[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a stoneware hutch cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a stoneware hutch cabinet showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is an elevation of one side thereof.

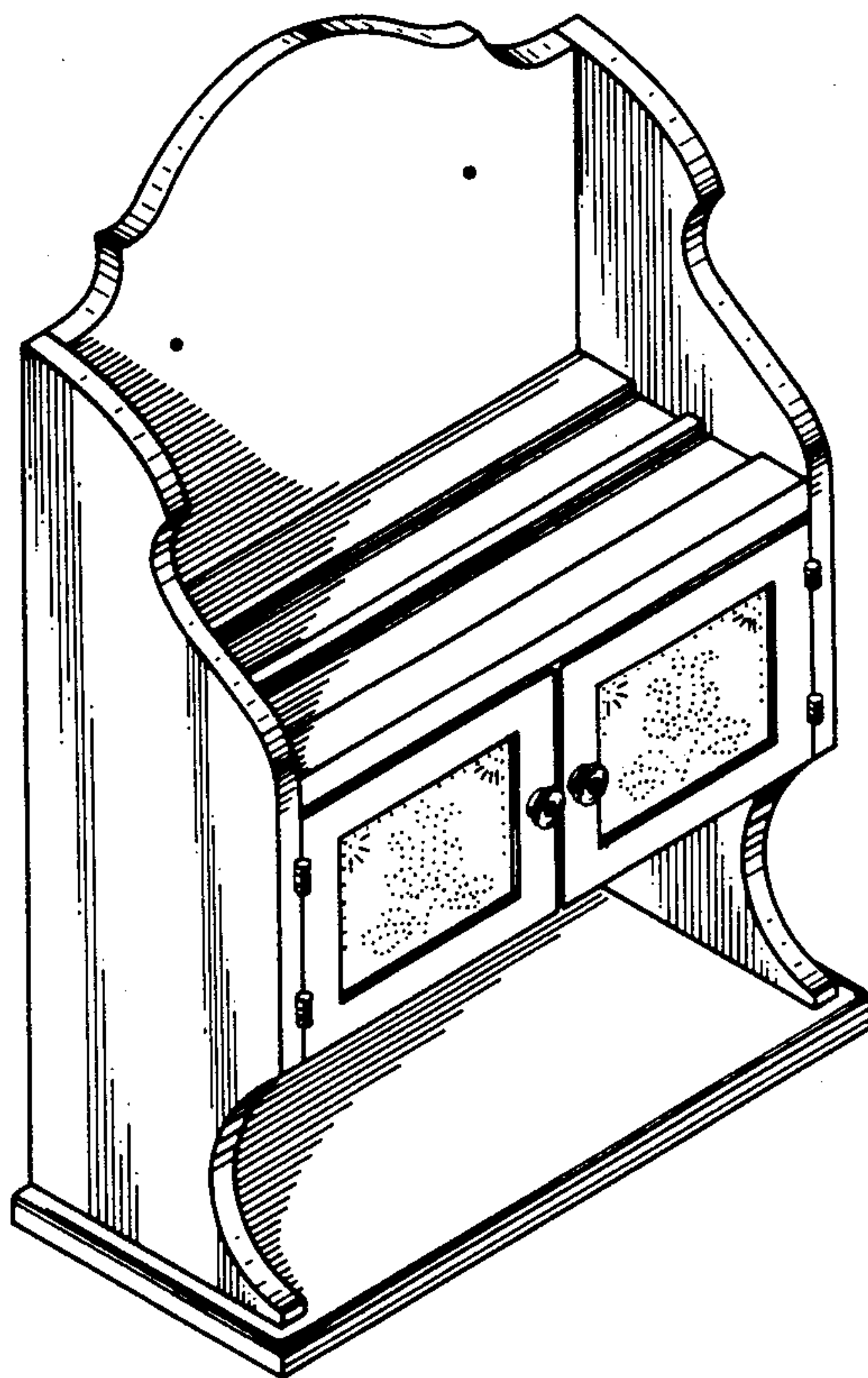
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof.

