FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy transceiver package showing our new design with some of the ornamentation seen in the remaining views being omitted for convenience of illustration;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view;


FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.














