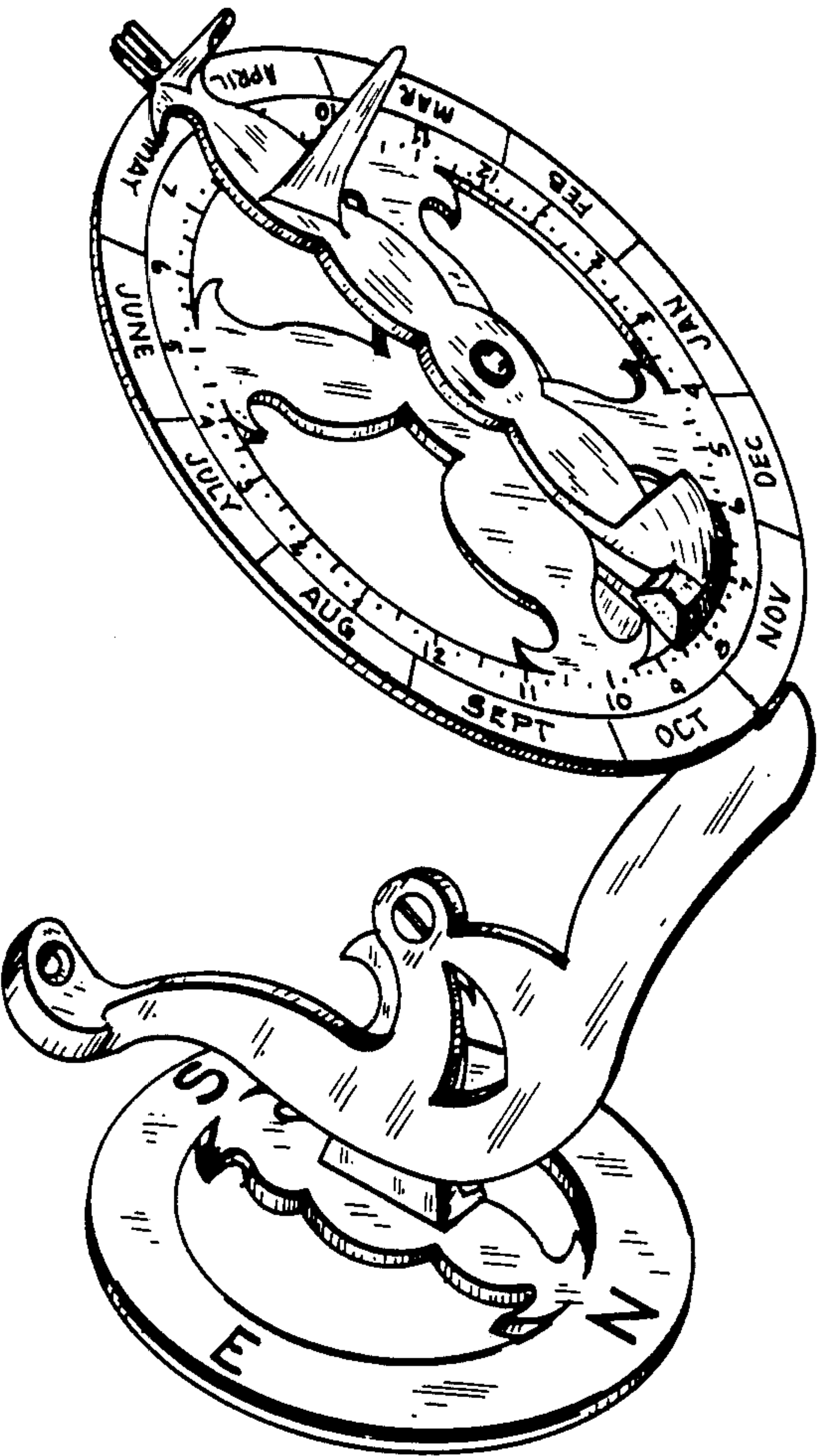

FIG. 2 is a right side perspective view thereof.



