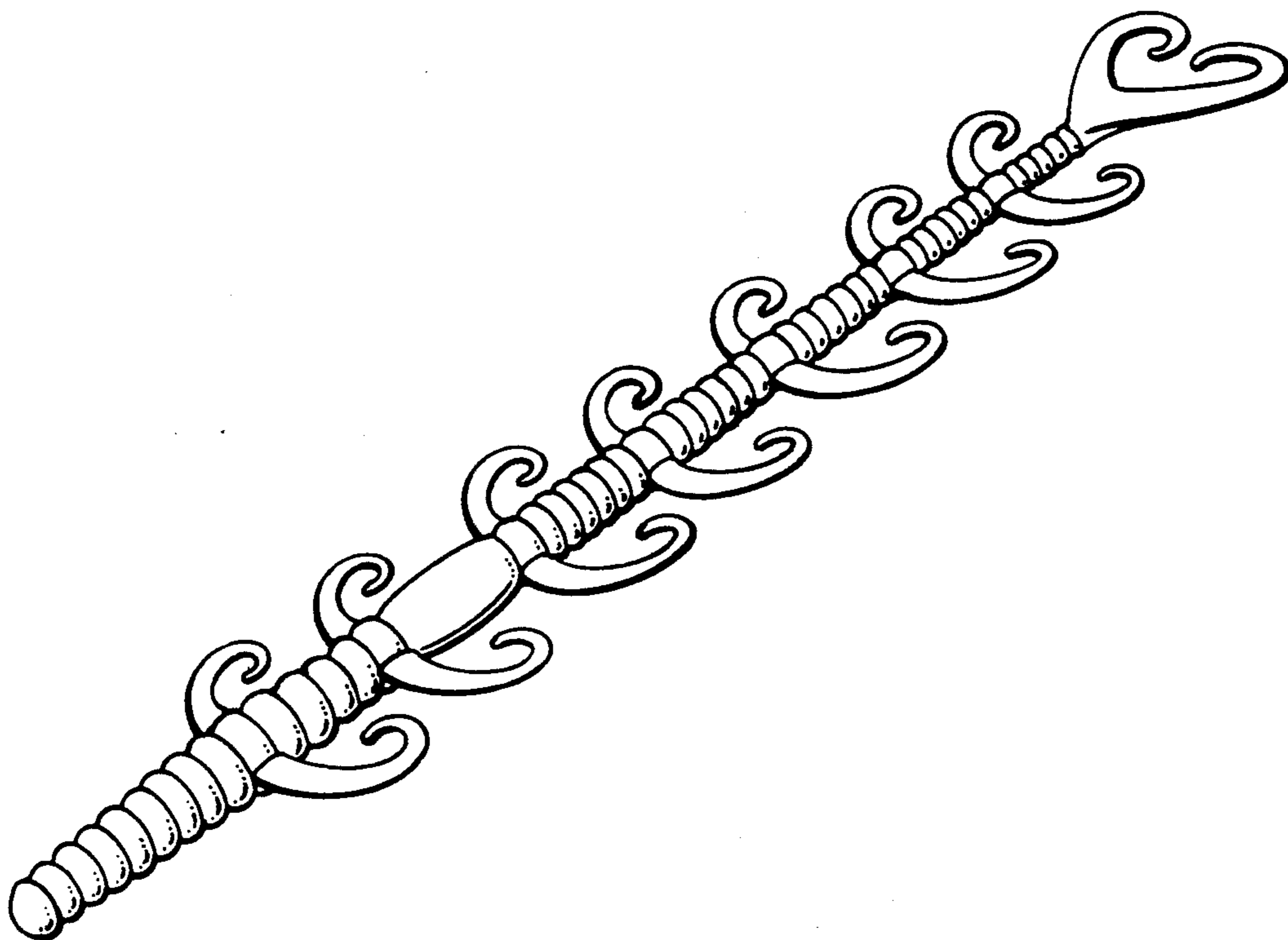

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing lure body embodying my new design.

 FIG. 5 is a front end view thereof.



