DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a modular newsstand showing my new design, the adjacent modular newsstands being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

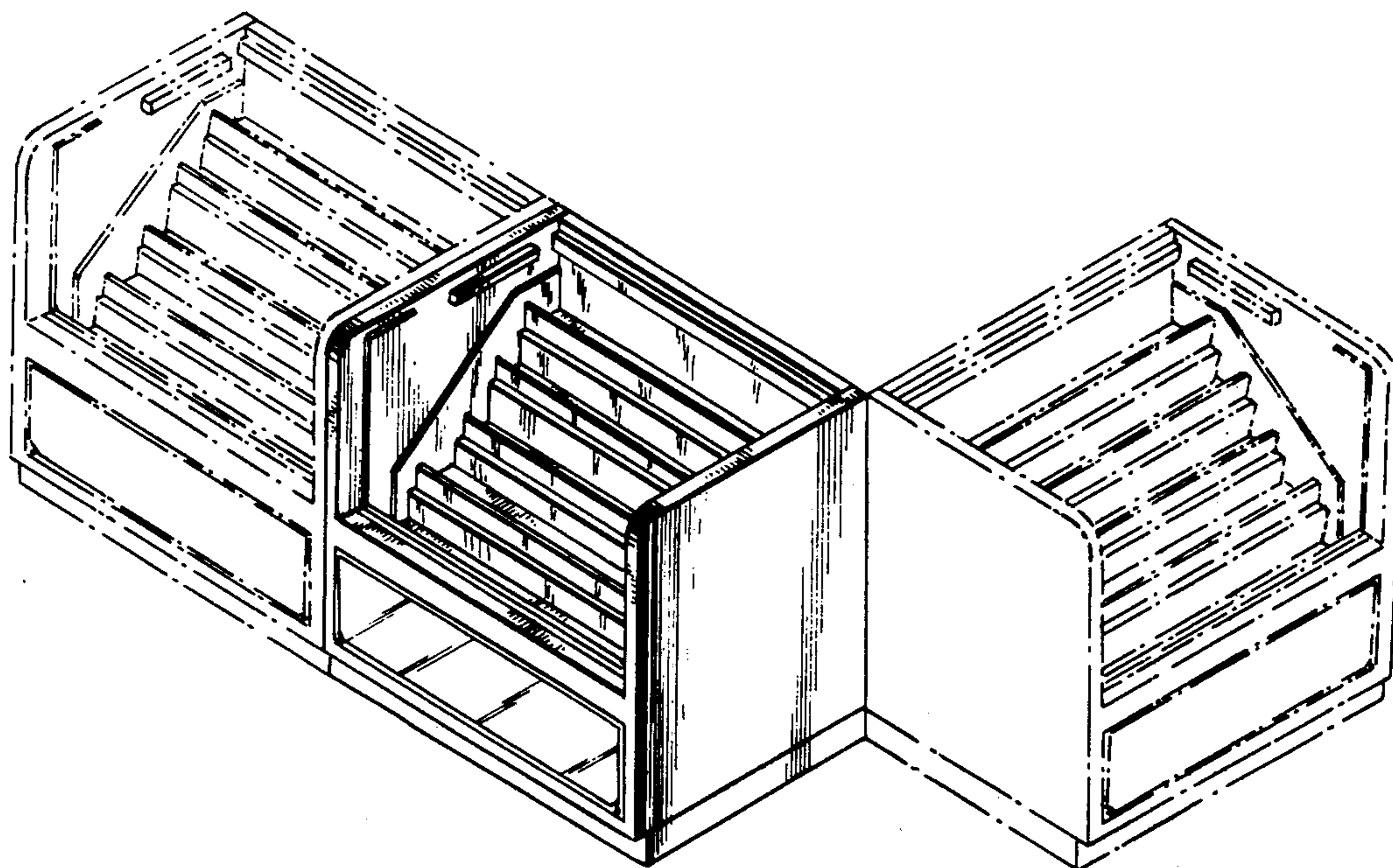
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 3, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view with the cover in place.