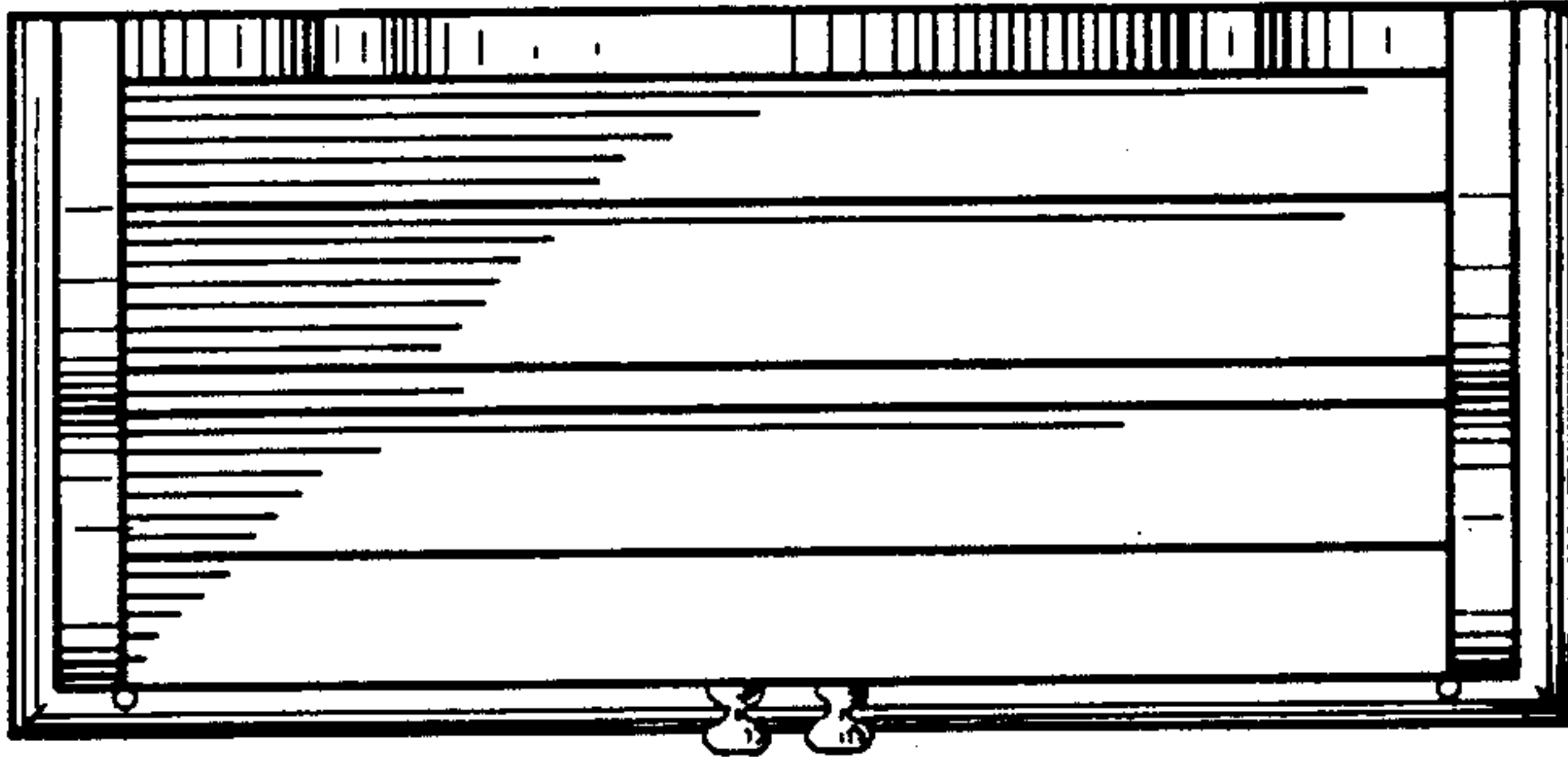
The other side of the stoneware hutch cabinet is the same as FIG. 2 in reverse.

The rear elevation and bottom plan view are plain and the same respectively as FIGS. 1 and 3 in outline.

