[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bowl or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bowl or similar article showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is an exploded elevational view thereof of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a developed plan view of the floral motif on the bowl wall thereof.

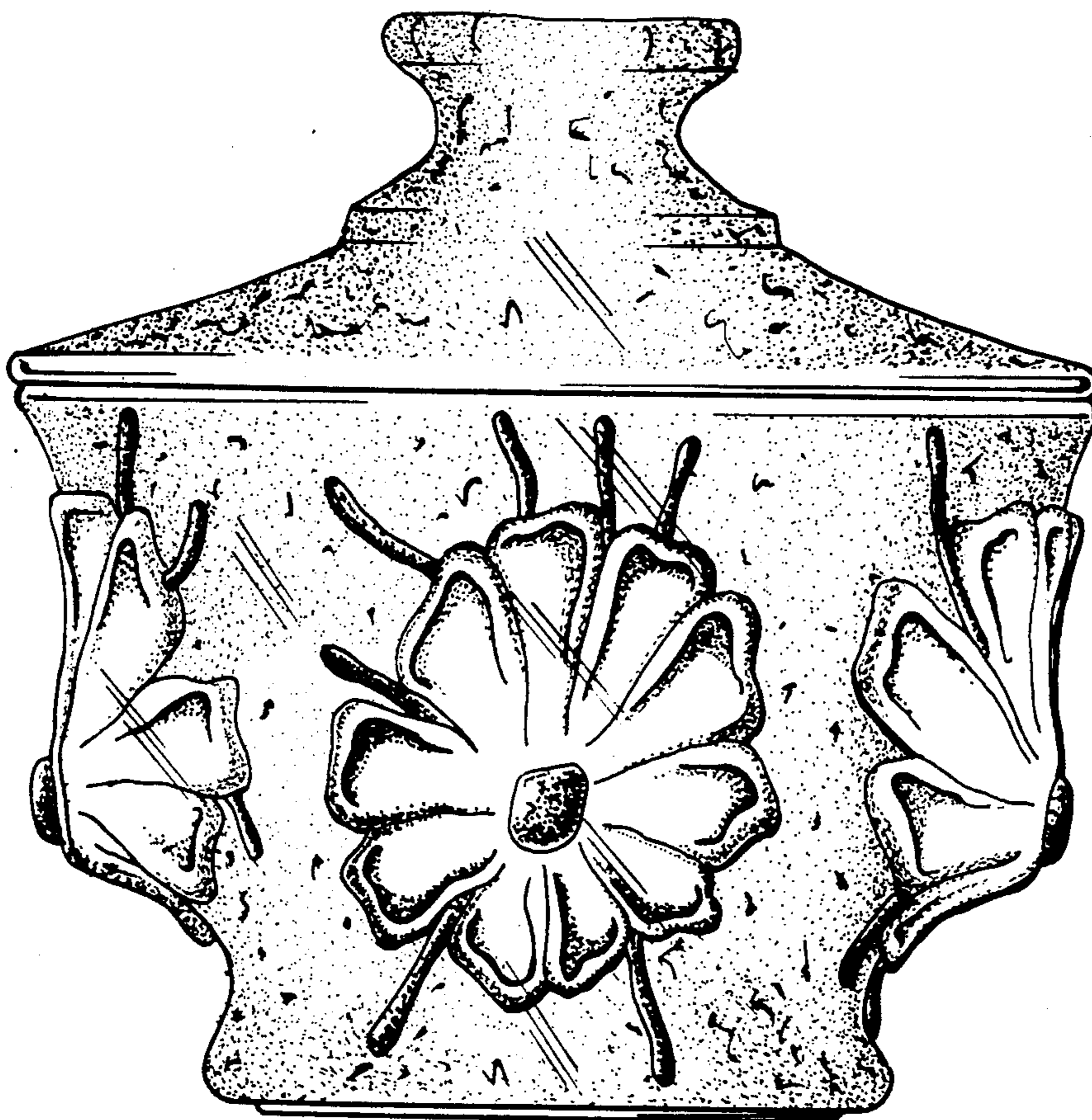

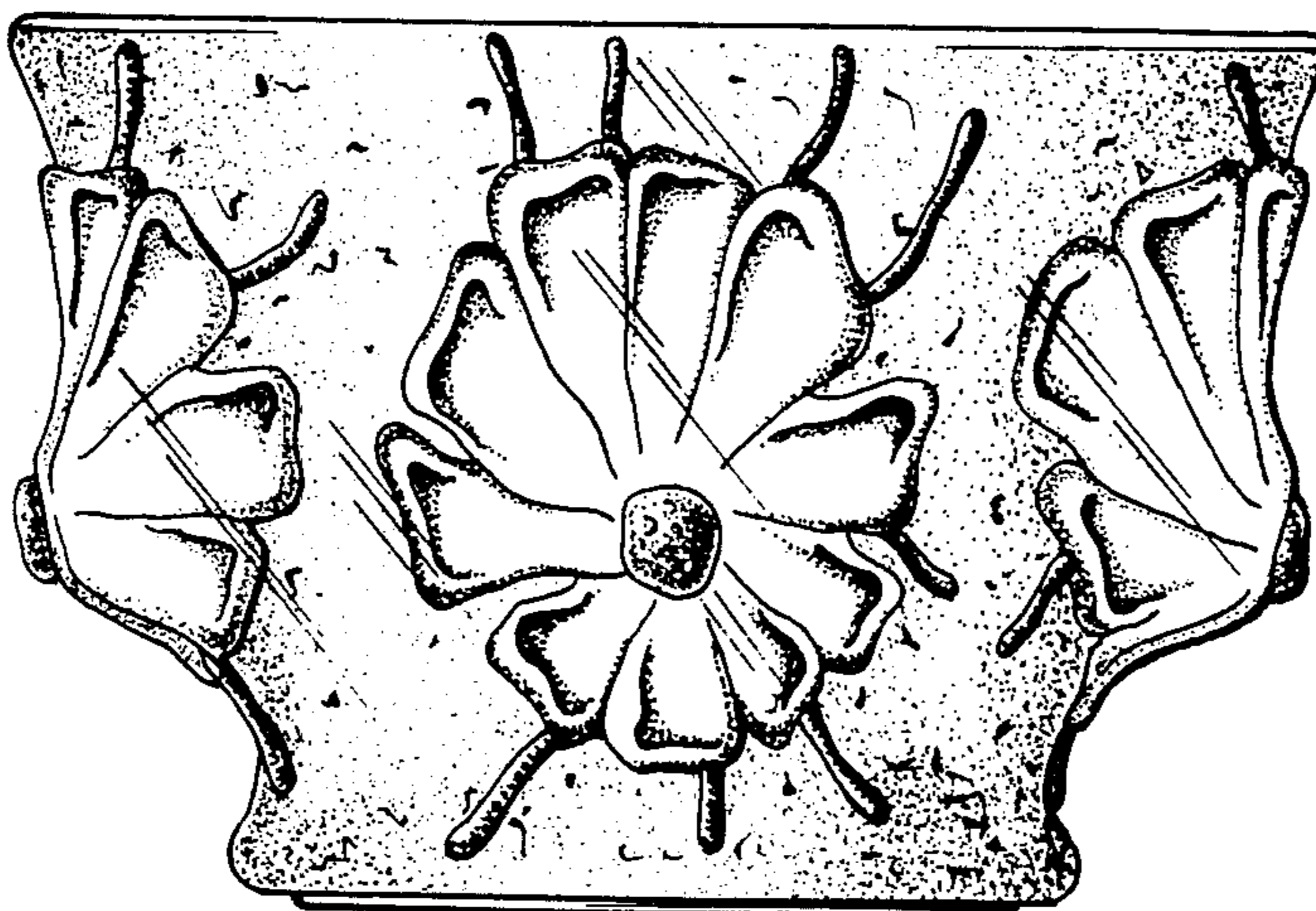