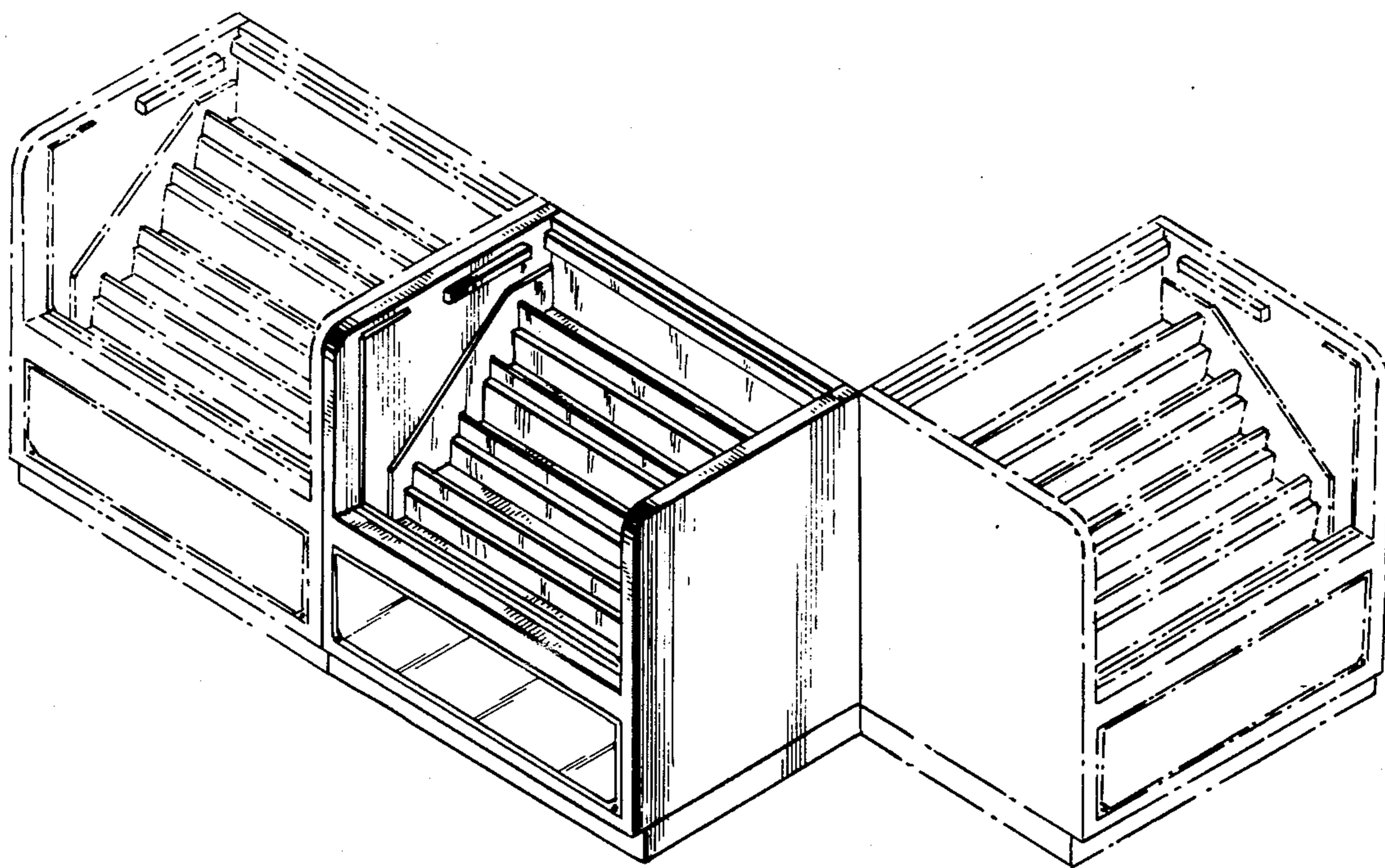