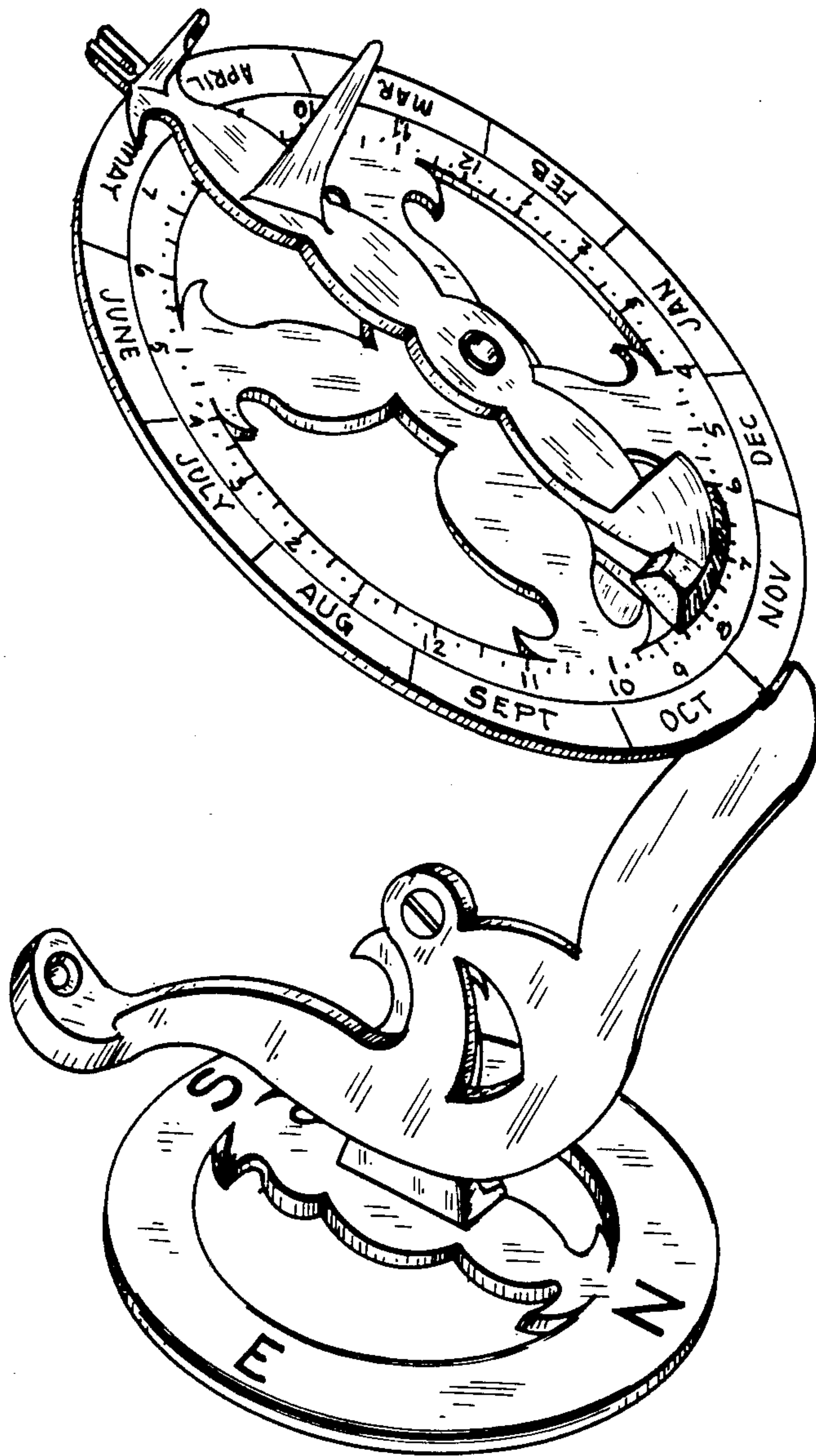