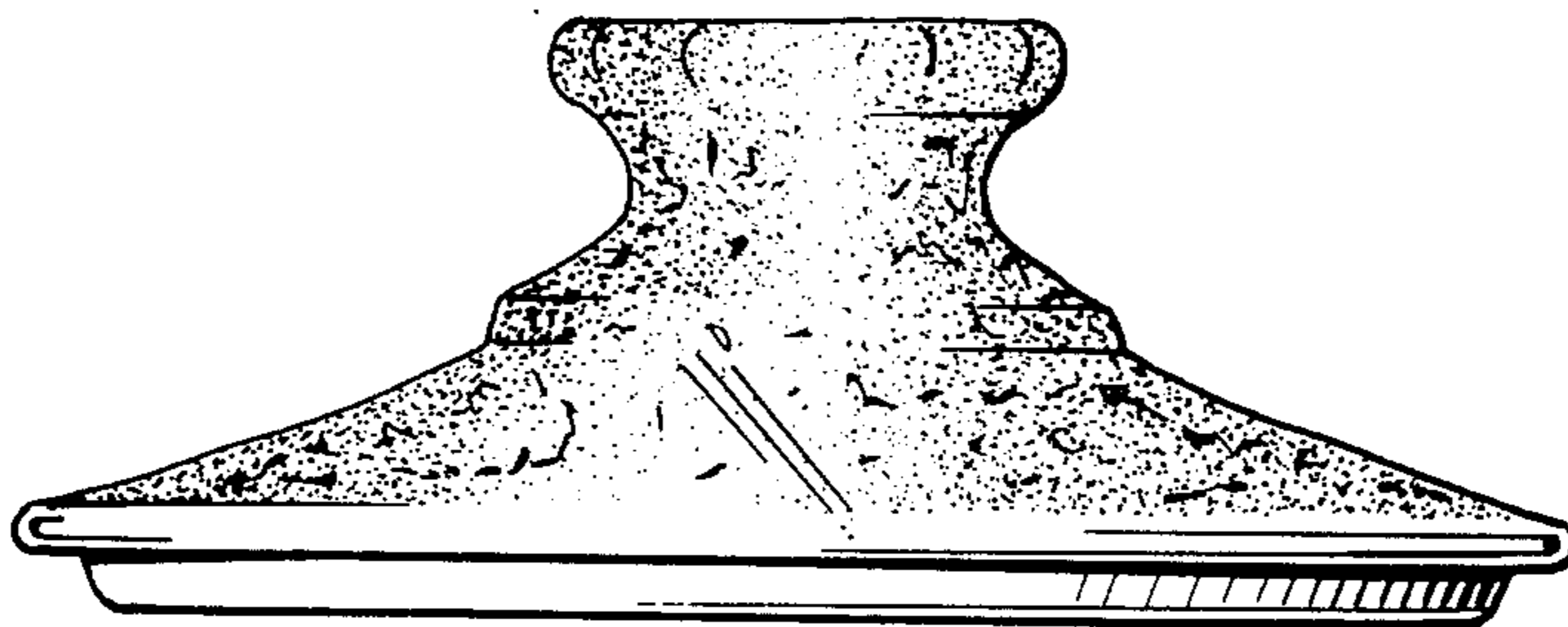
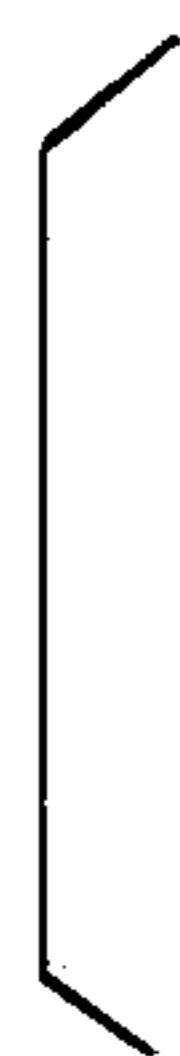