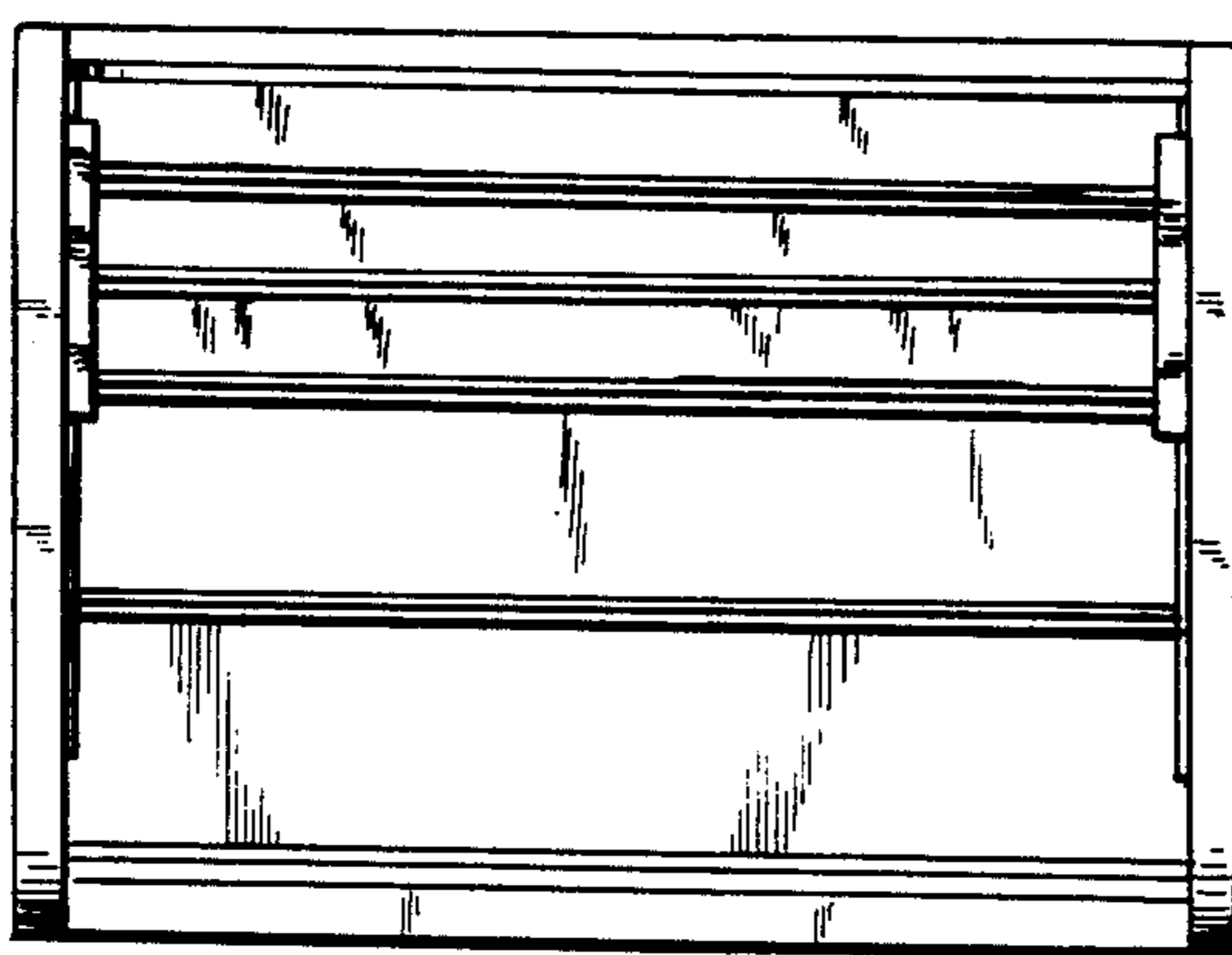