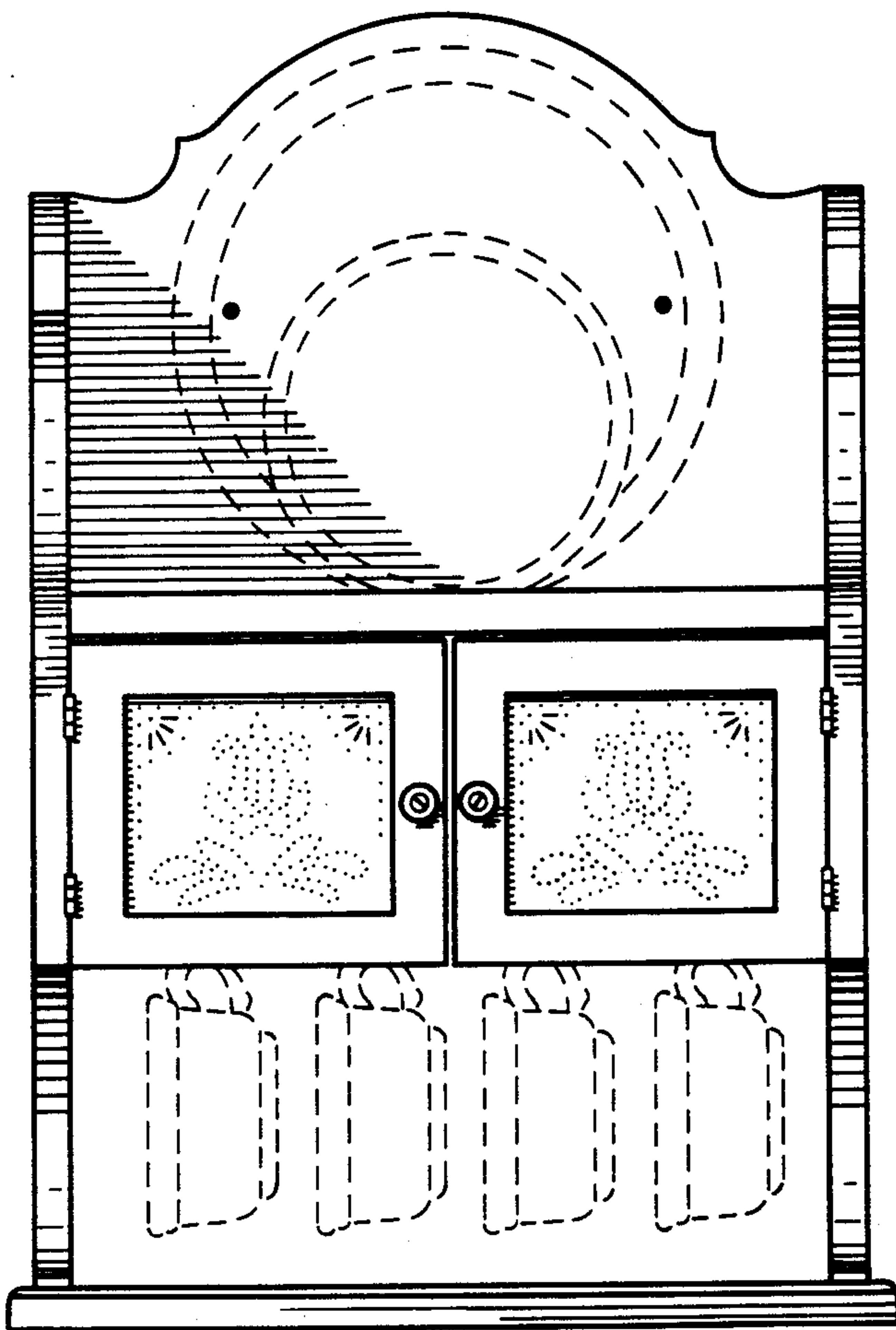
The broken lines in the figures are for illustration purposes only.



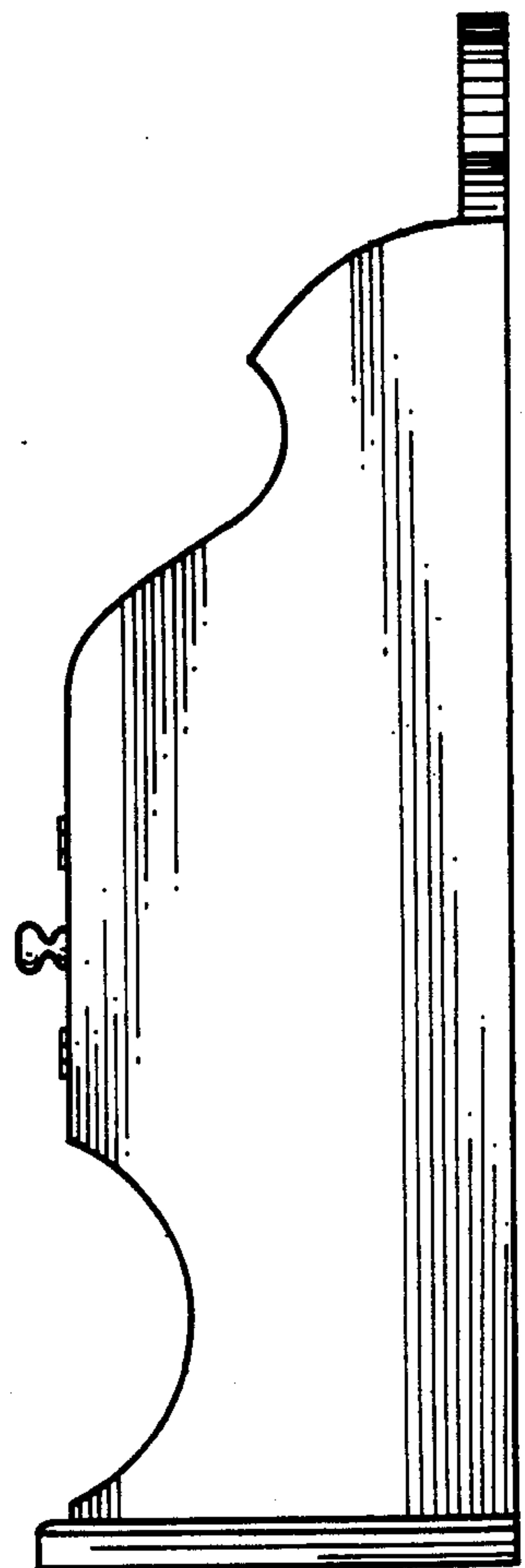
