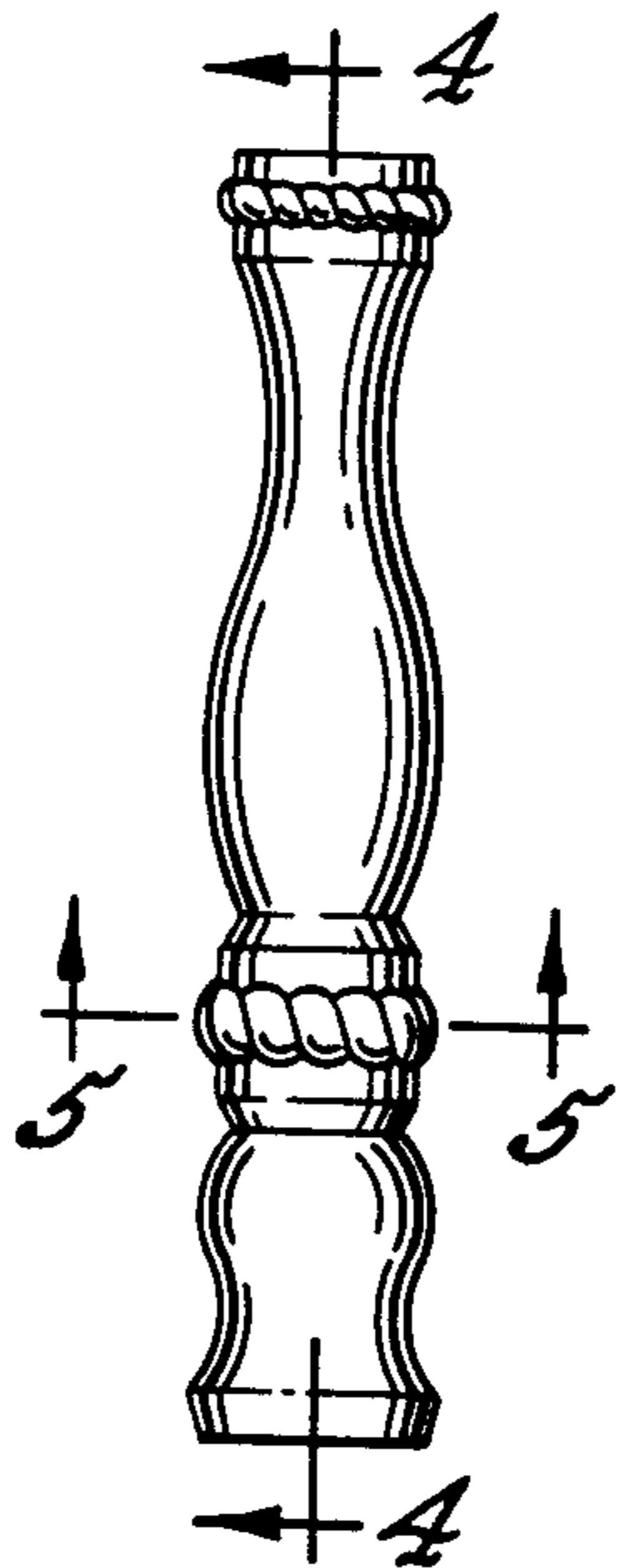

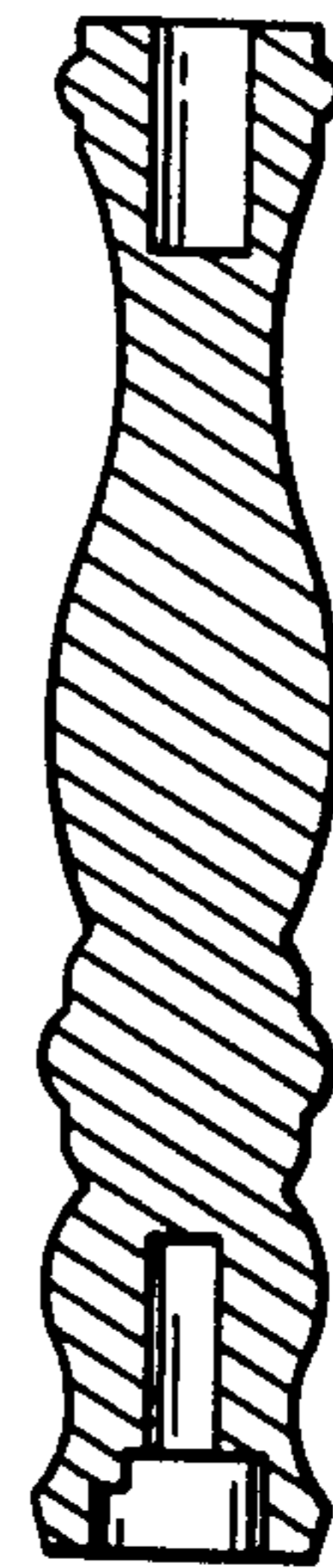