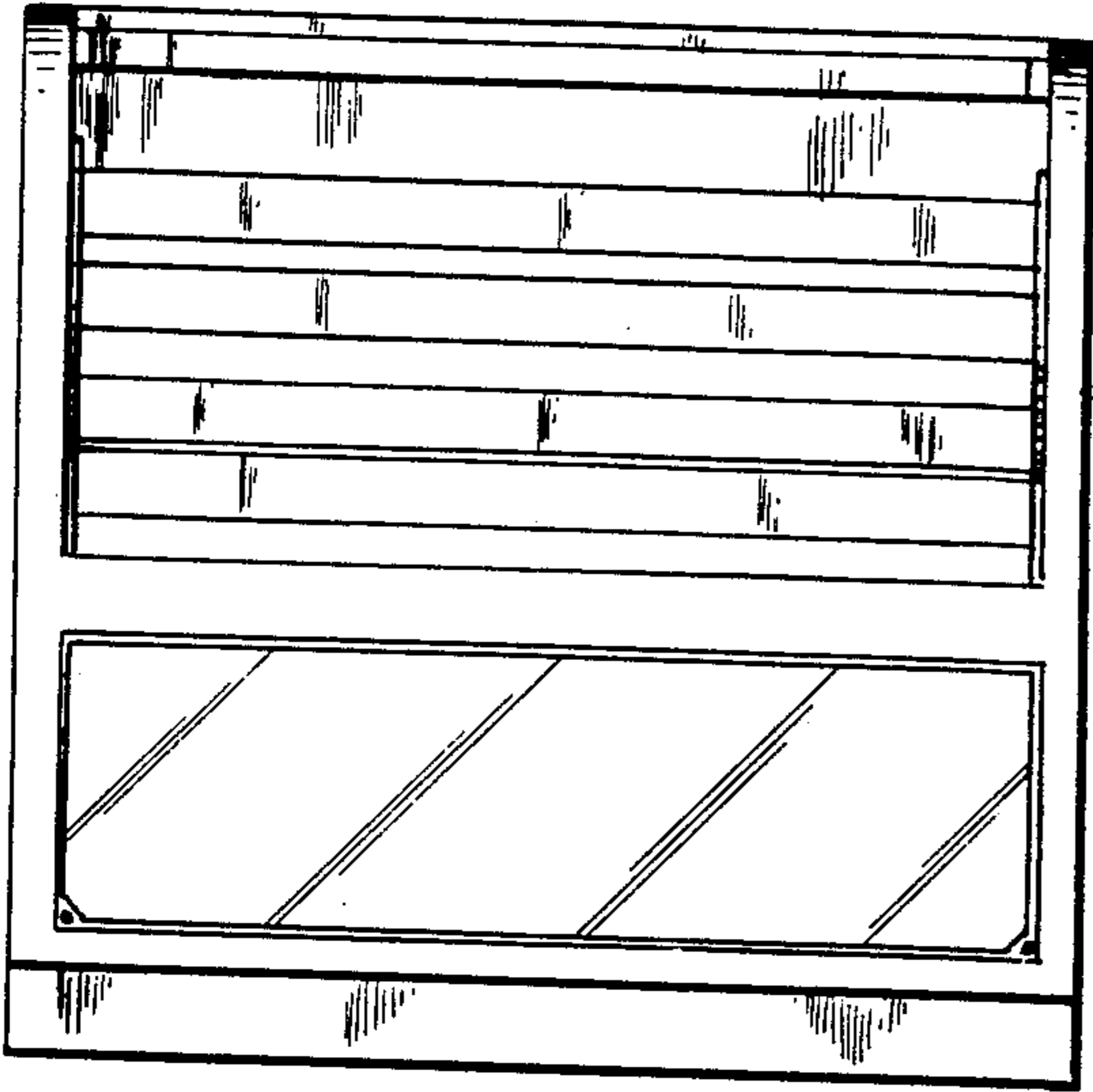