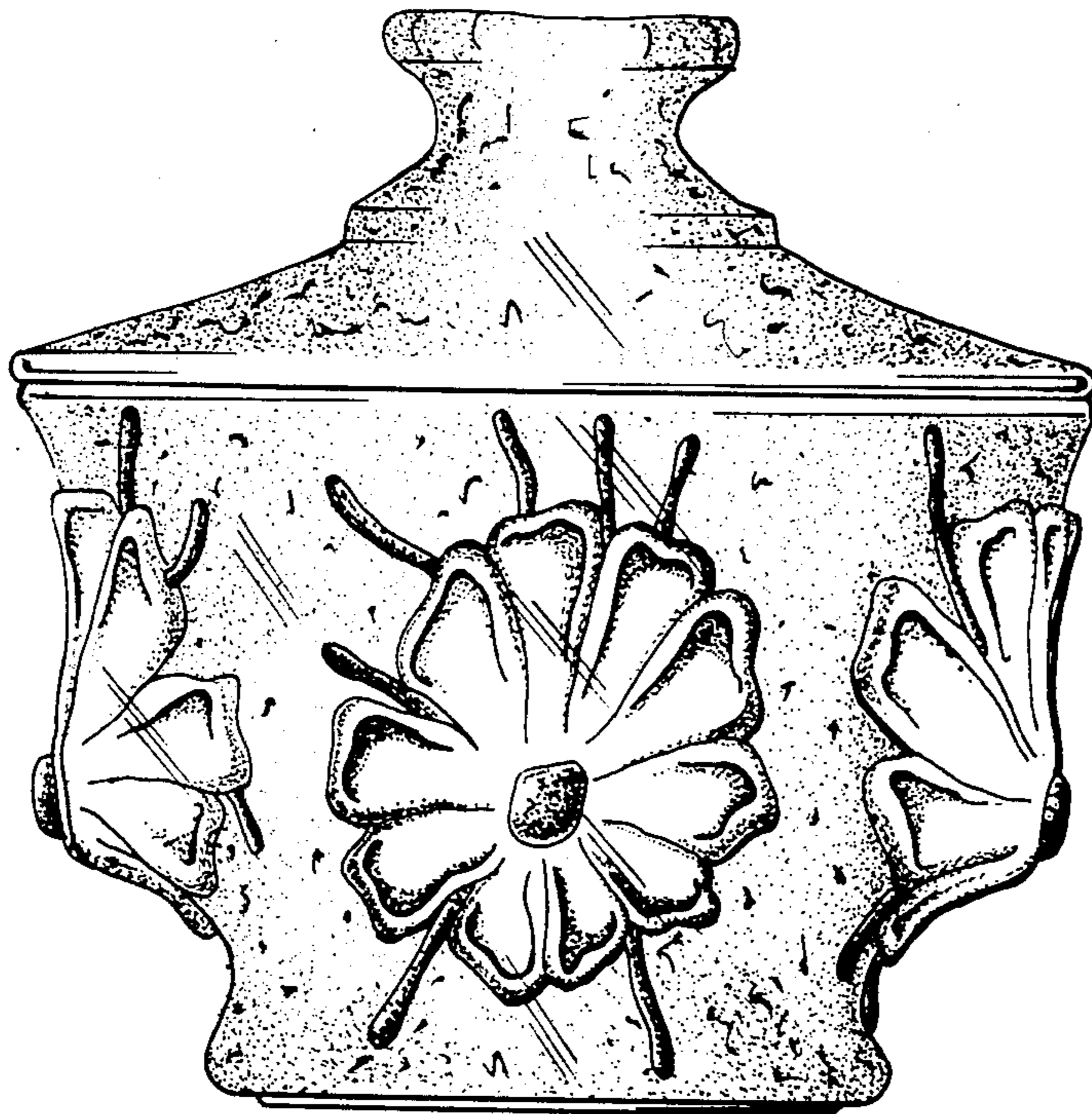

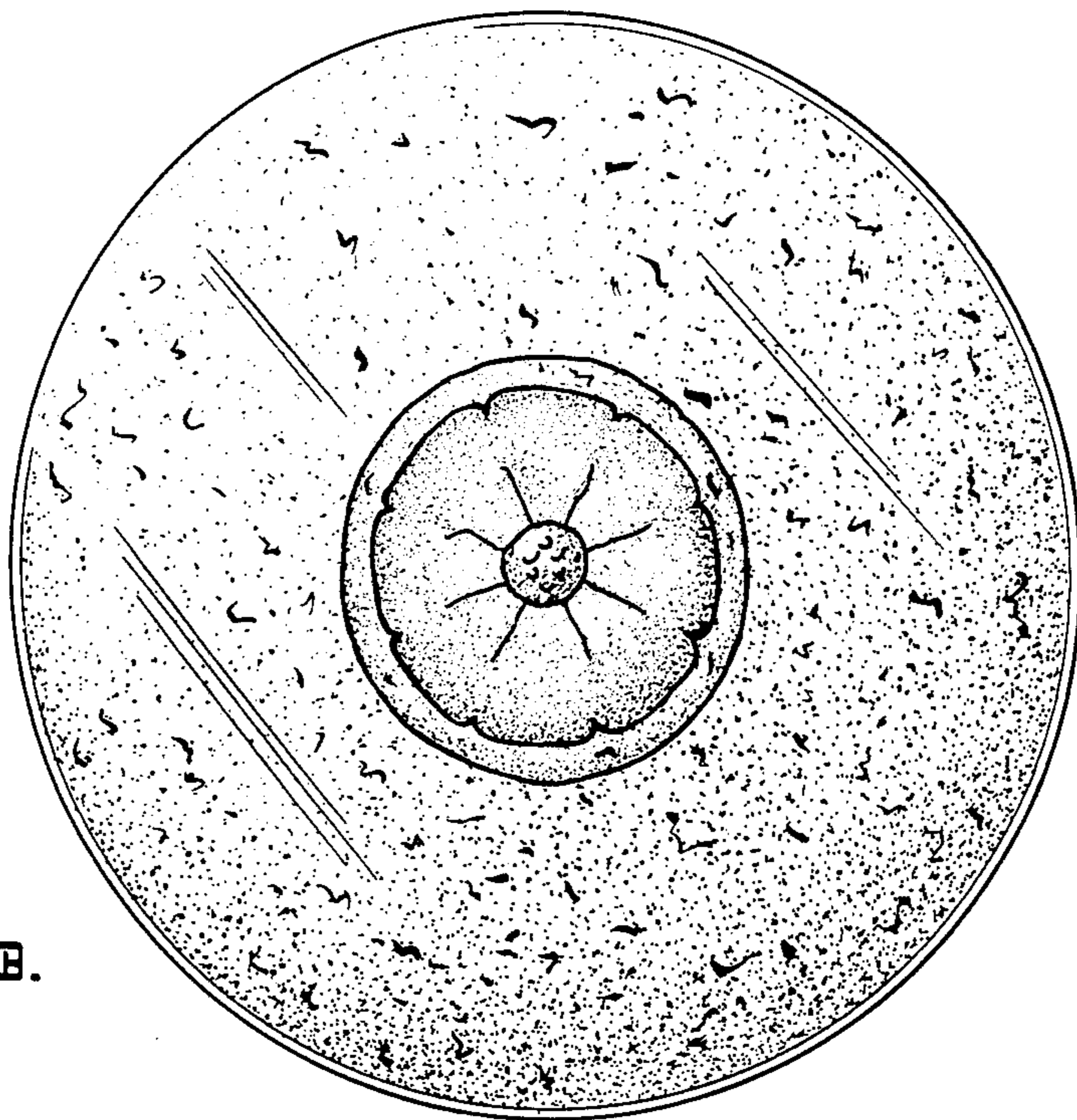

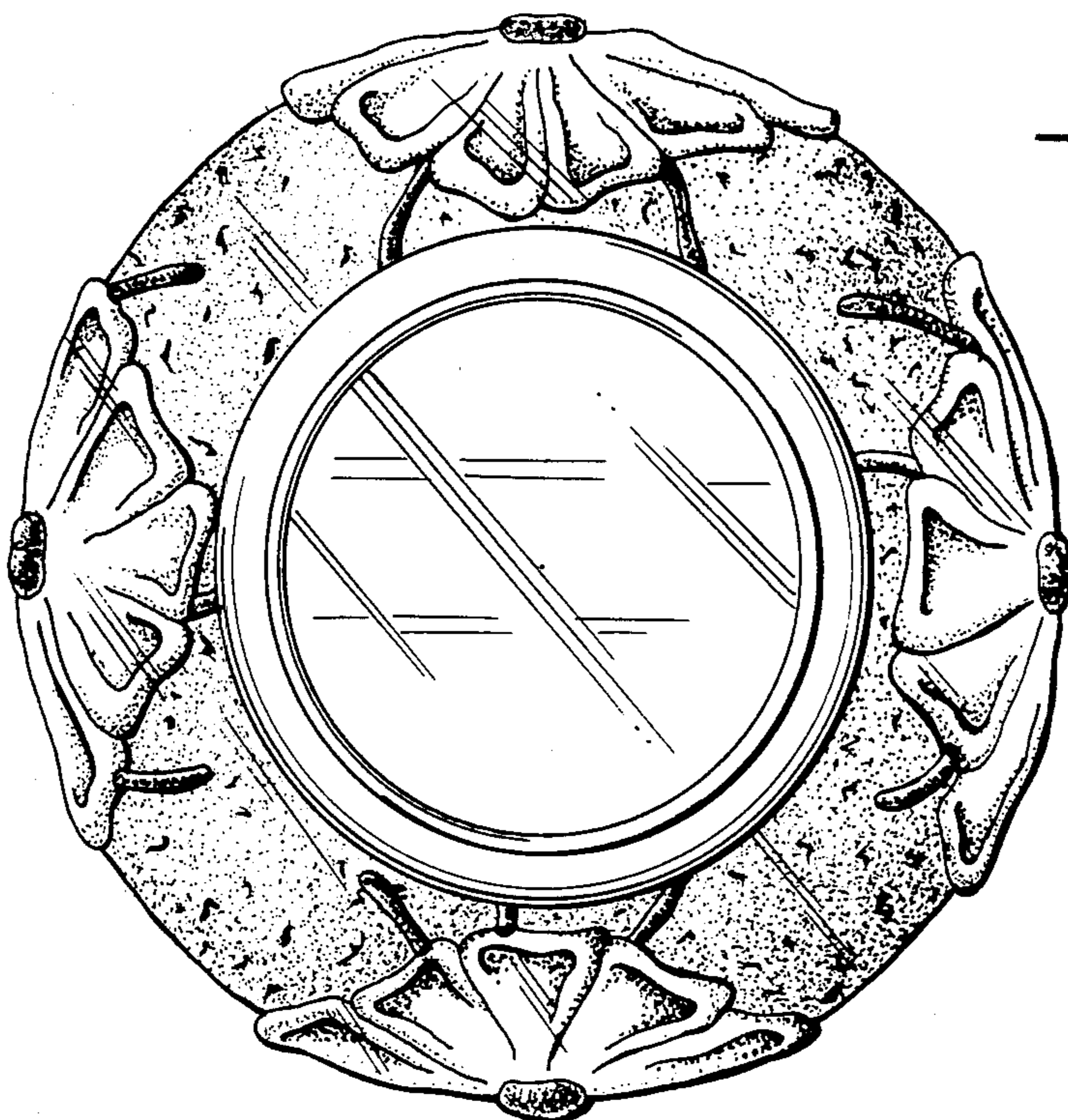