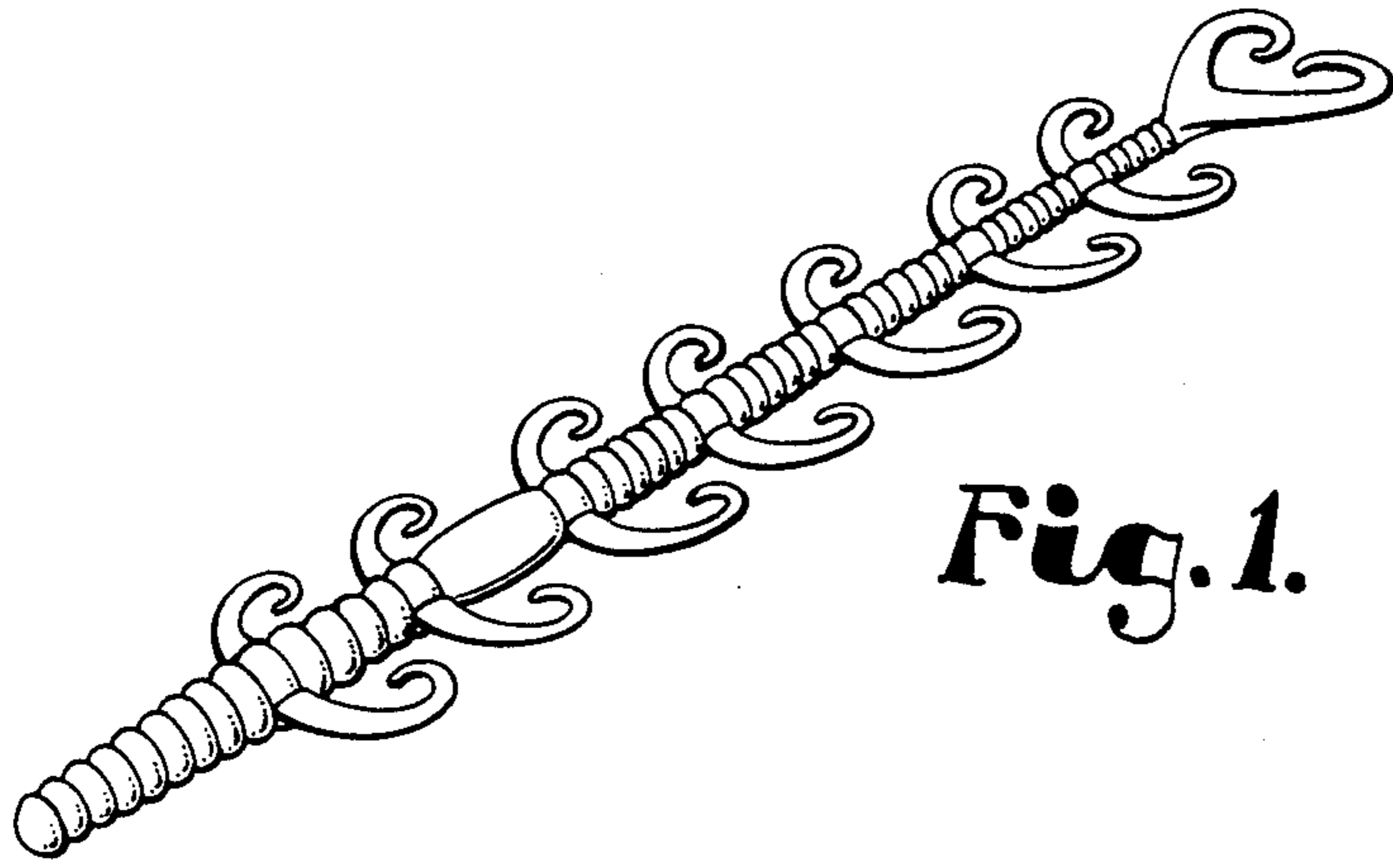

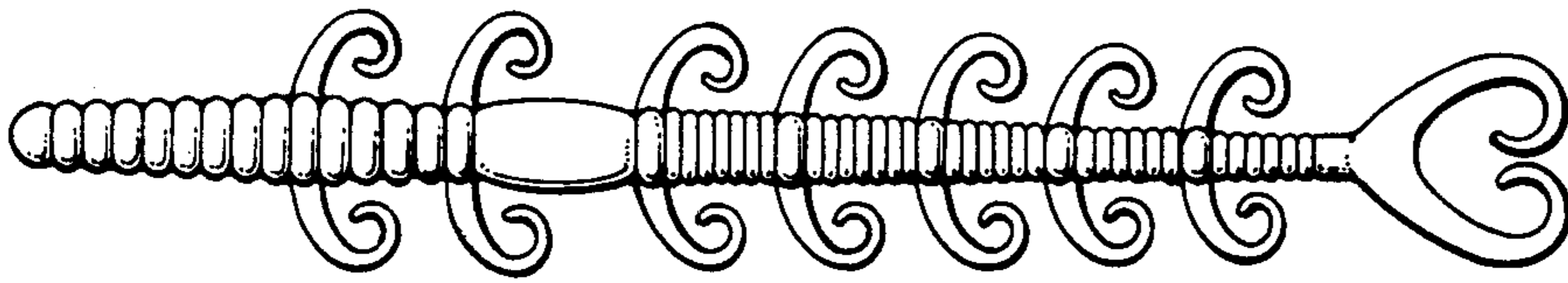