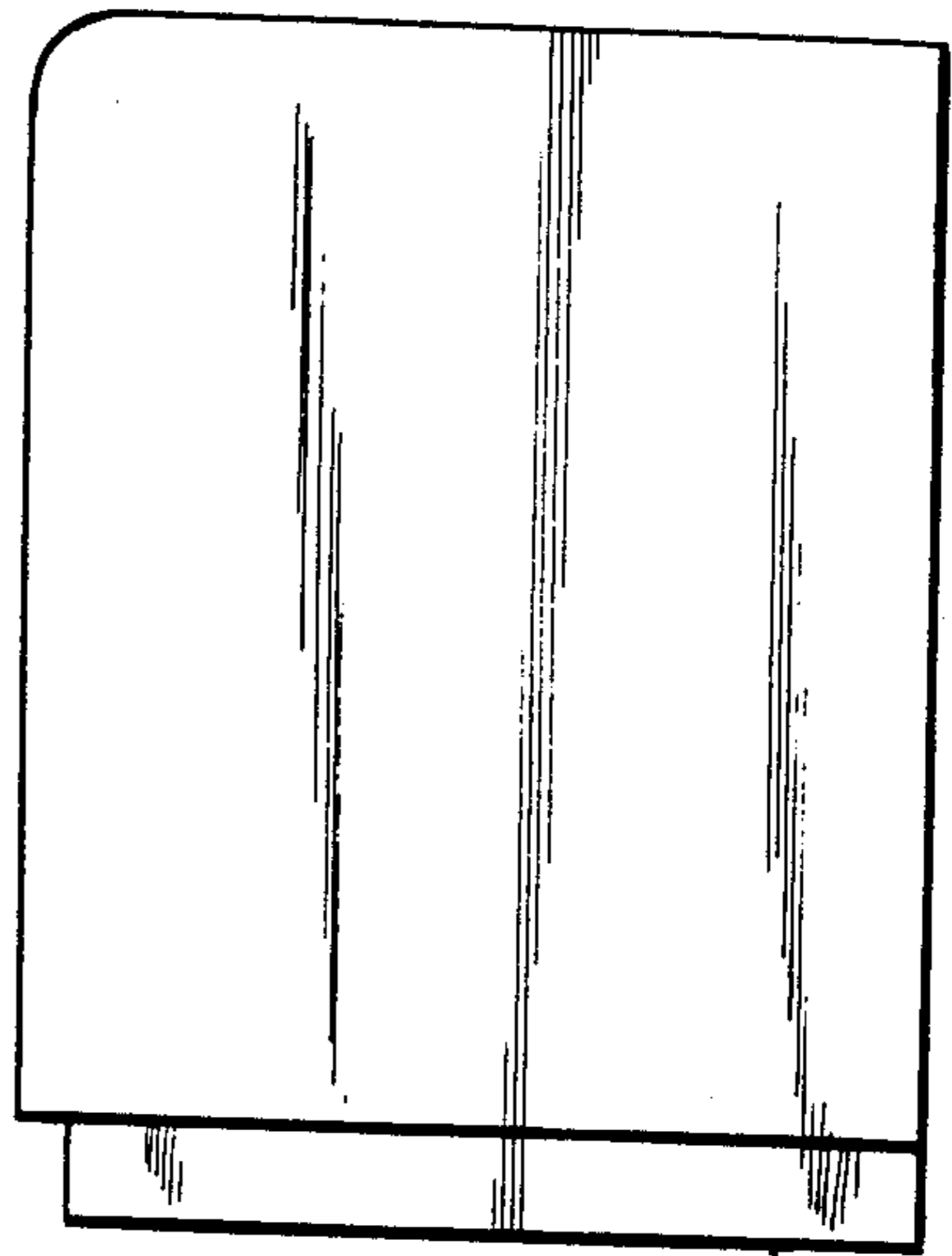

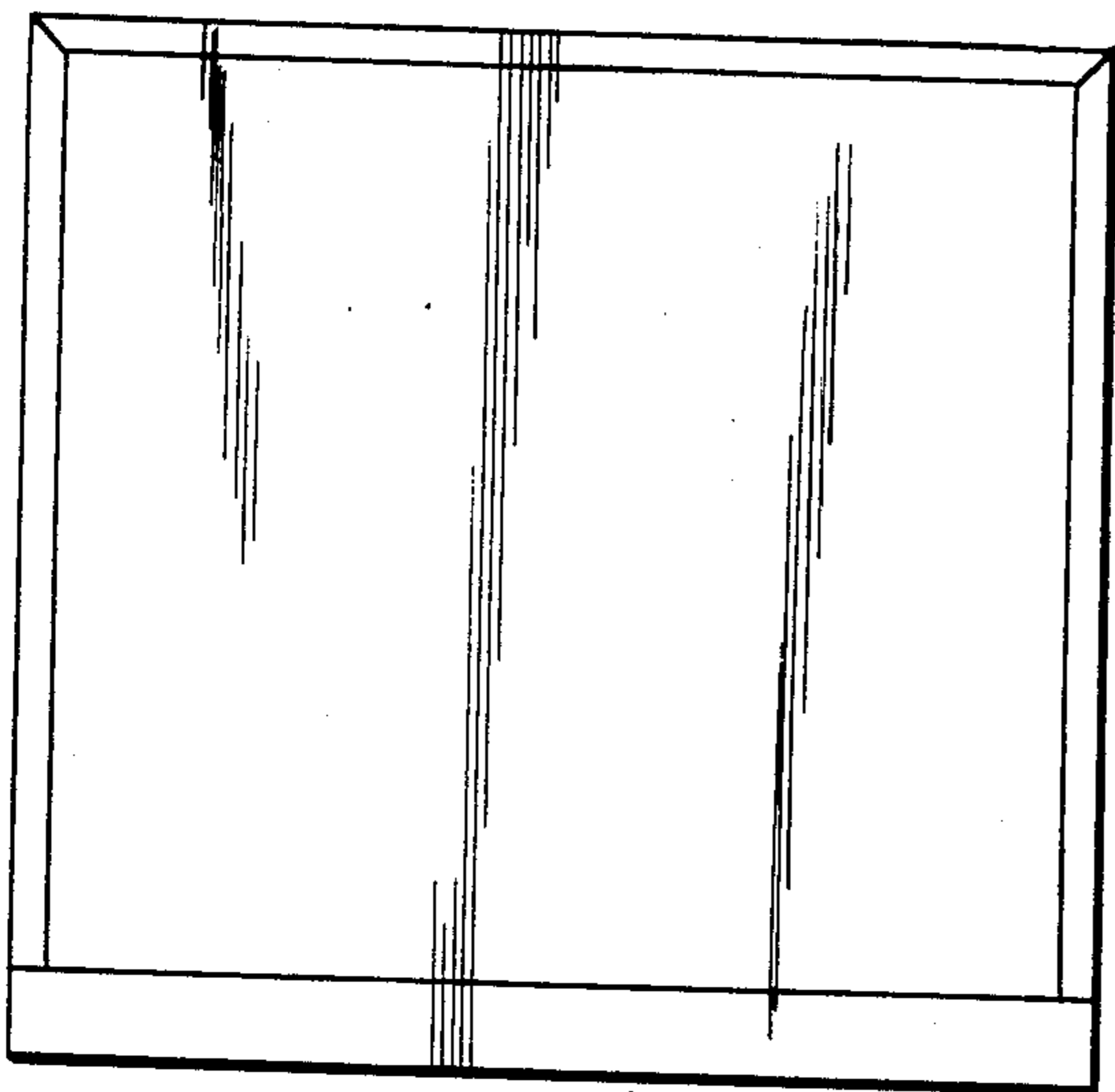

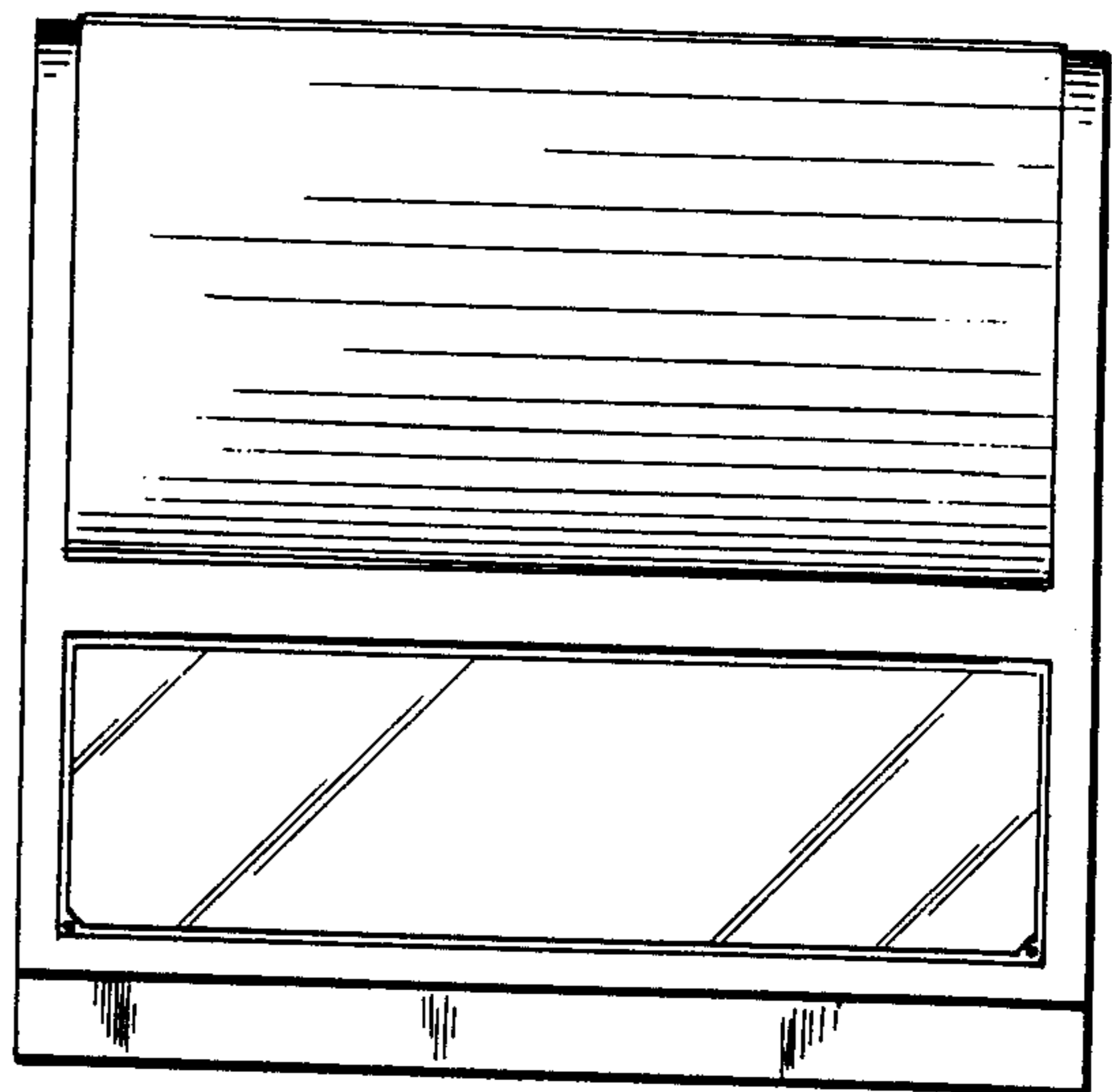
